[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chipmunk feeder stand, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a chipmunk feeder stand showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line representation of a food dish in FIGS. 1 through 5 and the broken line indicia in FIGS. 1 and 4 are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.

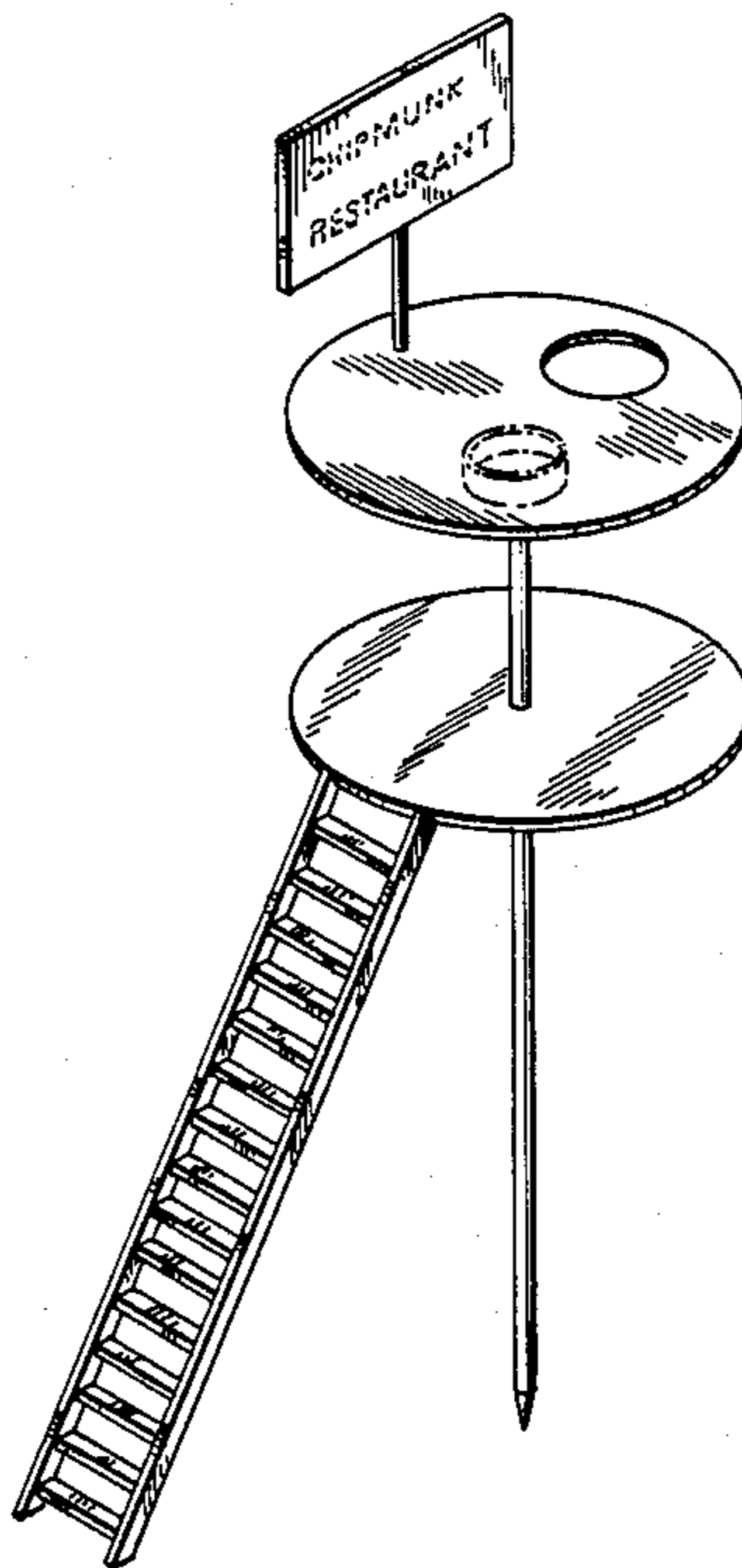
