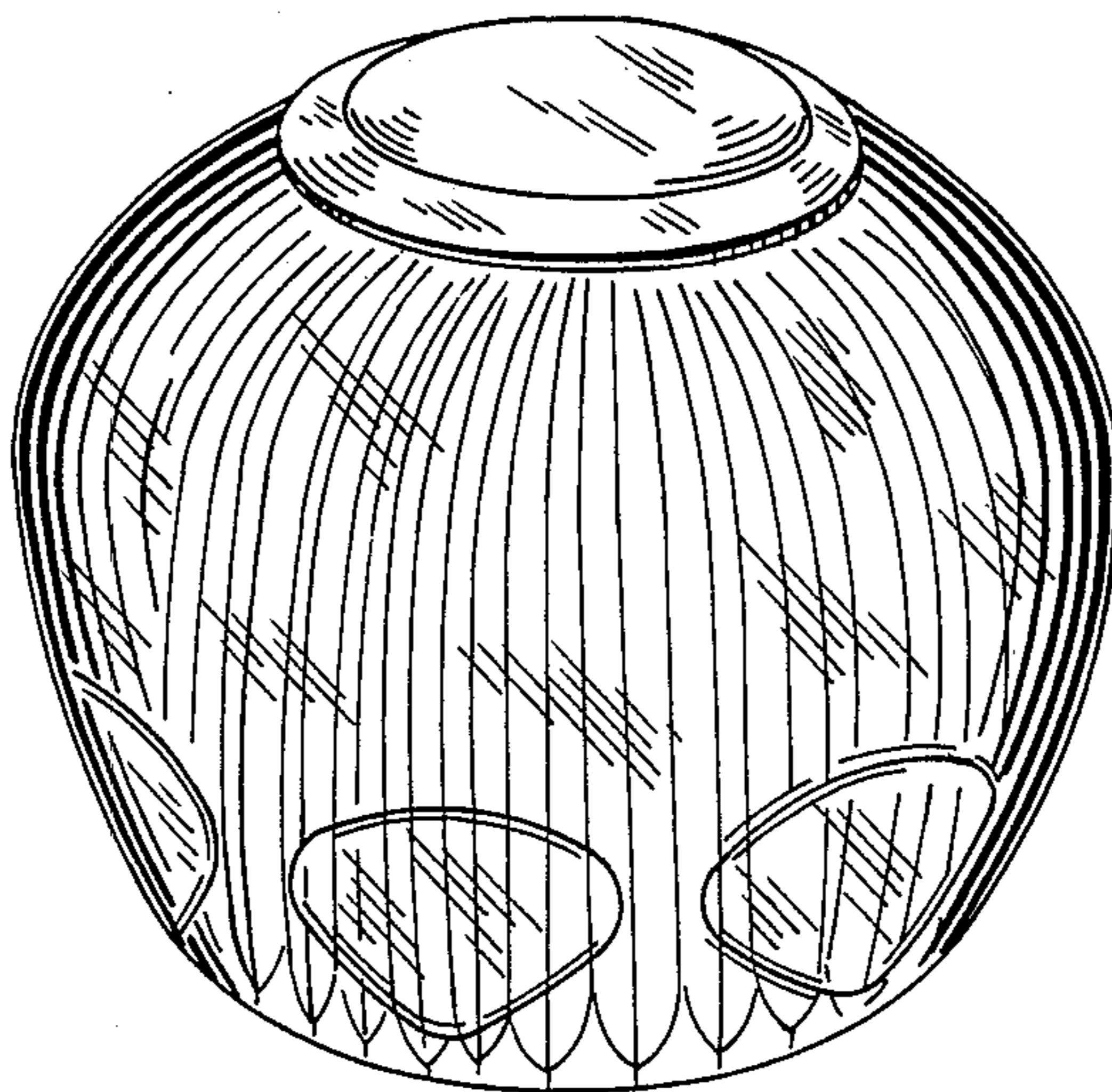
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a faucet handle or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a faucet handle or the like showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other sides being the same as the side shown;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a sectional view thereof taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 2; and
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

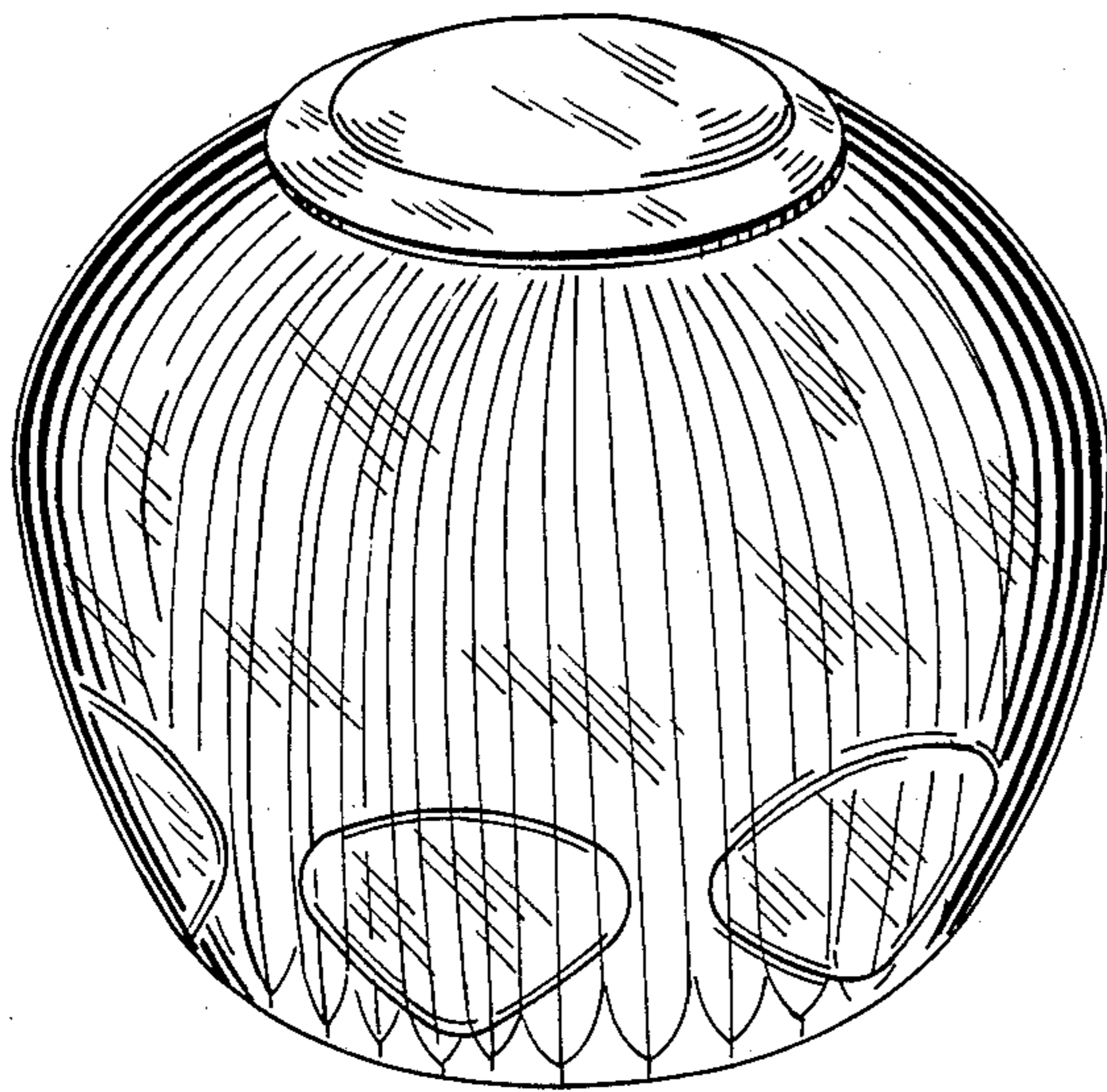

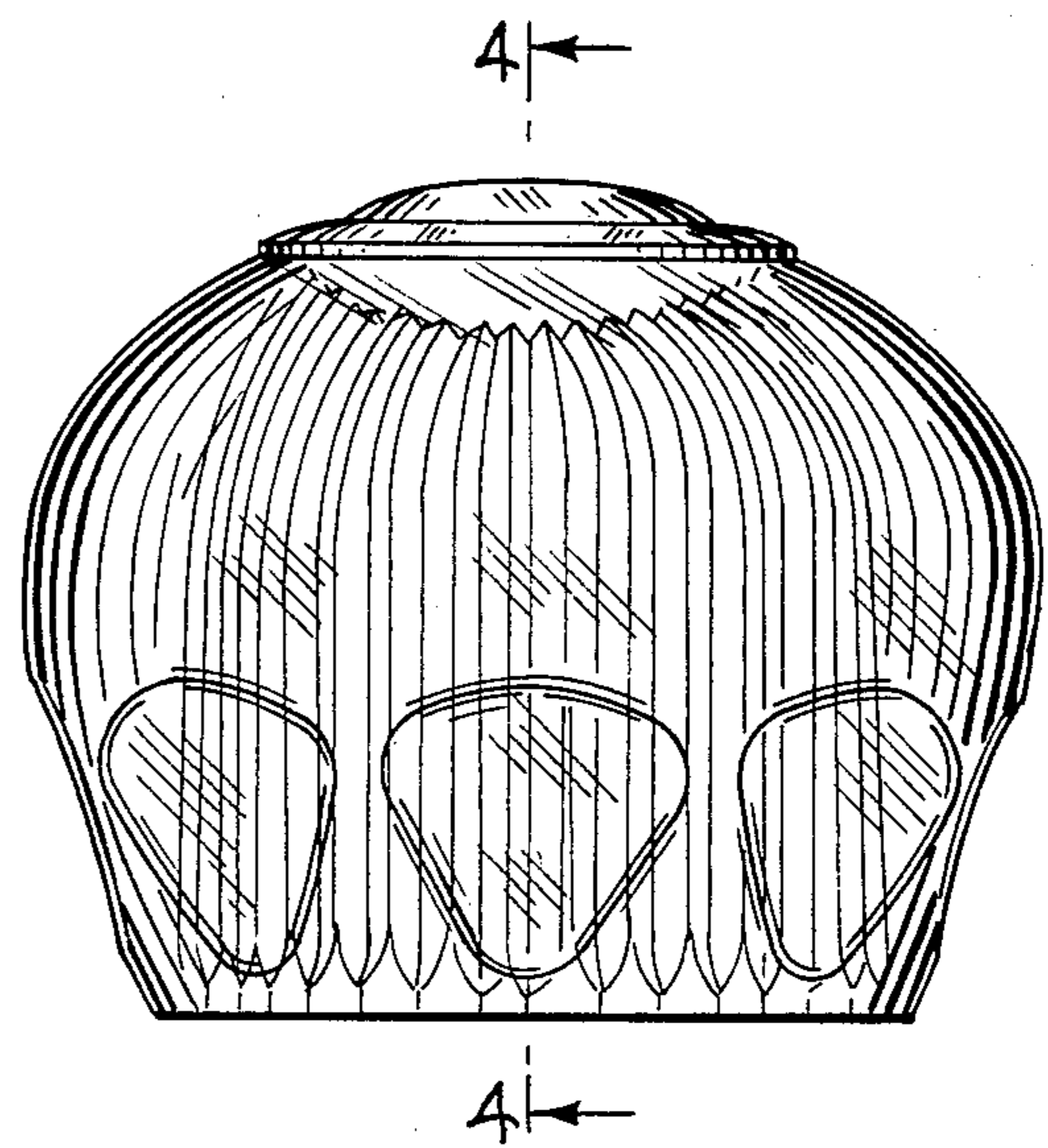

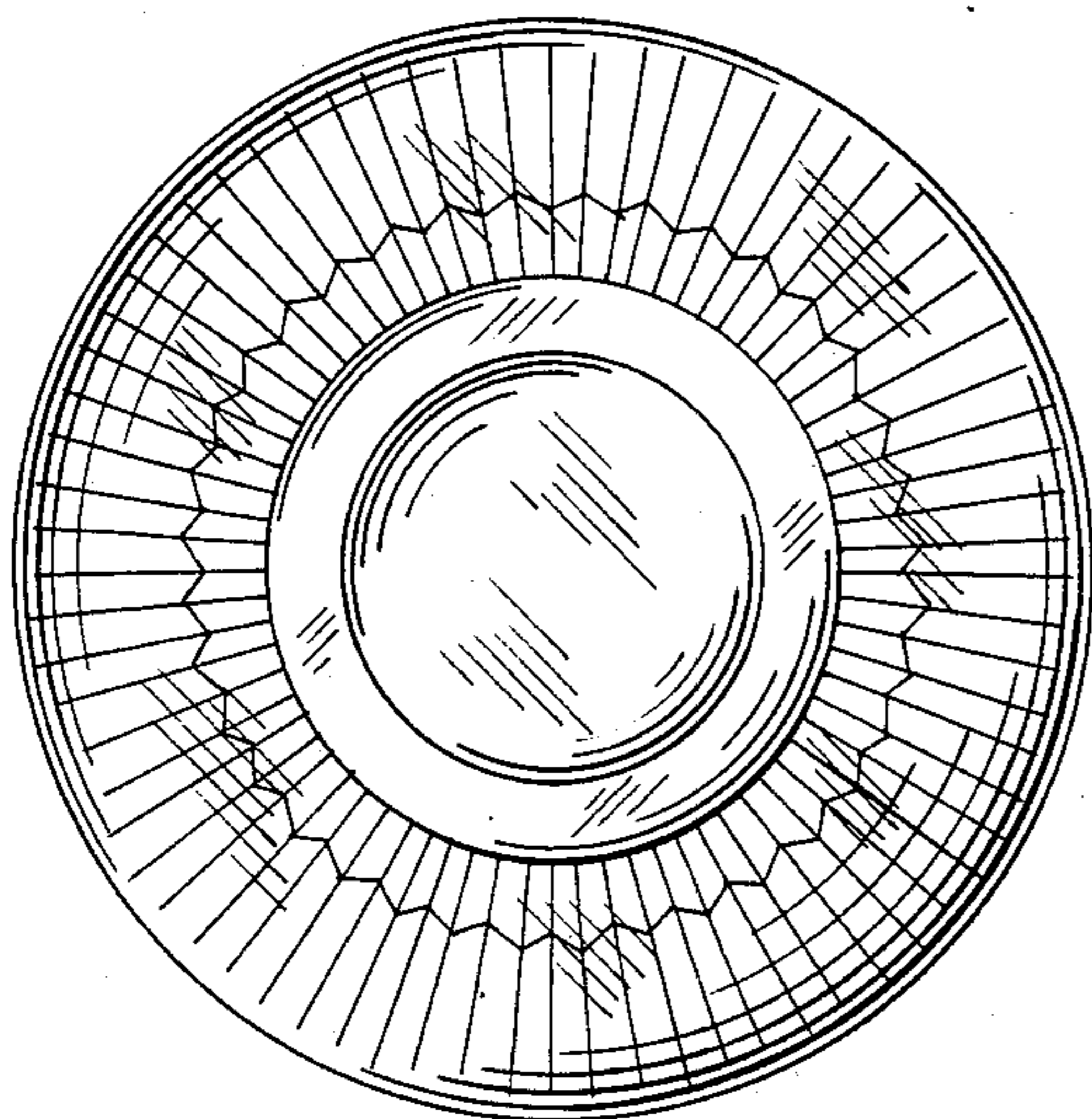

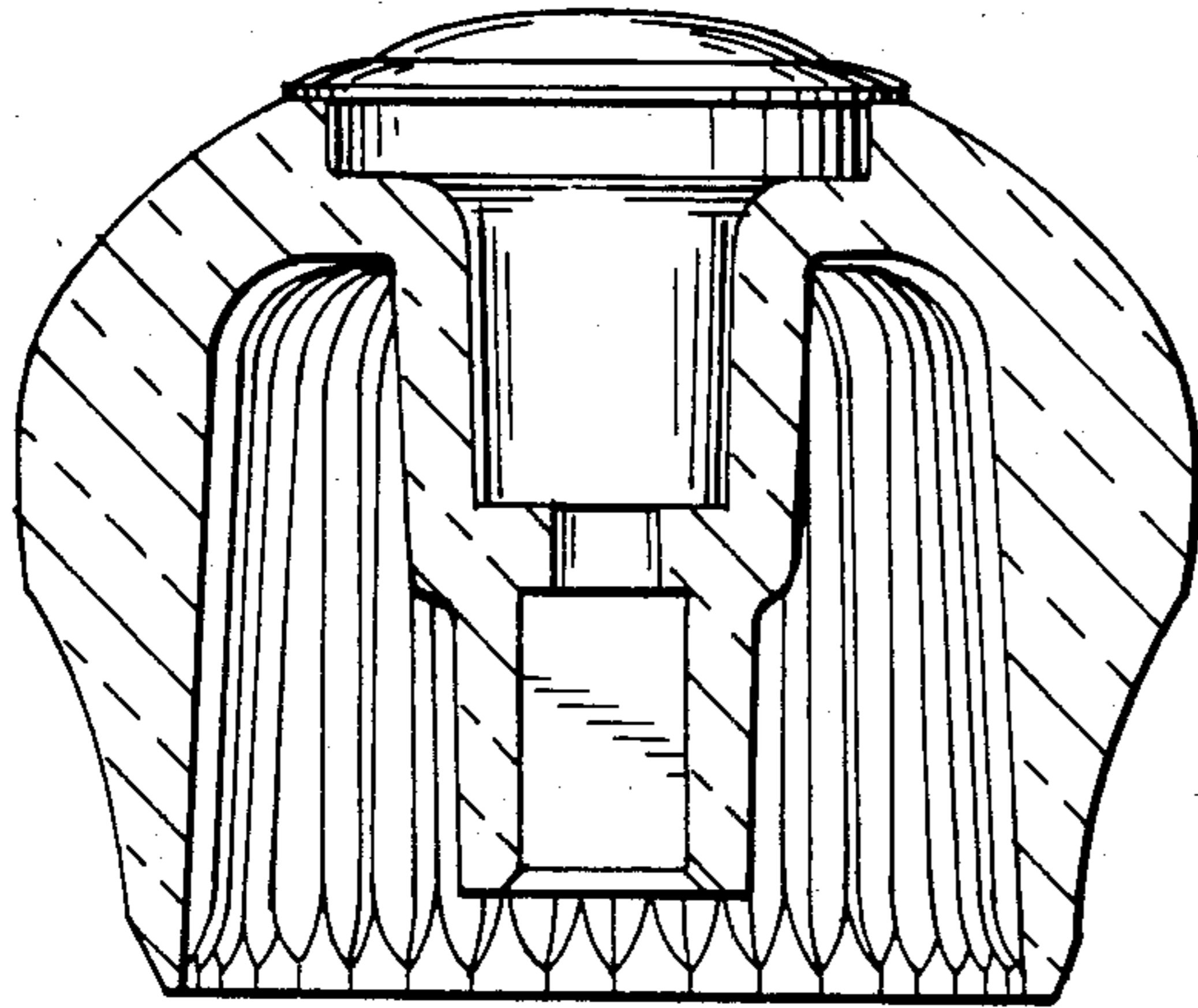
