DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a gutter showing our new design; the broken lines showing shingles and fascia board is for illustrative purposes only; and FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof. The broken line showing of environmental structure in Figs. 1, 2 and 3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
