[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an automobile trunk liner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the automobile trunk liner;
 FIG. 2 is another top perspective view of the automobile trunk liner but looking from the right side of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view on an enlarged scale taken substantially along line 3—3 of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the automobile trunk liner installed in the trunk compartment of an automobile the peripheral boundaries of which are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

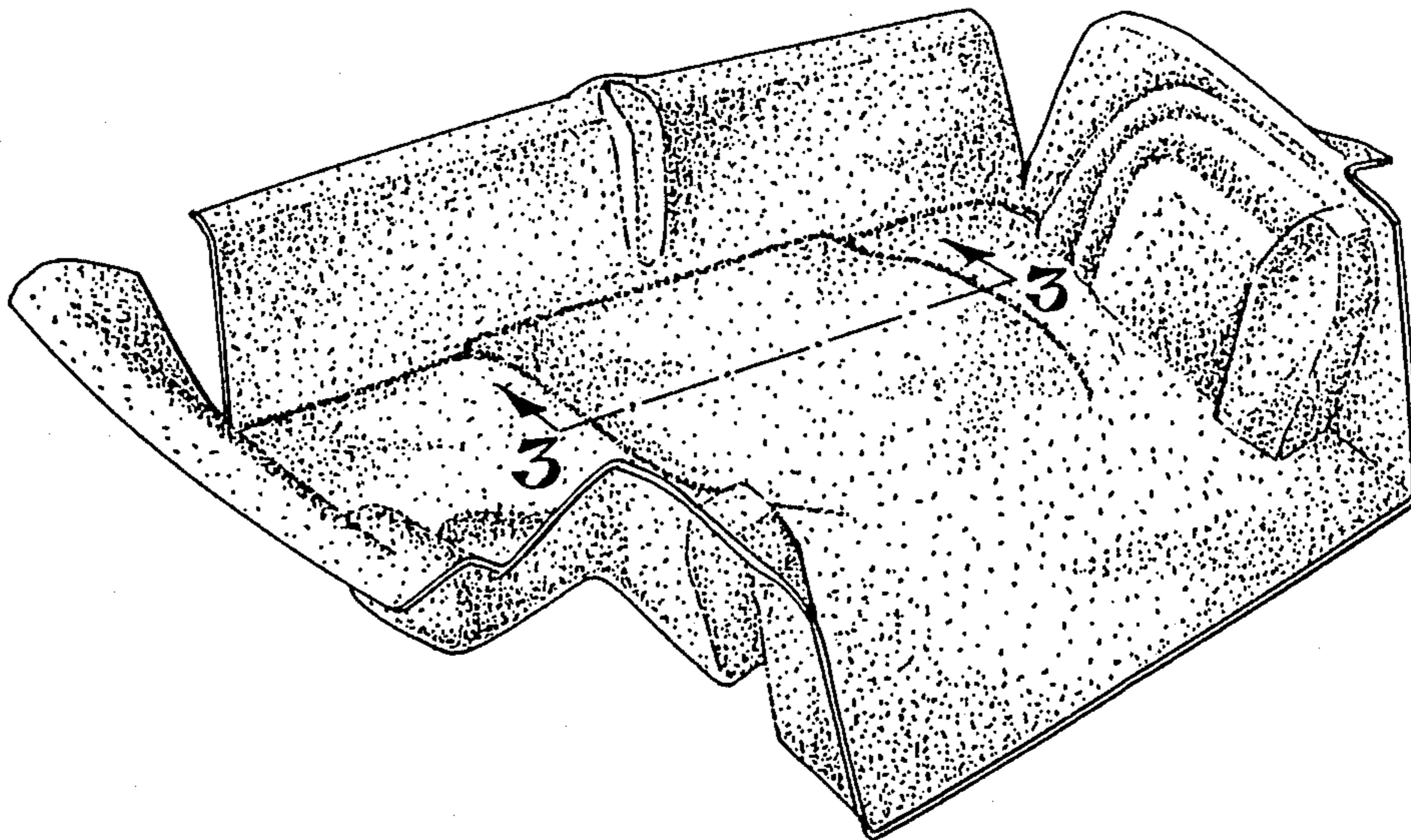

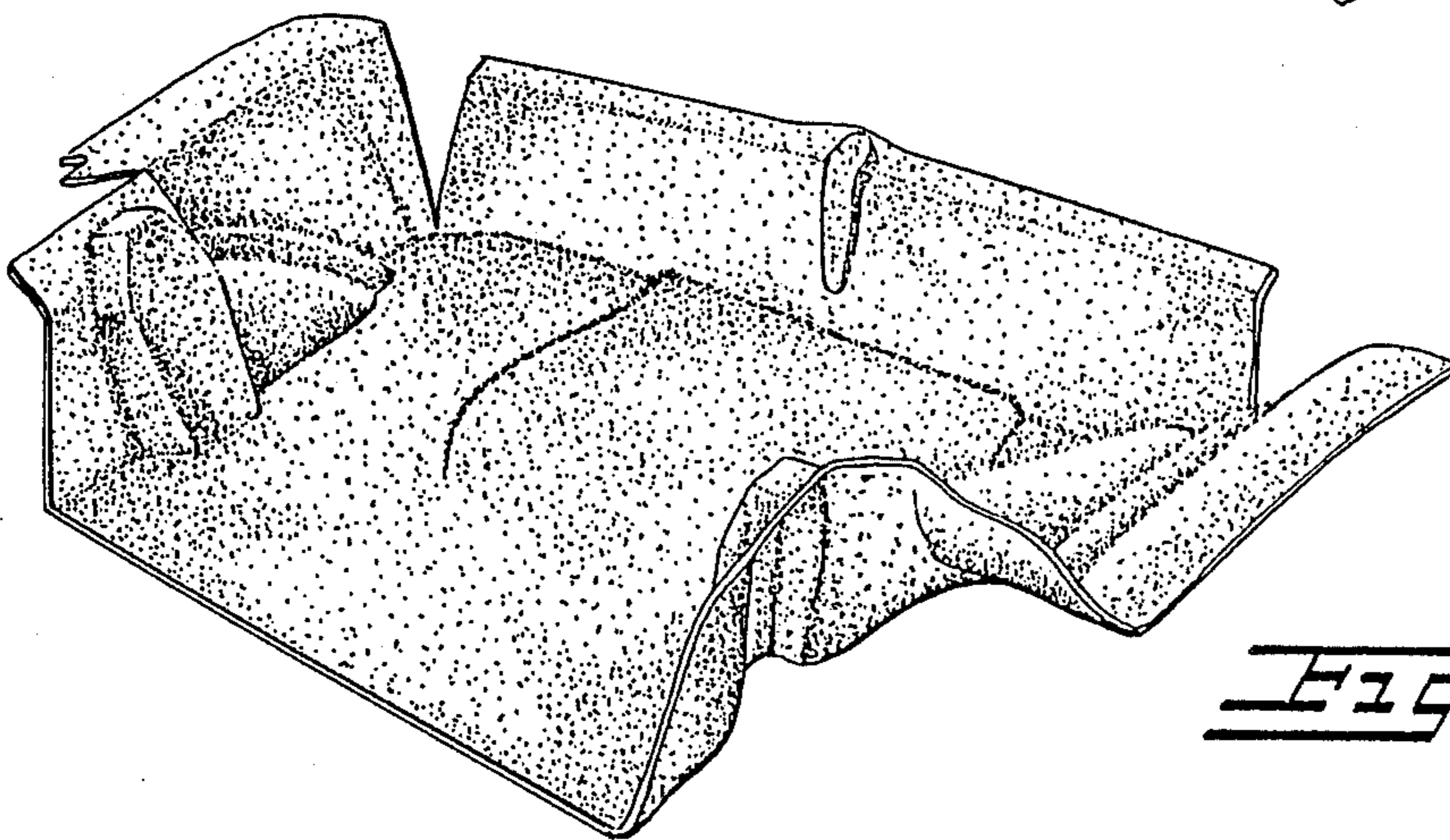
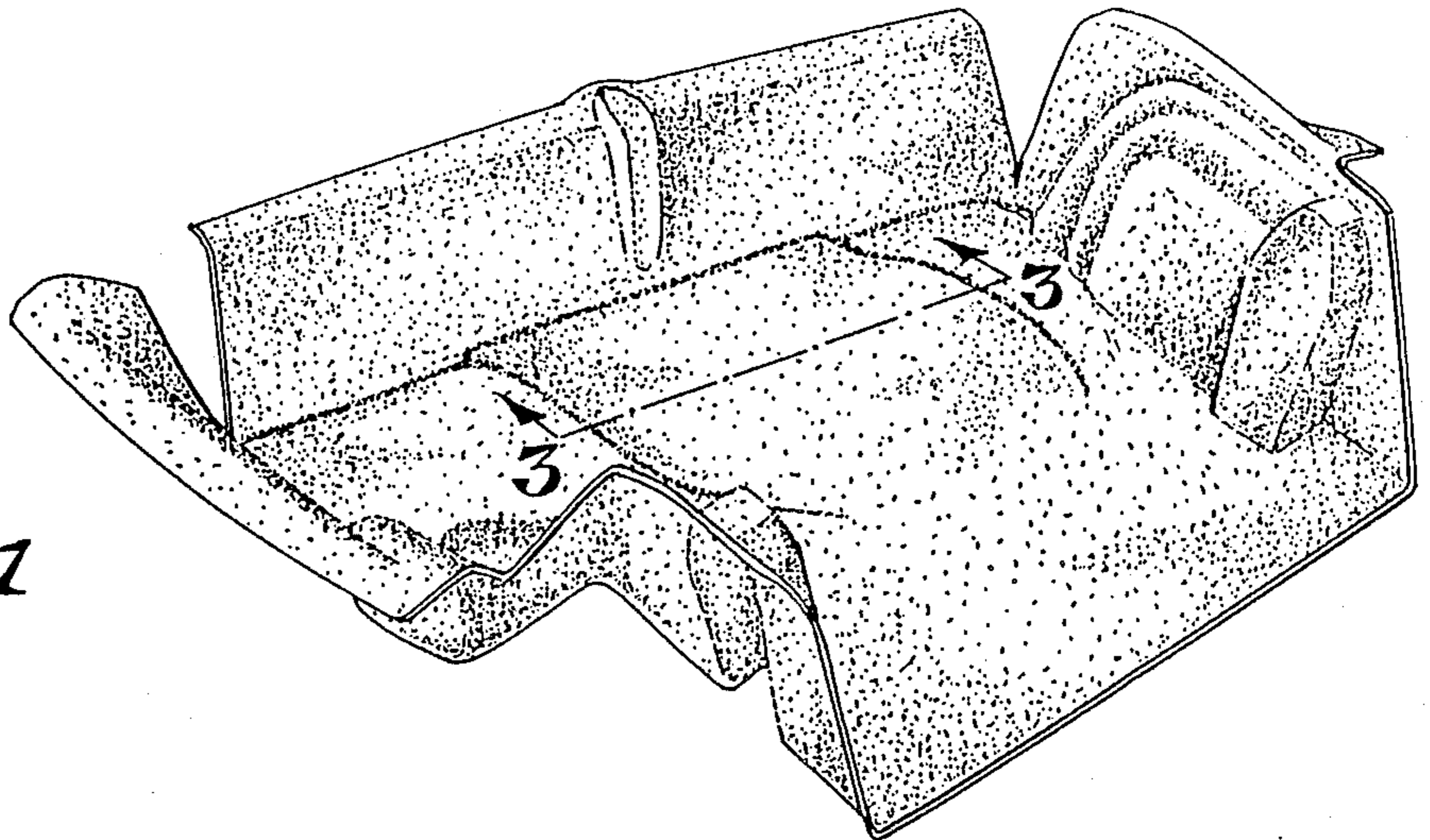
