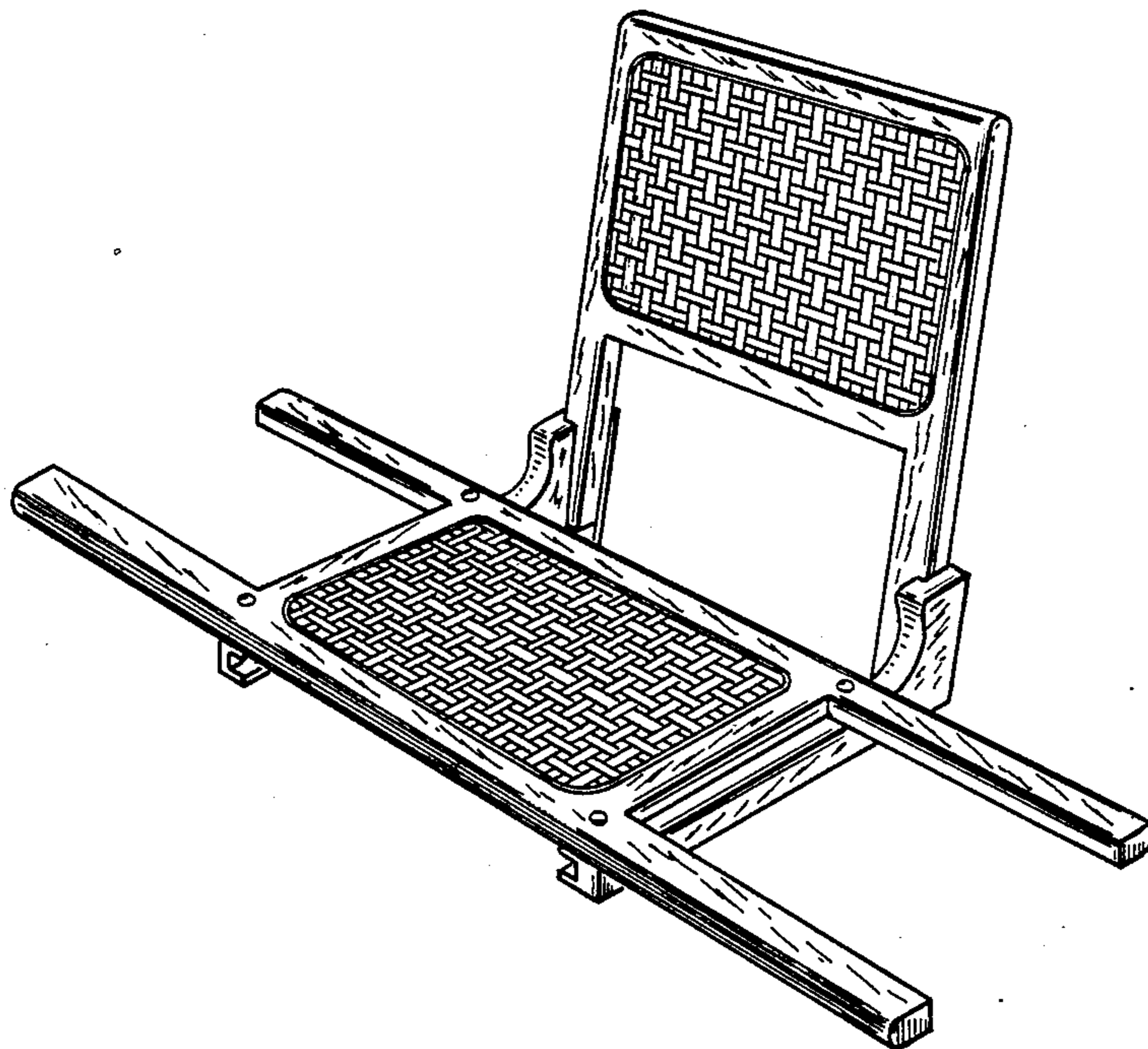

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foldable seat for use primarily in a canoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the foldable seat for use primarily in a canoe showing my design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top view; FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the foldable seat for use primarily in a canoe in the folded position.



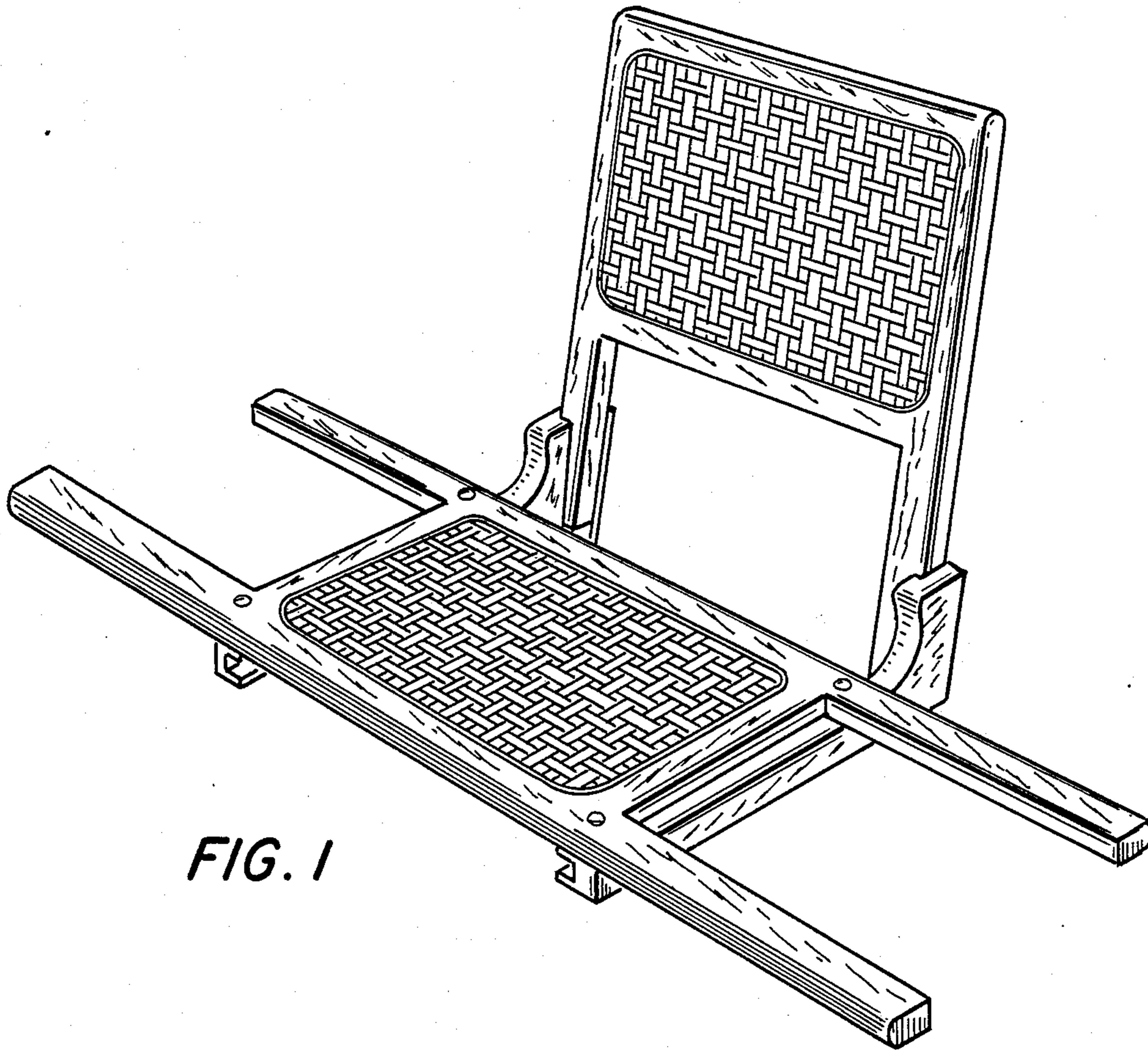

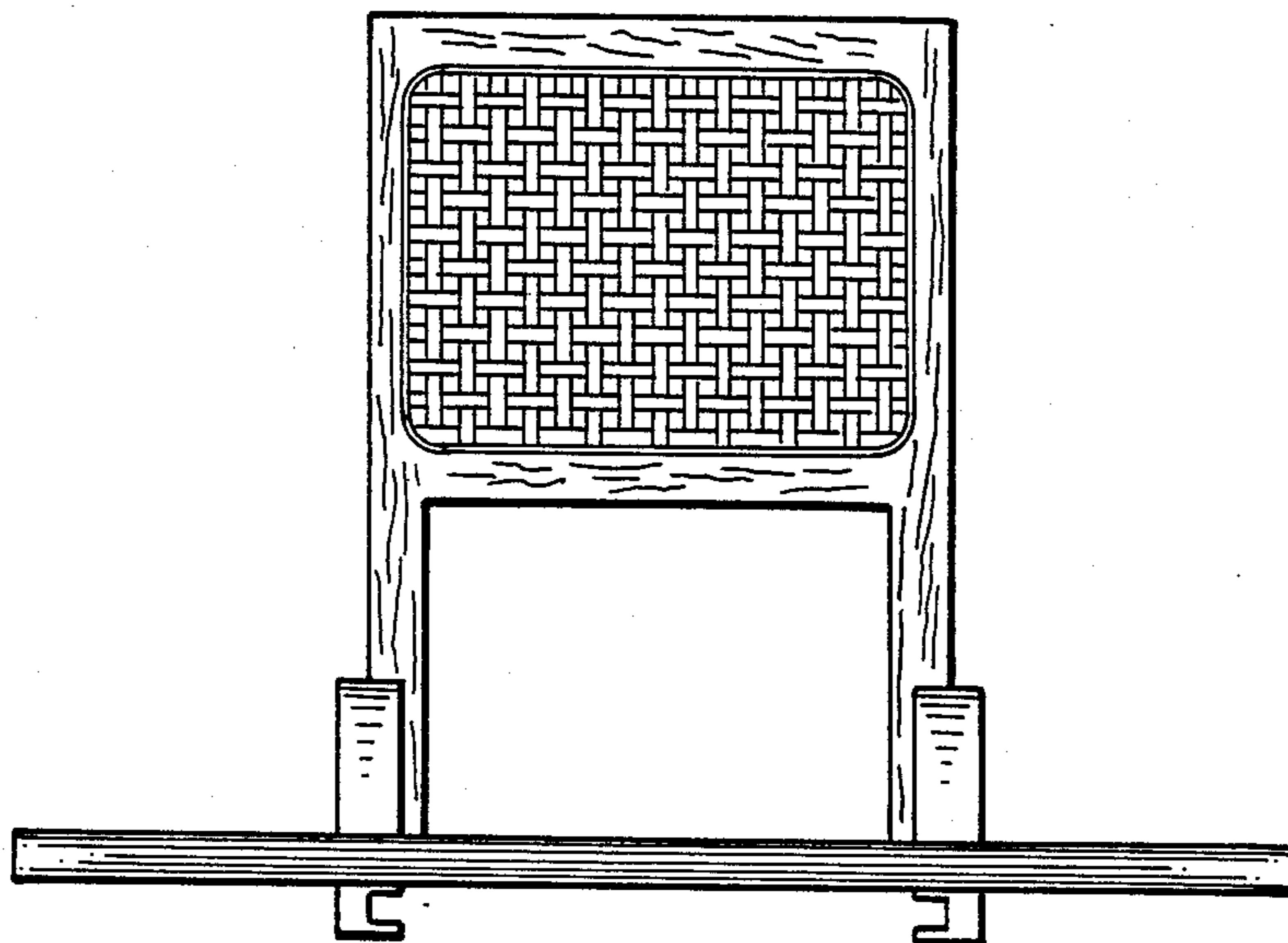

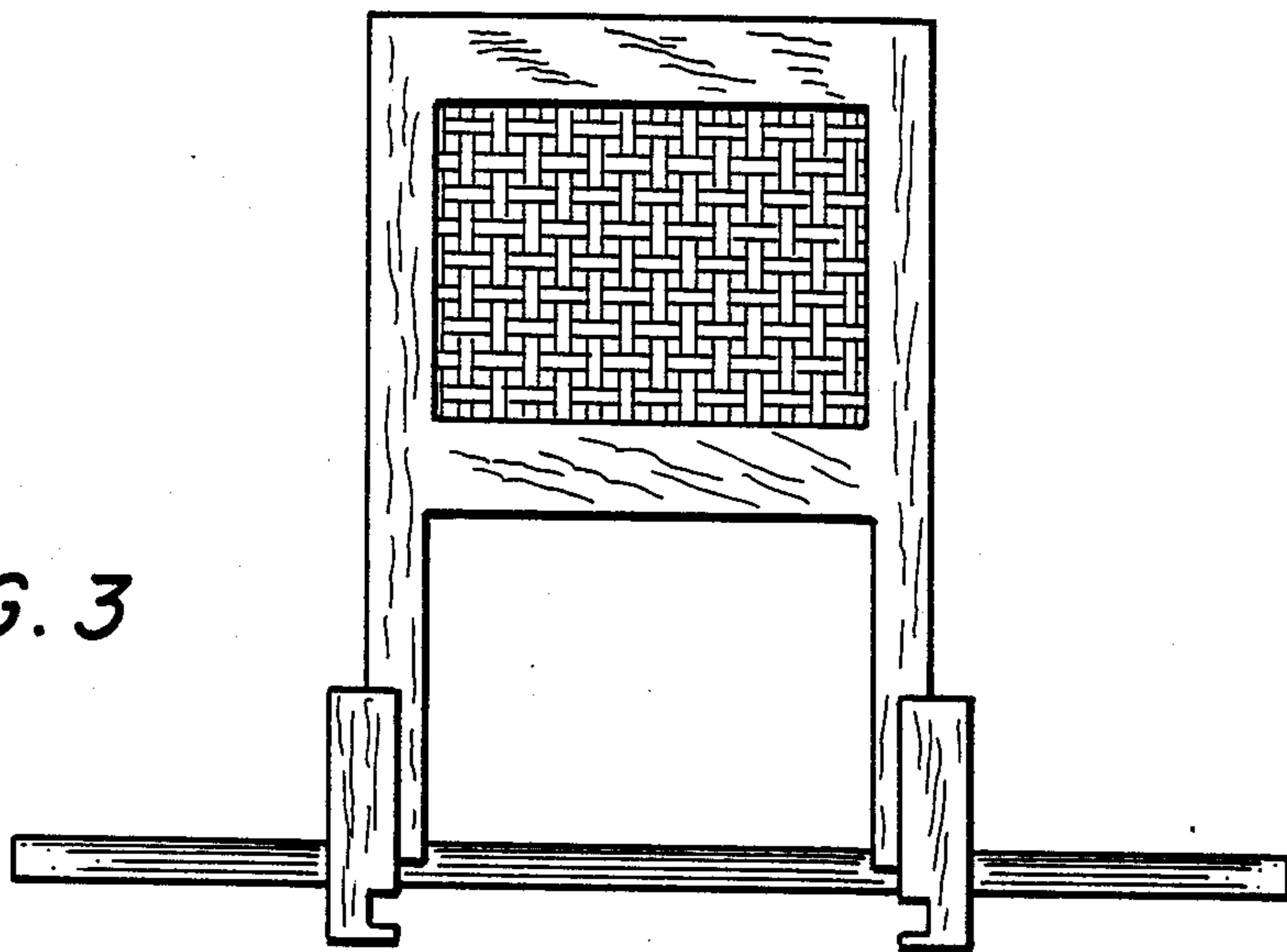

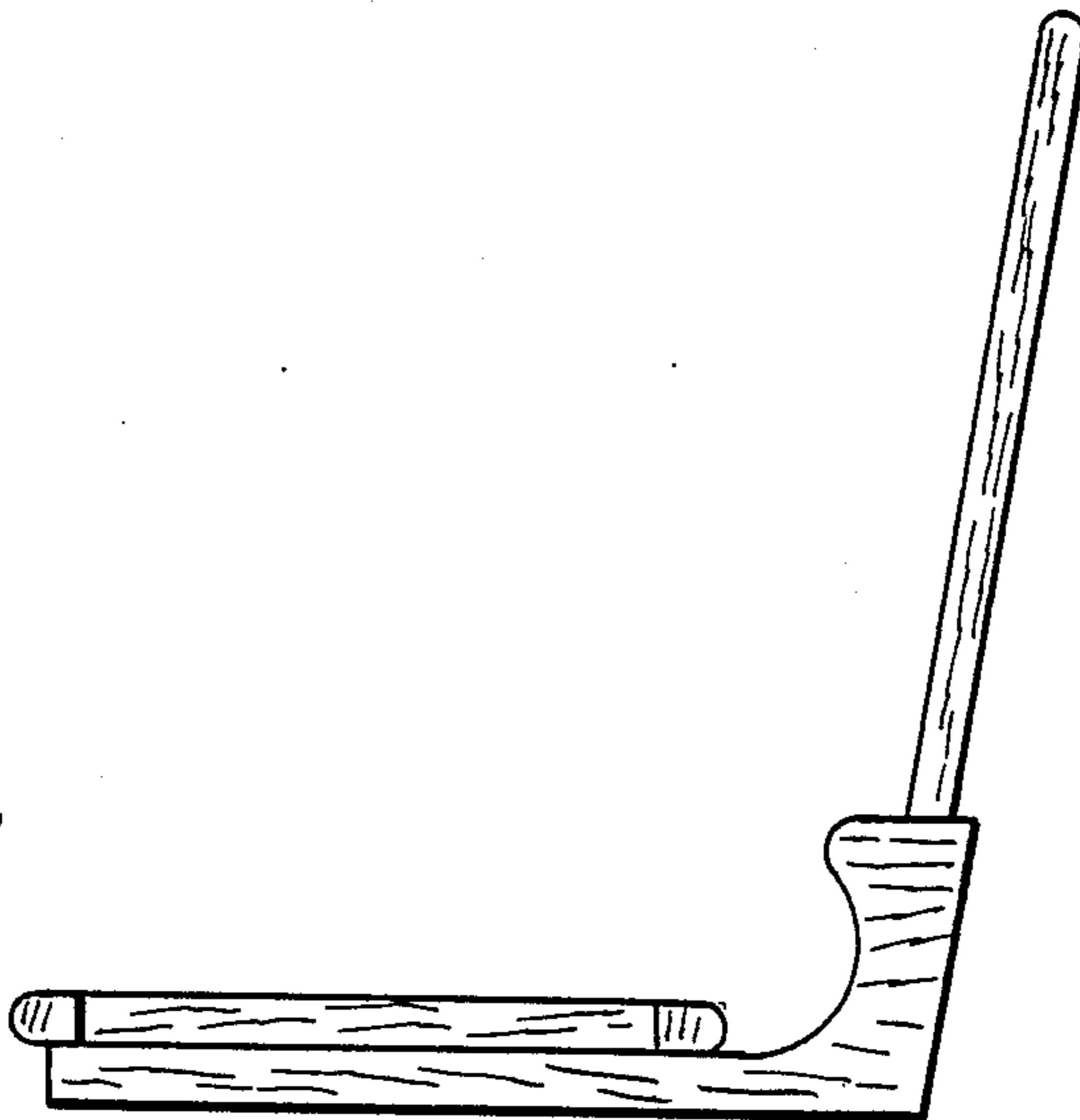
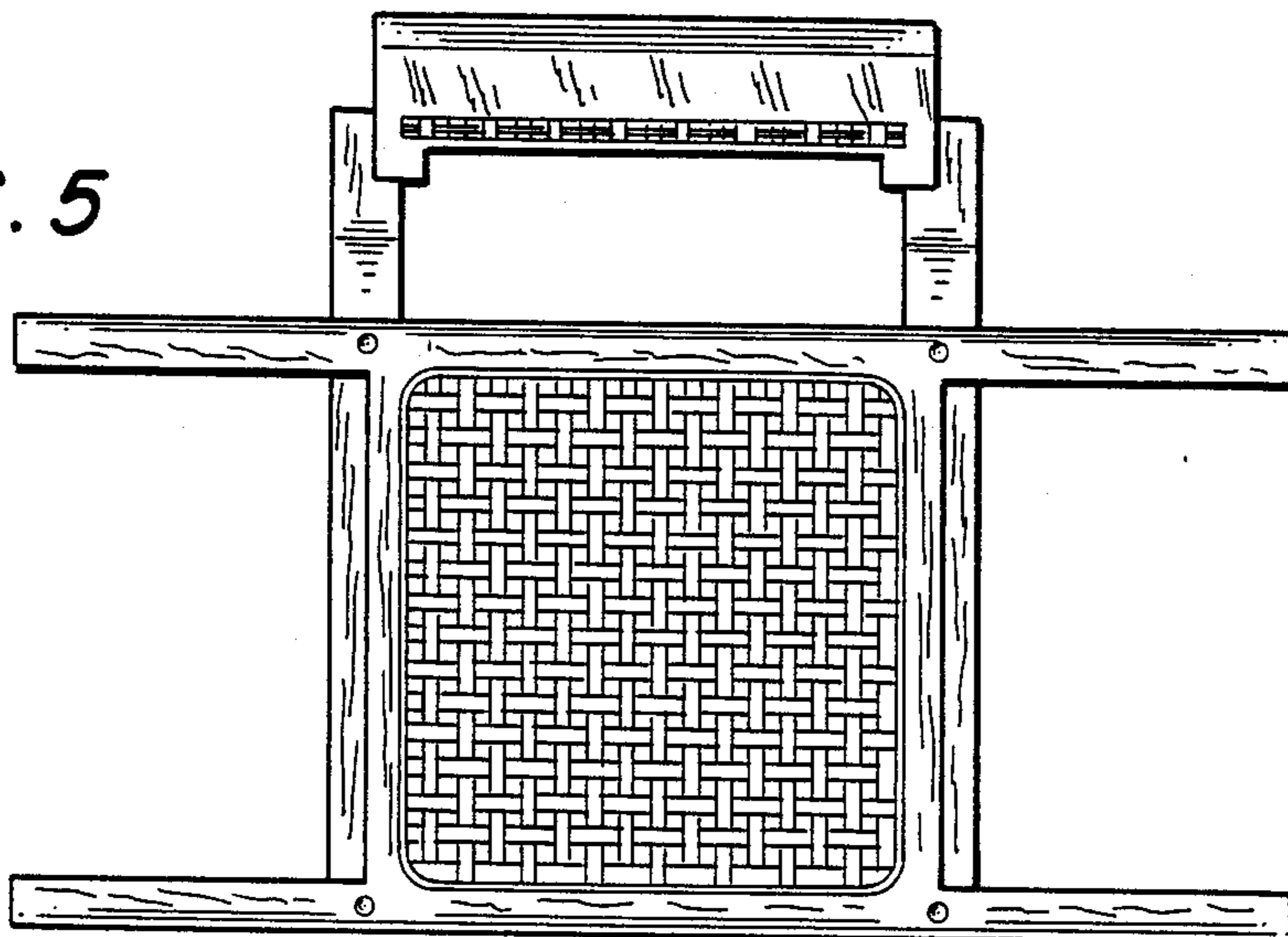

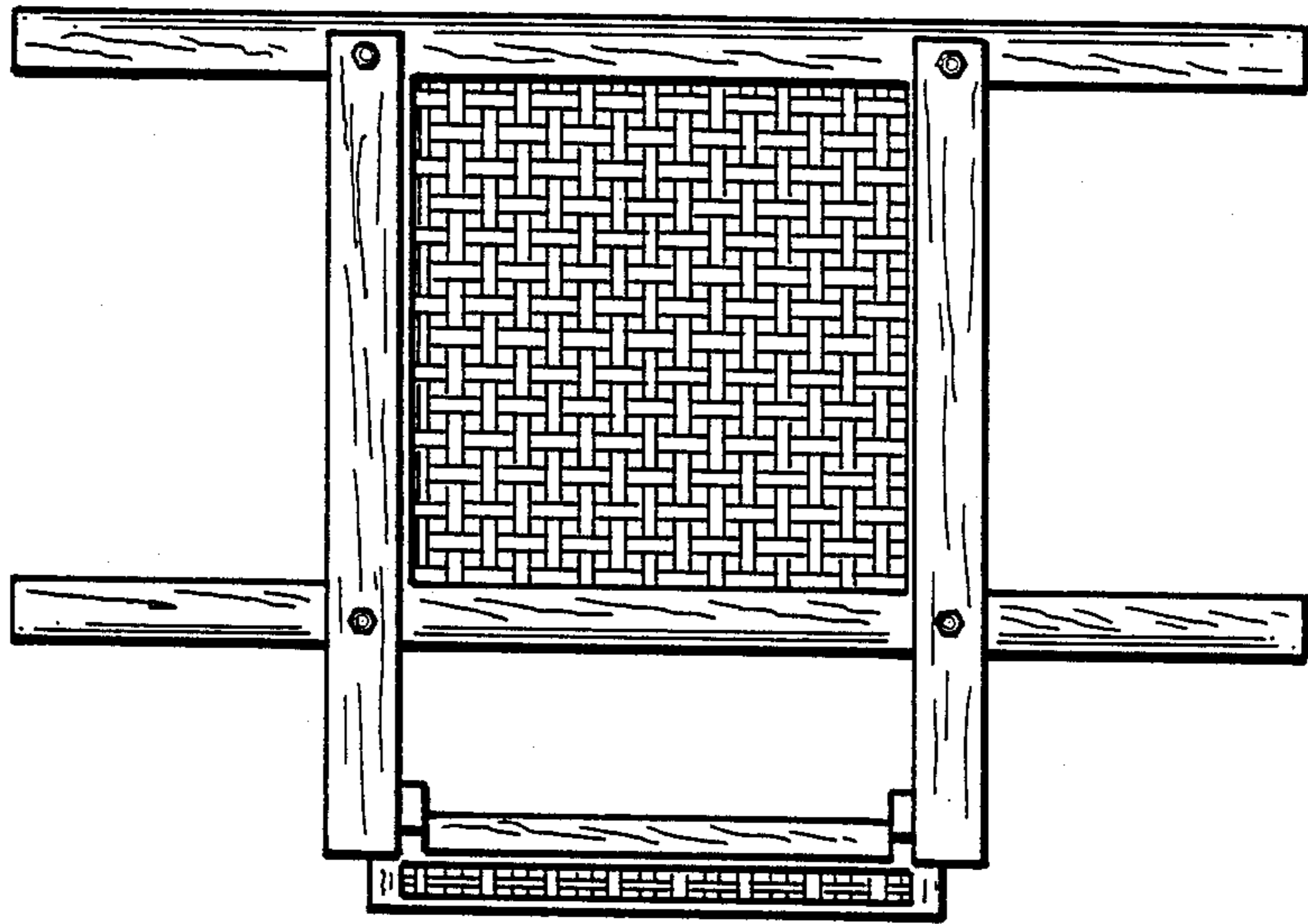
