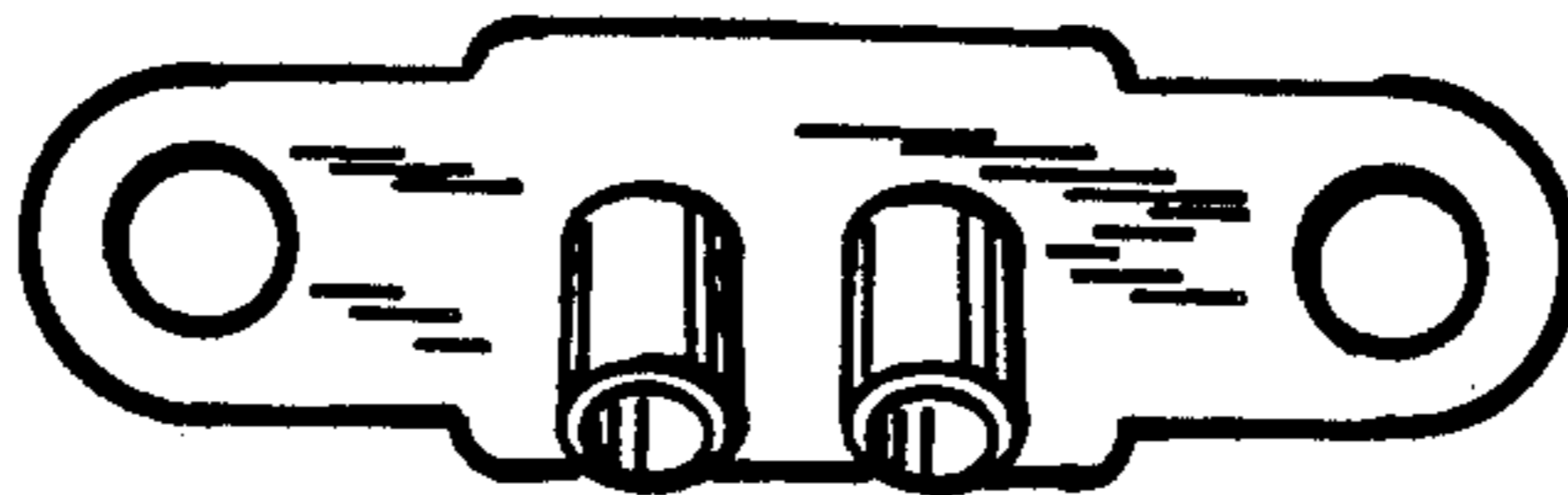

The ornamental design for a nasal breathing piece, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a nasal breathing piece showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is bottom plan view thereof.



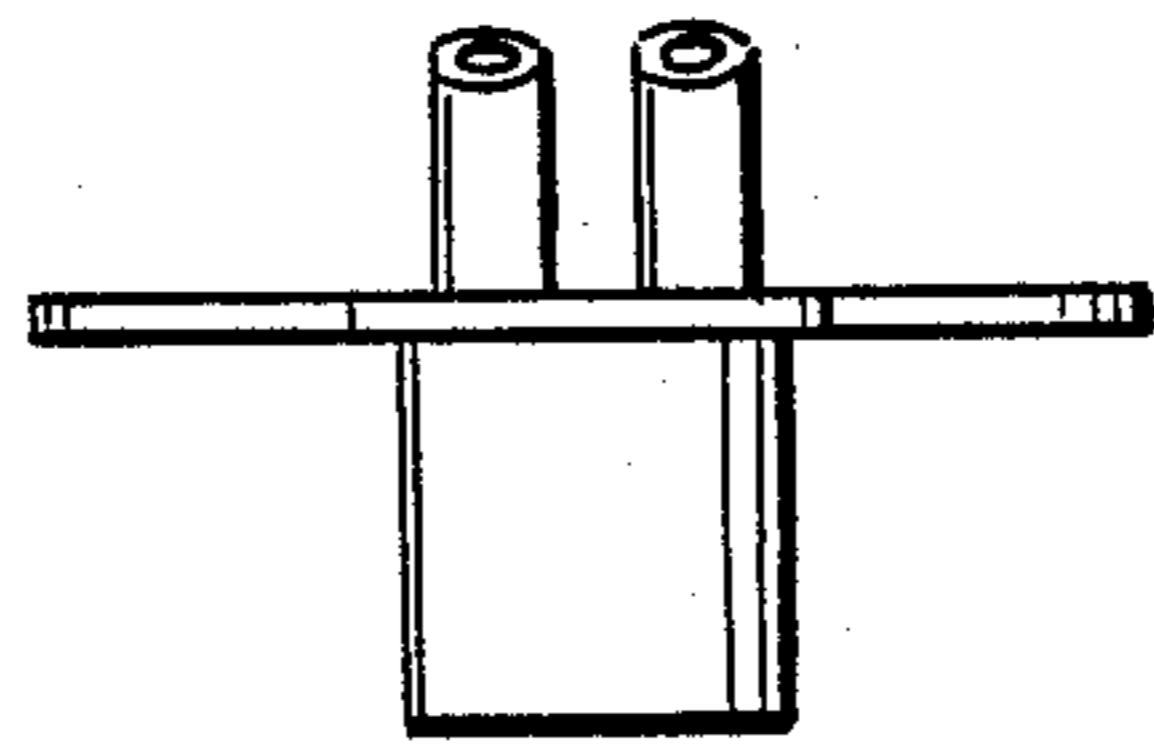

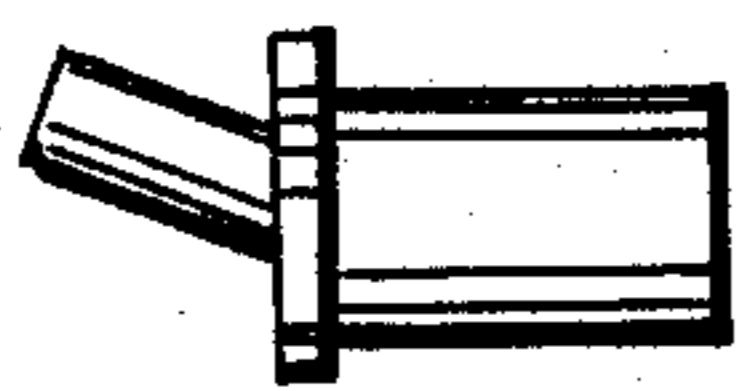

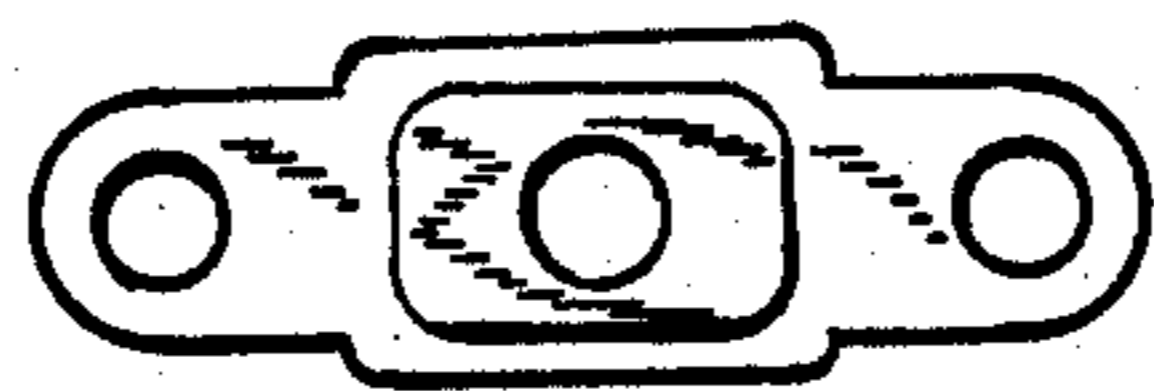

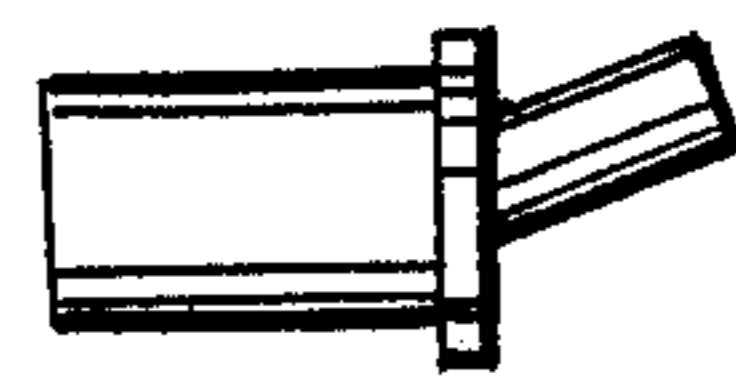

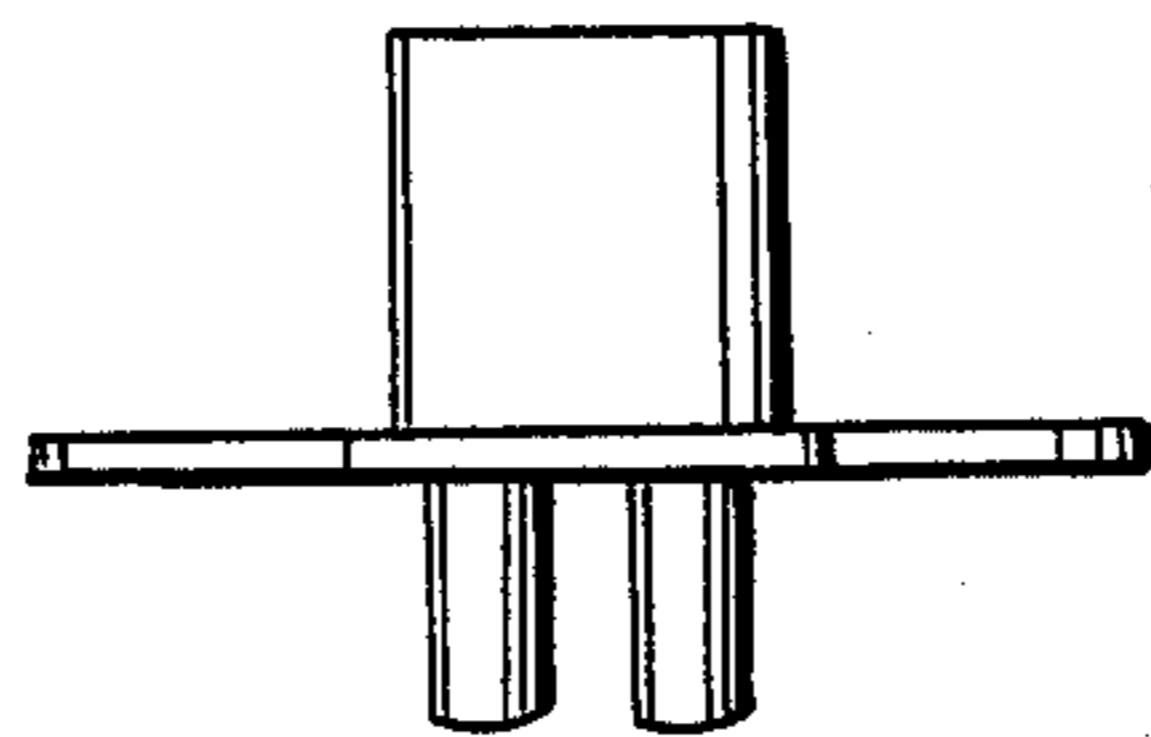
