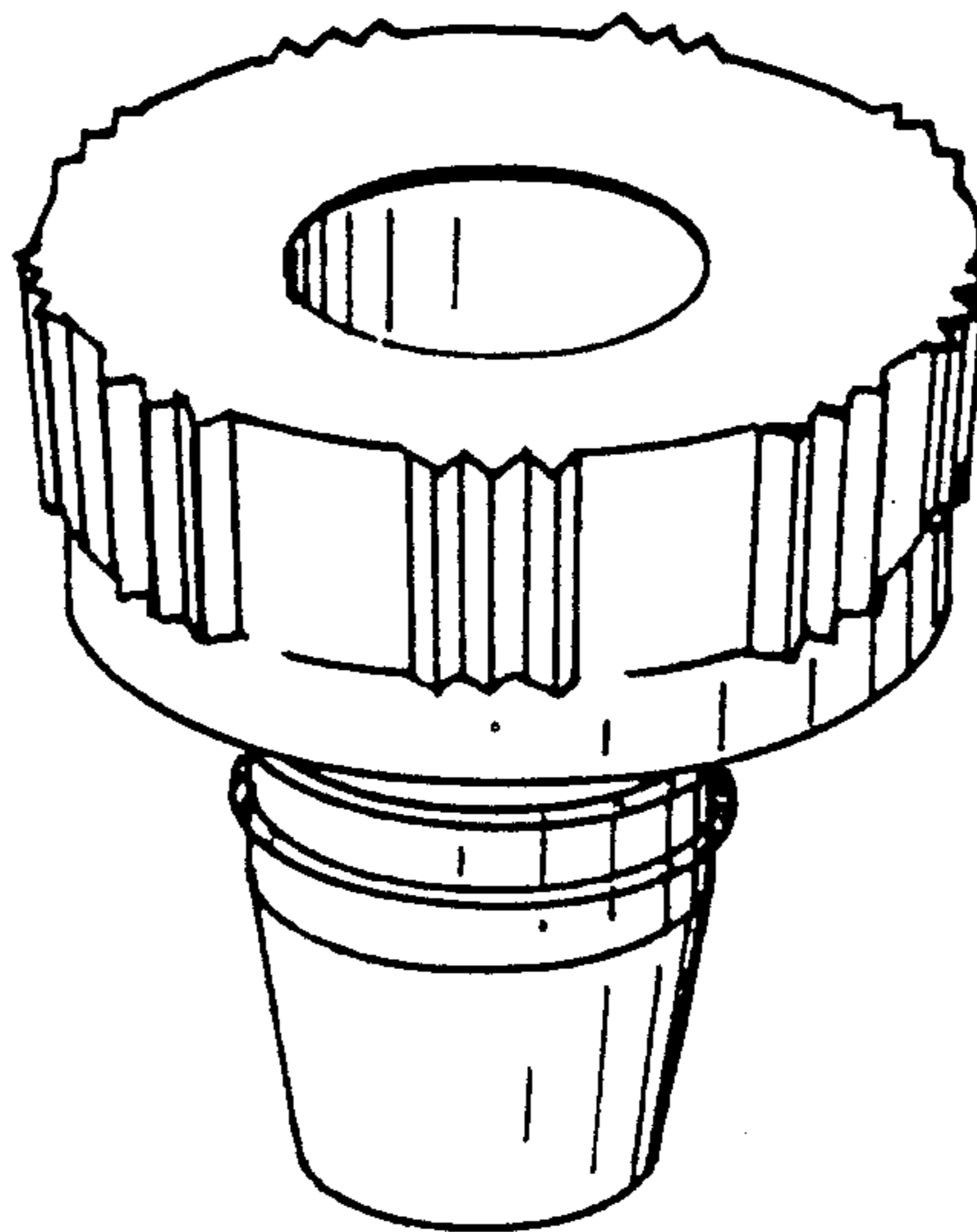

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sample vial plug, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a sample vial plug showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed sides being identical thereto.



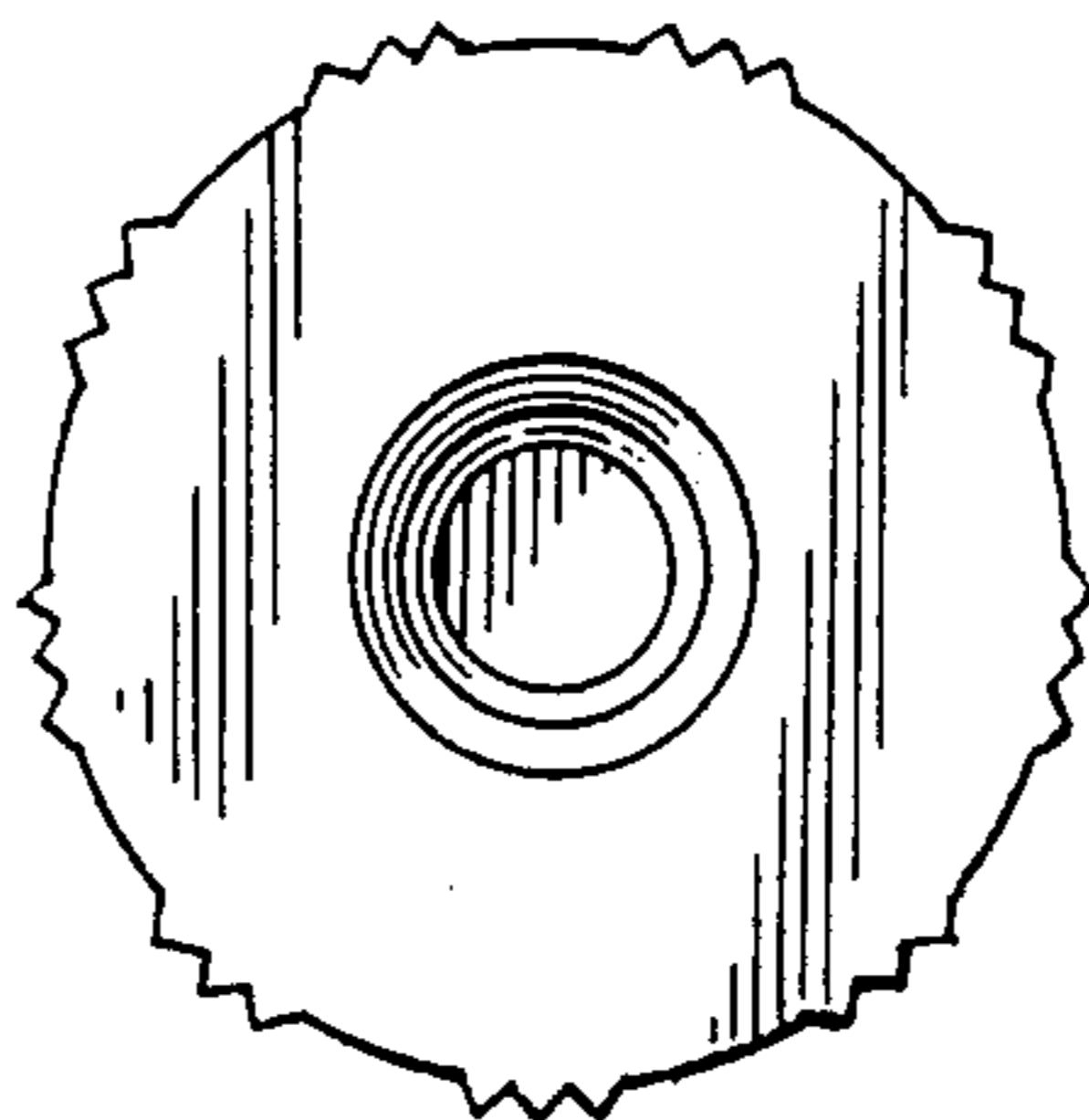

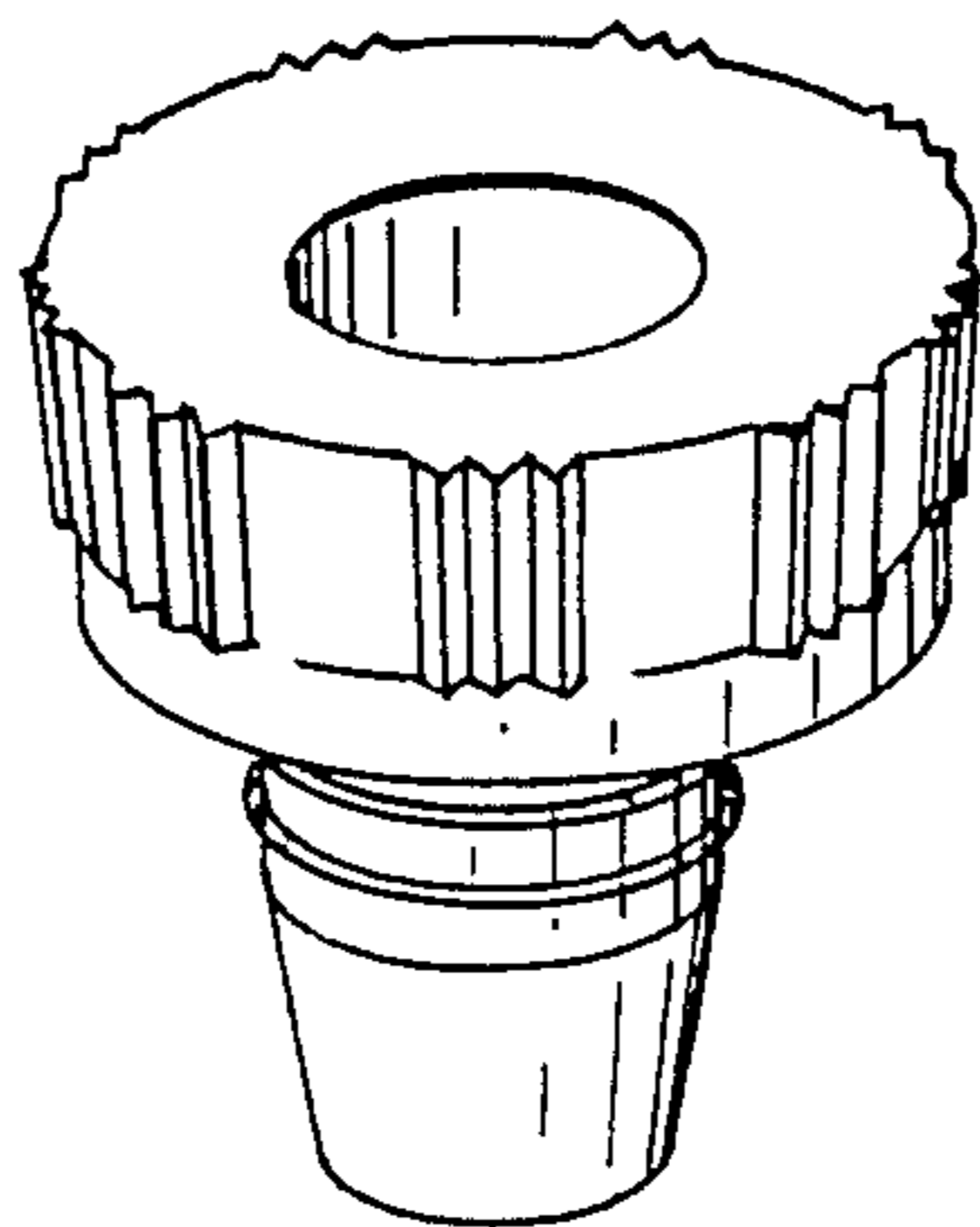

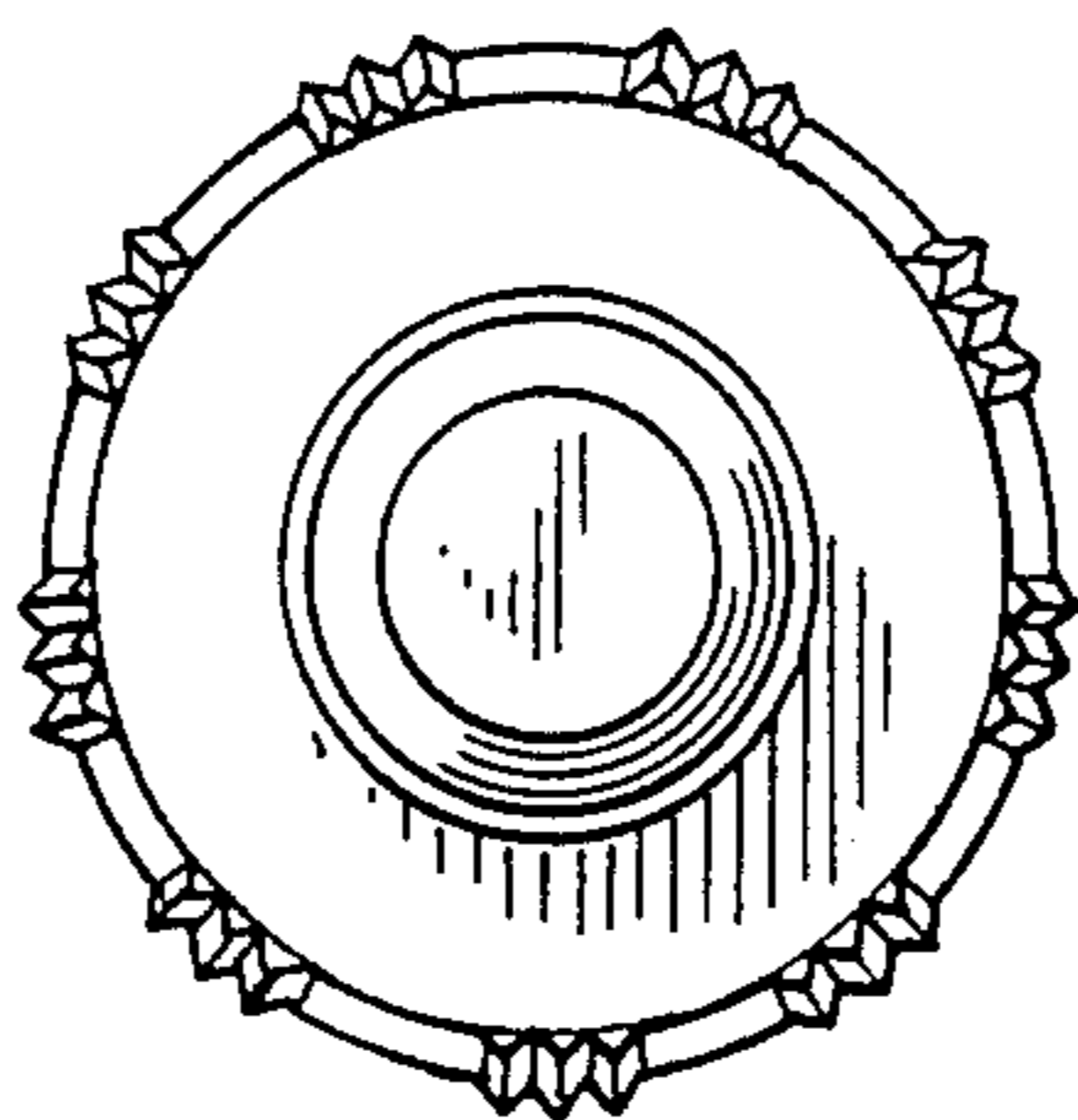

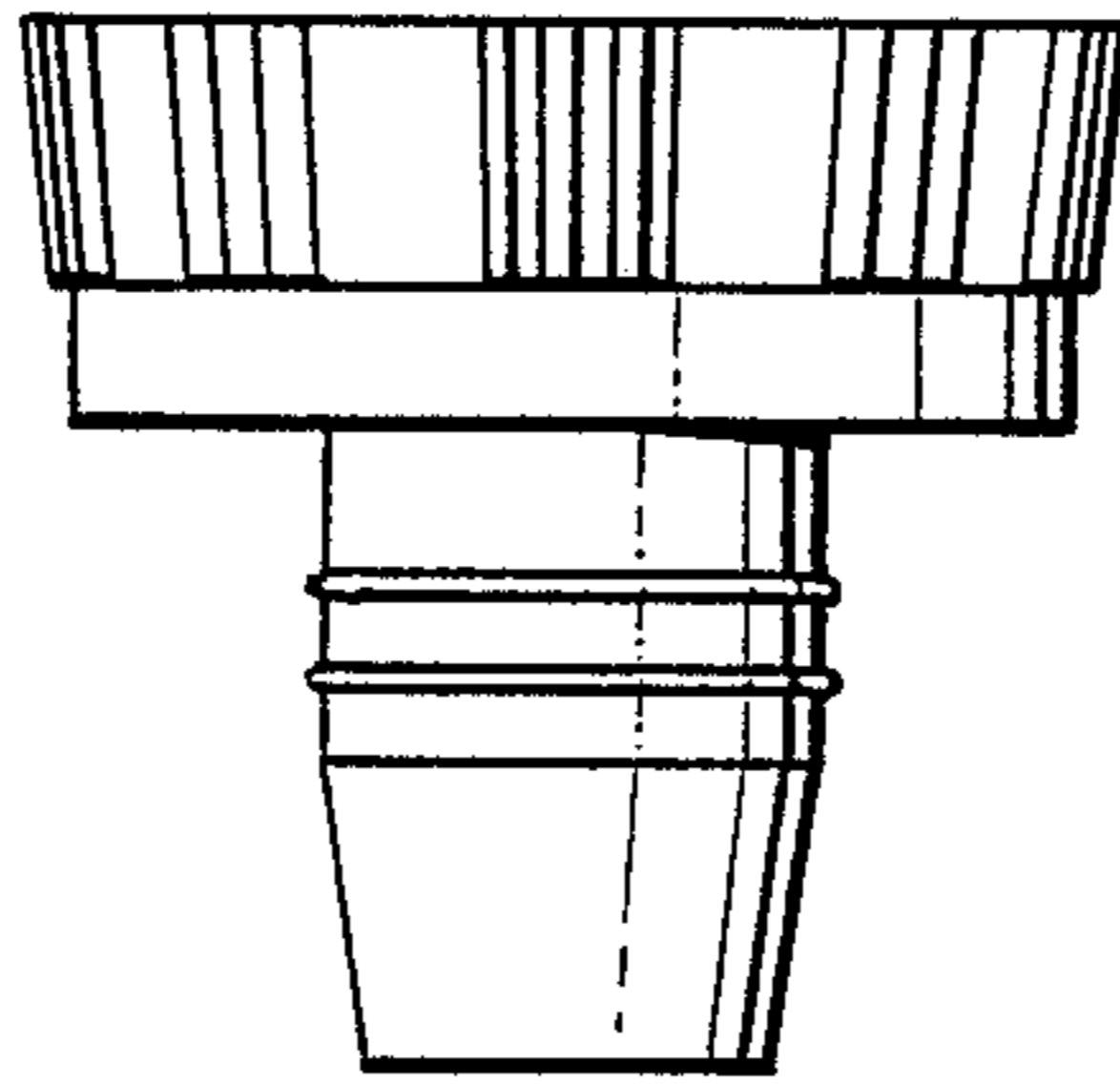
