FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a gnaw-proof waterer for small animals showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of the left side shown;  
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

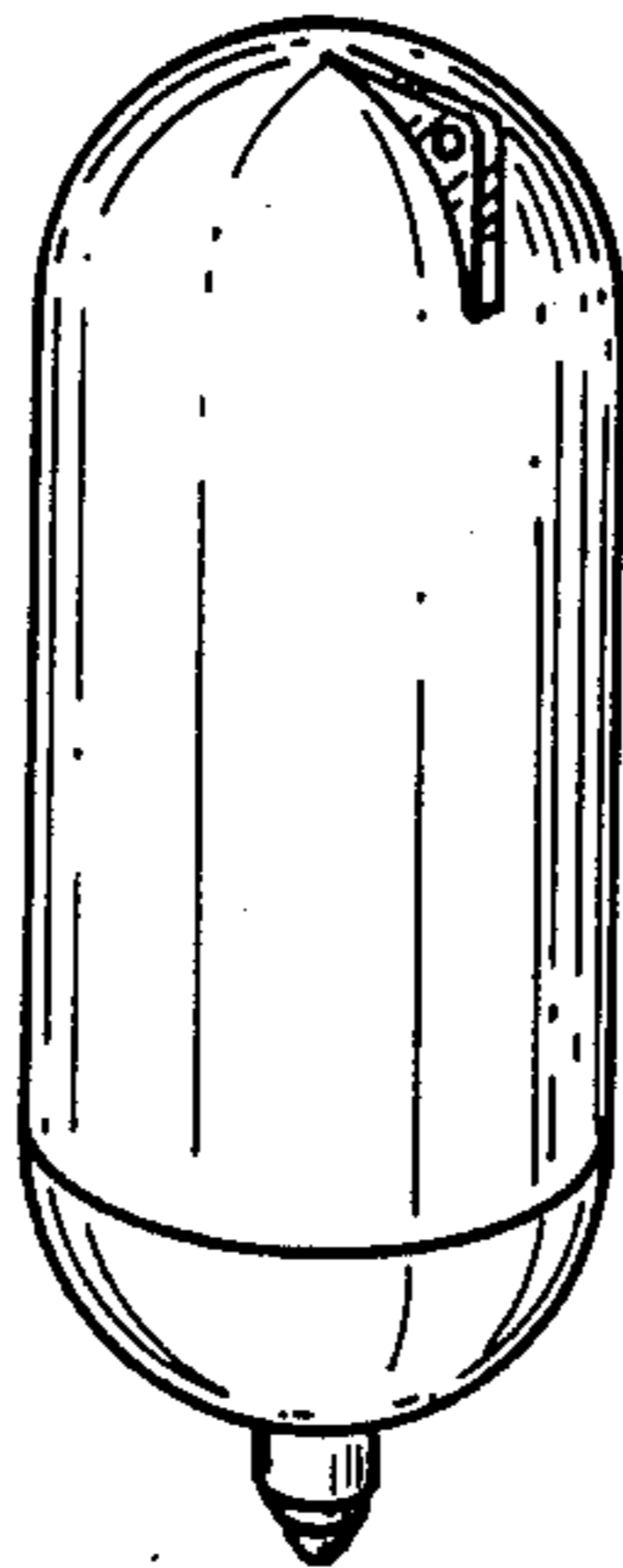

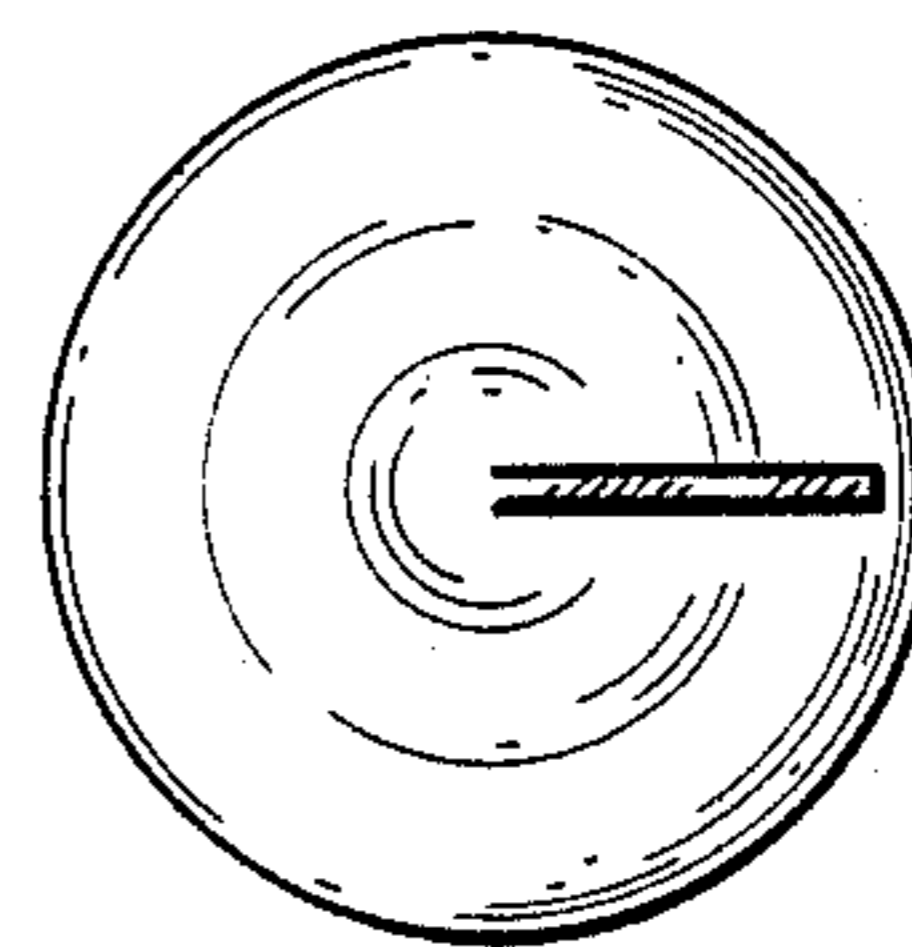
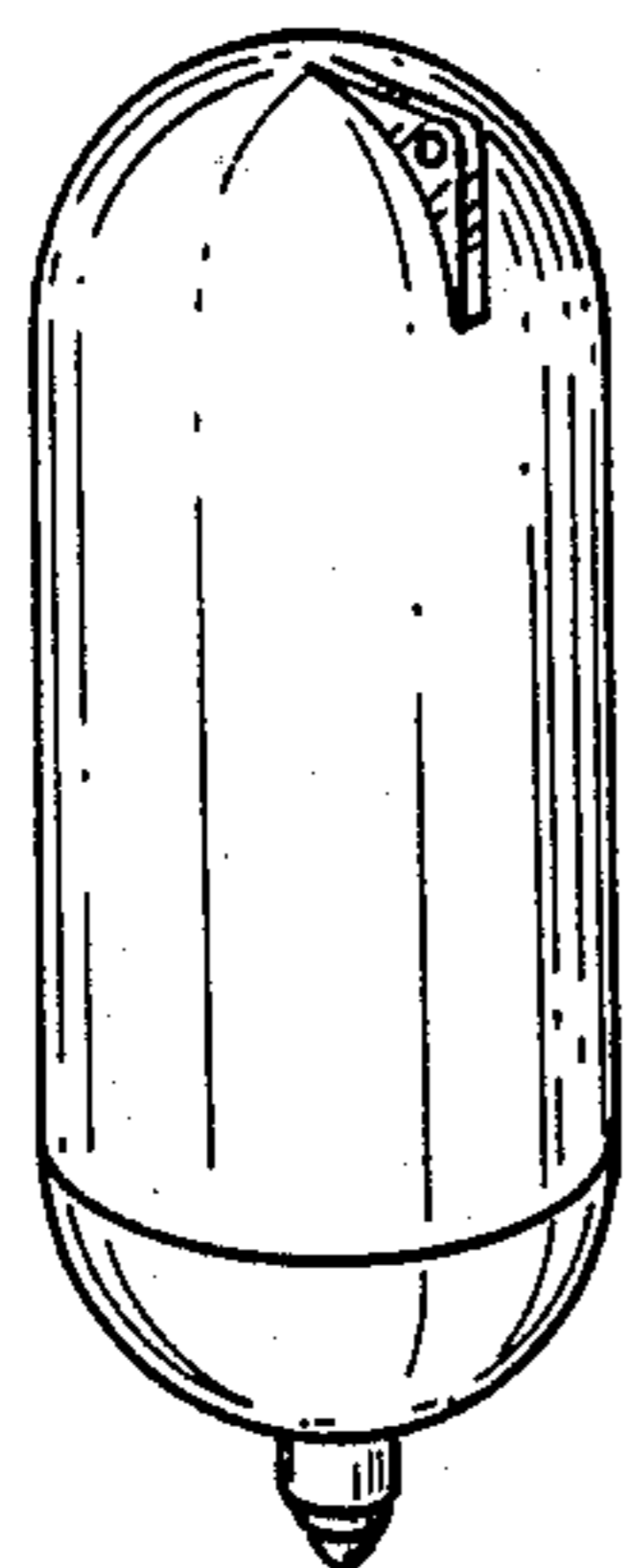

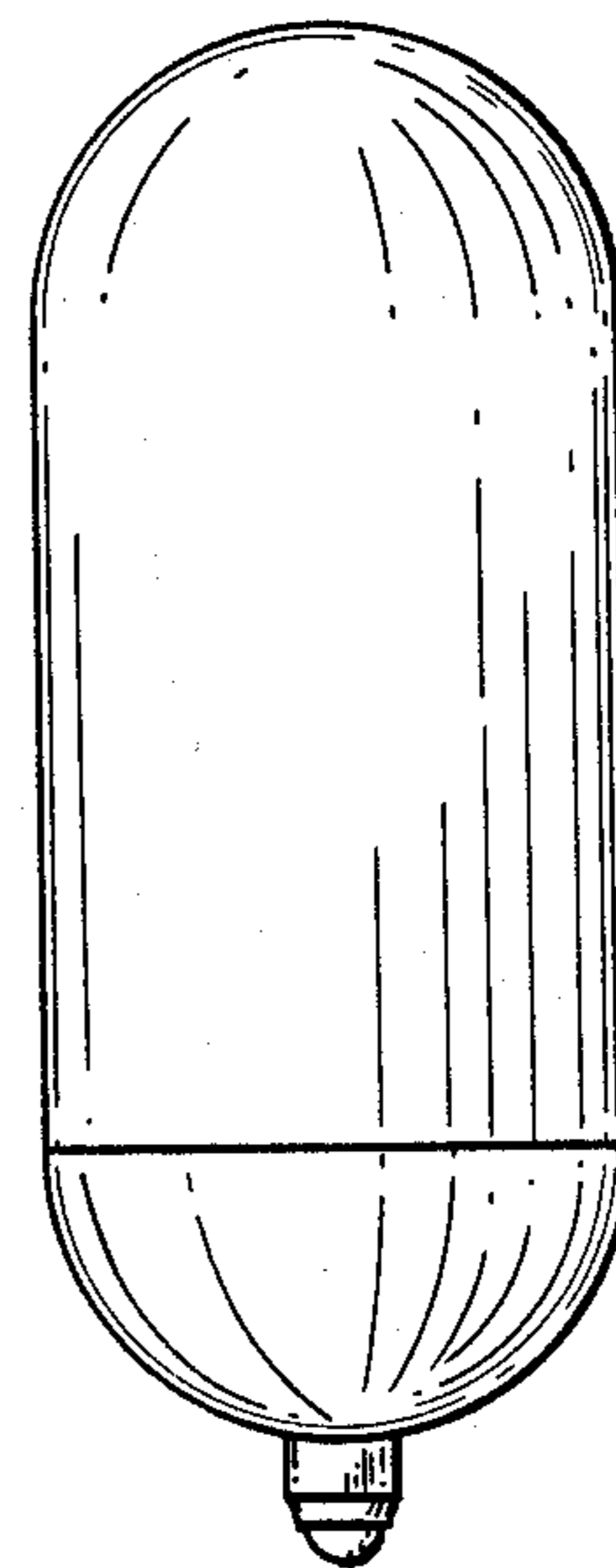
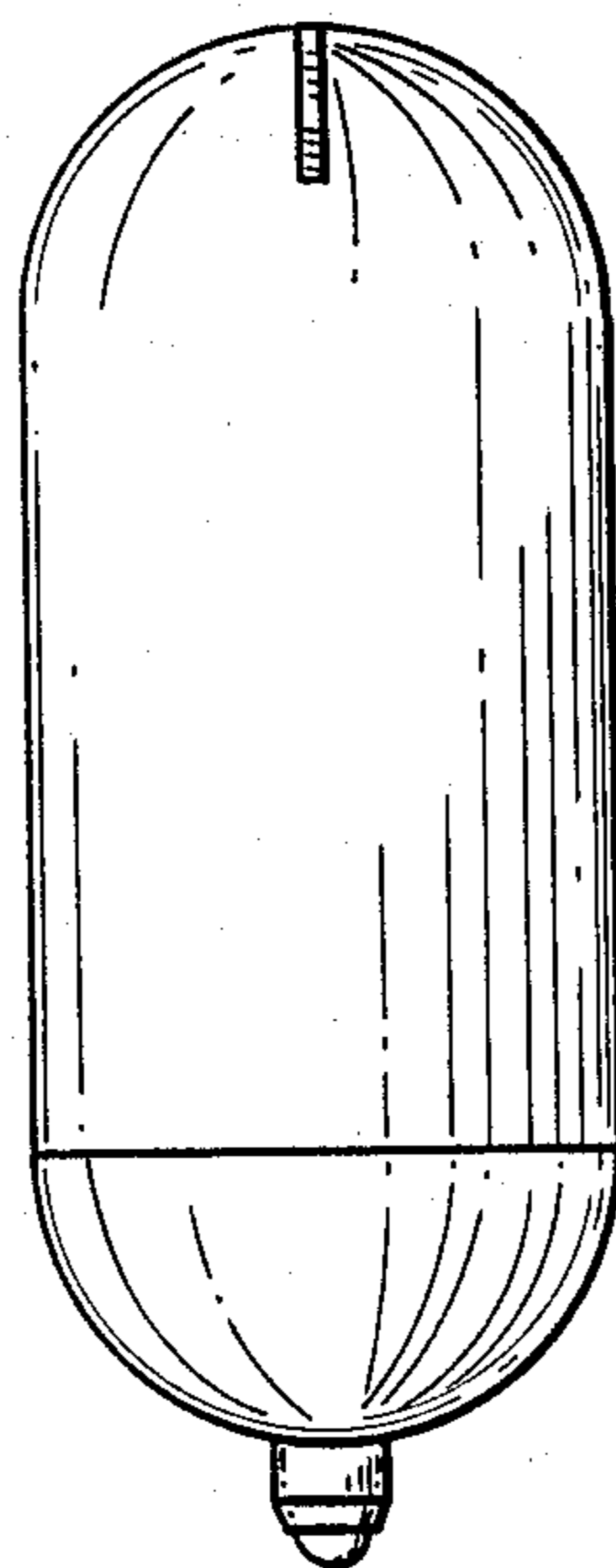
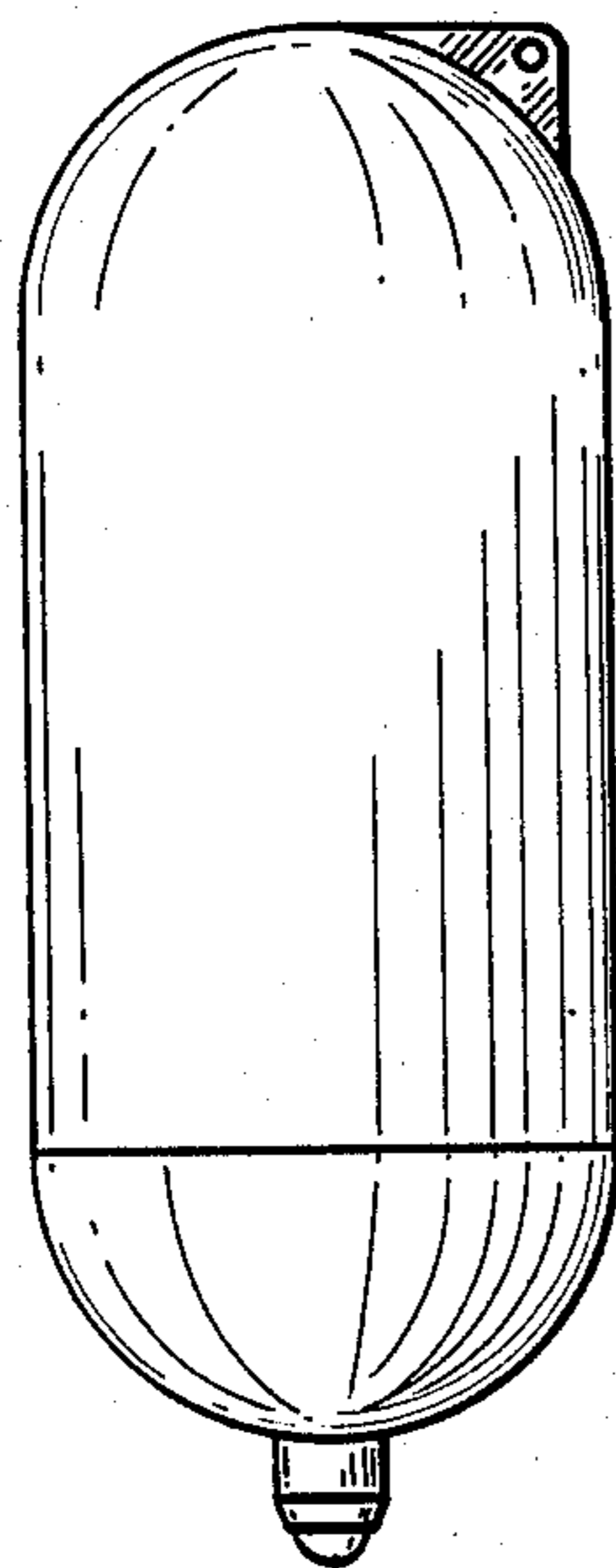

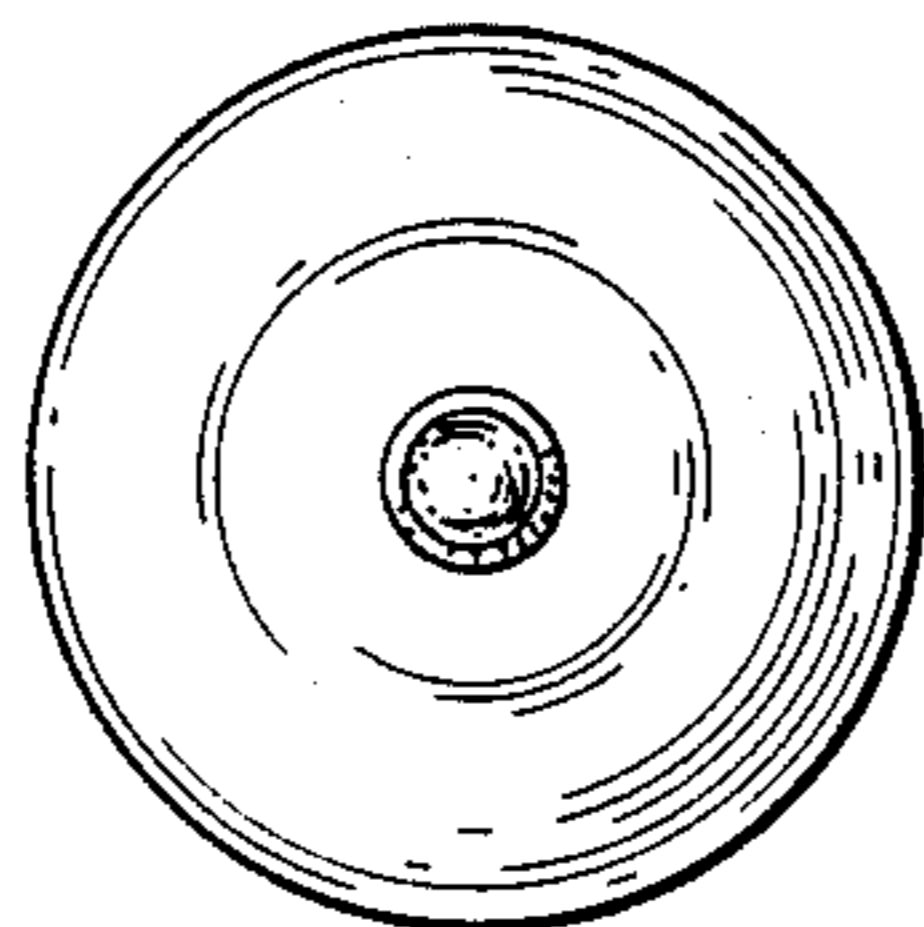
