The ornamental design for a combined courtesy and adjustable light for the interior of automotive vehicles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a combined courtesy and adjustable light for the interior of automotive vehicles showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

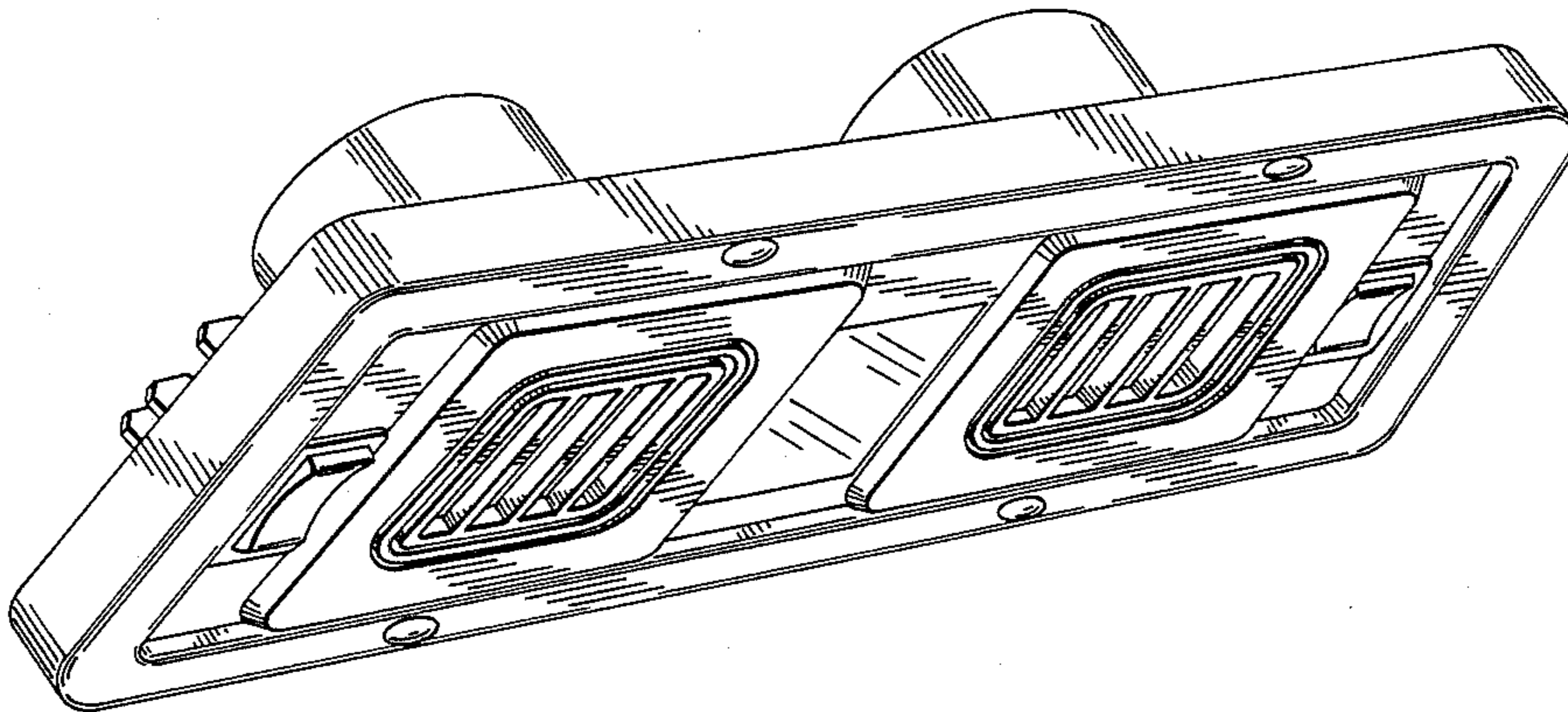

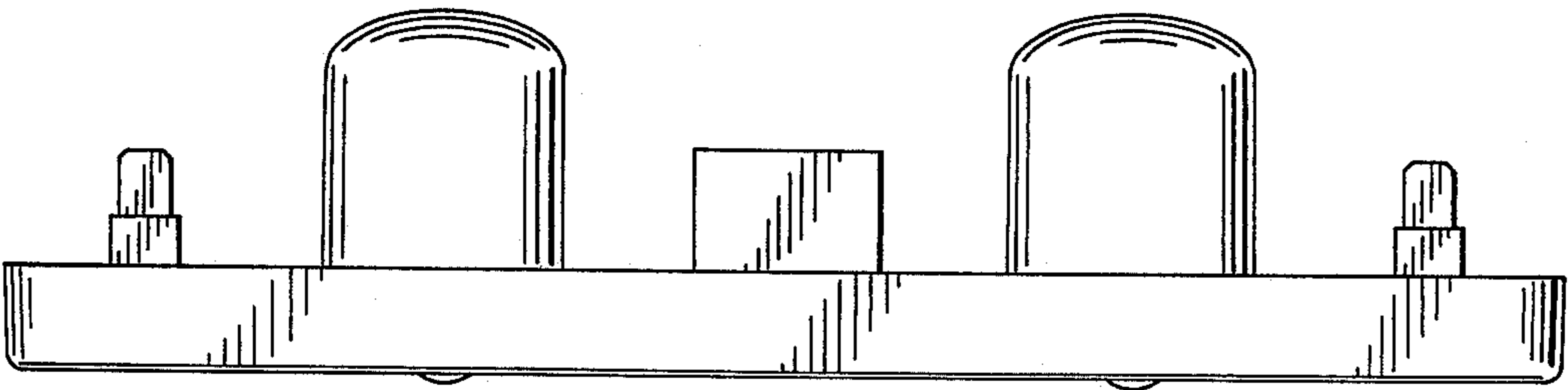
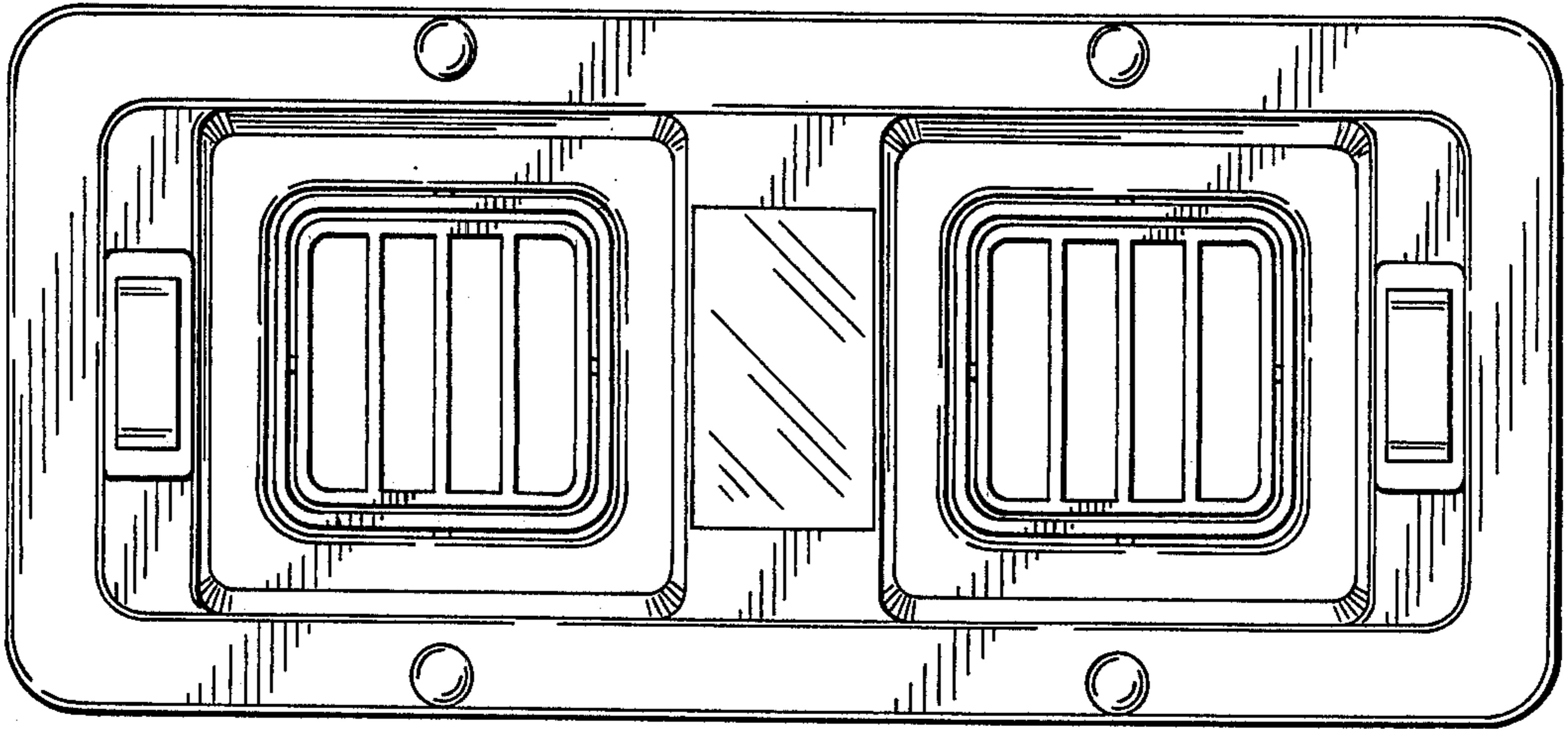

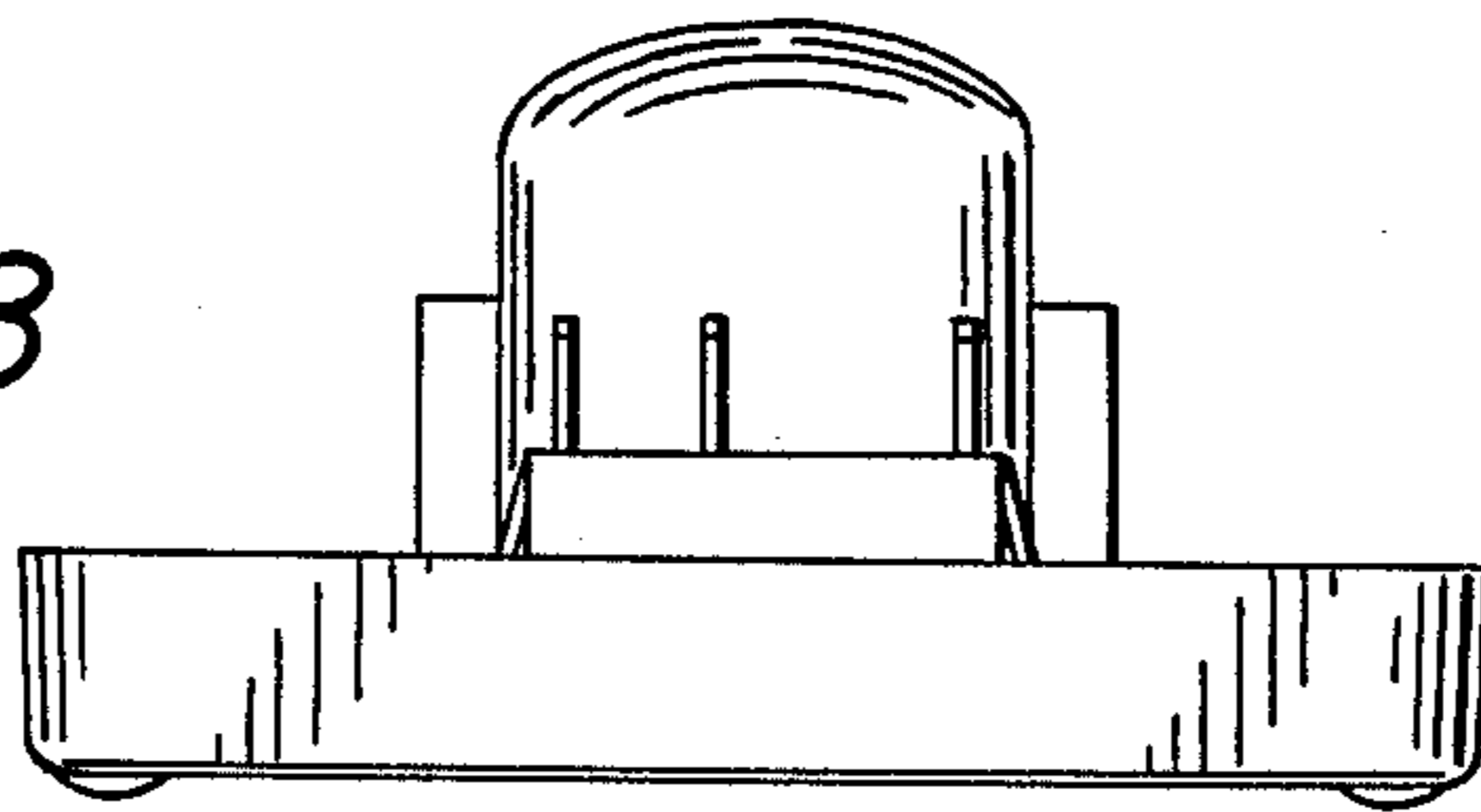
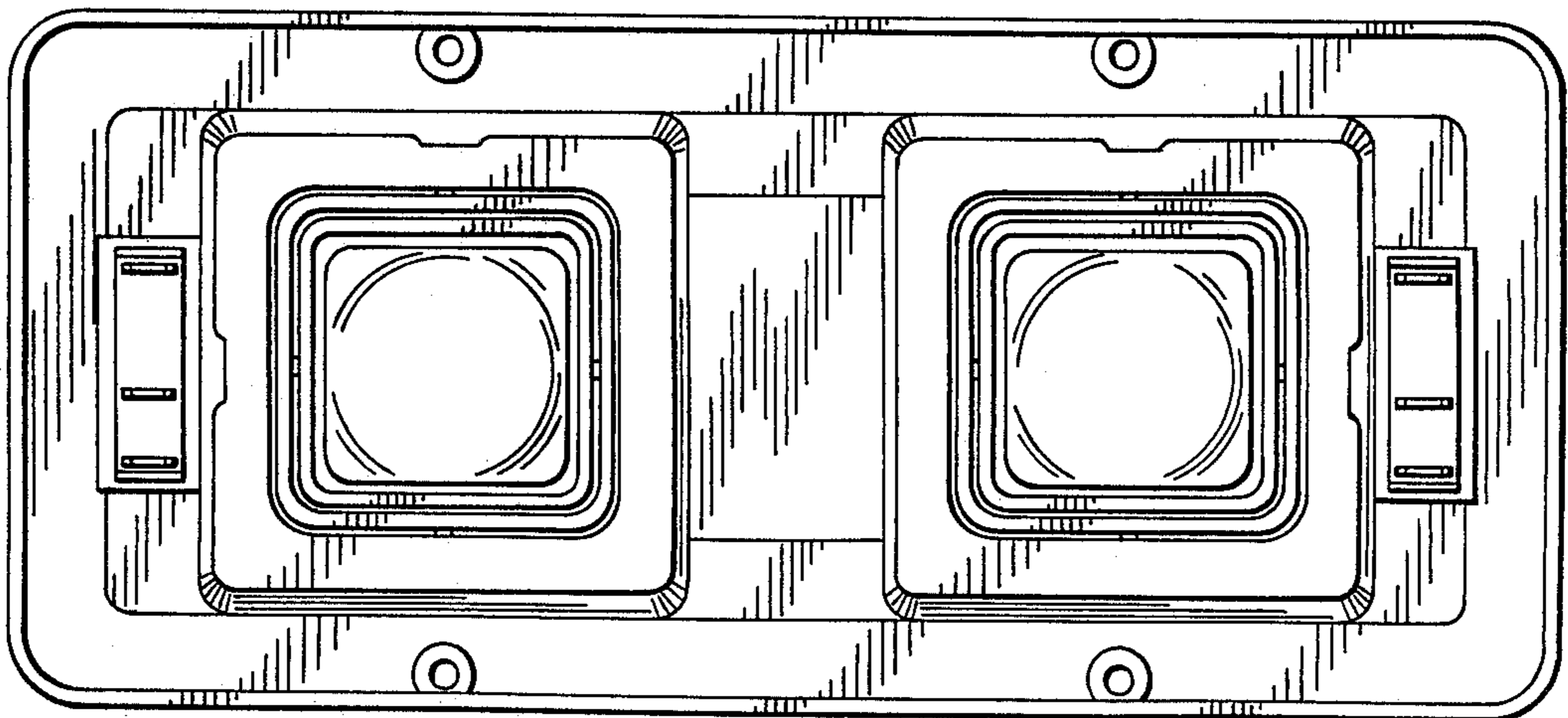

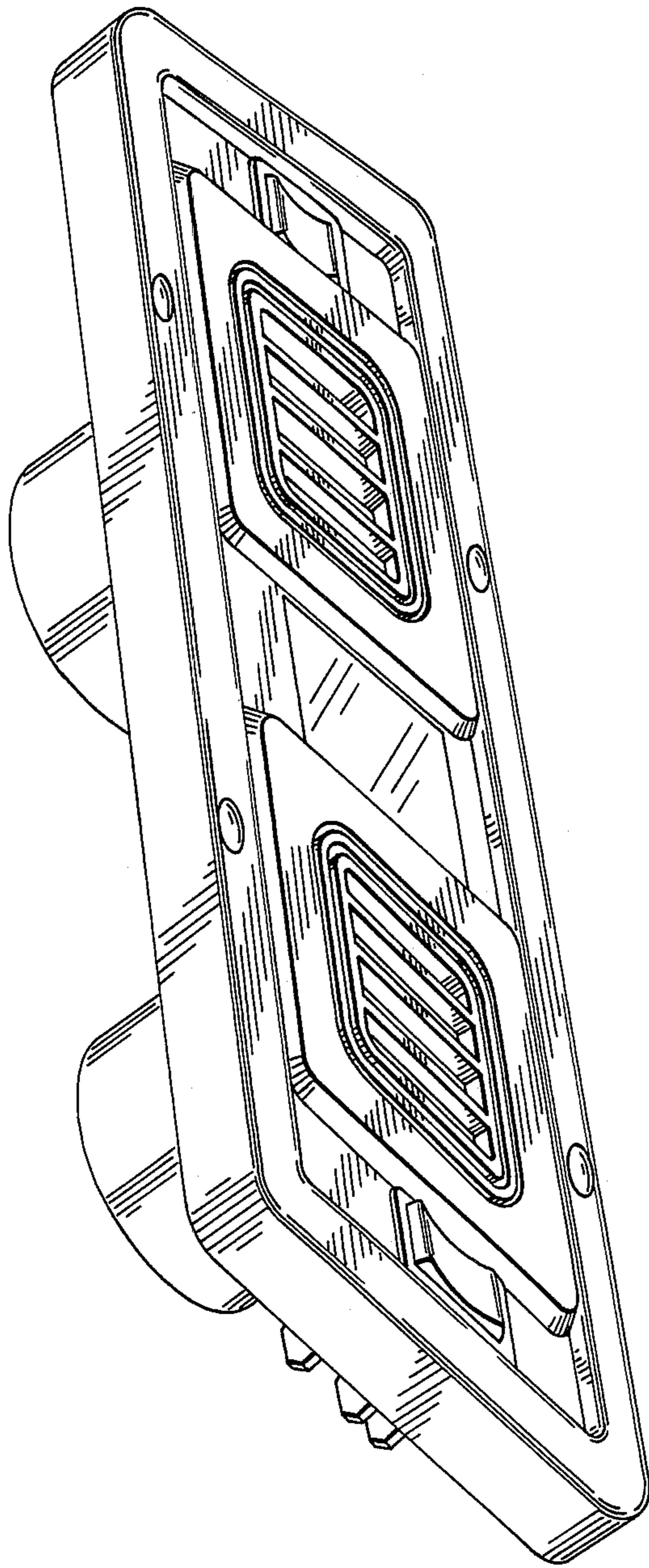
