FIG. 5 is a top and right-front perspective view thereof in an exploded position.

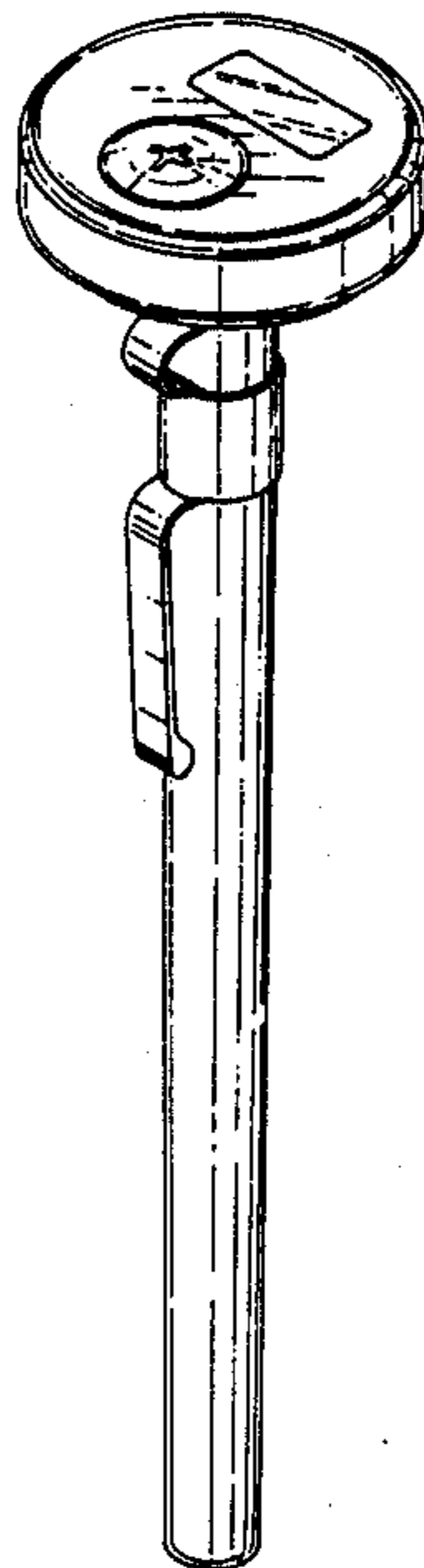

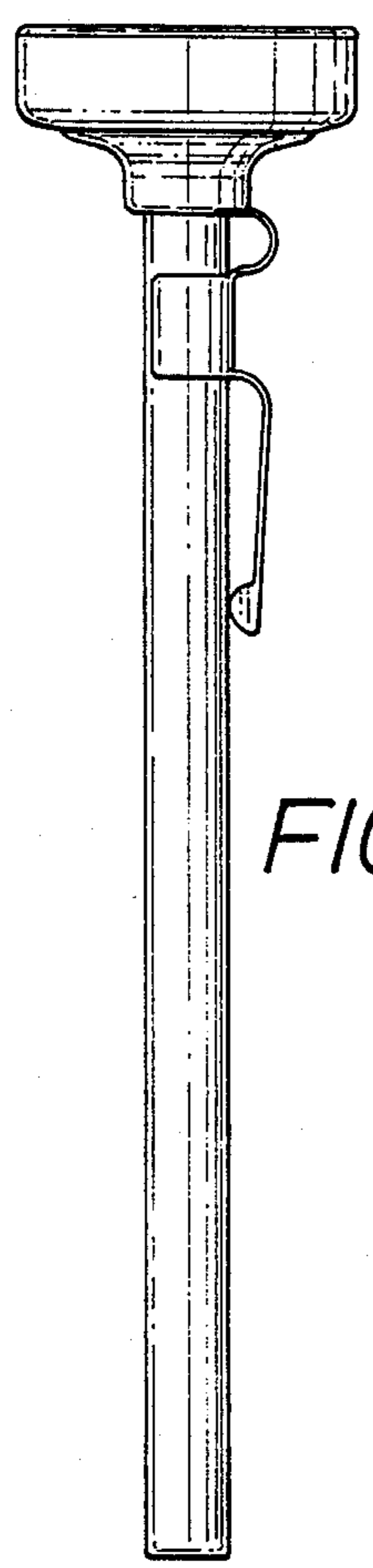
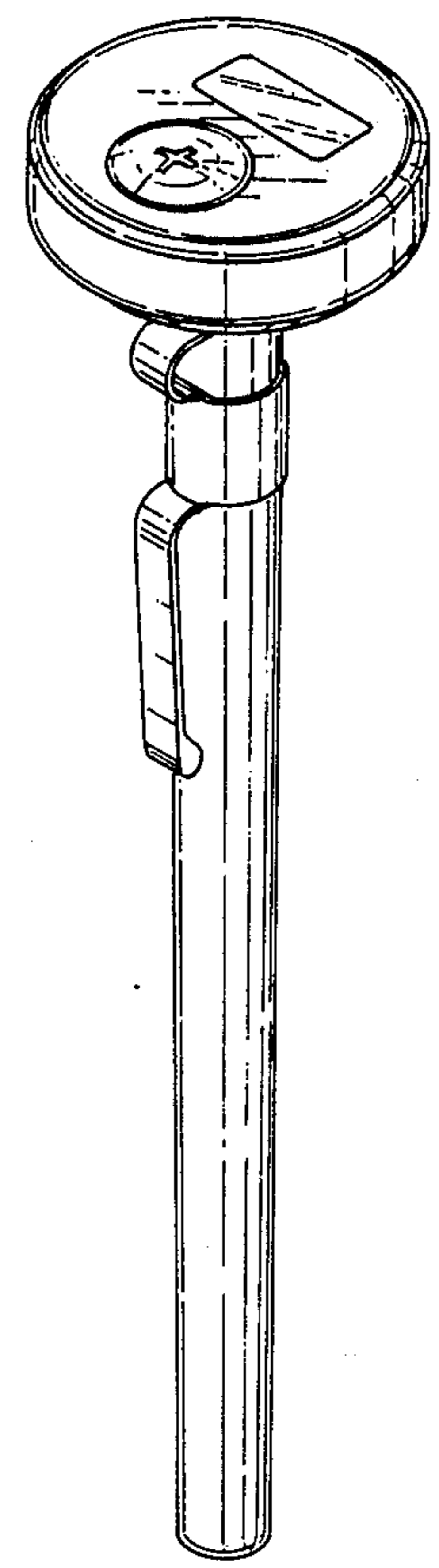

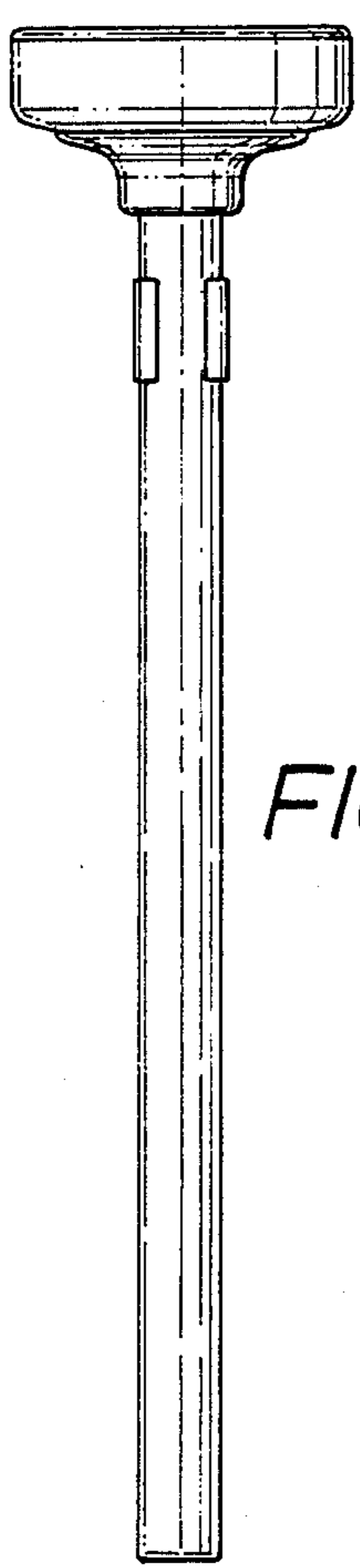
