**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bead showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.

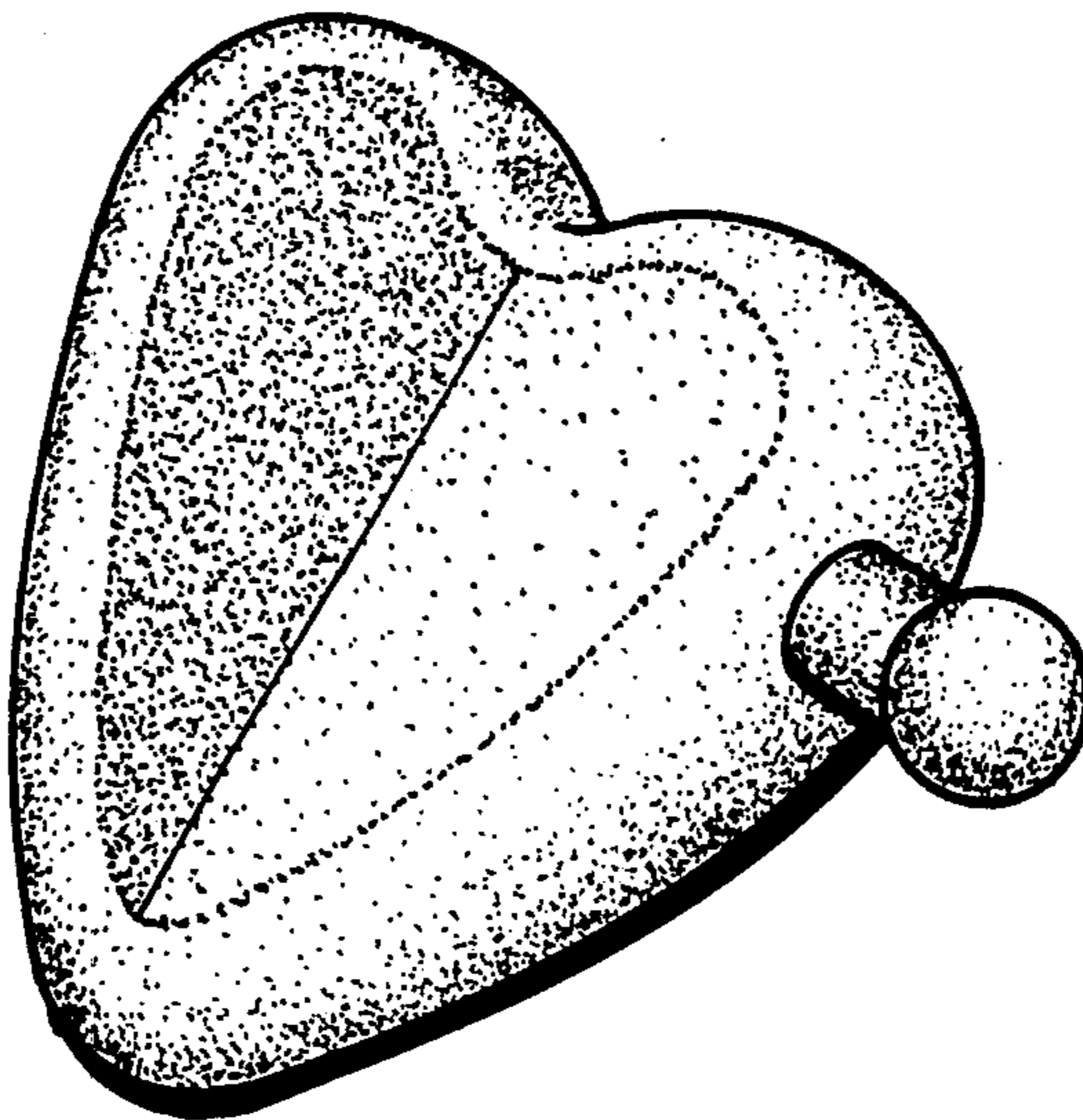

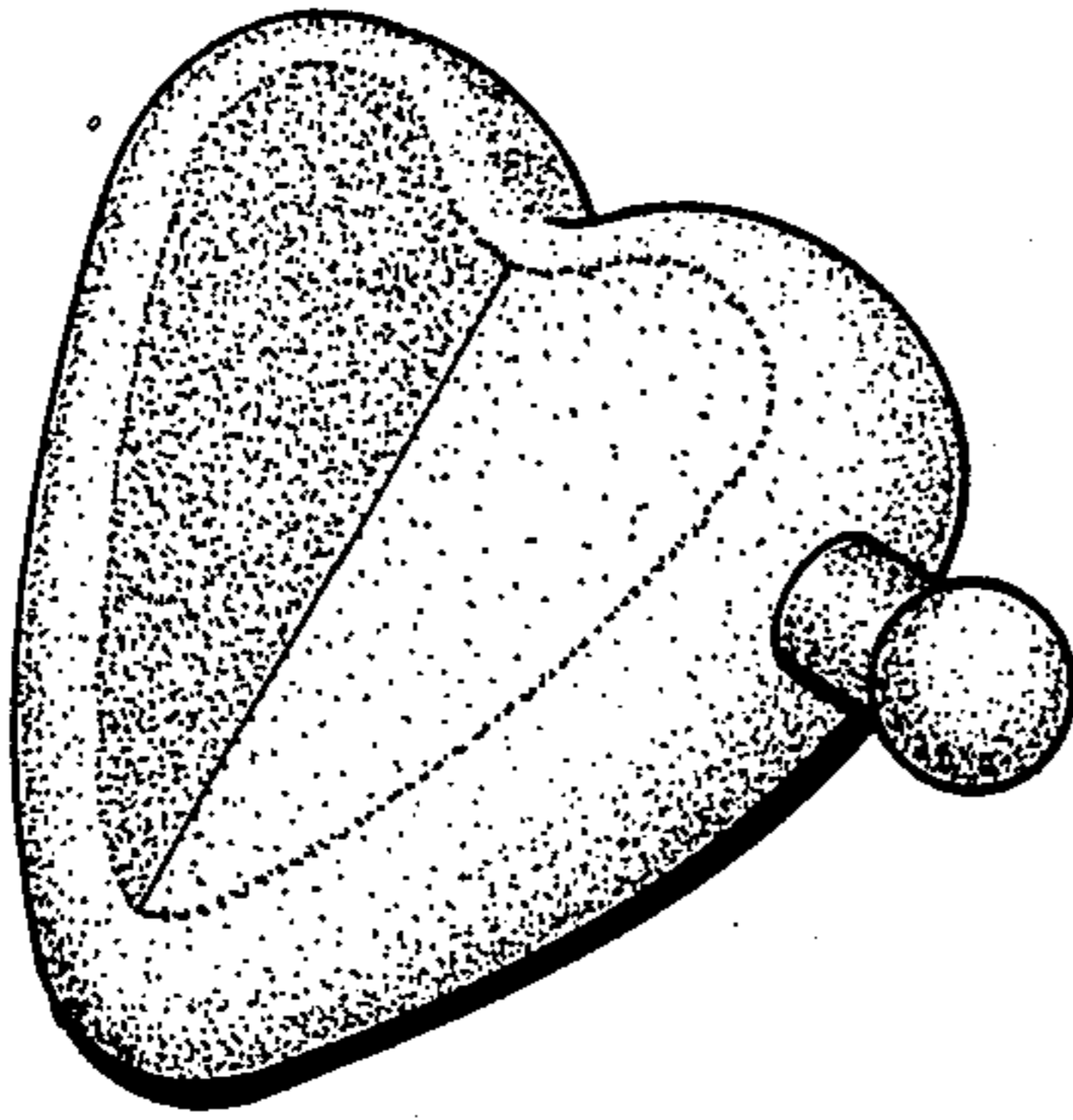

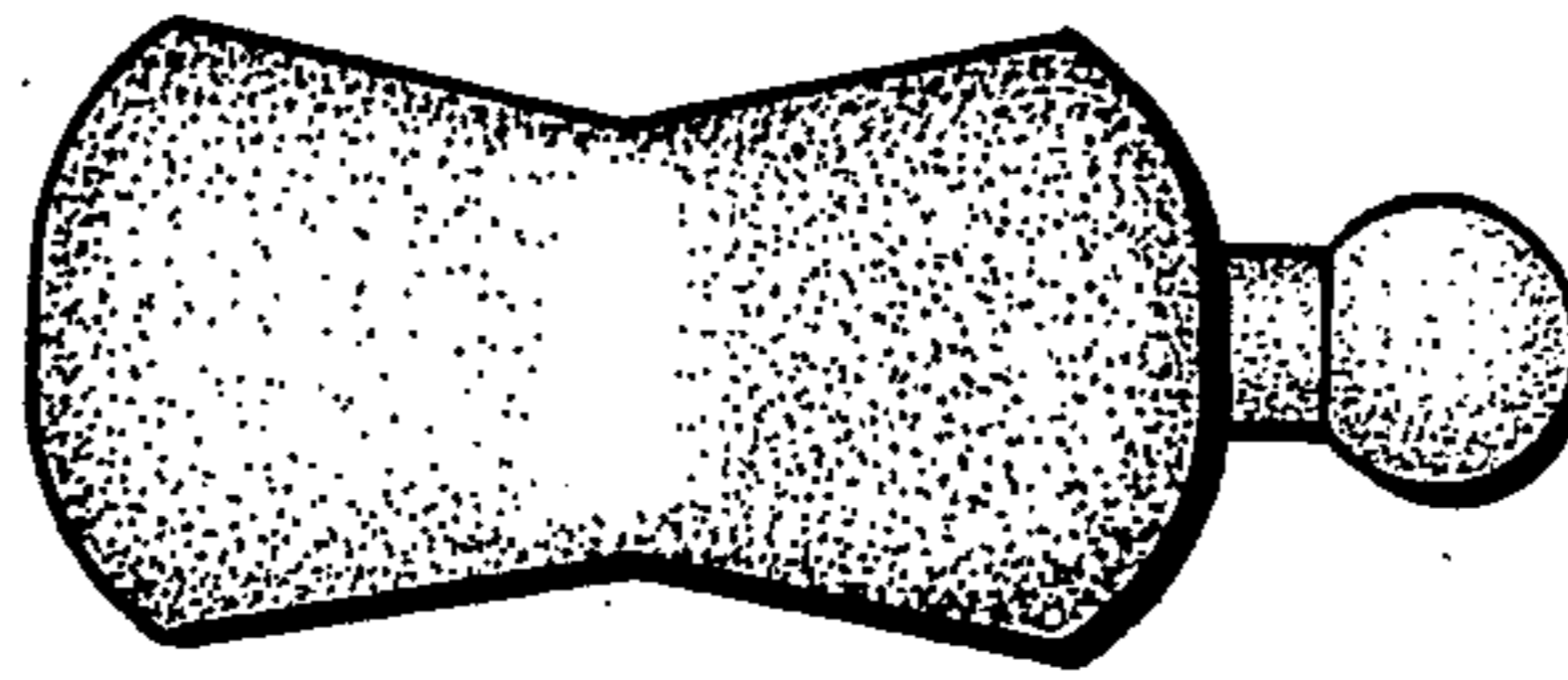

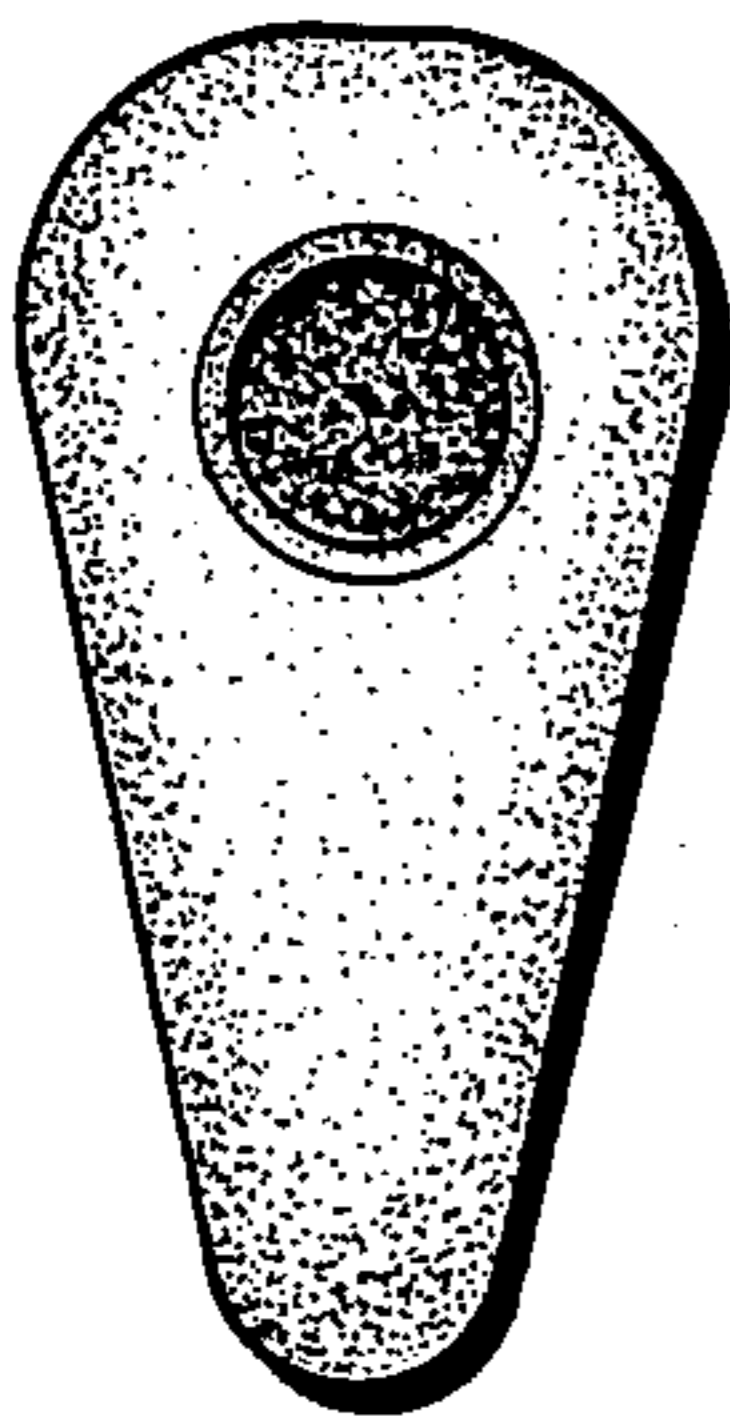

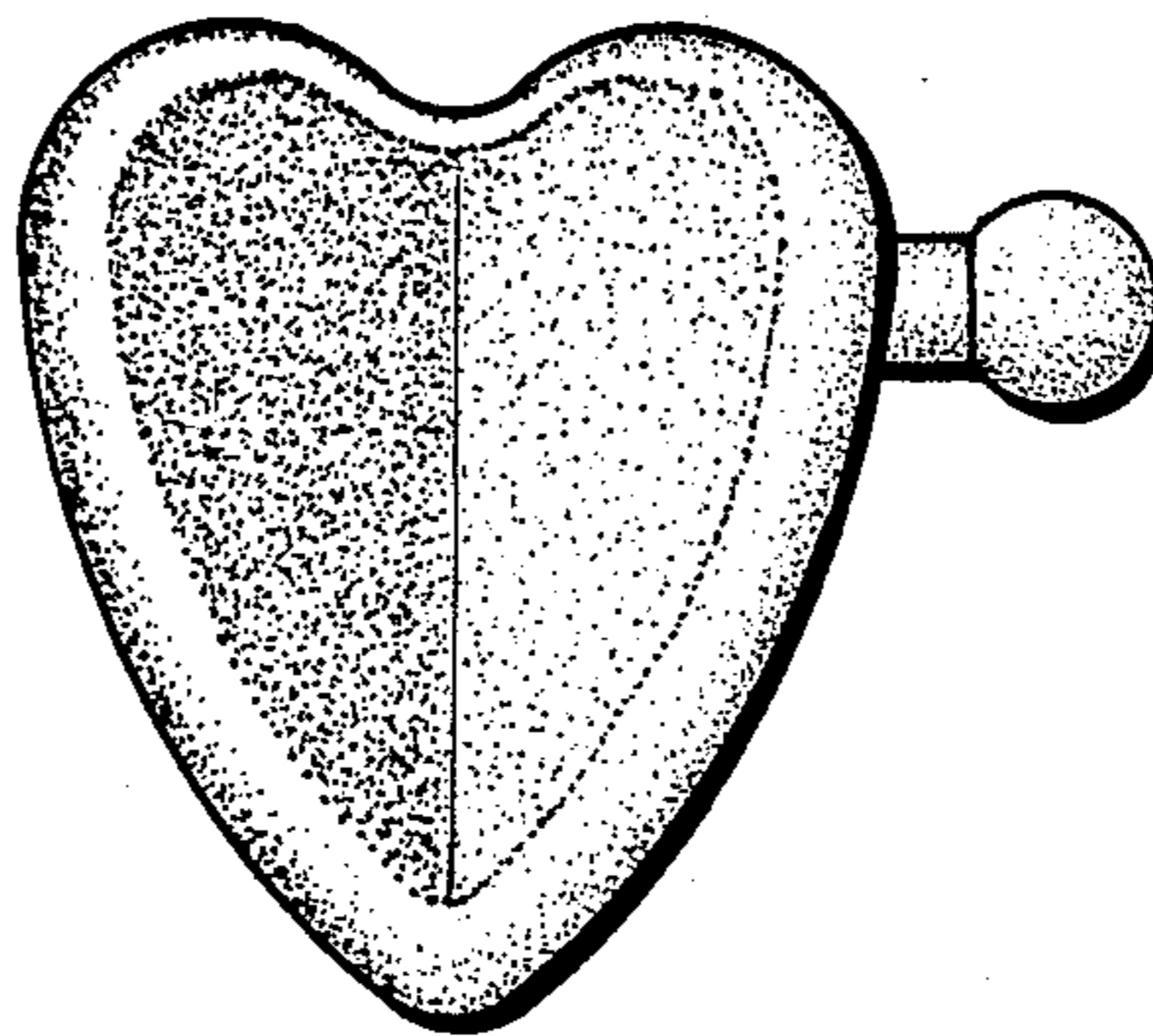

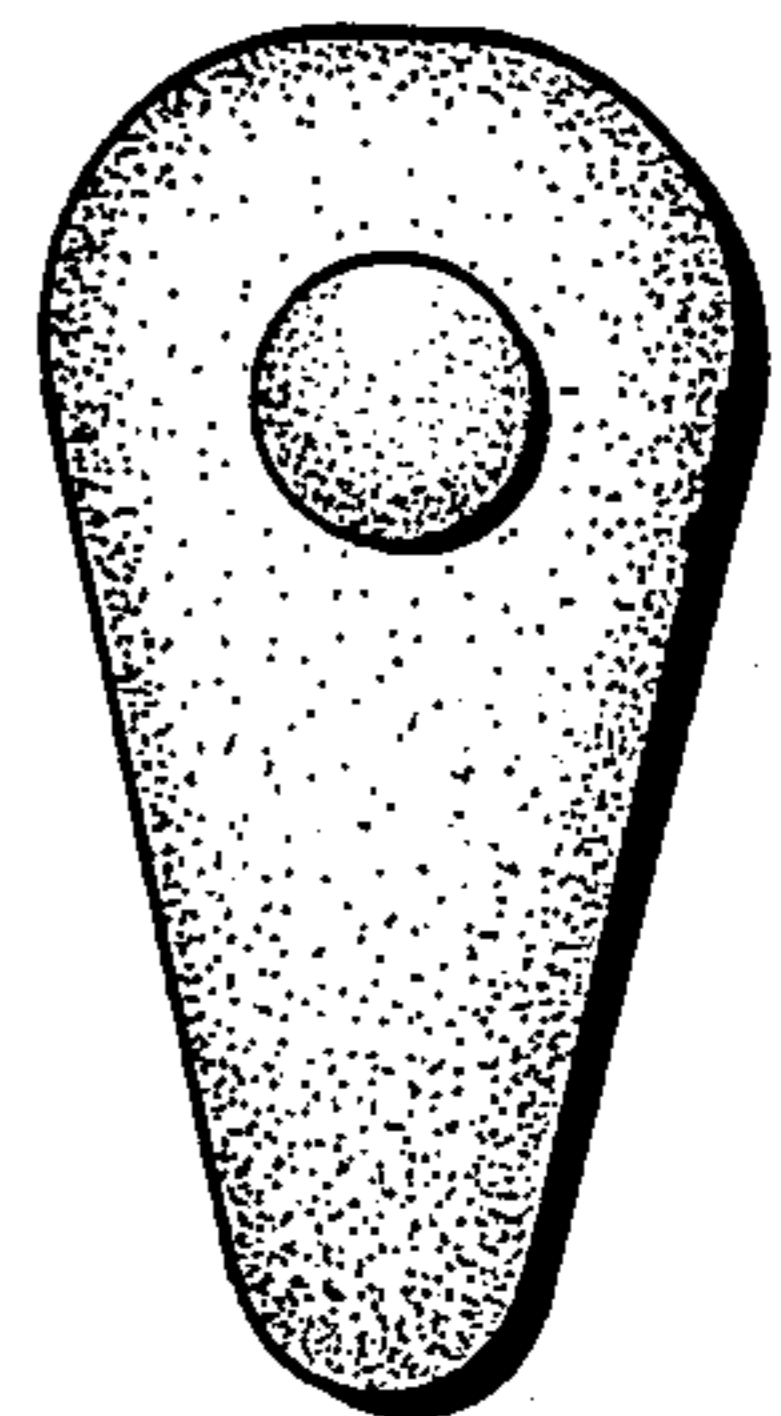
