[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a bathtub, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bathtub embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from one side thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and one side thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a modified form of the bathtub shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is an elevational view taken from one side of FIG. 7, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7; and

FIG. 12 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and one side of FIG. 7.

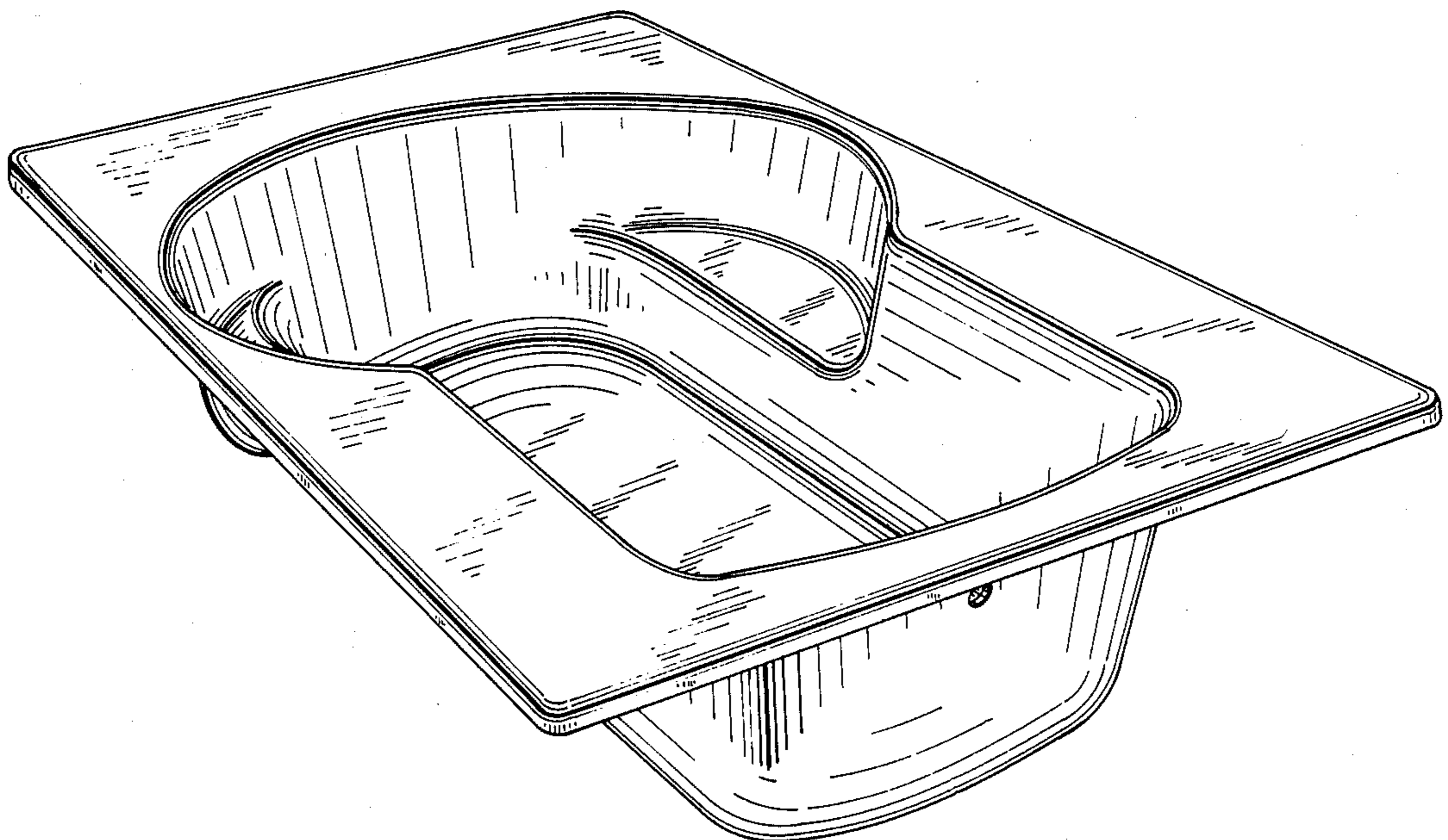

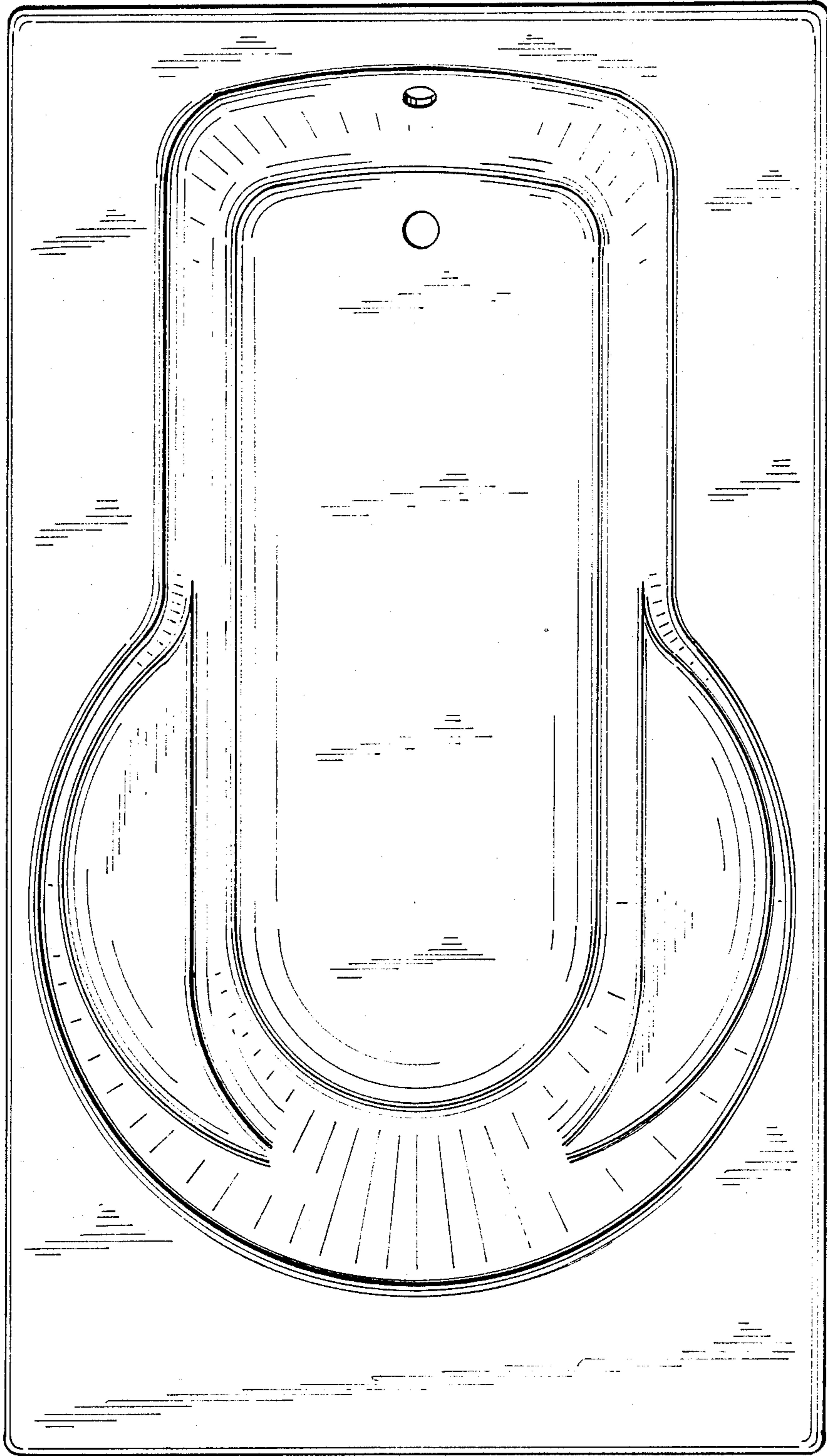

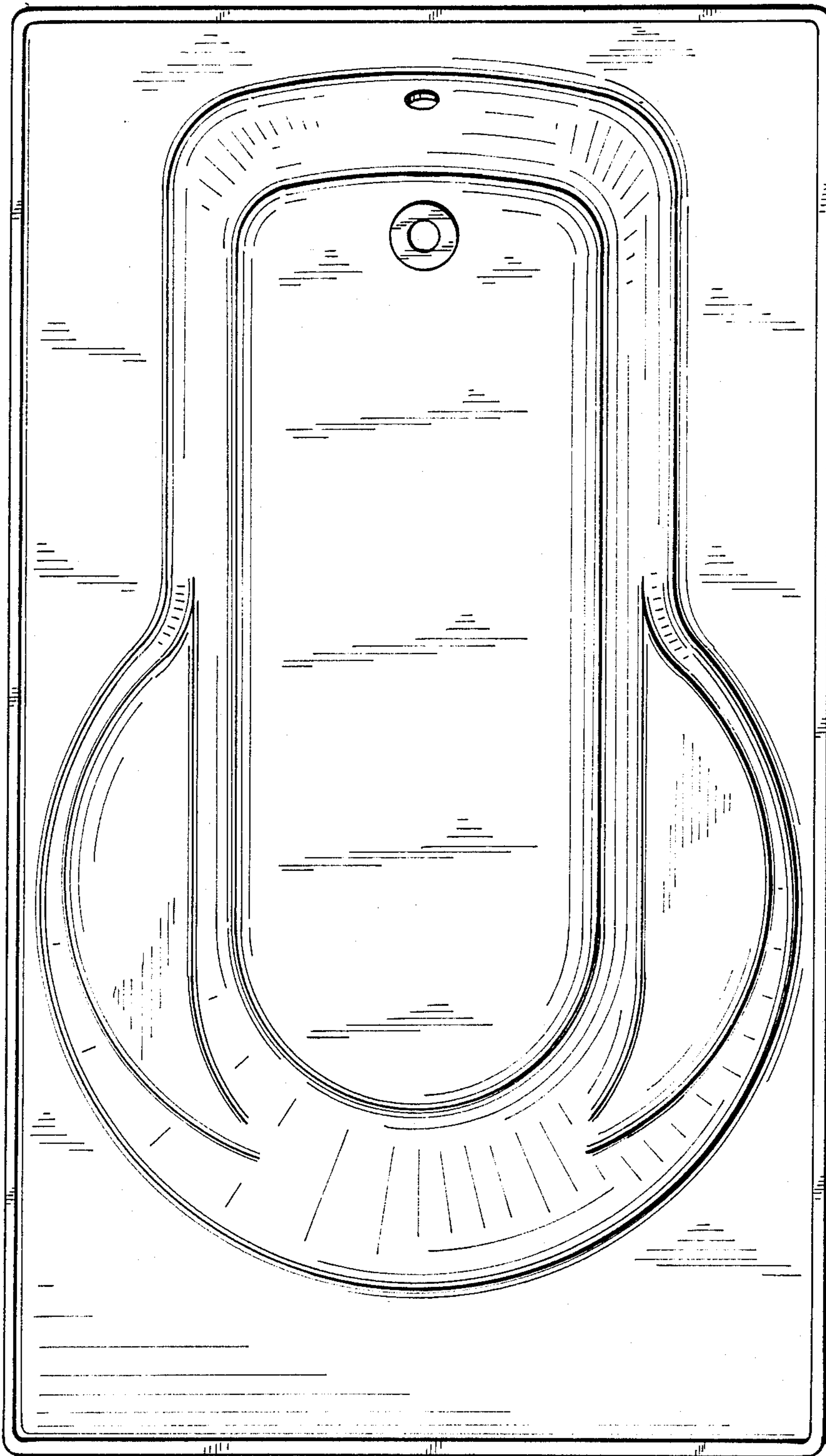

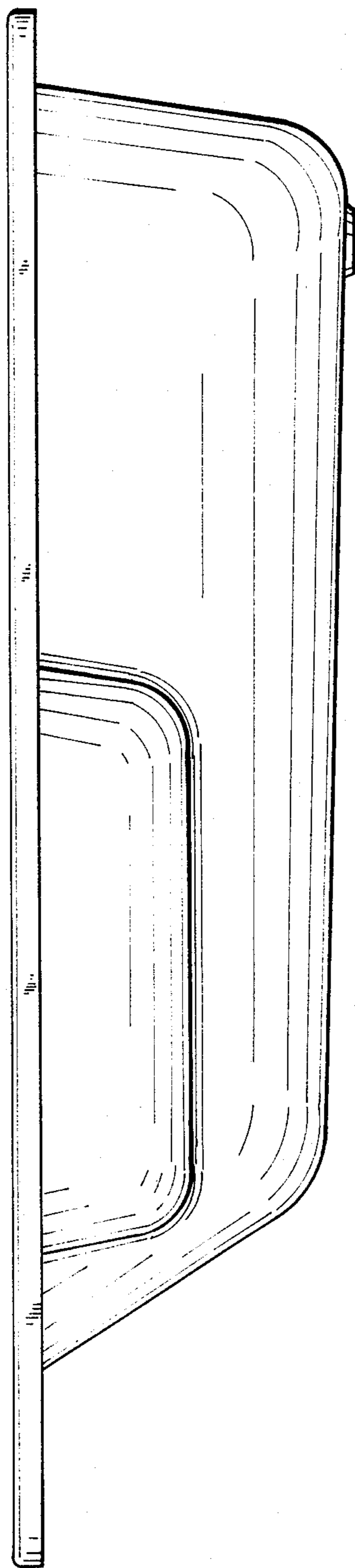

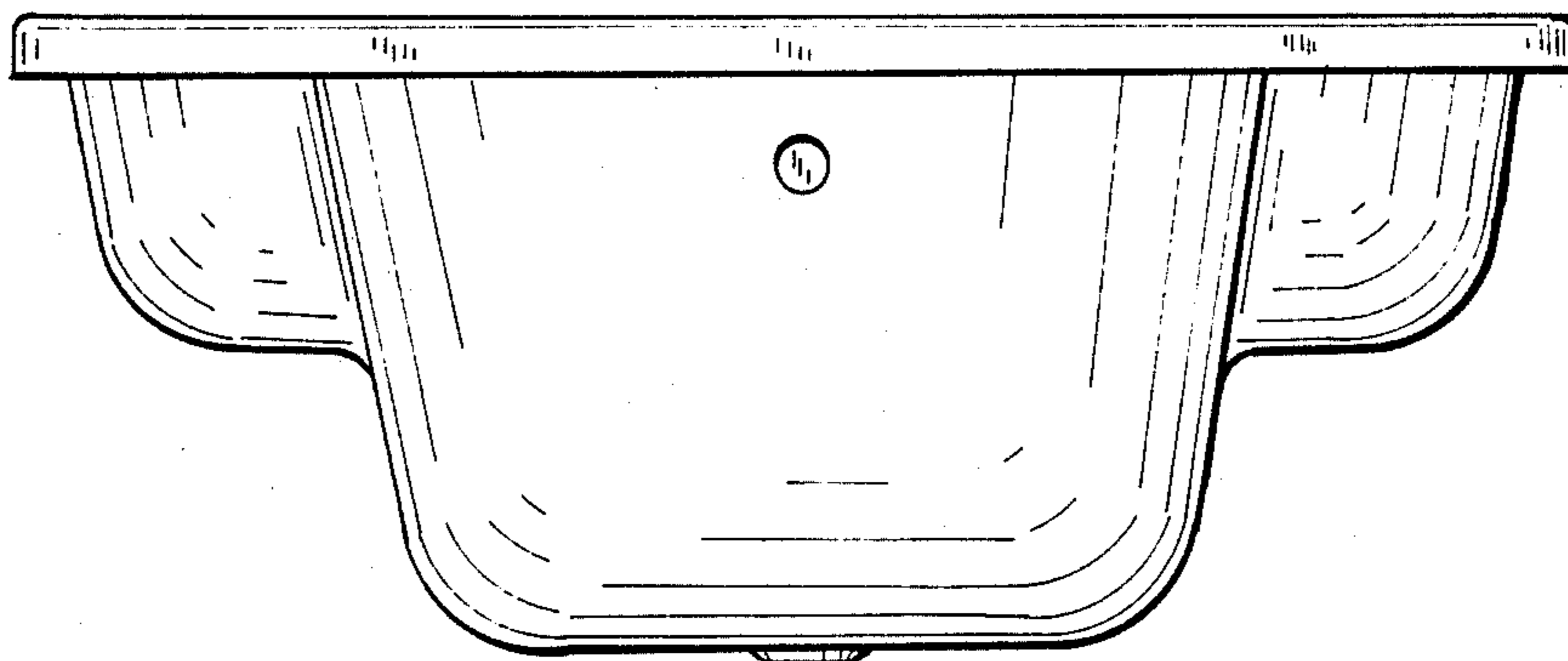

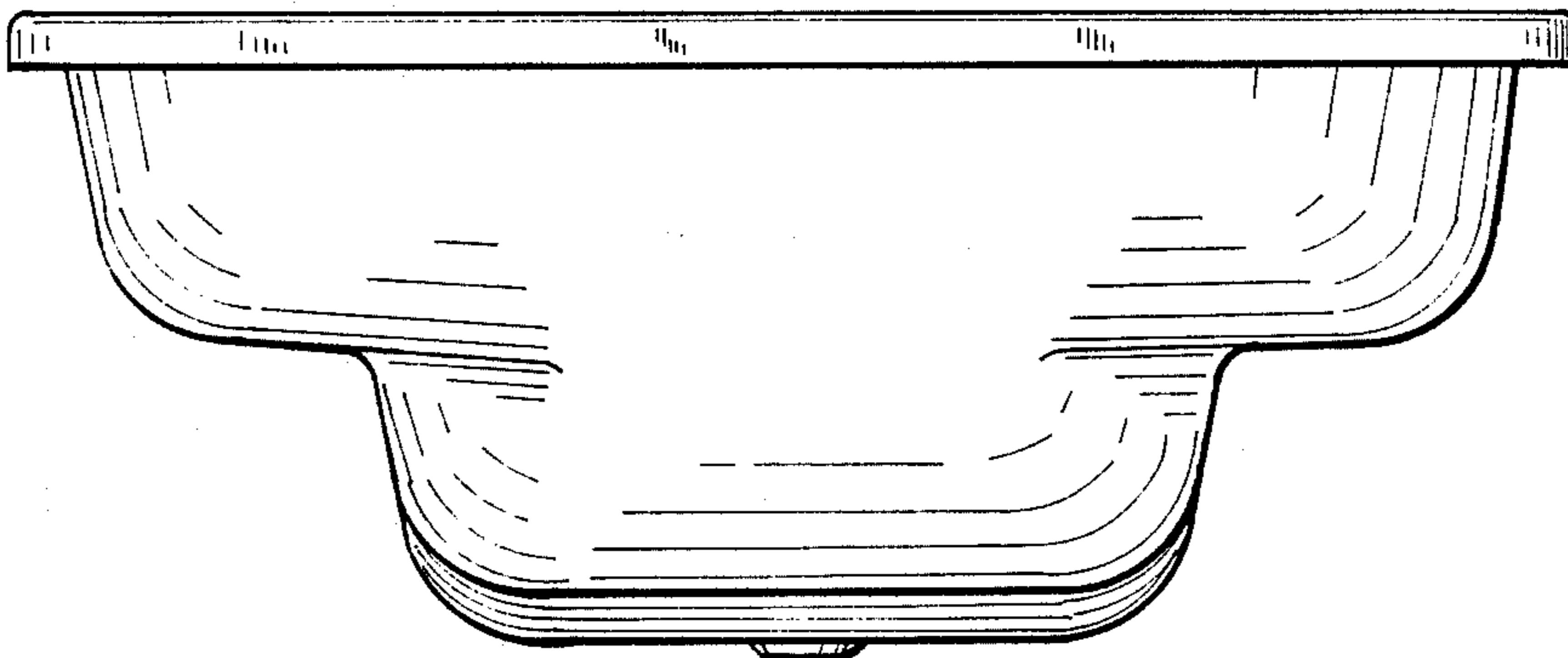

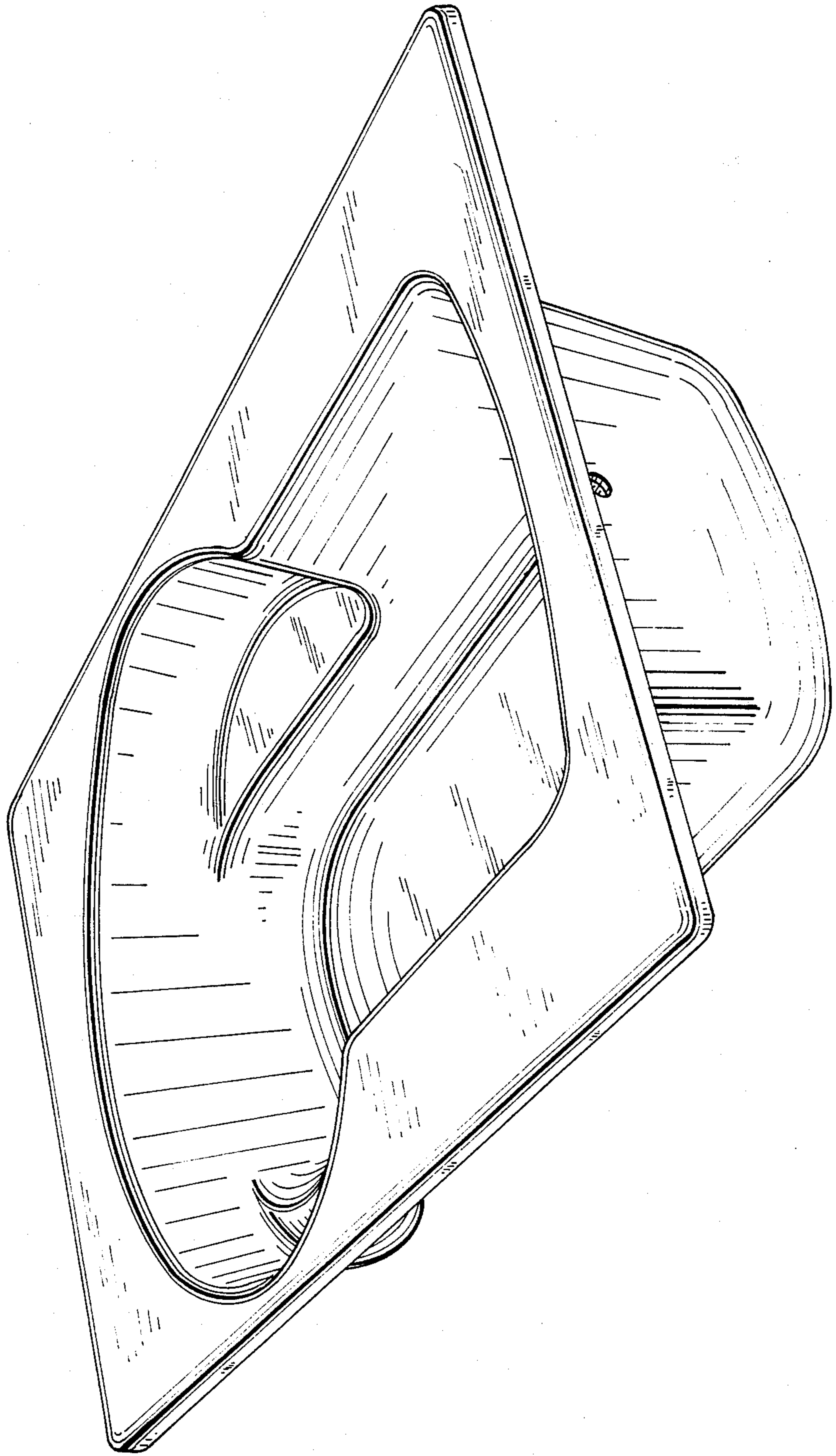

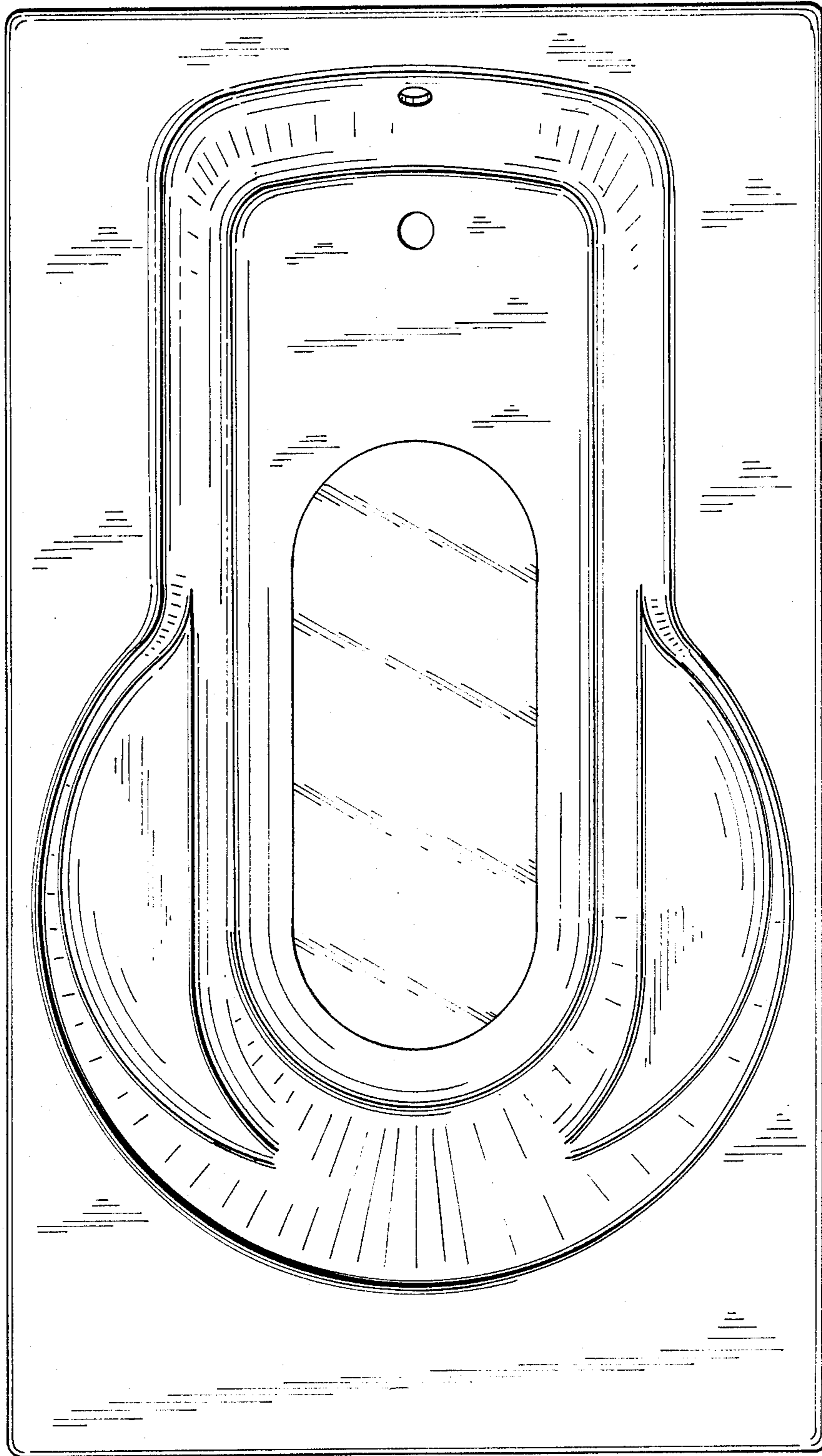

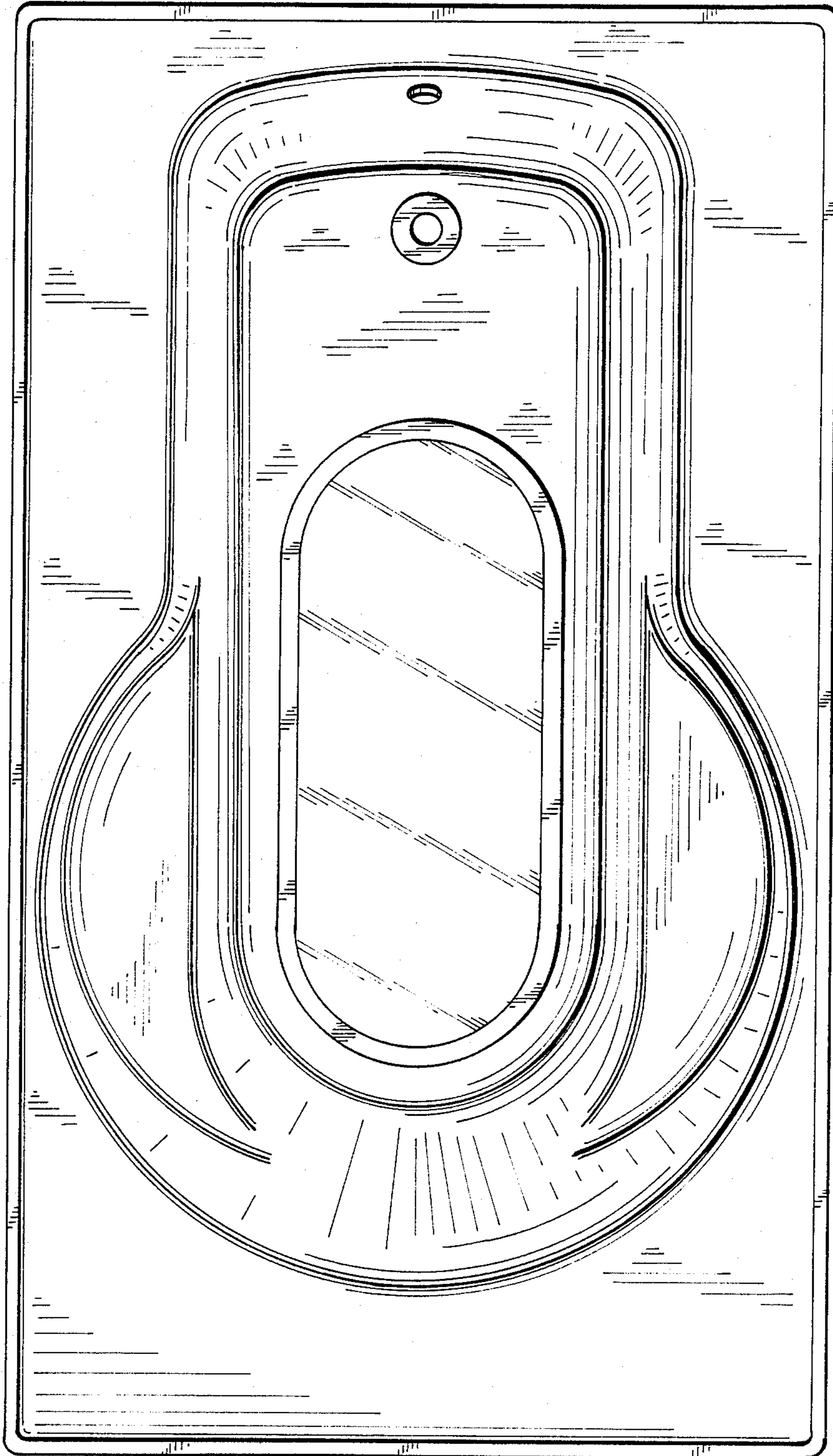
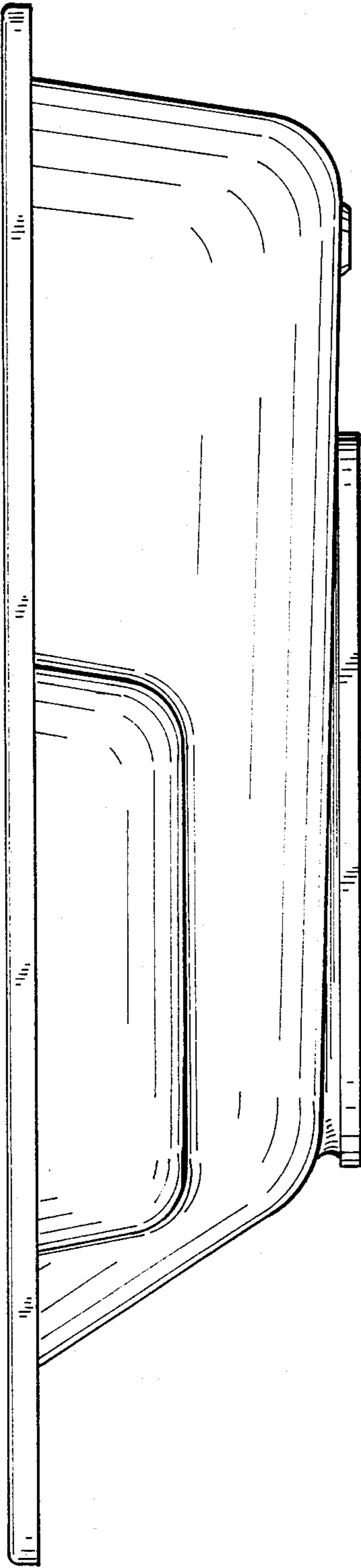
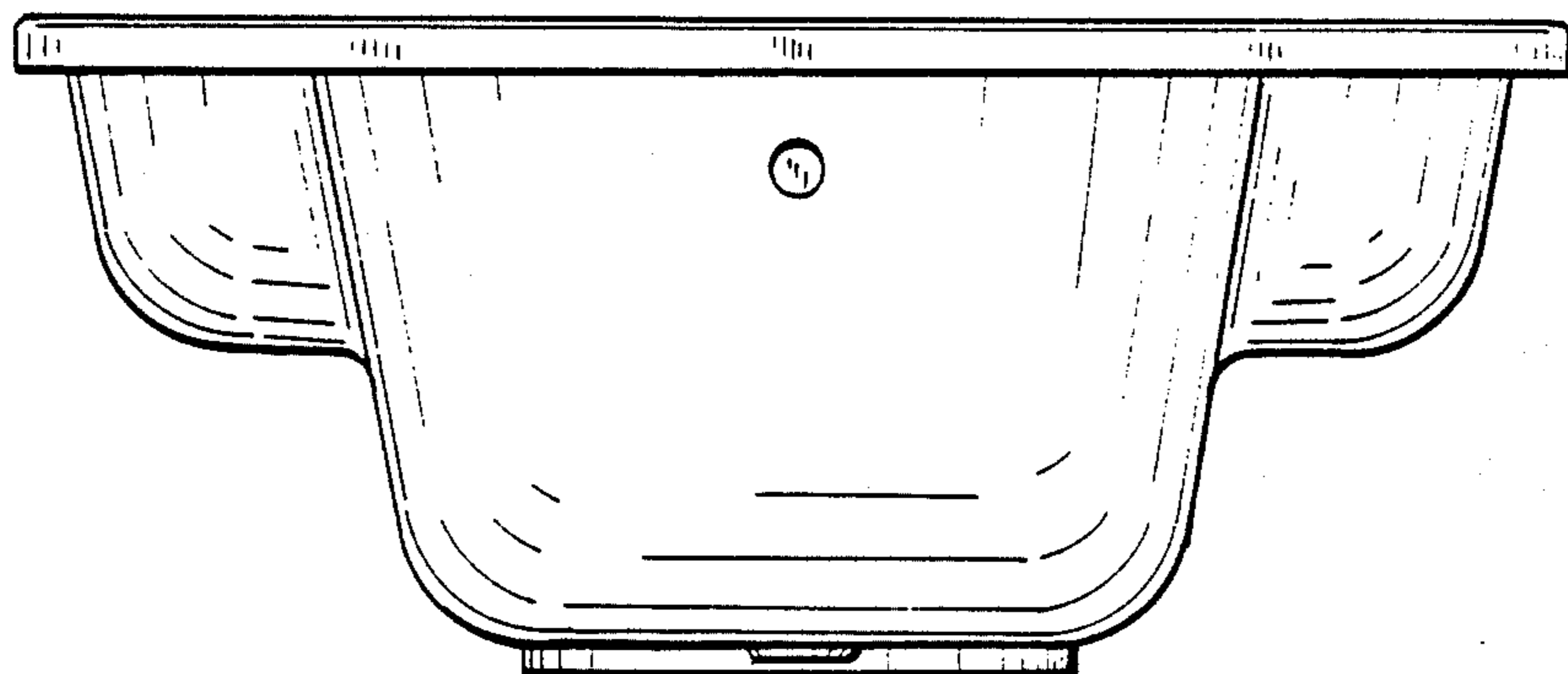


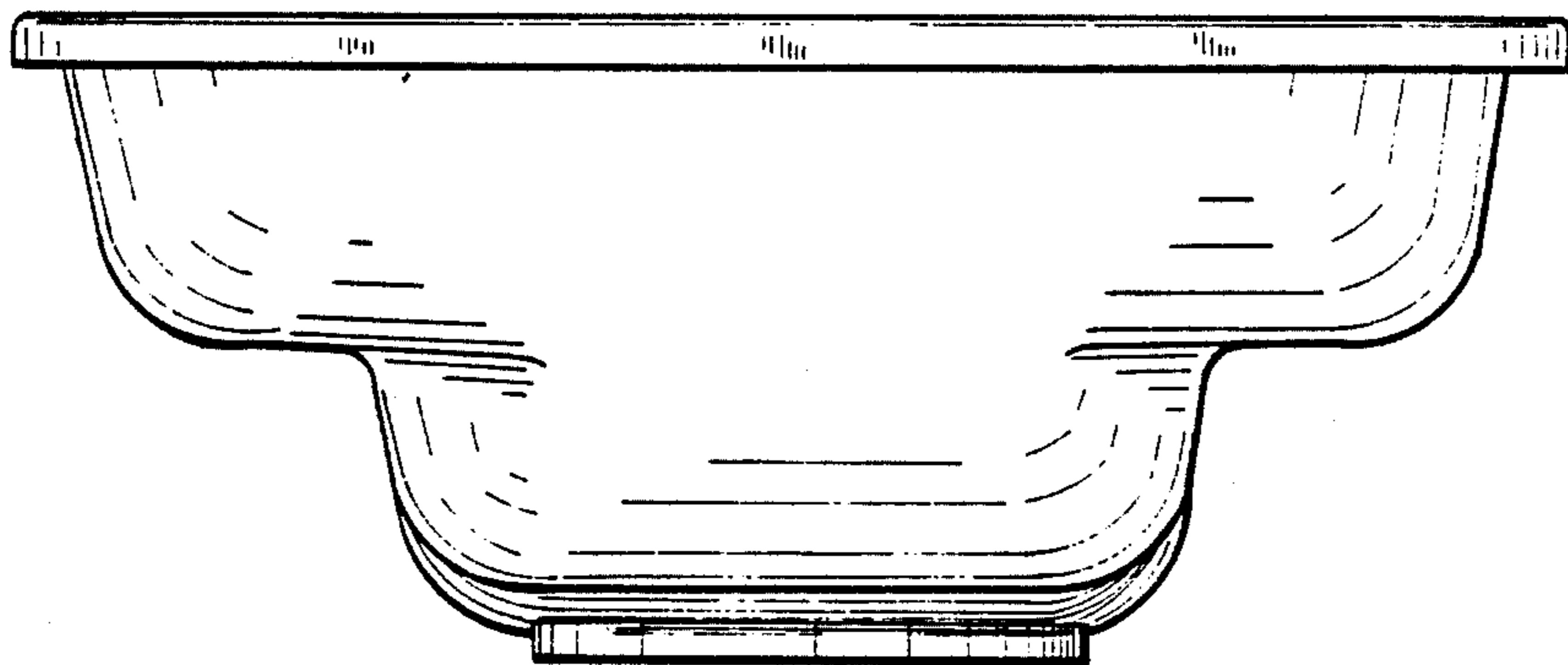

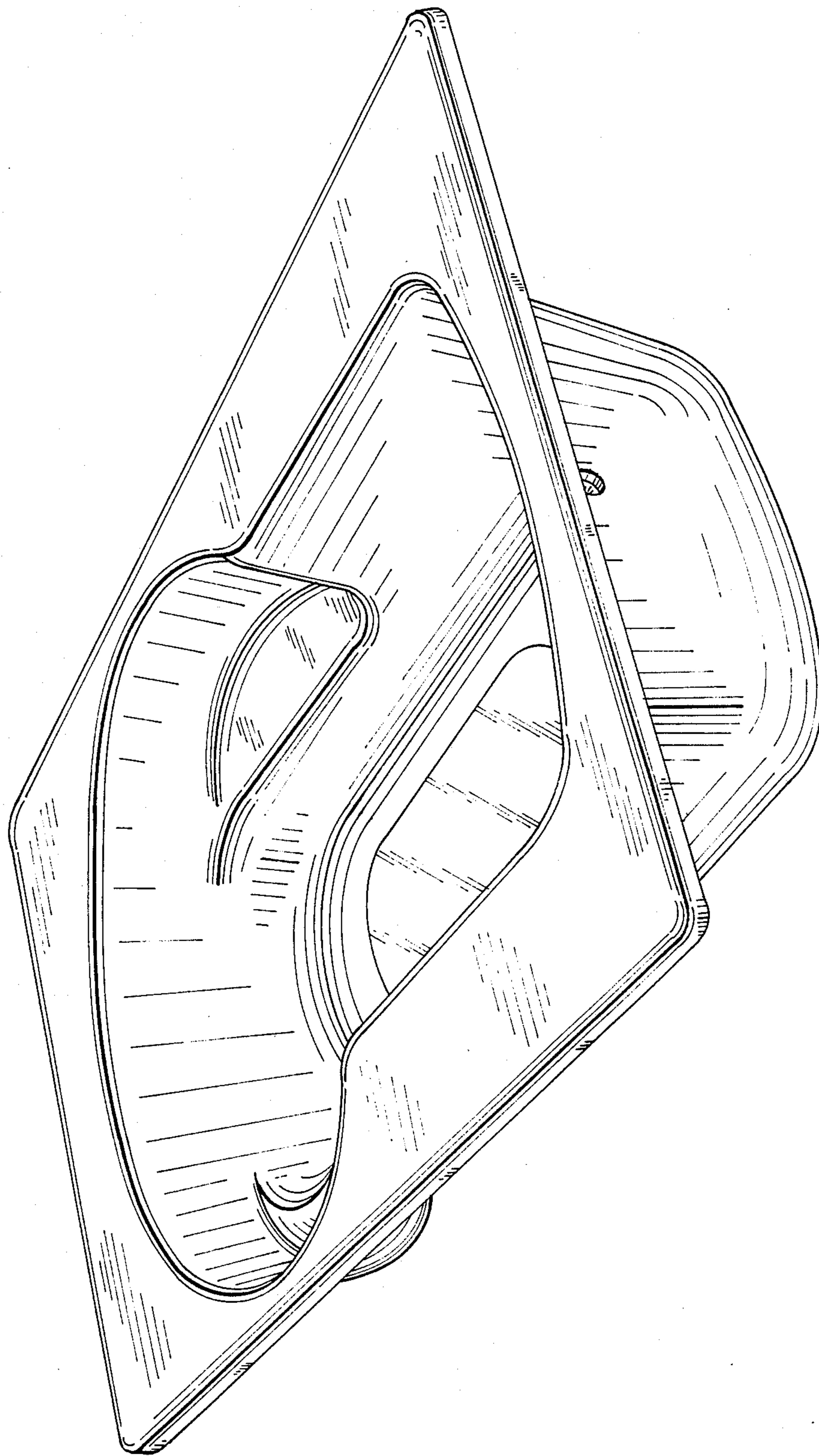
