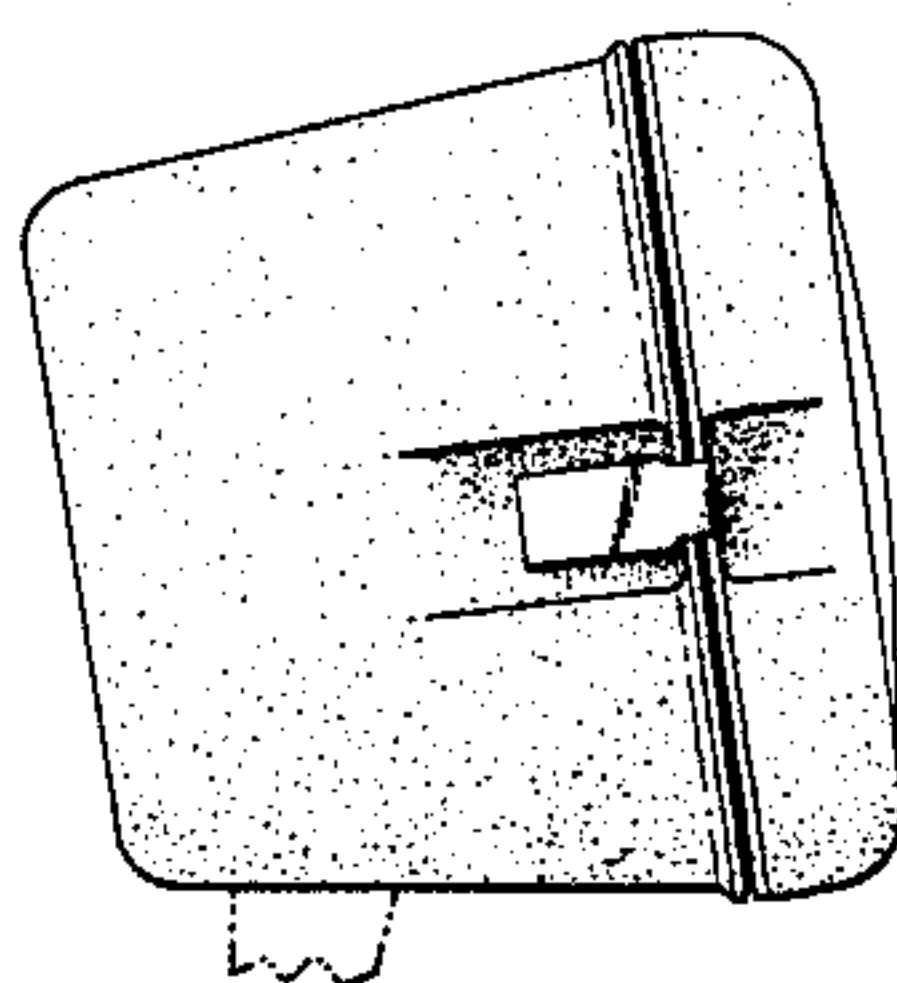
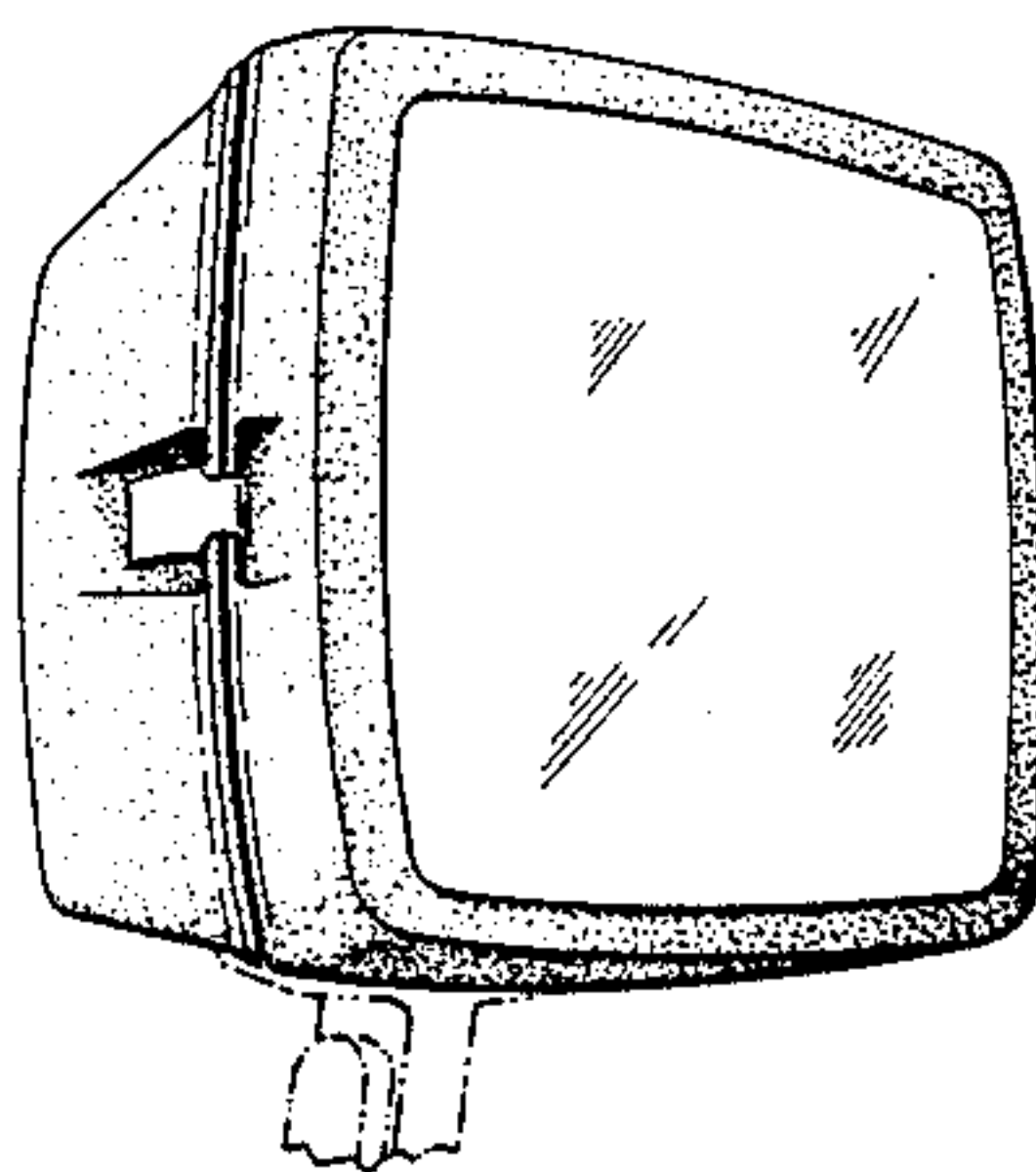

The ornamental design for a floodlight, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a floodlight, illustrating my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The showing of support structure in FIGS. 1-4 in broken lines is for the purpose of illustrating environmental use only.



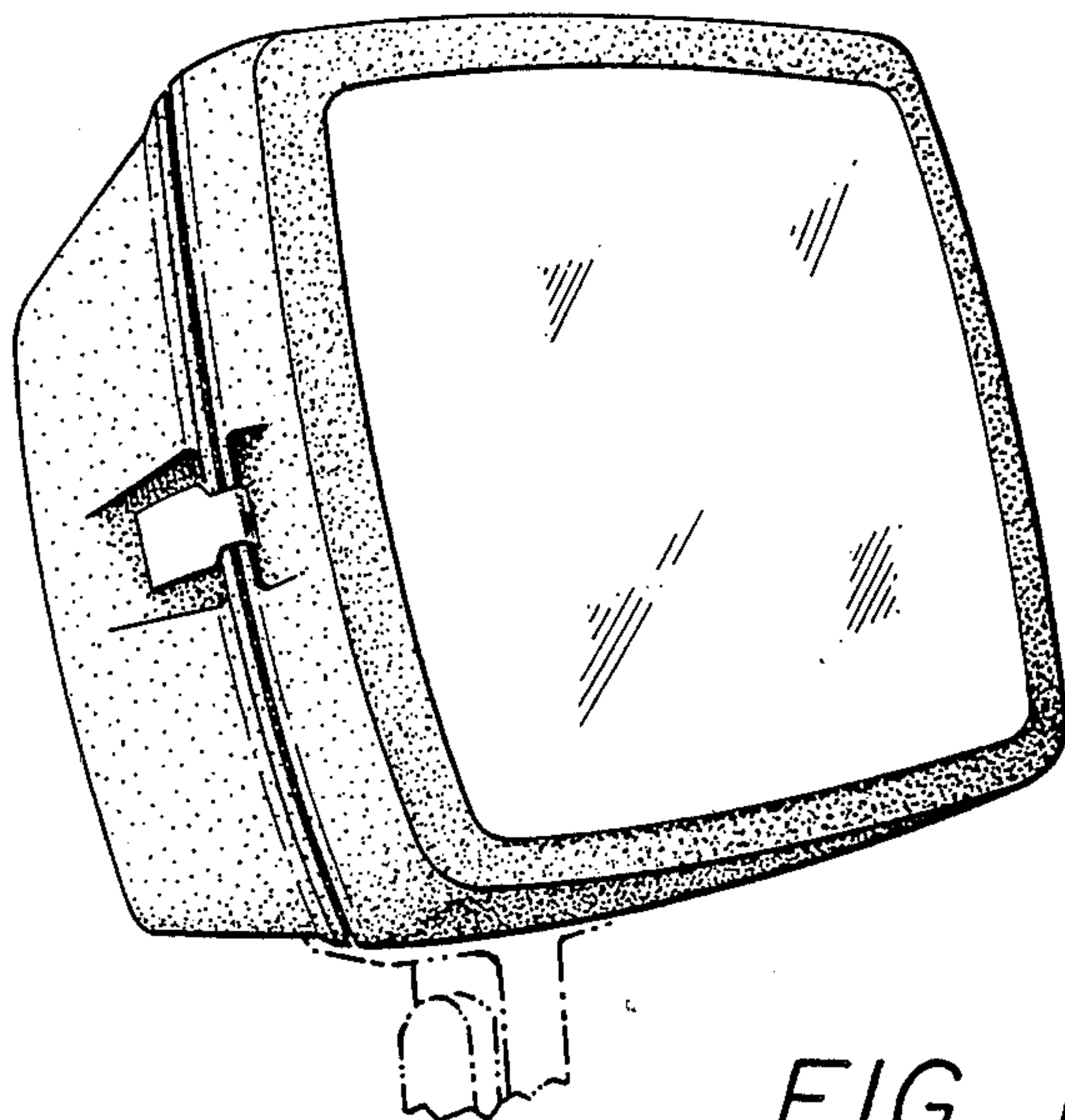

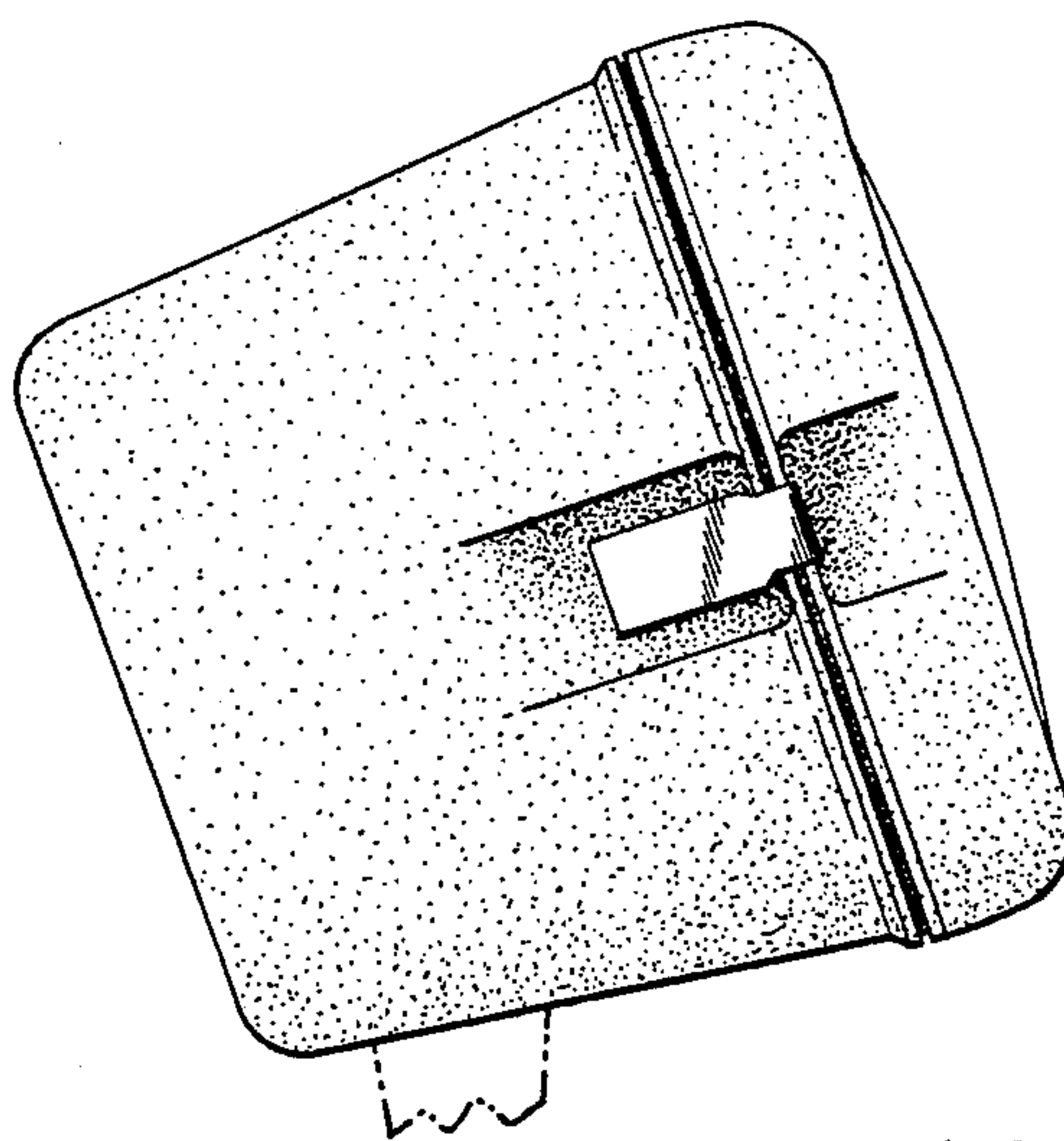

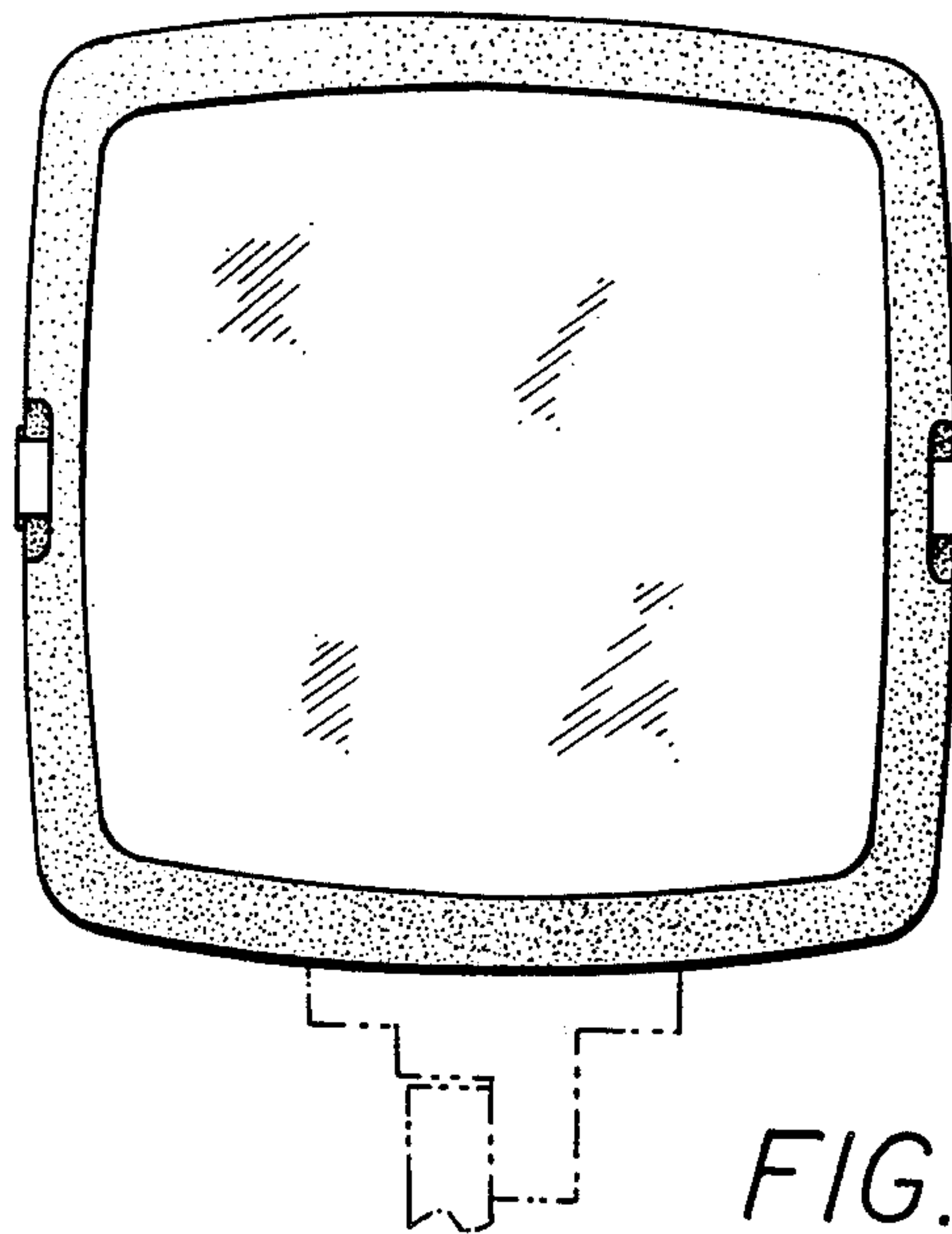

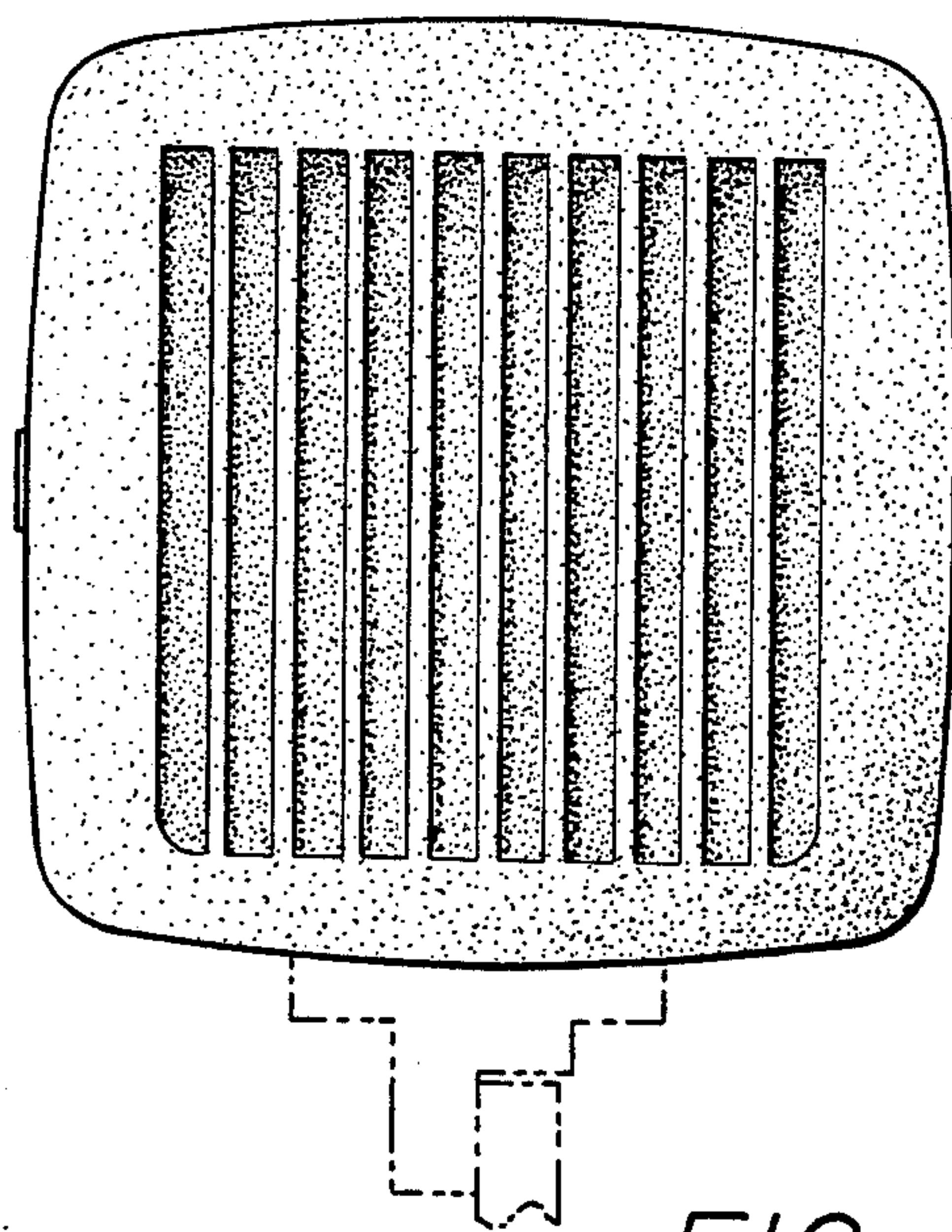

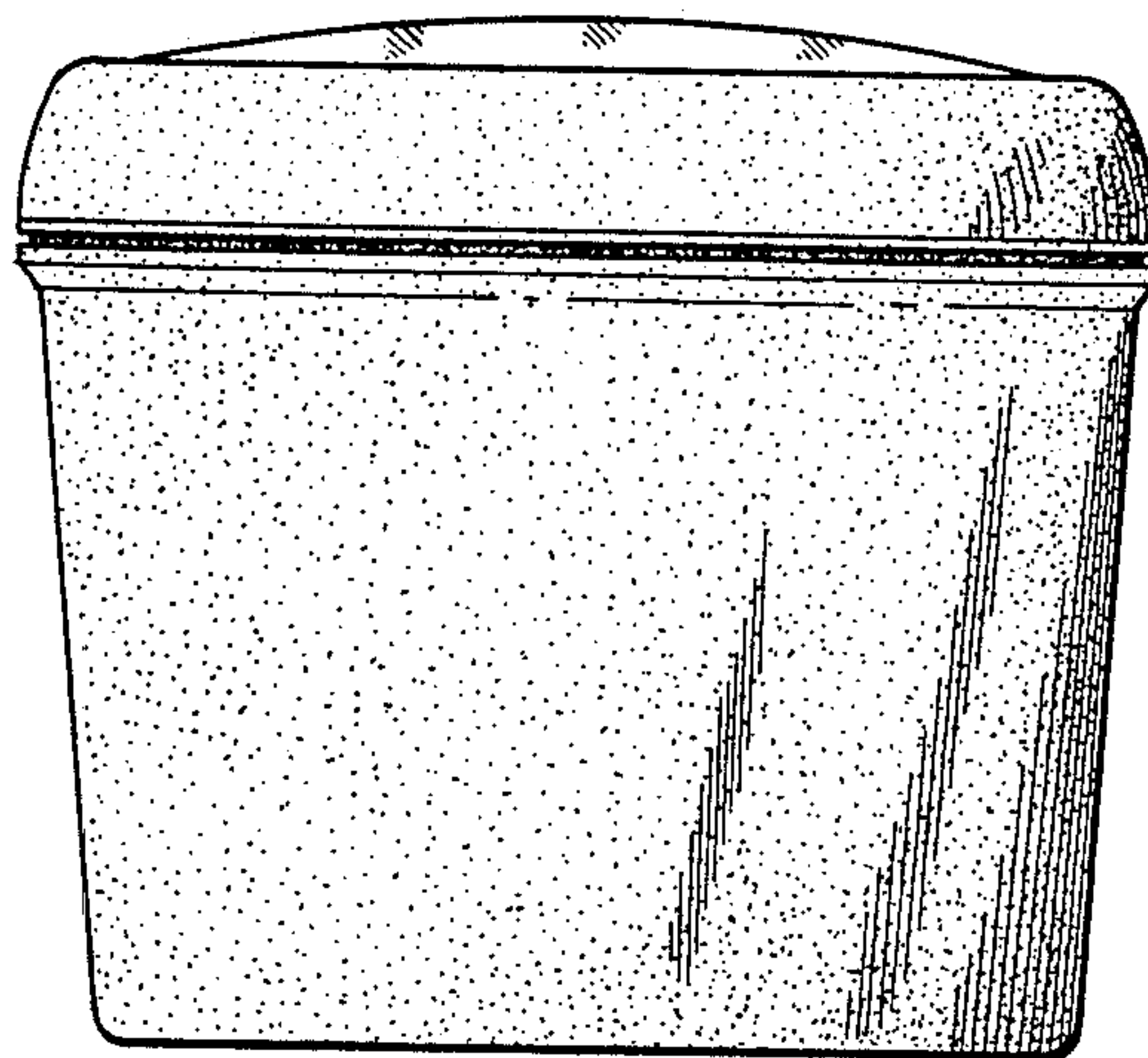

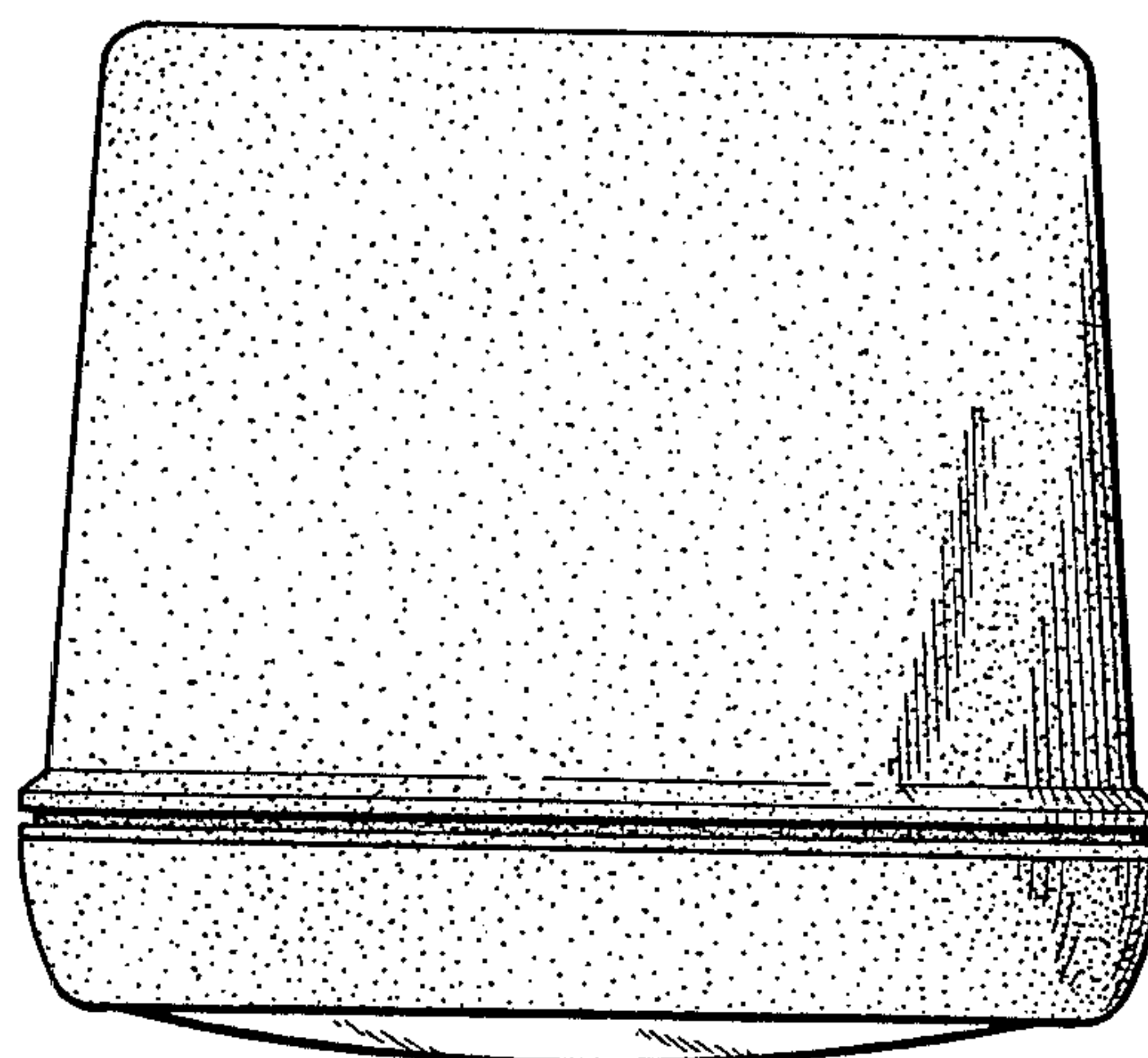
