DESCRIPTION

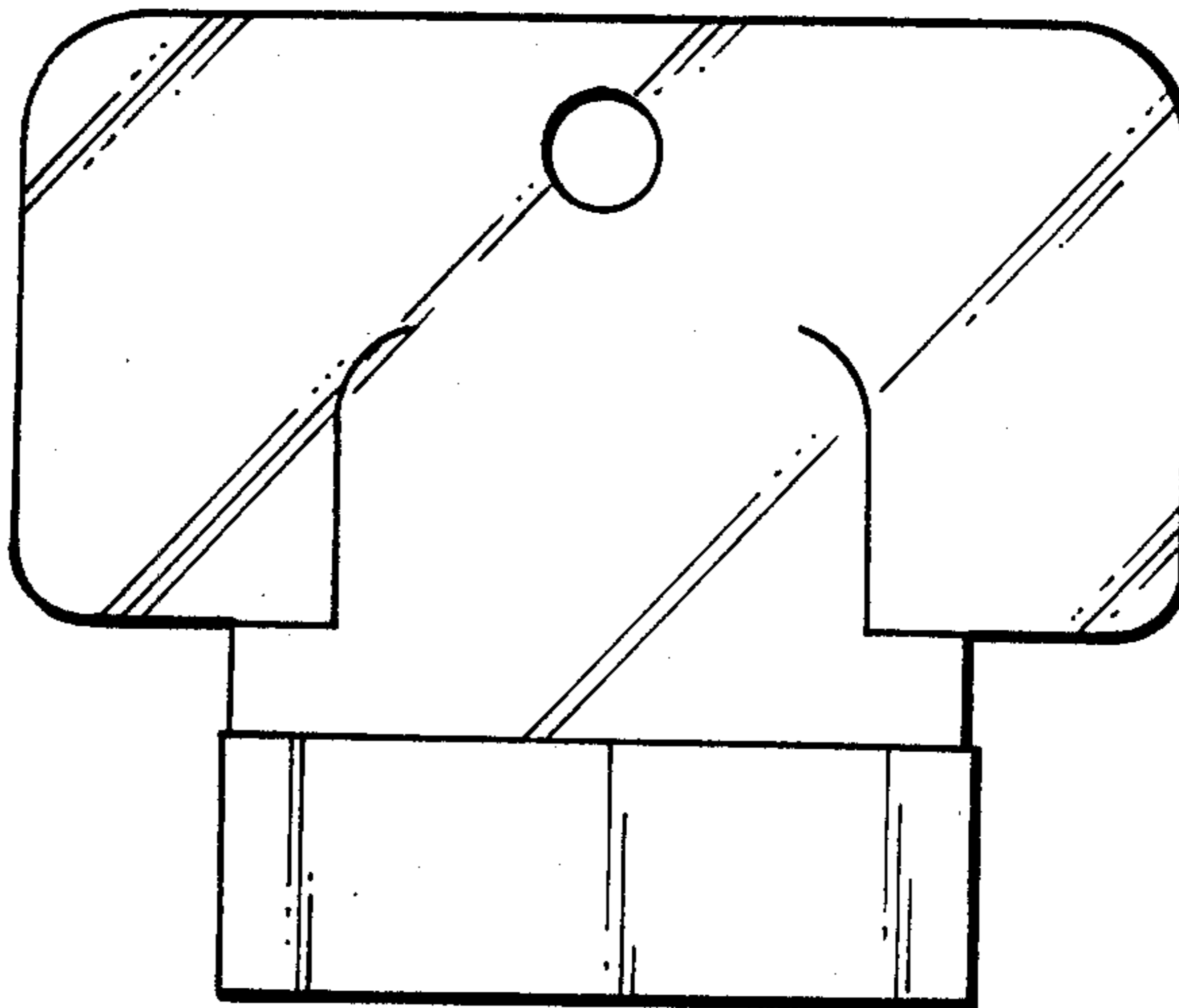
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a shelf clip for hold-  
ing promotional advertising materials showing my new  
design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



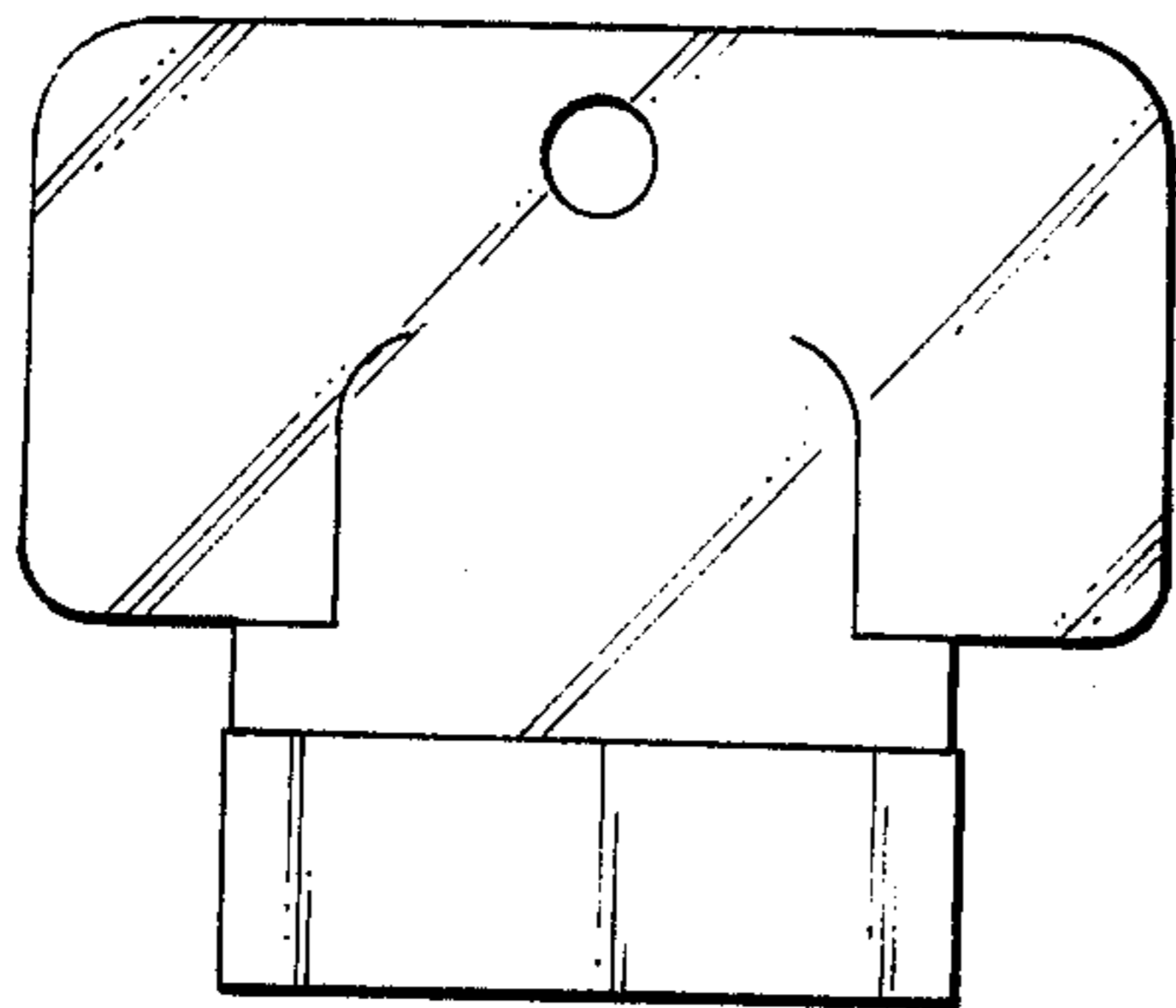

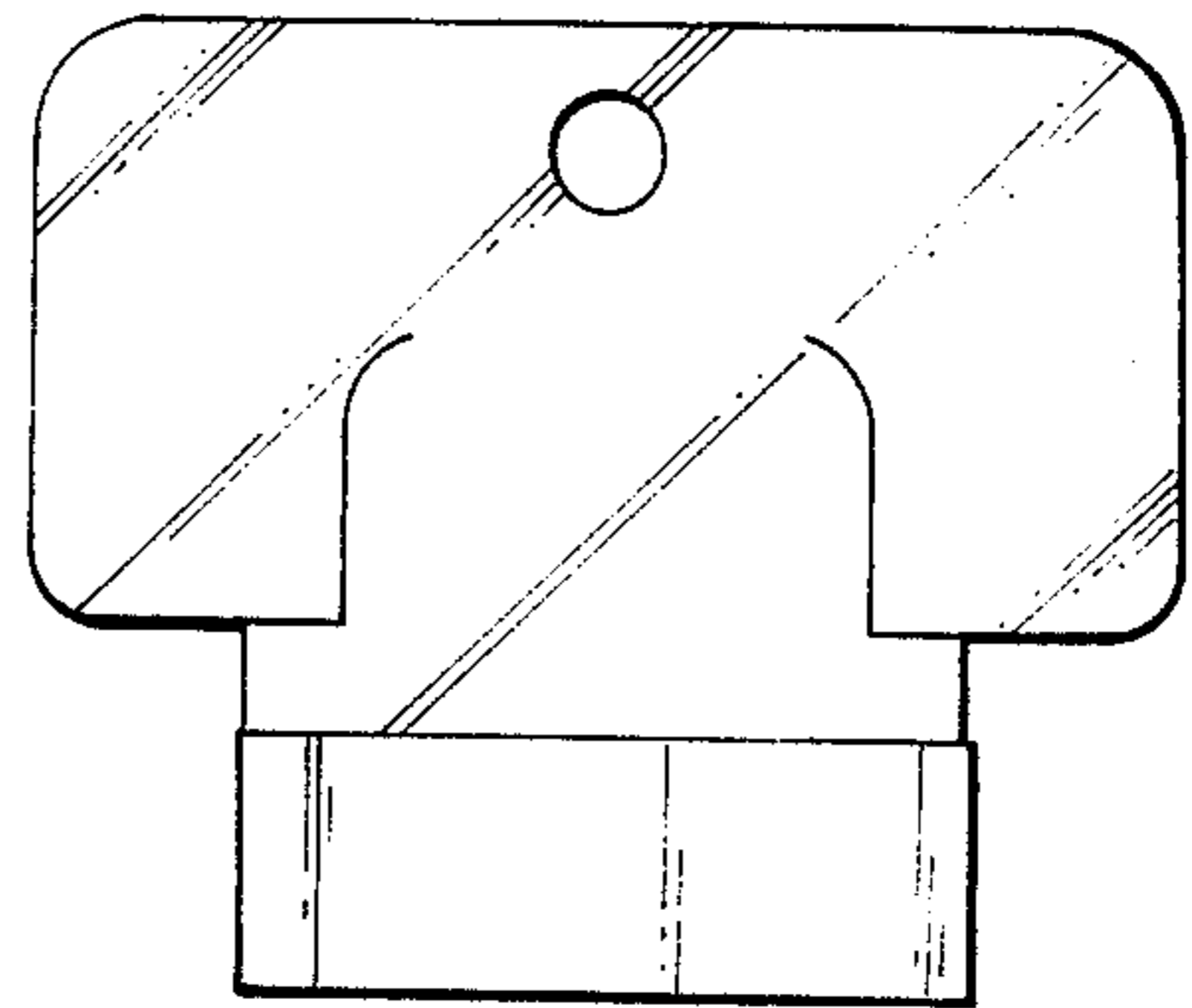

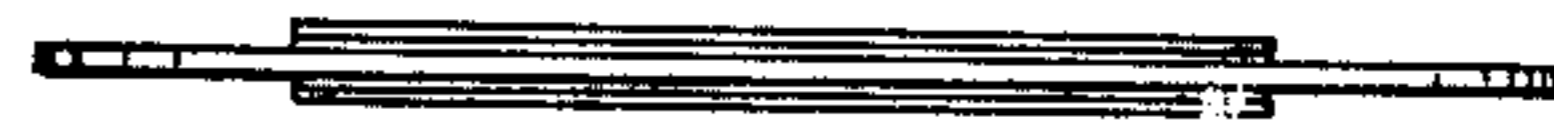

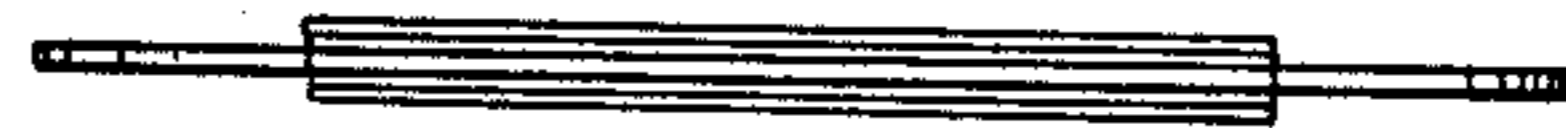
