FIG. 6 is an underside plan view thereof.

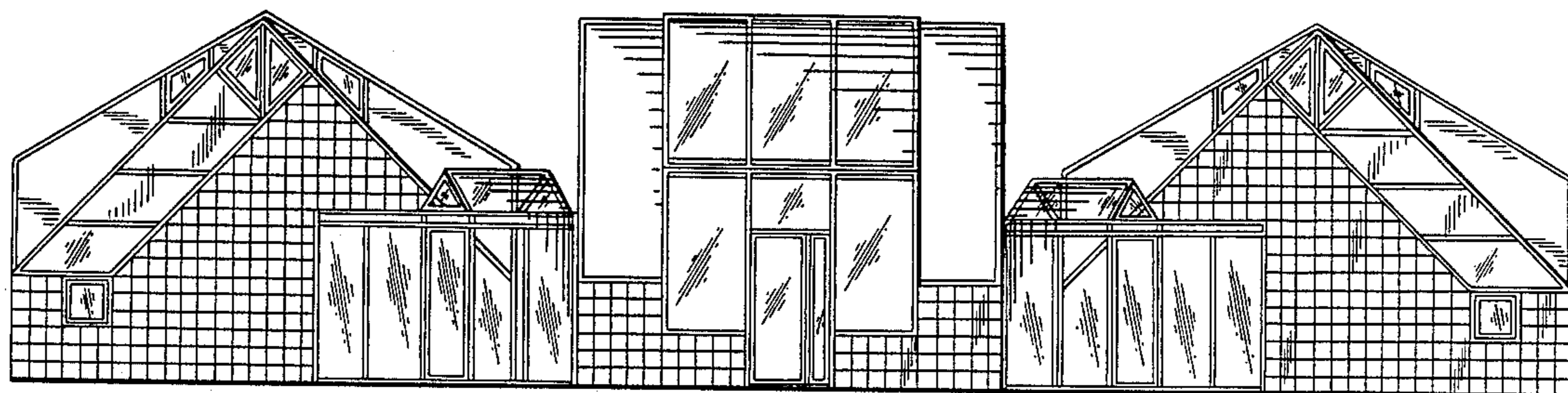

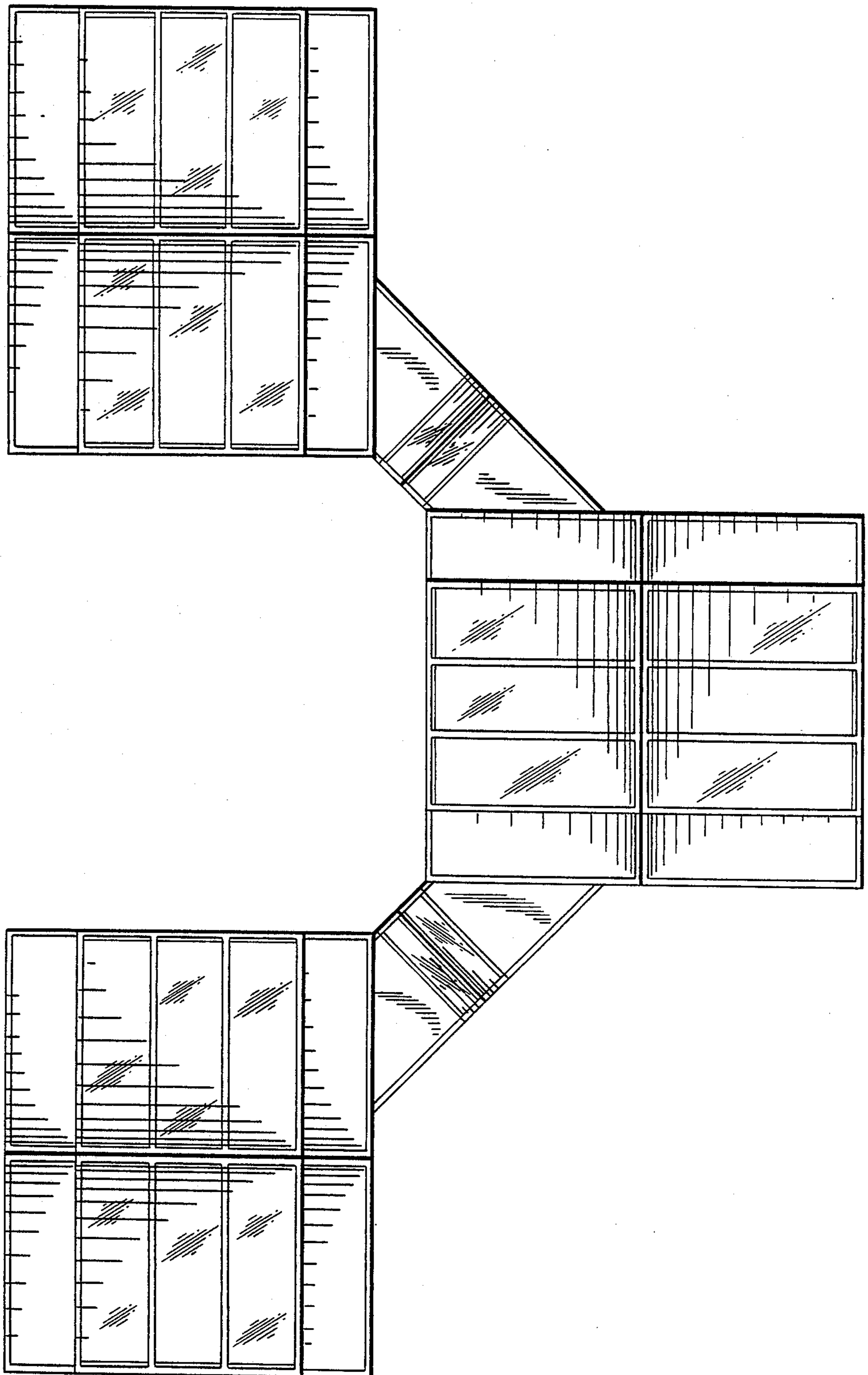

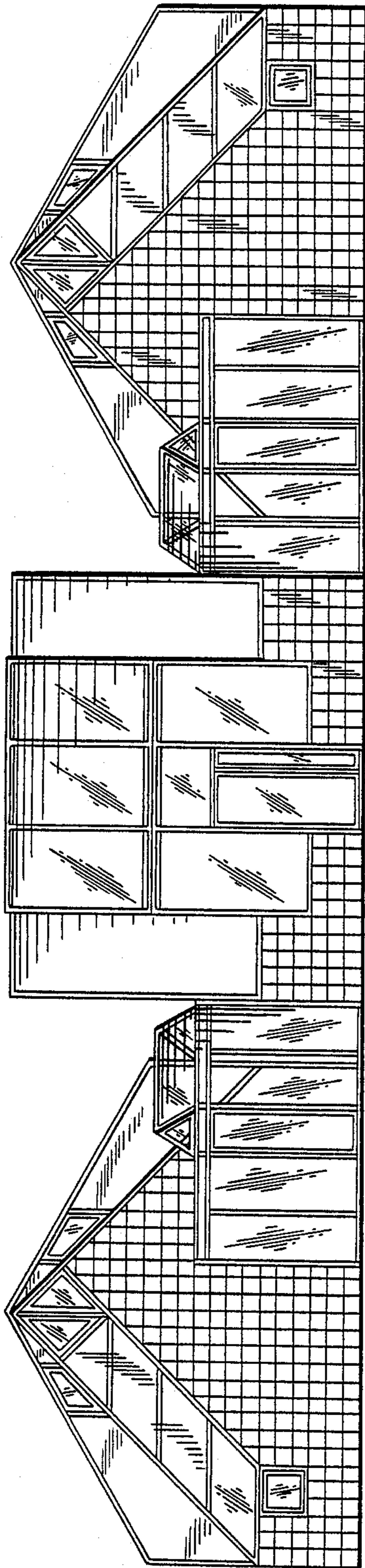

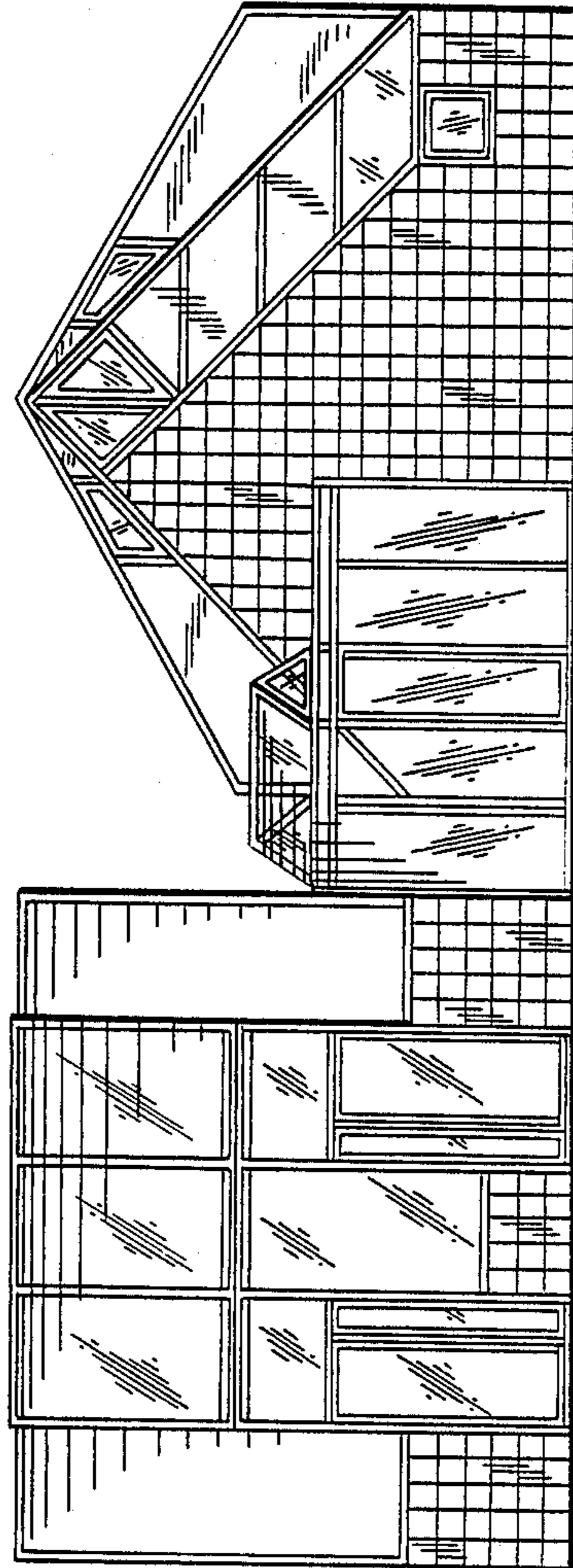

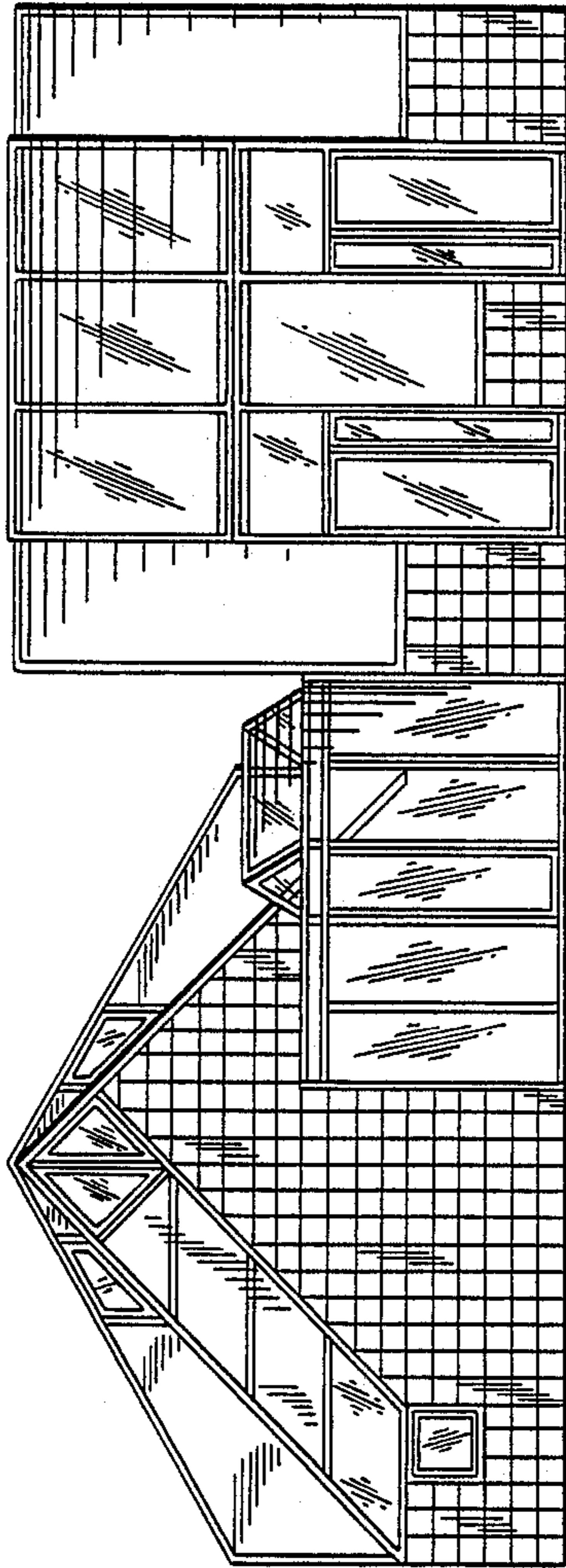
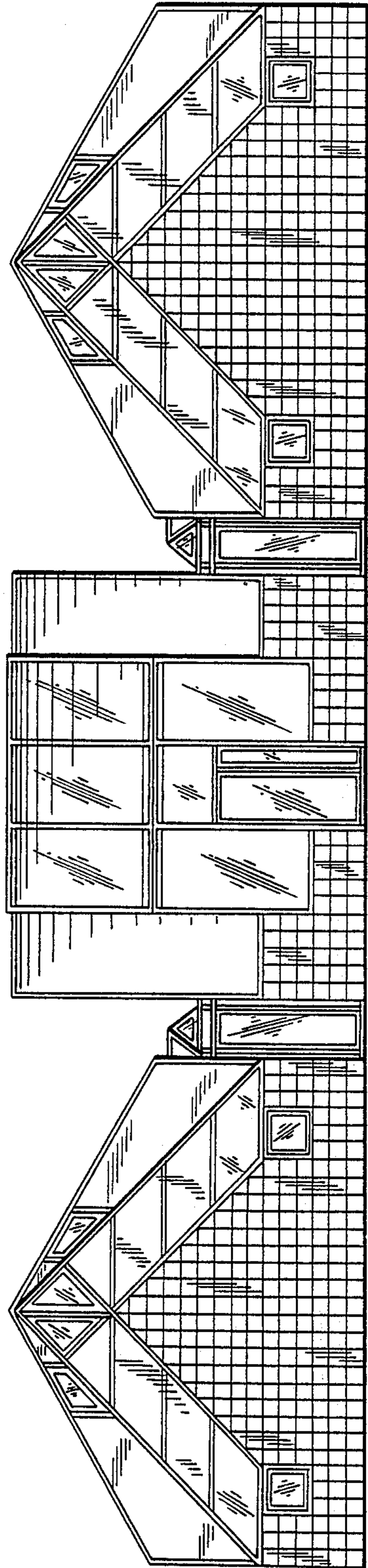

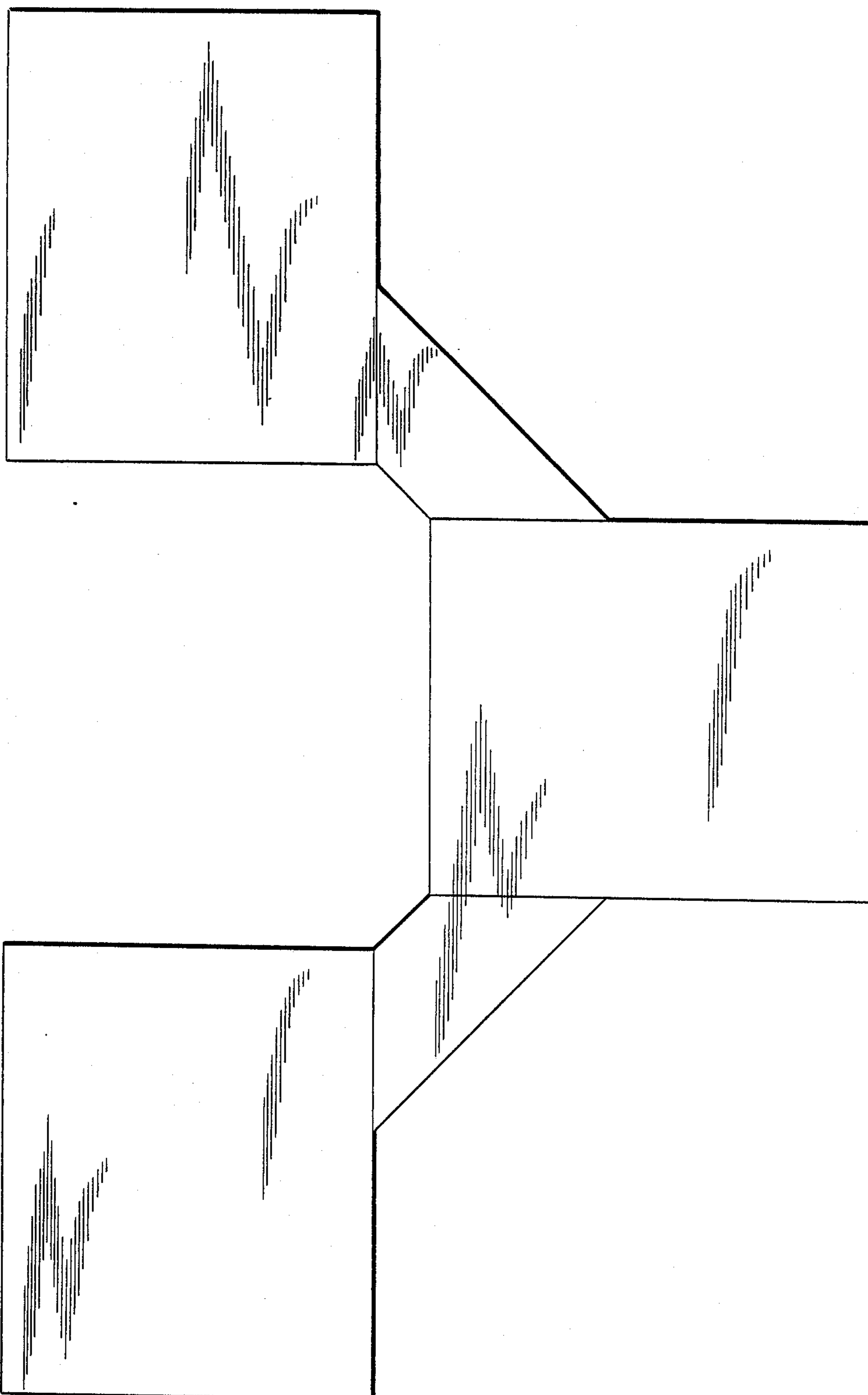
