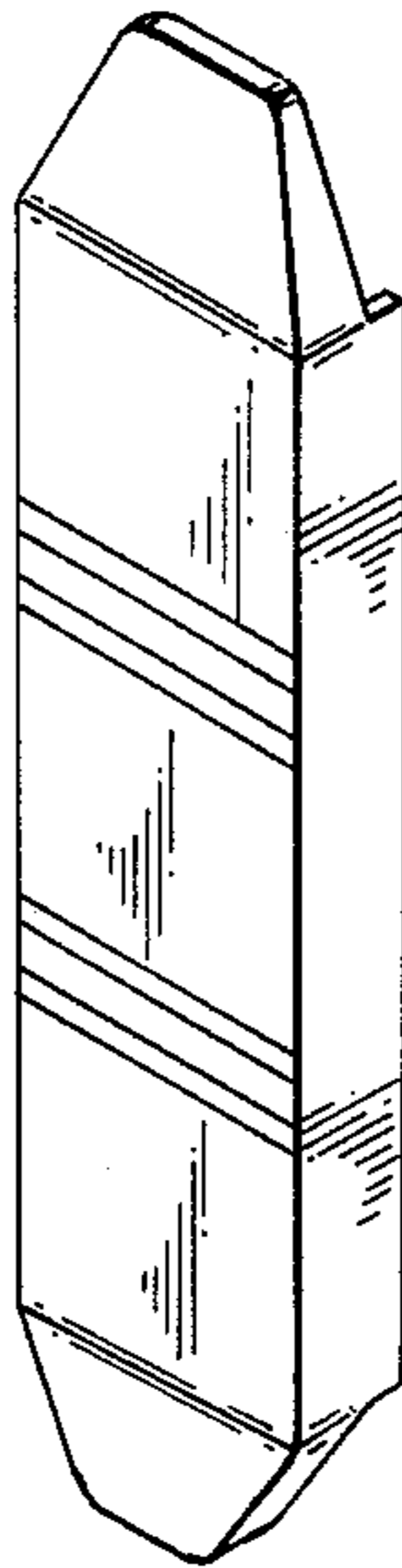
FIG. 2 is a greatly enlarged right front perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of FIG. 2 the bottom being a mirror image thereof.



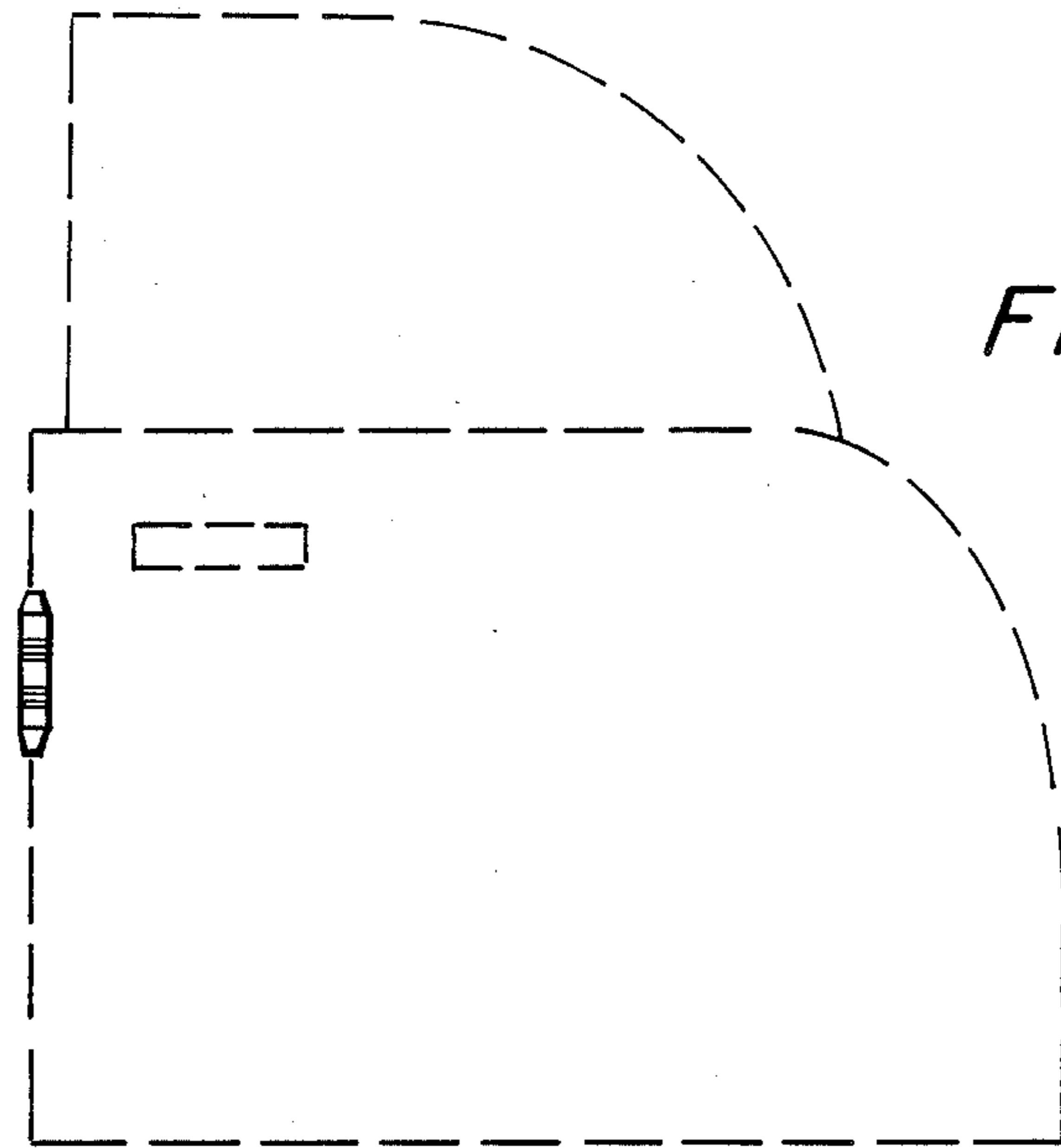

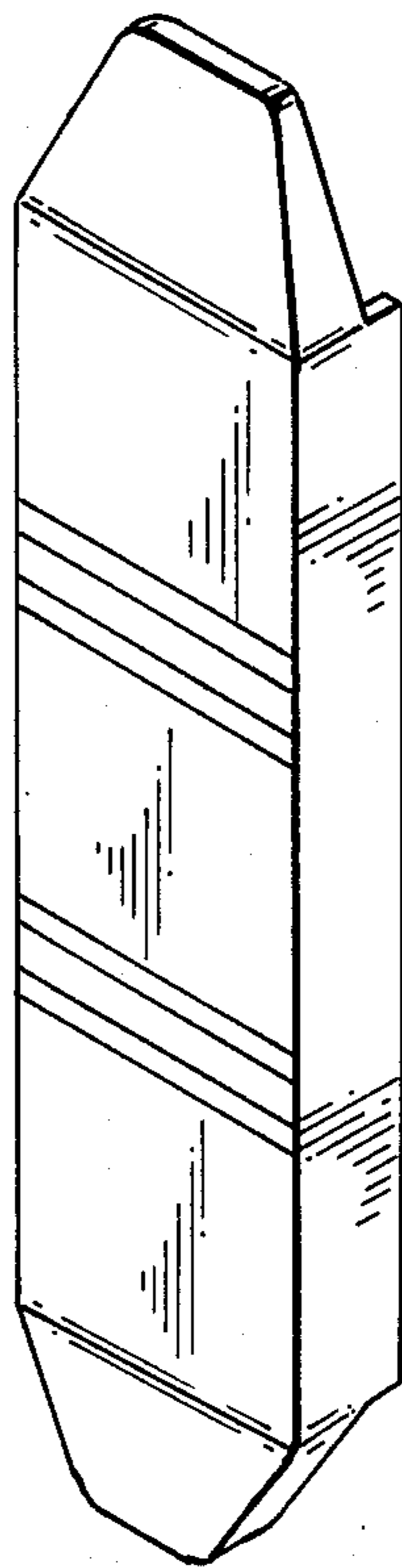

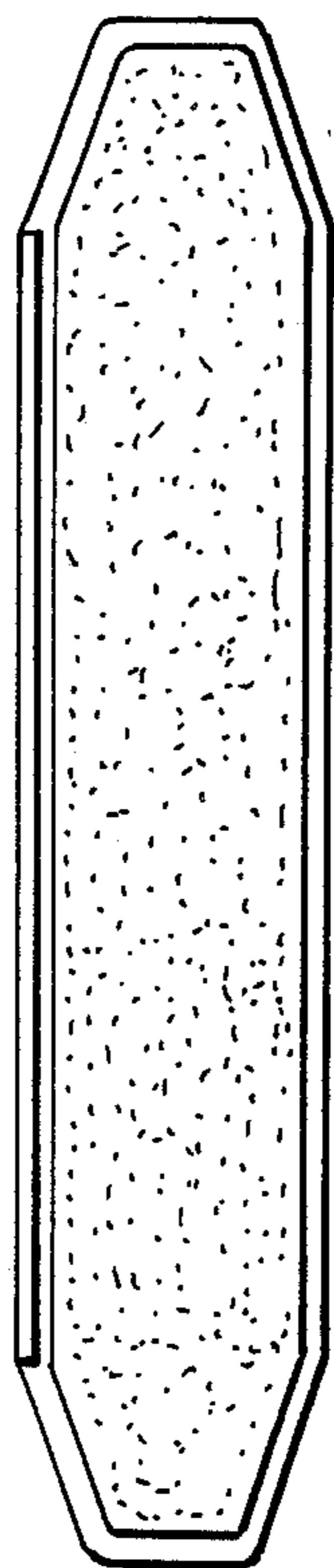

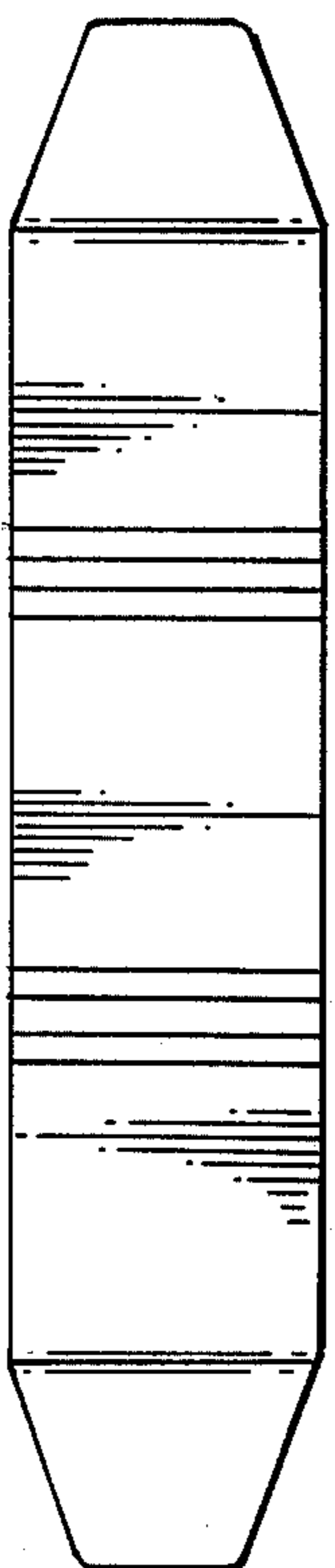

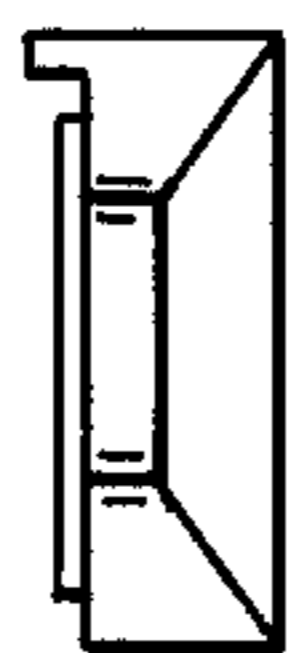
