DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a caddy for holding and displaying markers showing my new design, the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

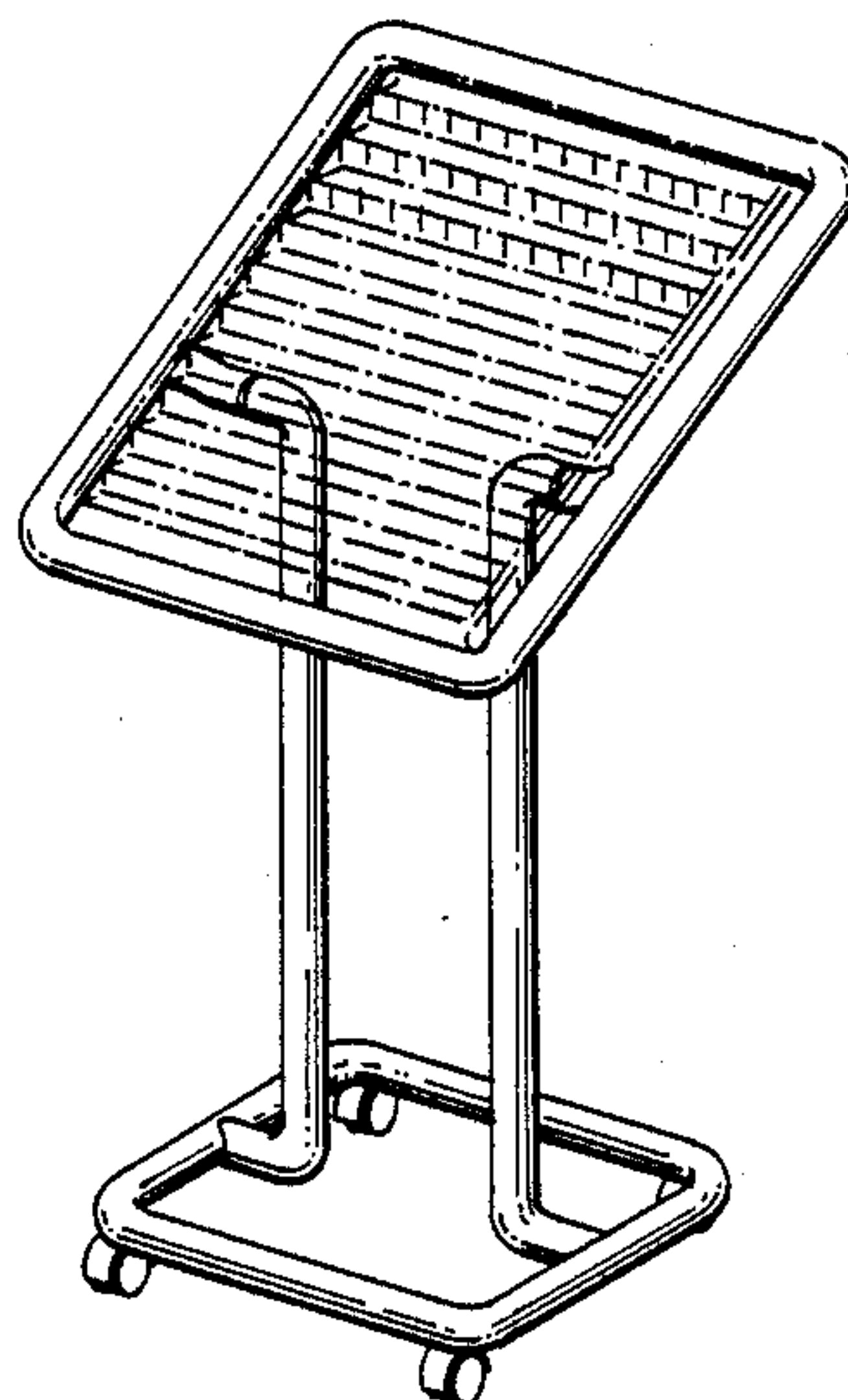
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



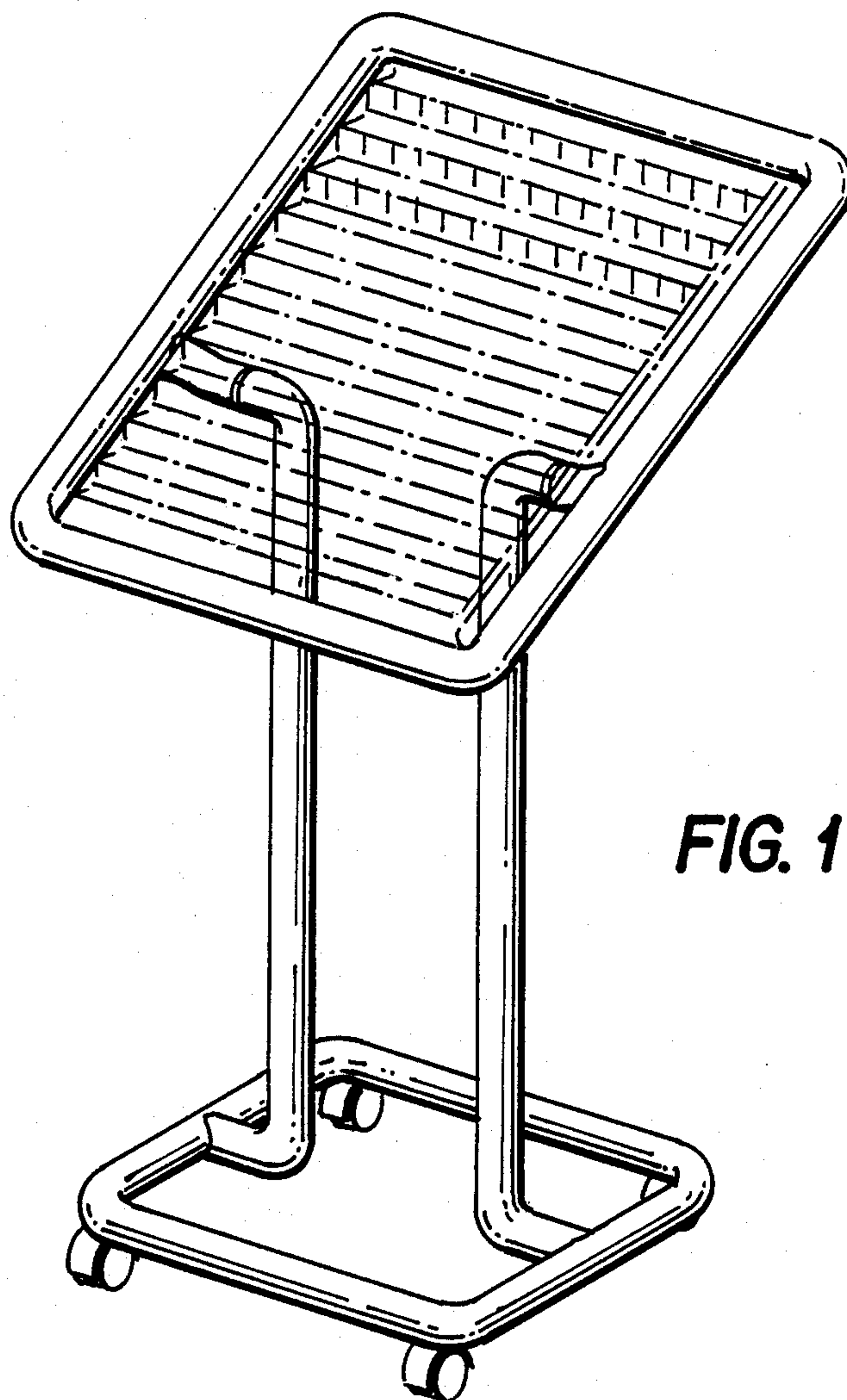
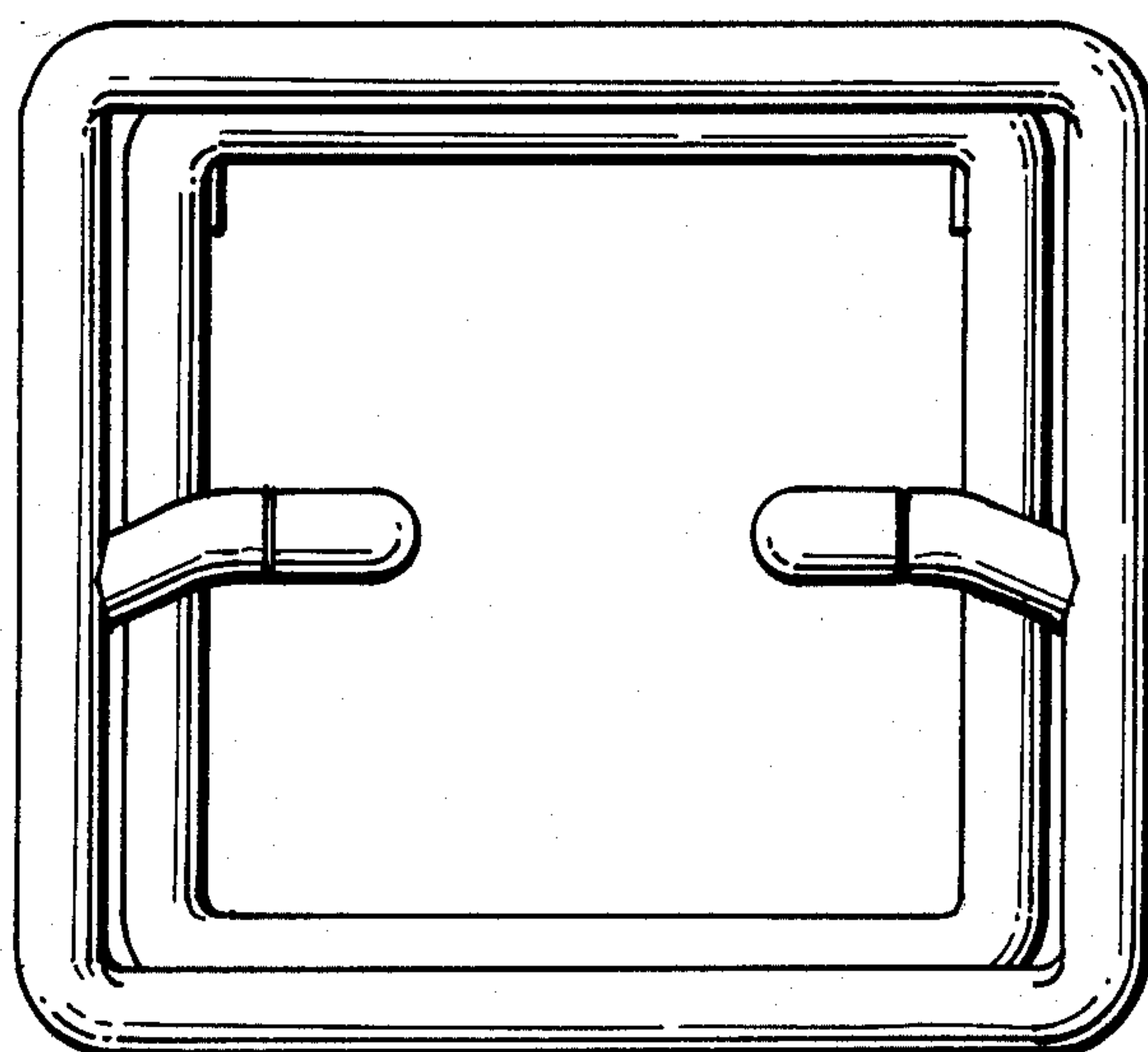

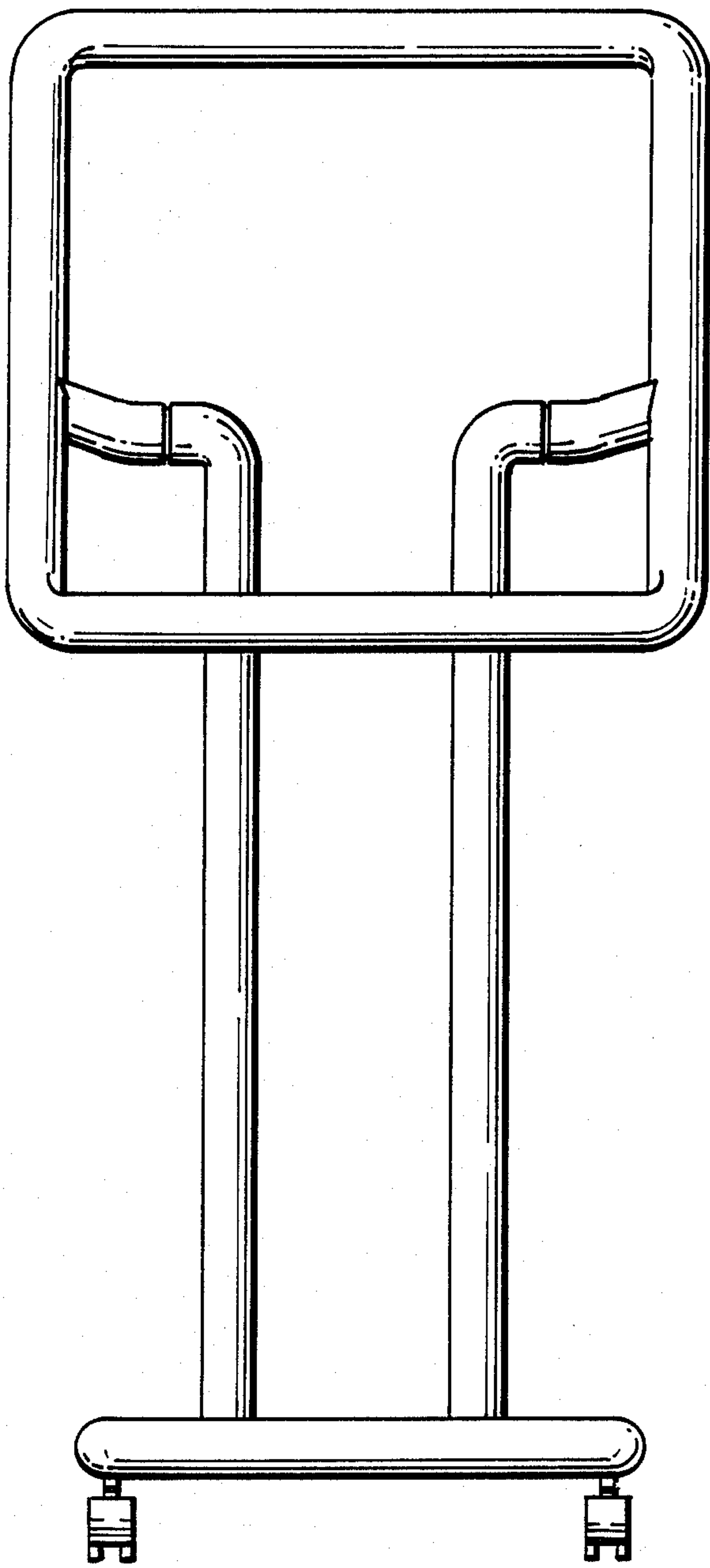

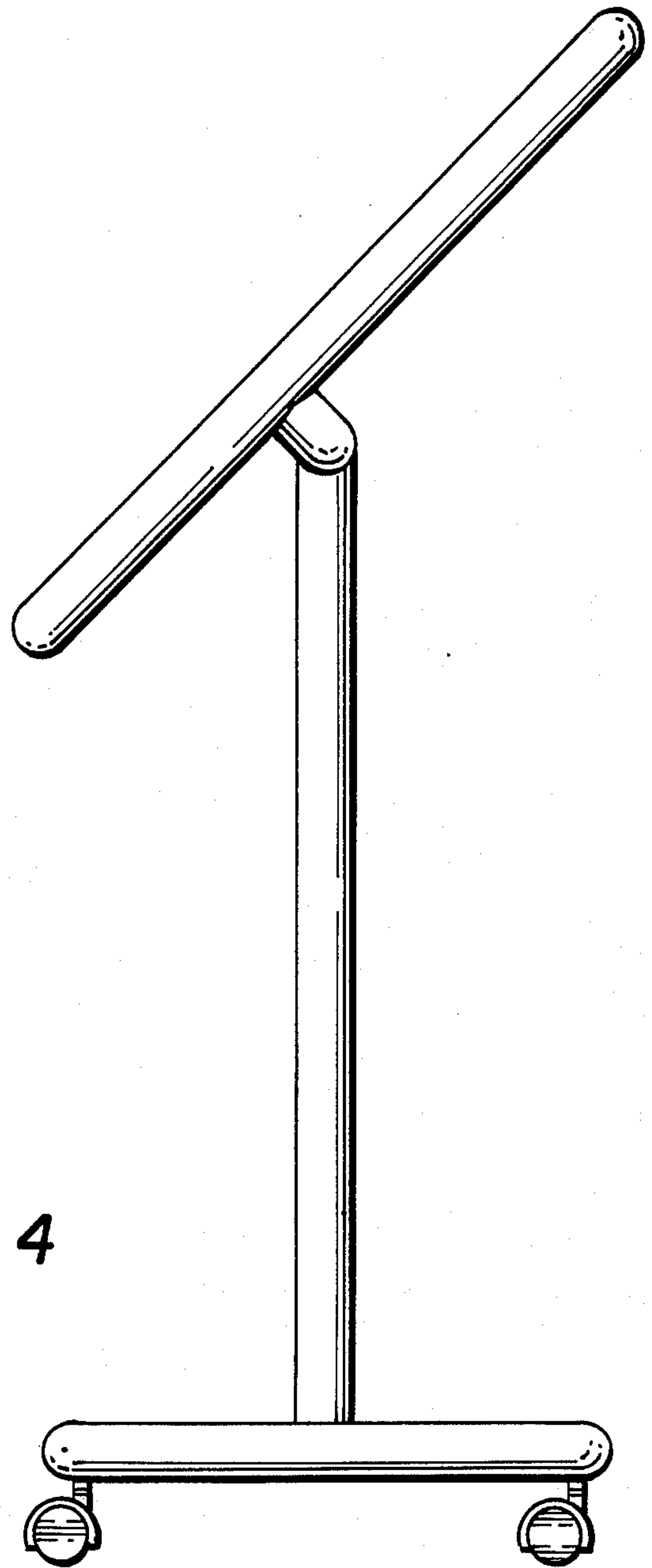

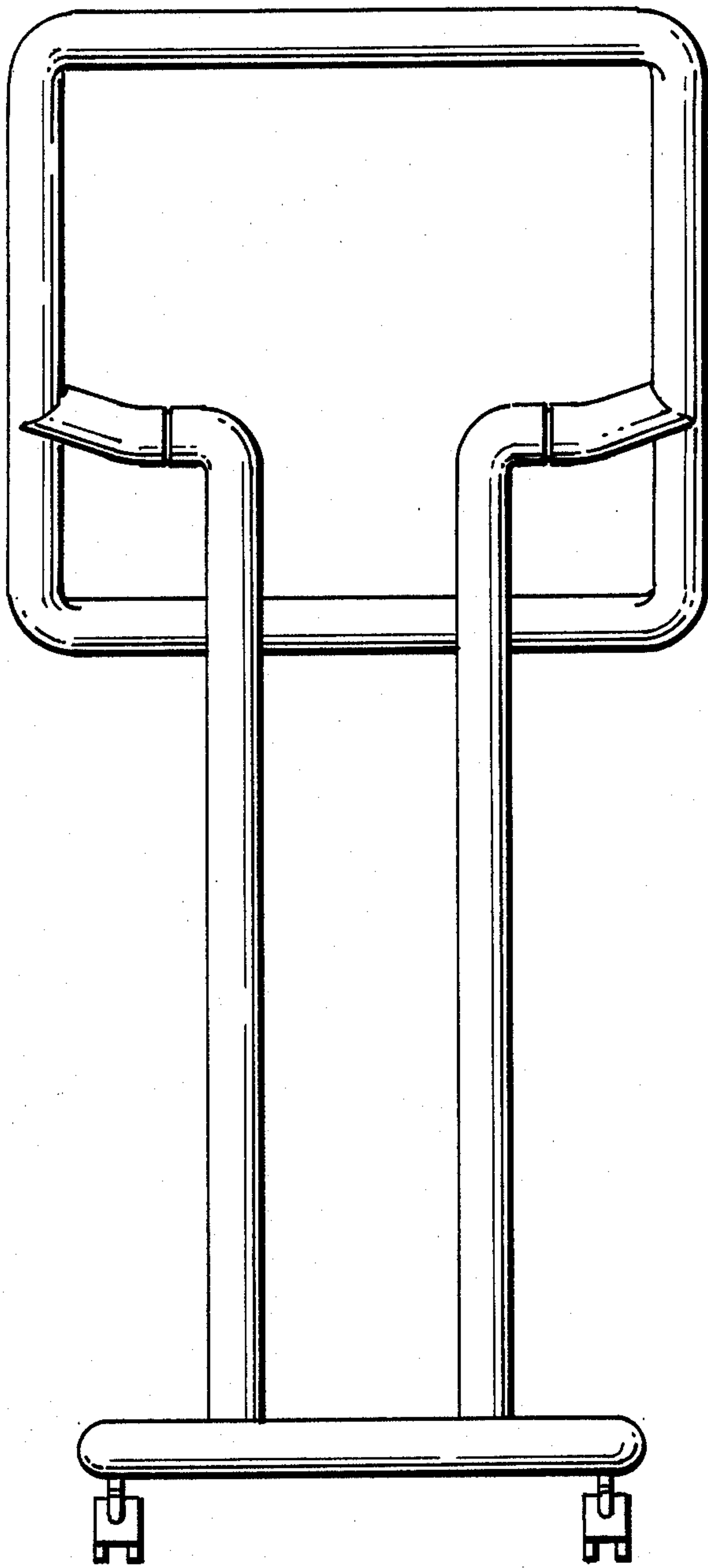
