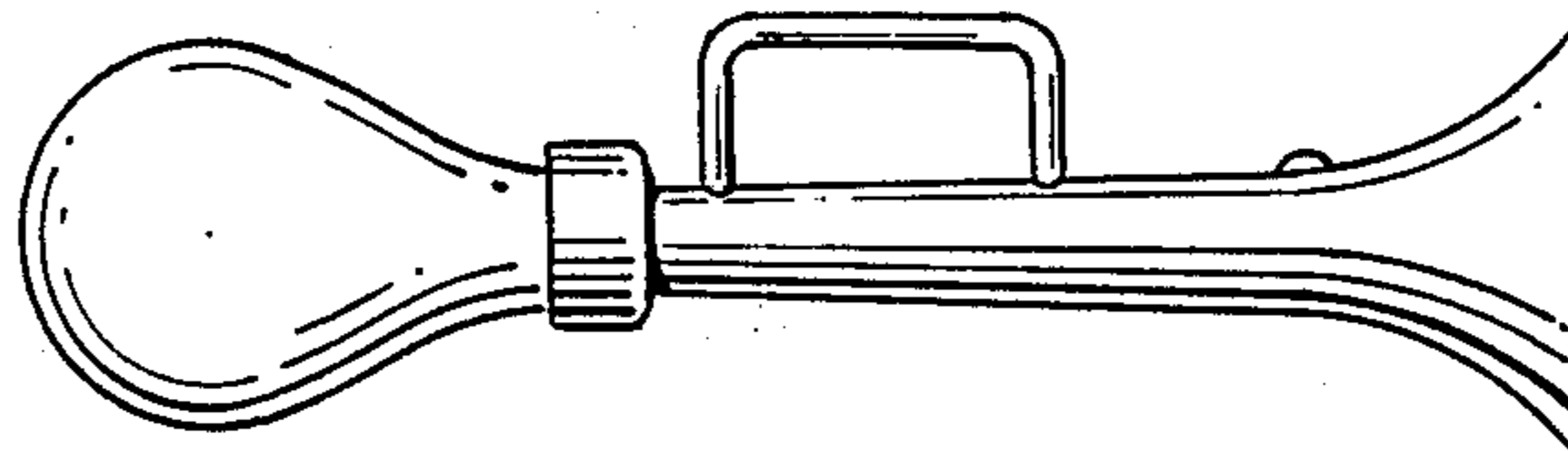
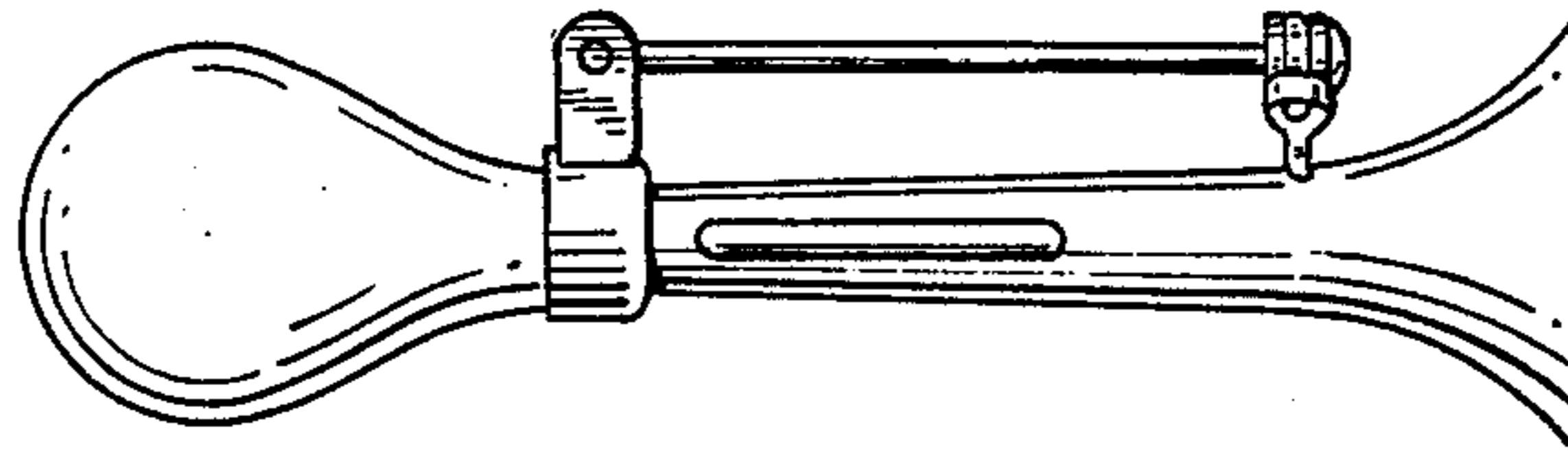

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined pendant and pin or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the design for a combined pendant and pin or similar article embodying the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the left hand end of the design of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 6 is an elevational view of the right hand end of the design of FIG. 1.



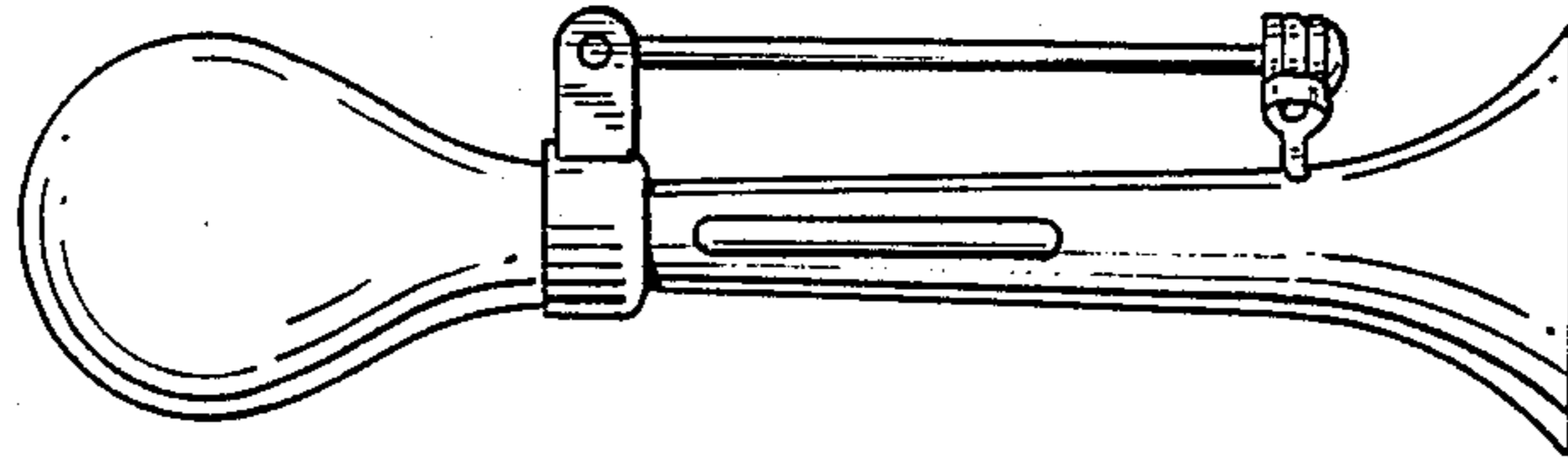

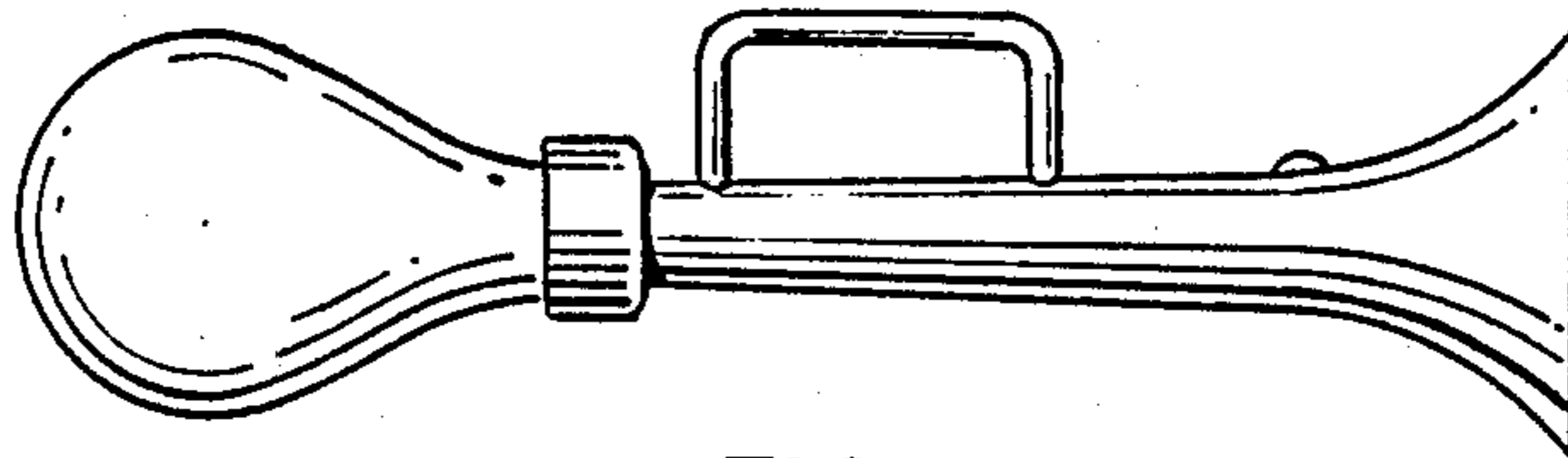

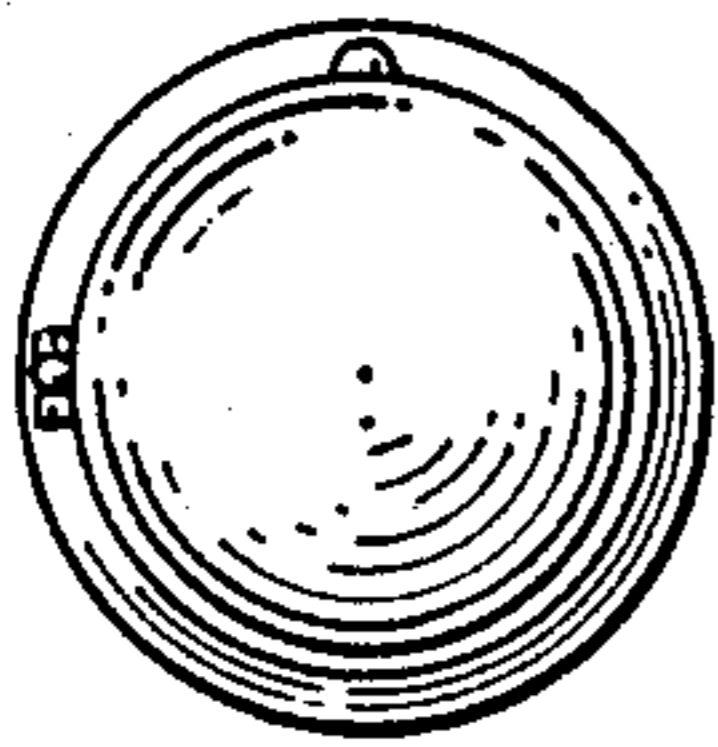

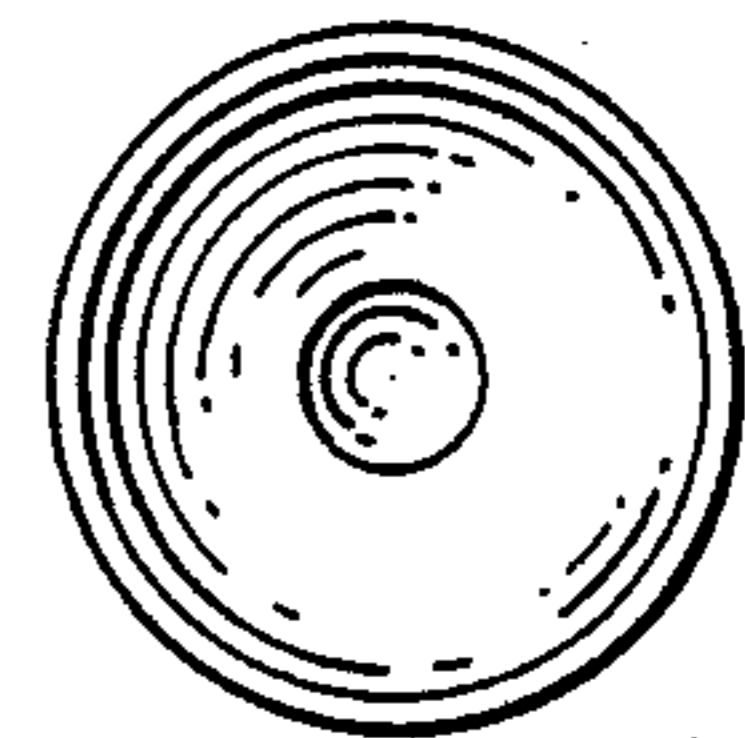

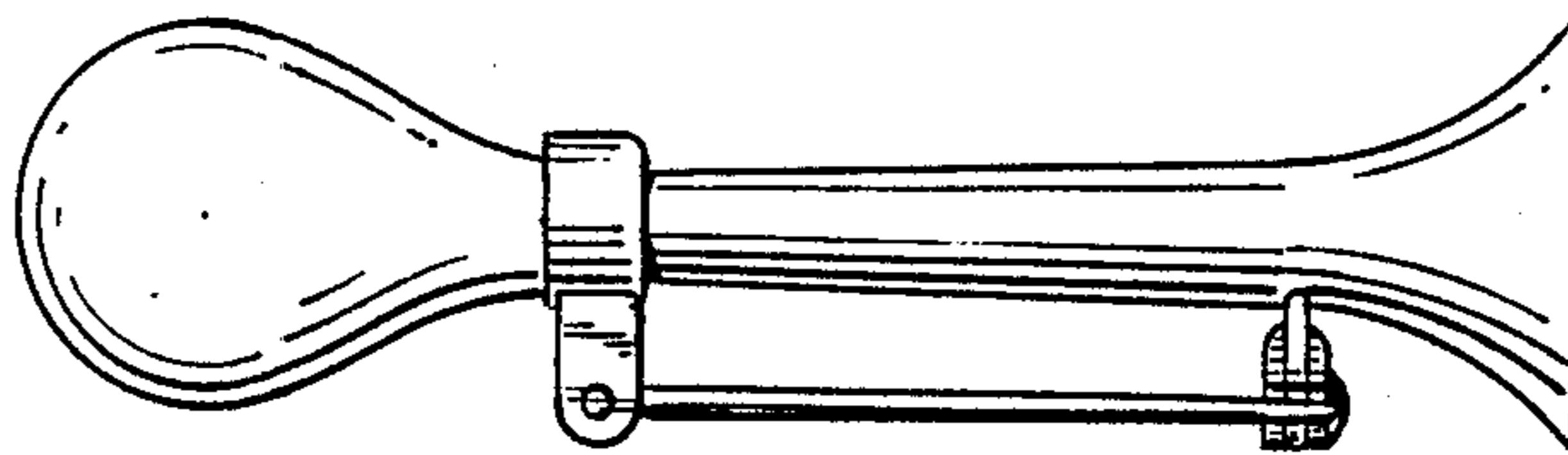

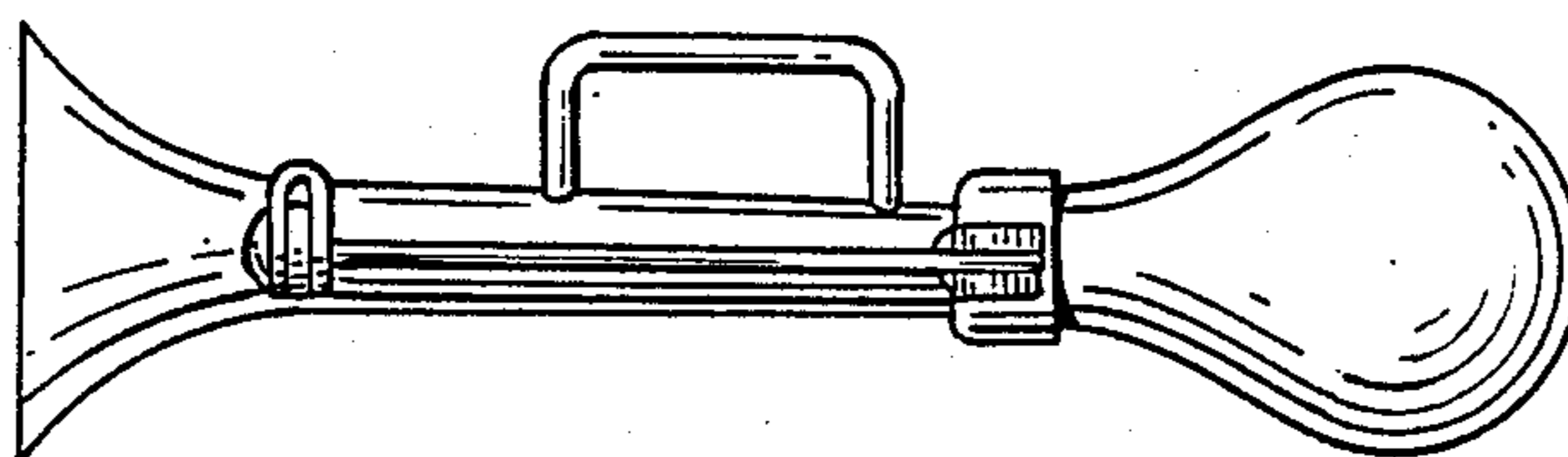
