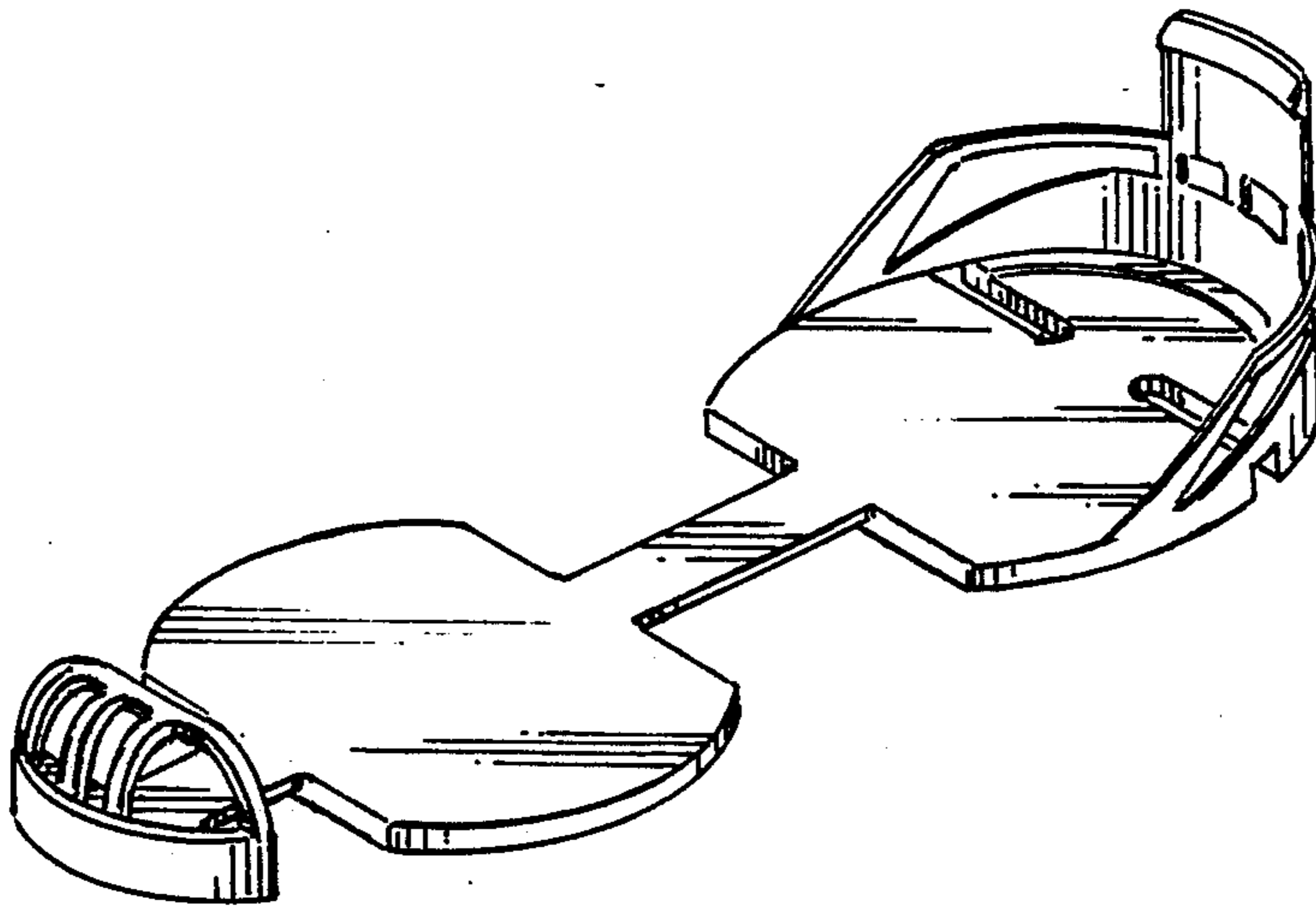

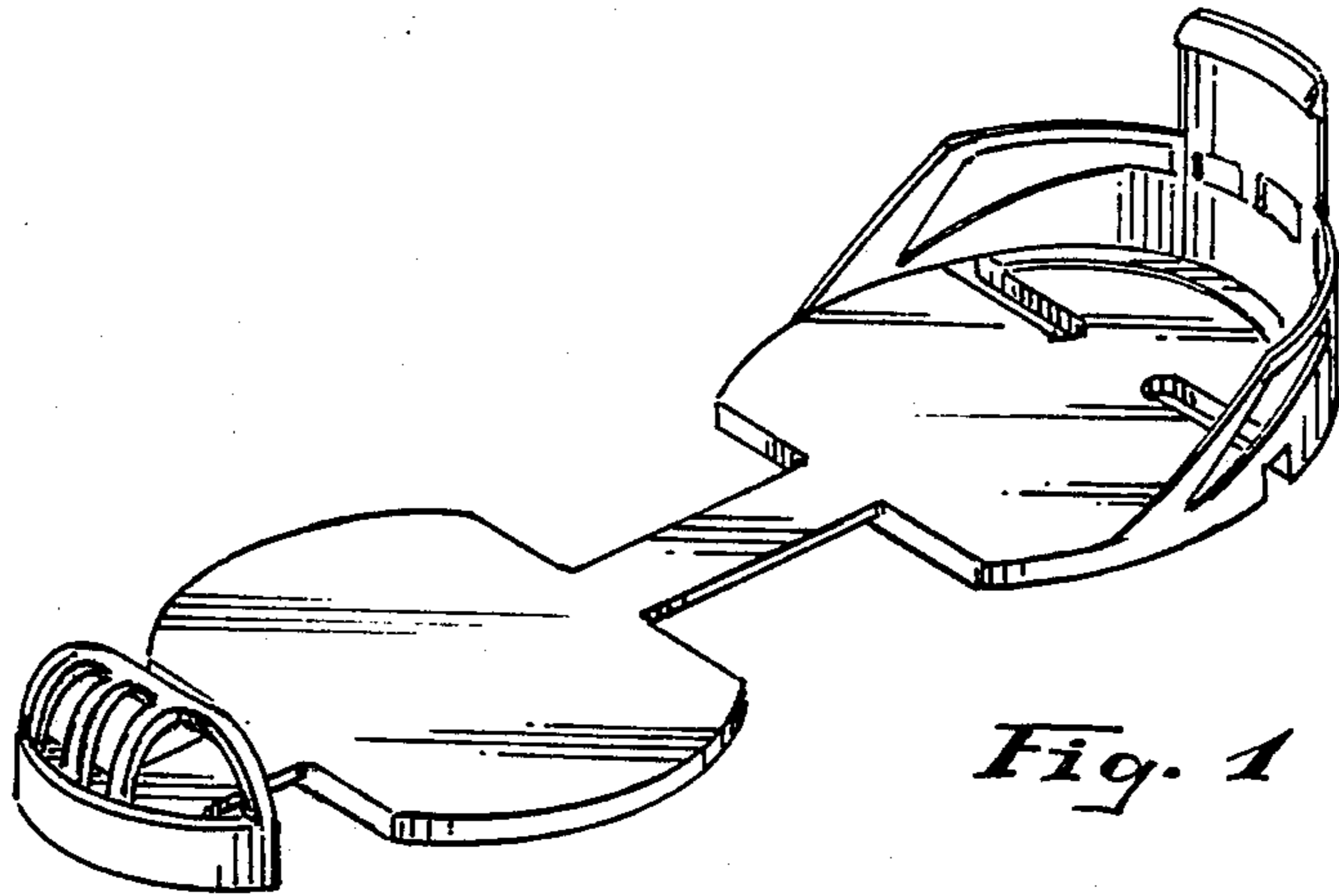
The ornamental design for a bowling shoe protector, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

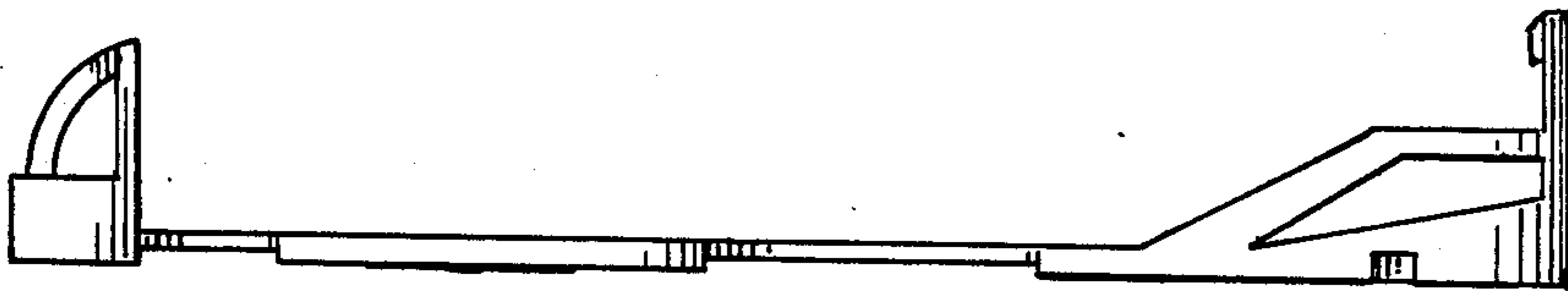
FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a bowling shoe protector, showing my new design;

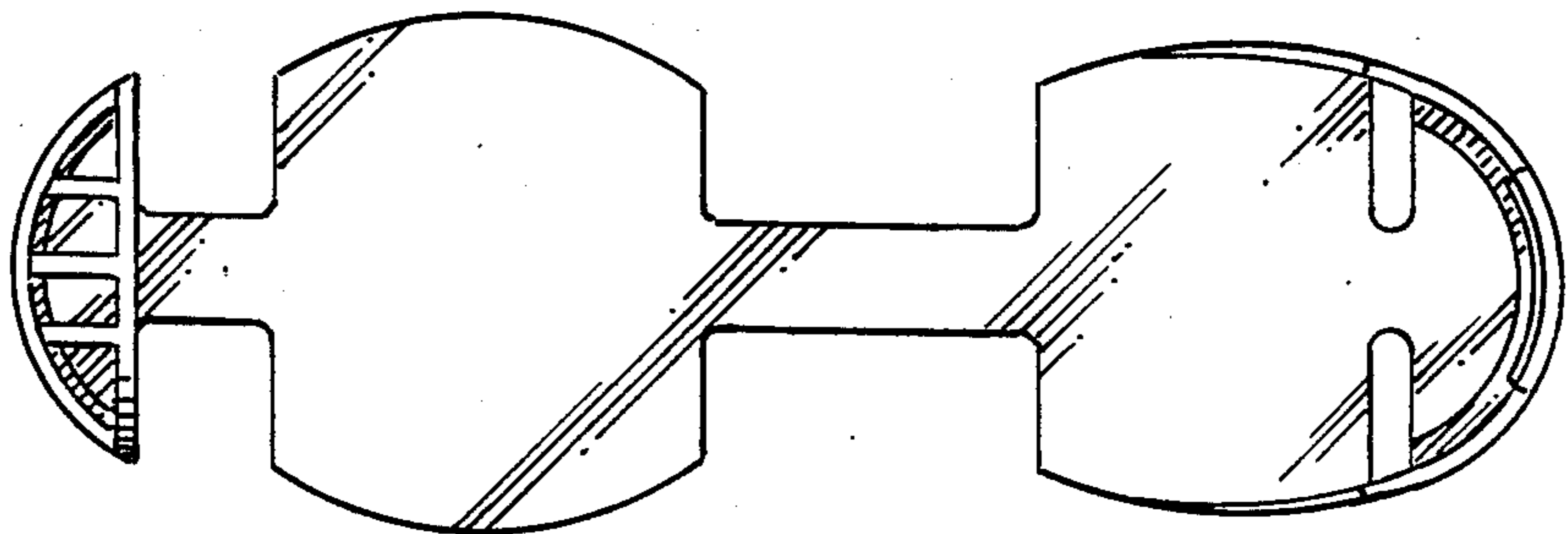




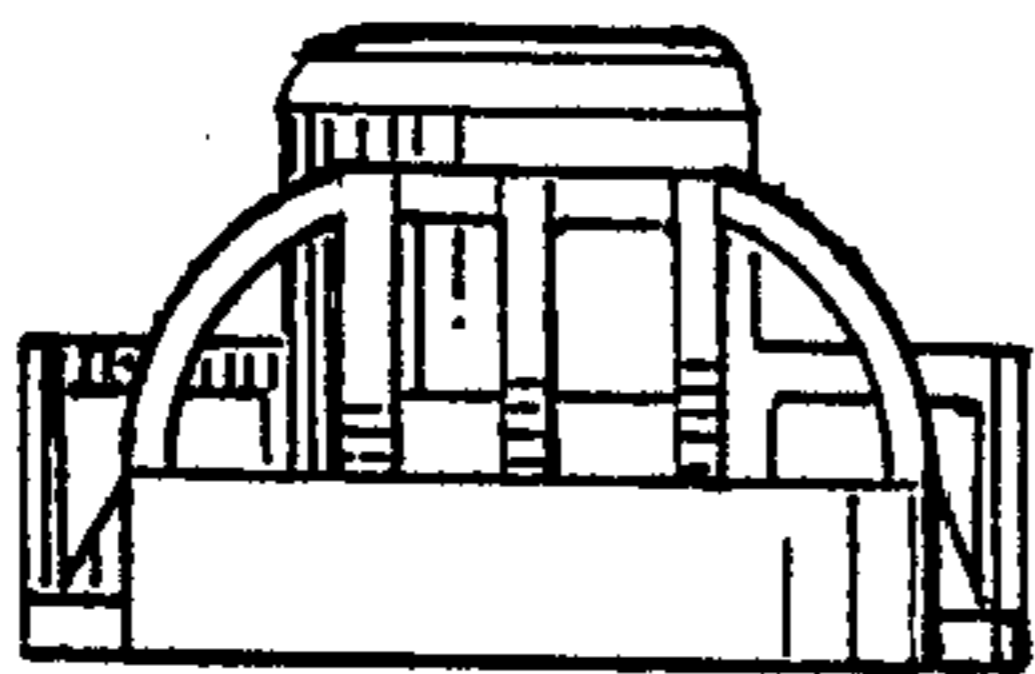

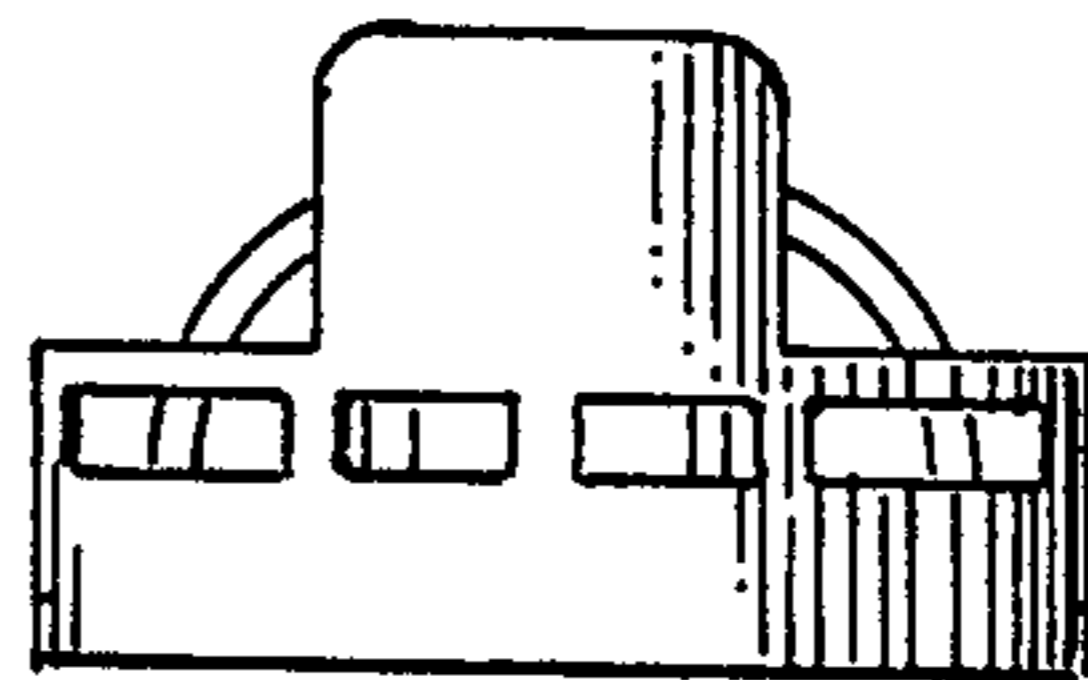

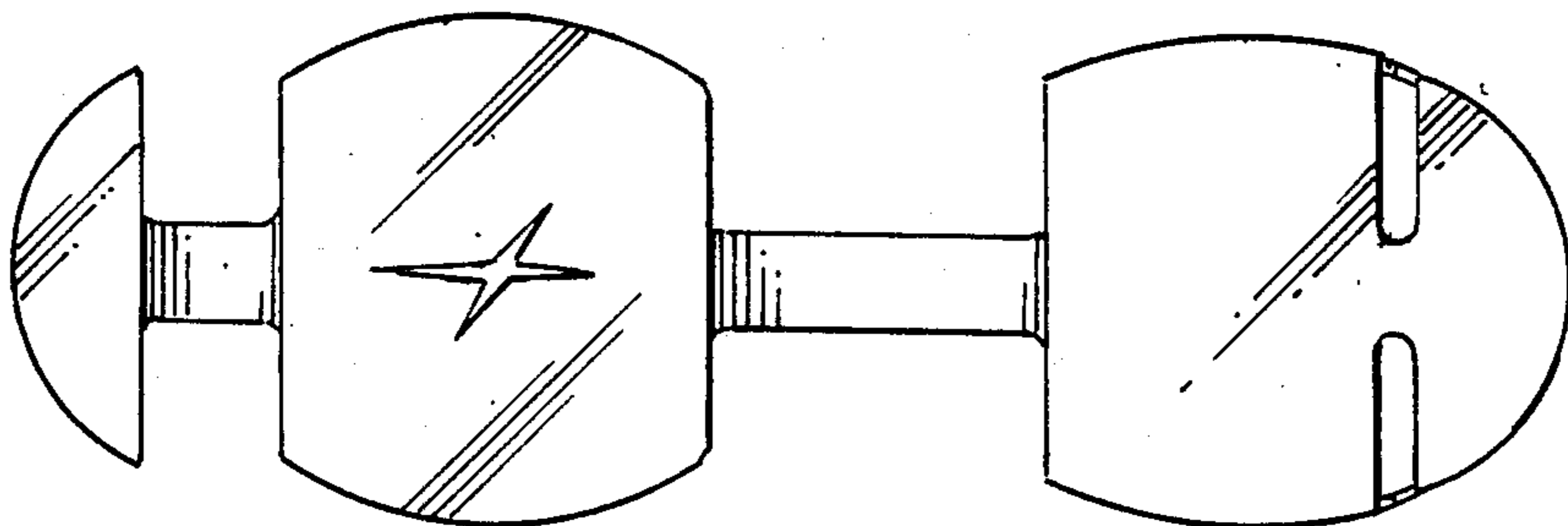
