DESCRIPTION

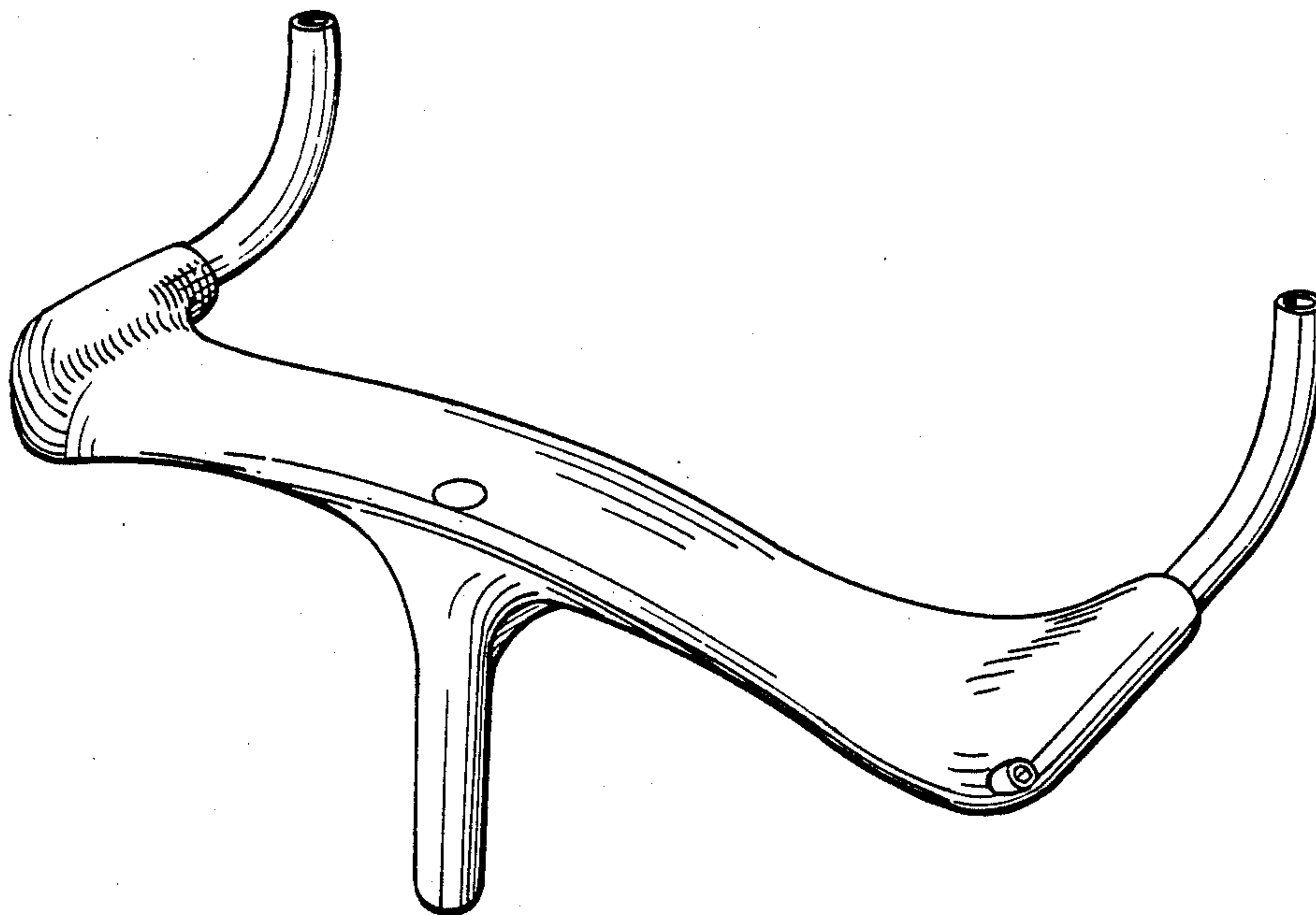
FIG. 1 is a rear elevation view of a handlebar, especially for racing bicycle;

FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof.



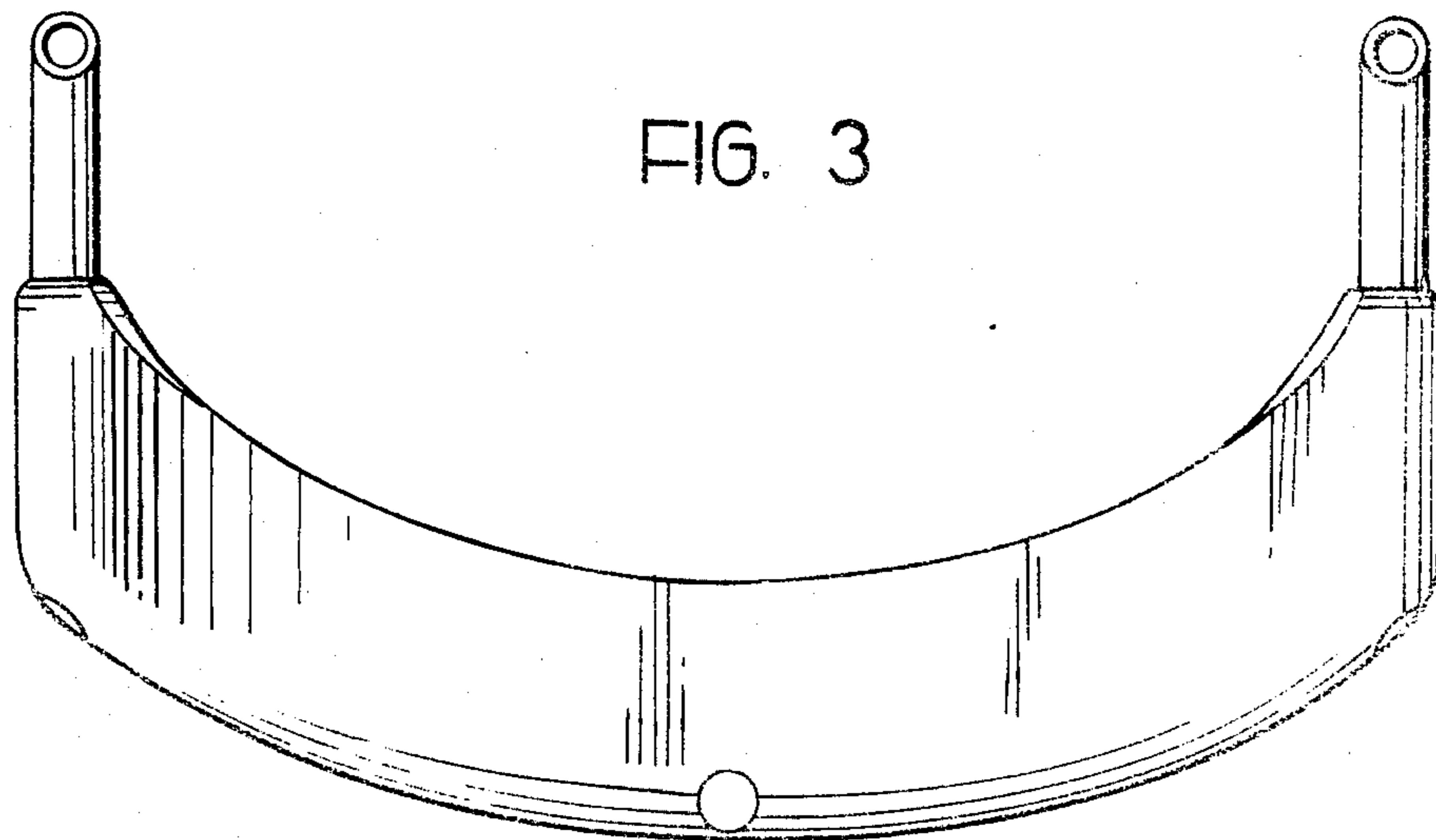
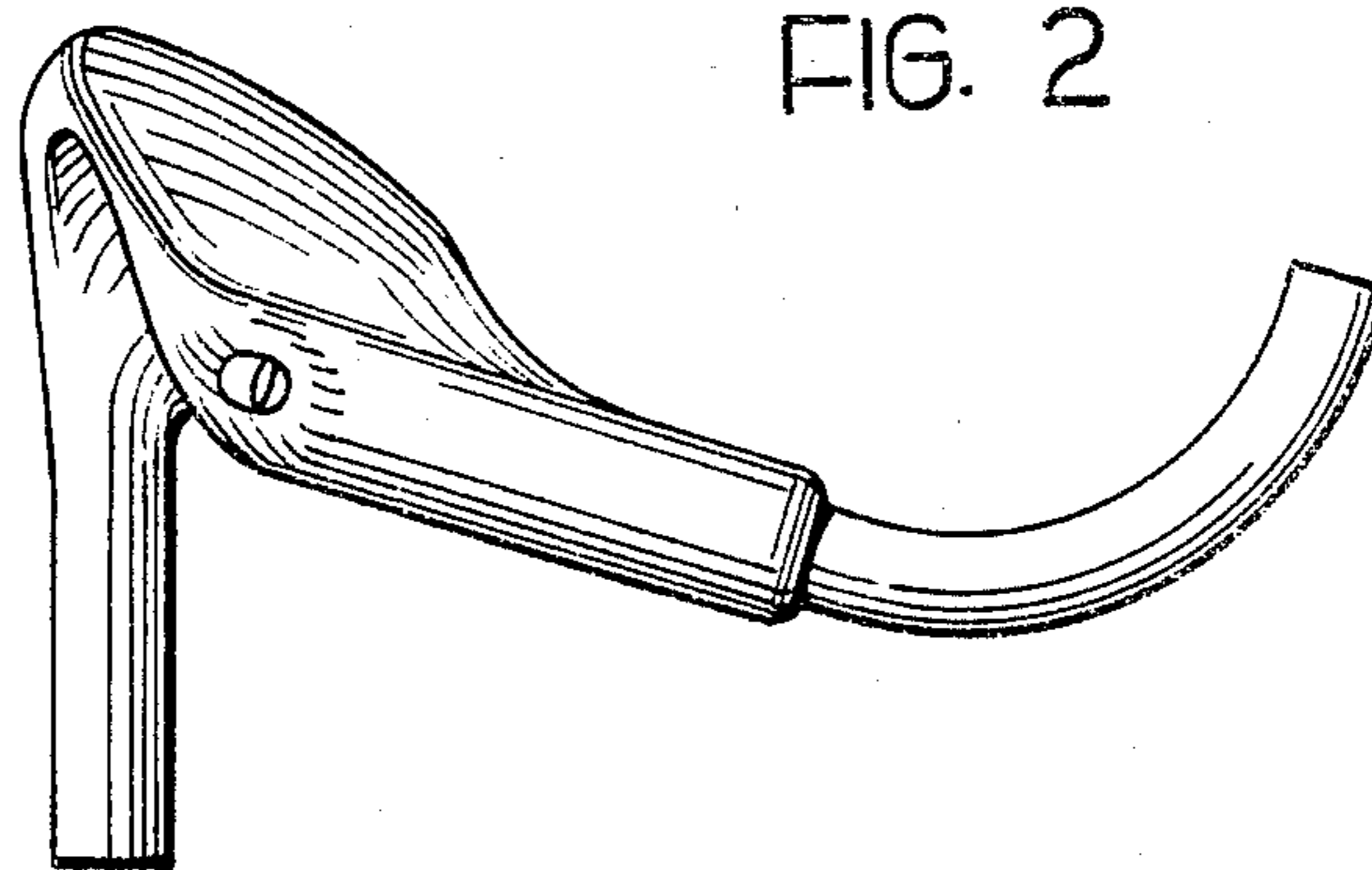
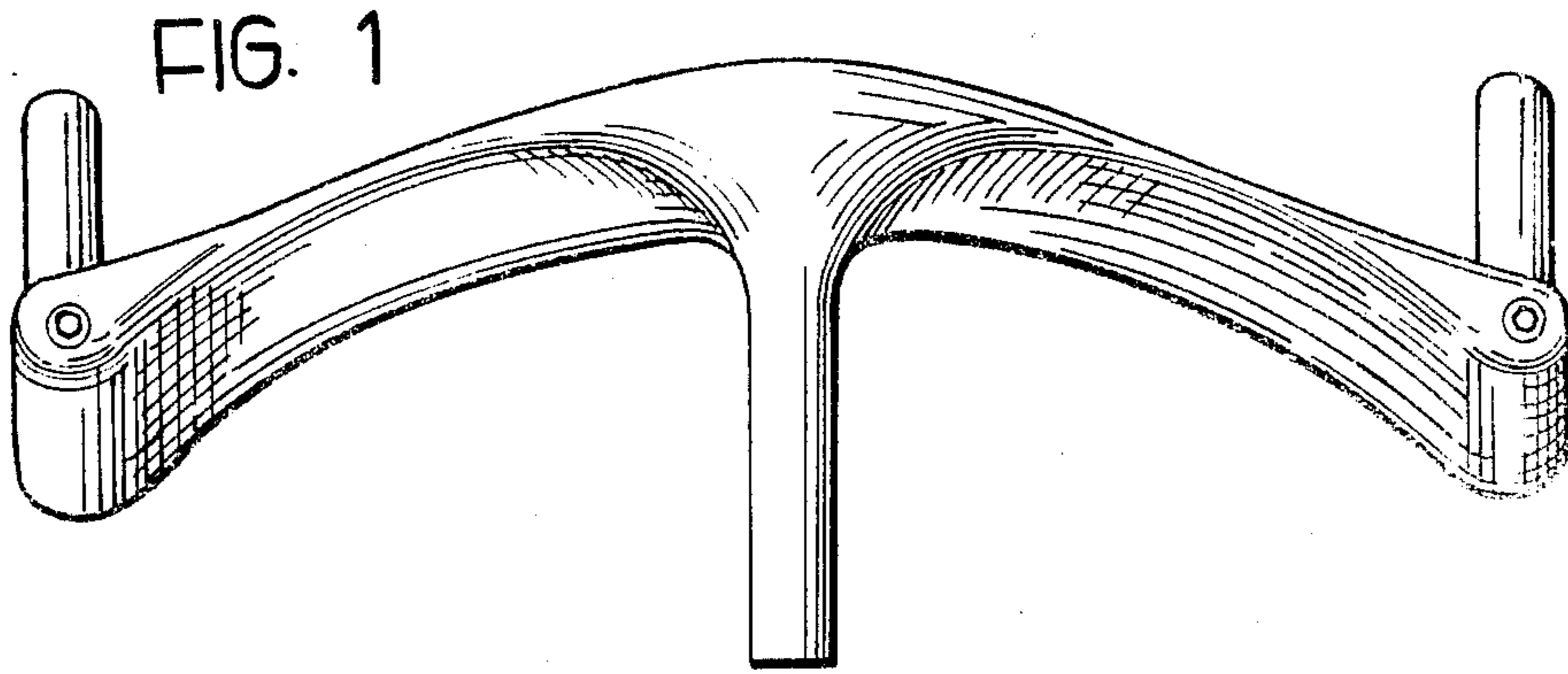

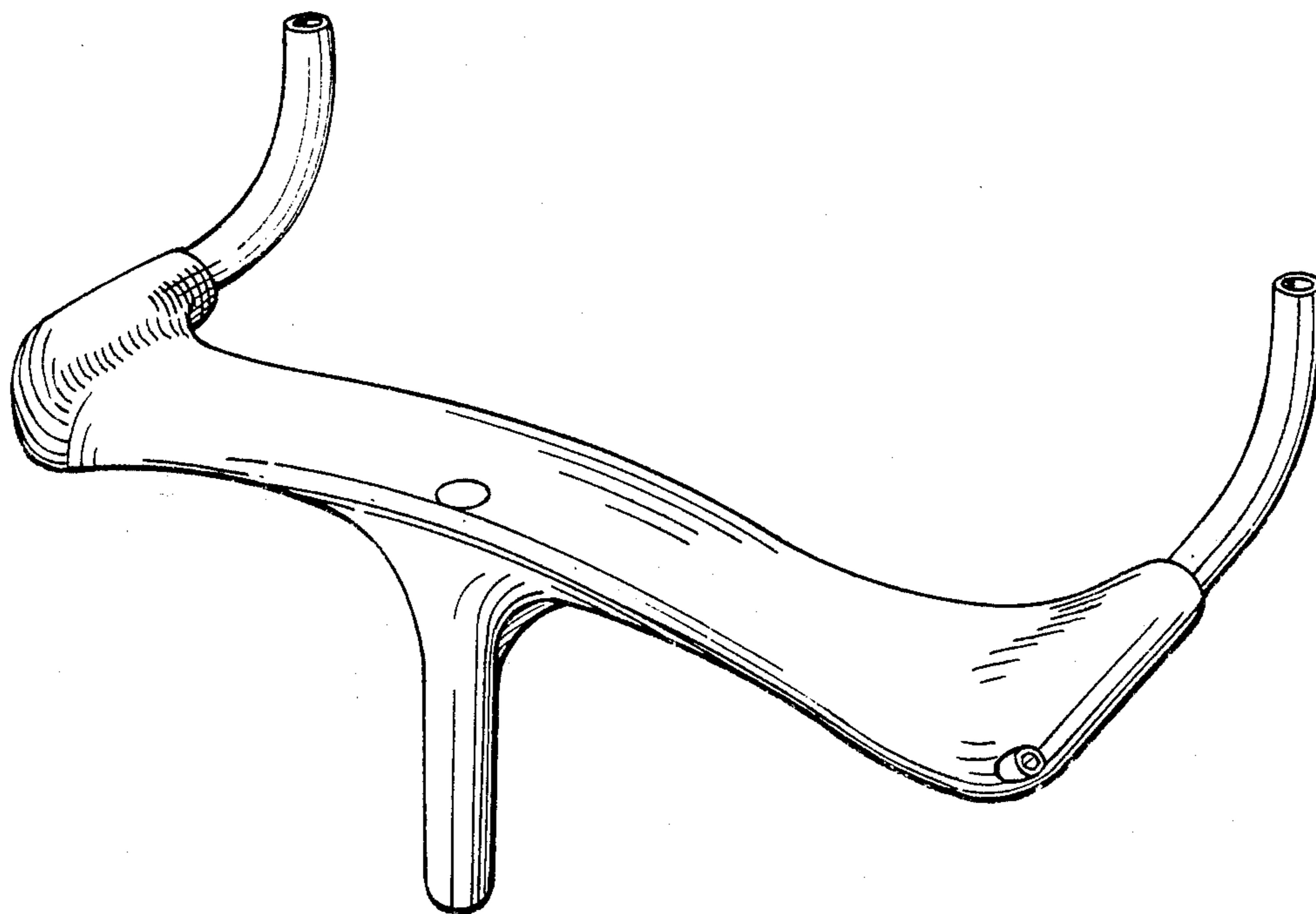
