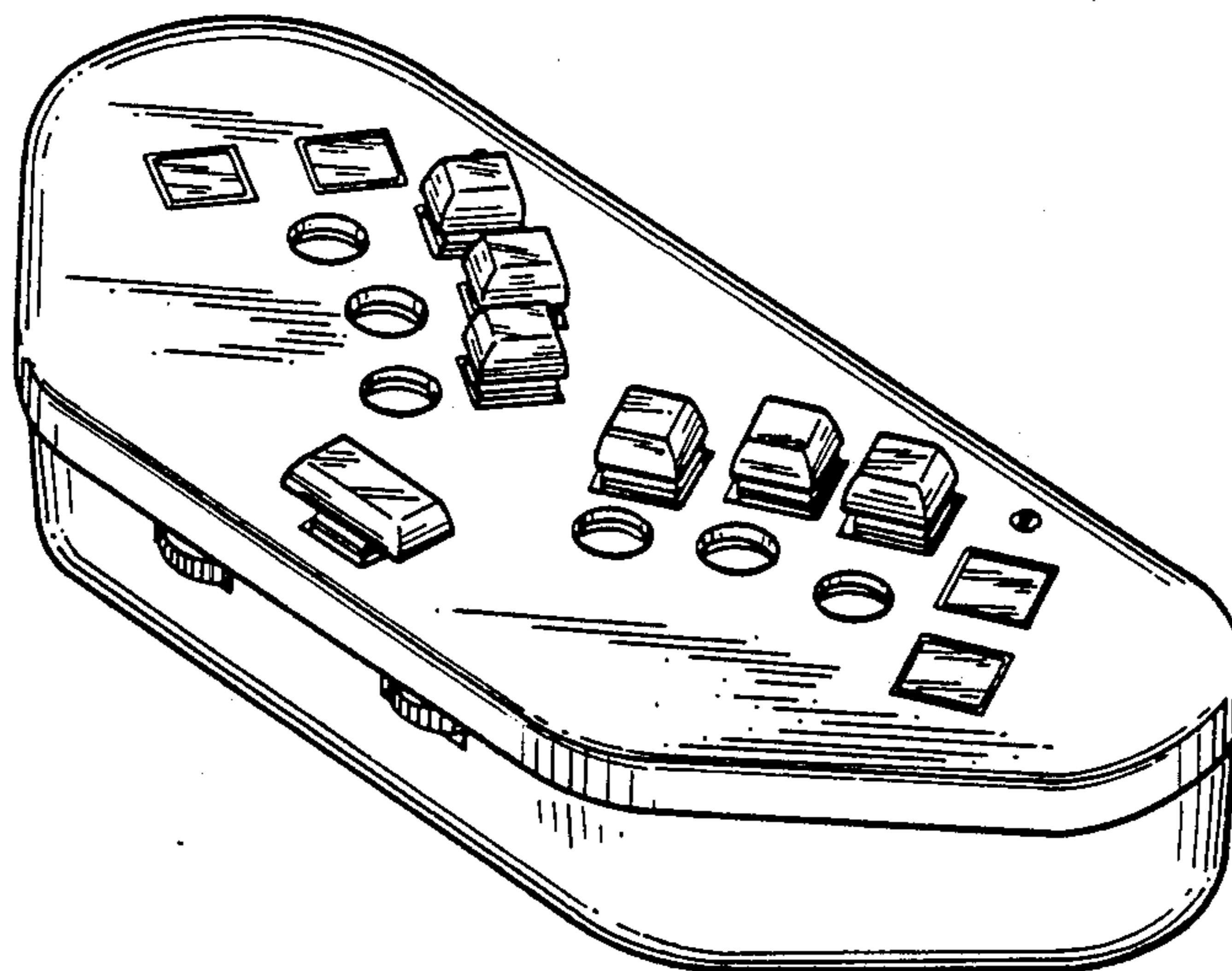

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a data communications terminal for deaf and/or deaf-blind persons, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a top, front, right hand side perspective view of a data communications terminal for deaf and/or deaf-blind persons;
- FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
- FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
- FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
- FIG. 5 is a left hand side elevational view thereof.



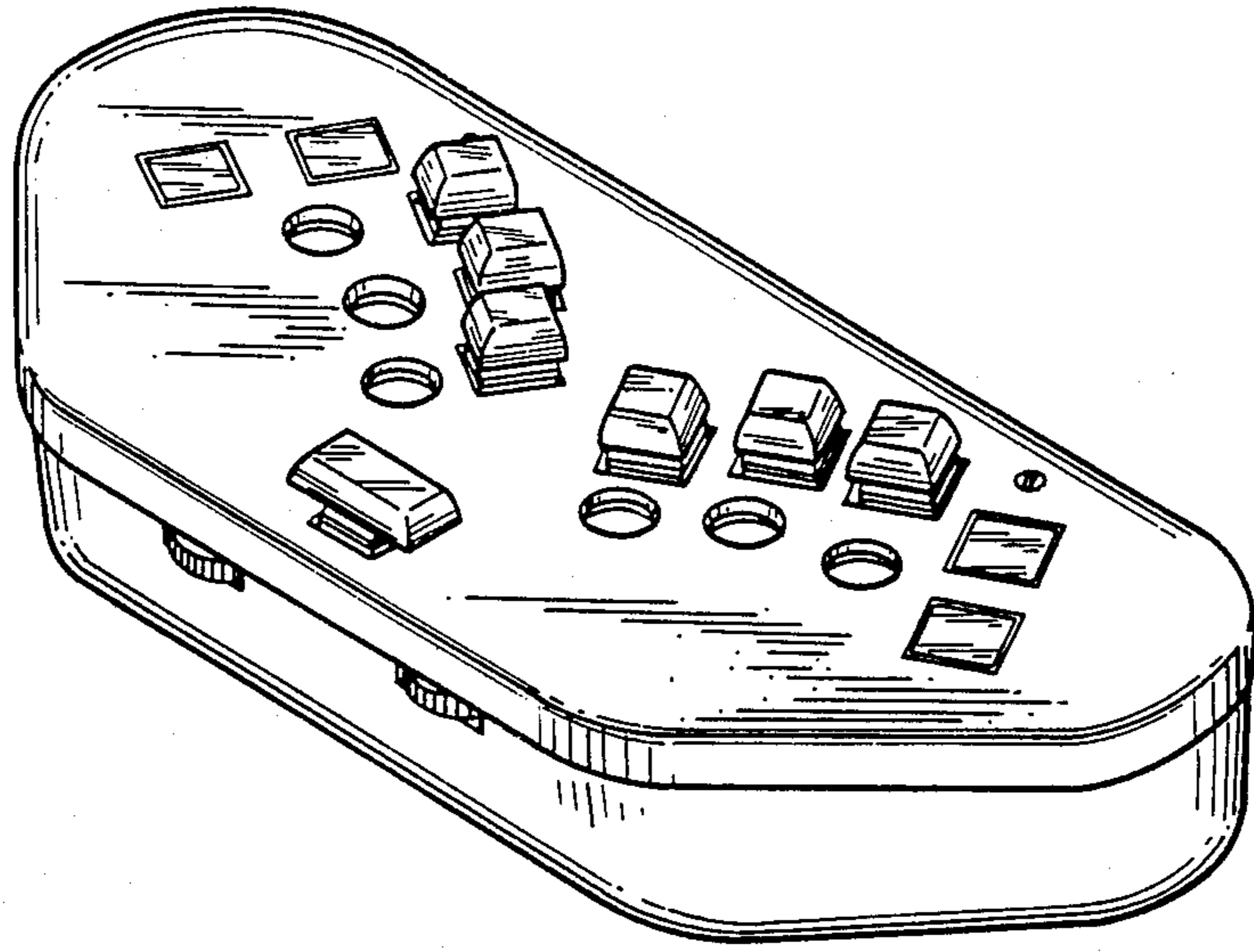

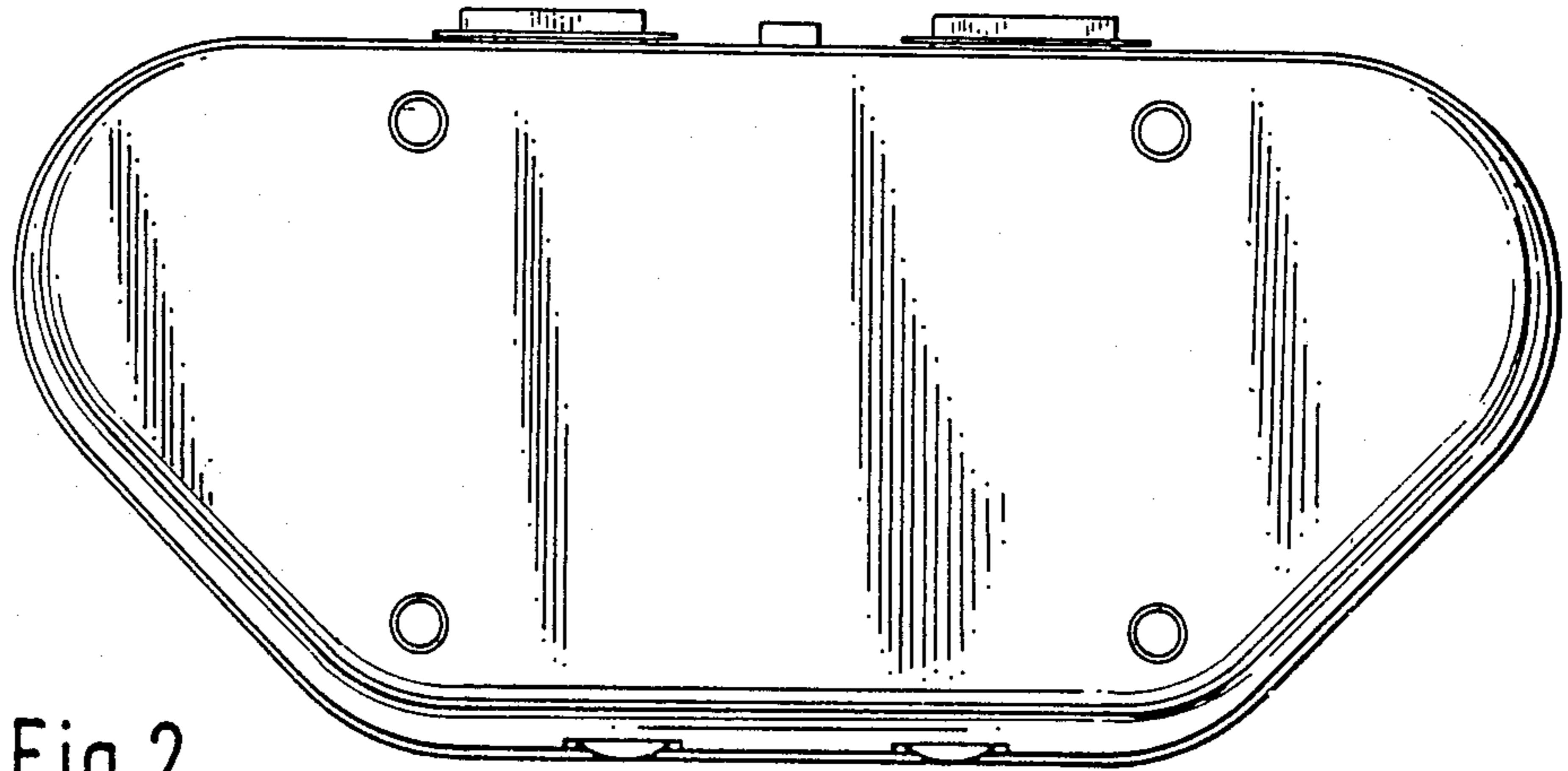

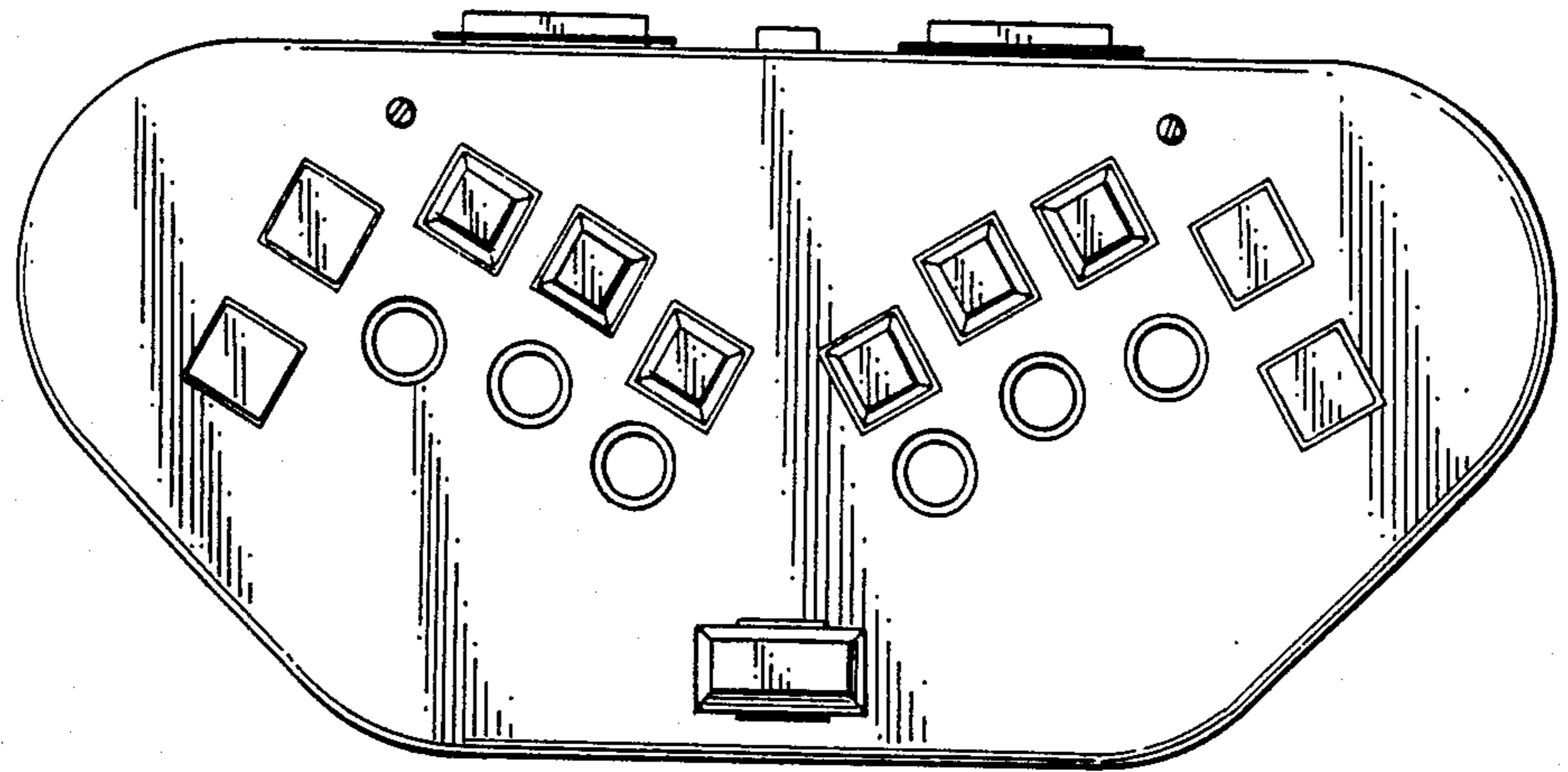

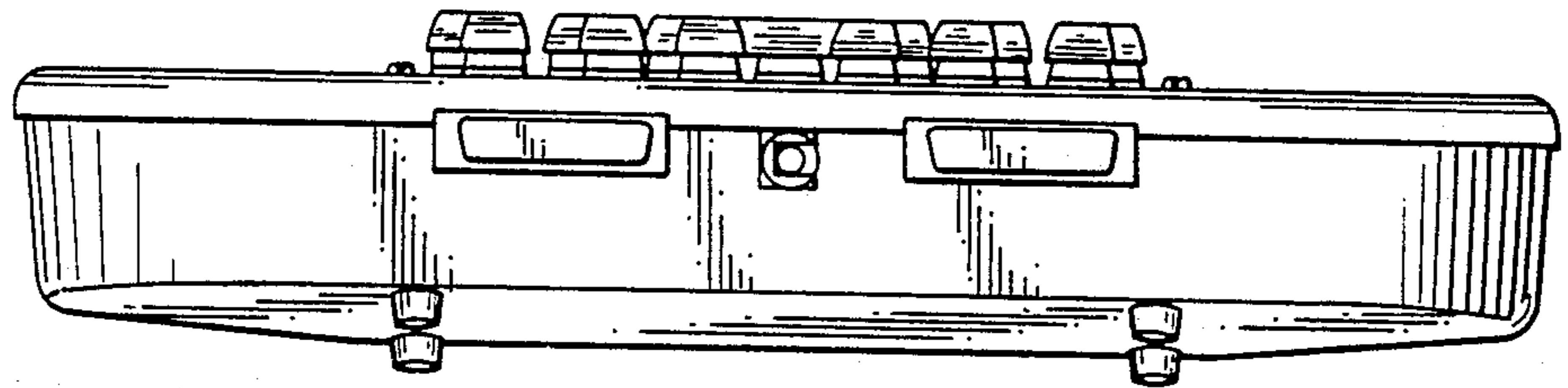

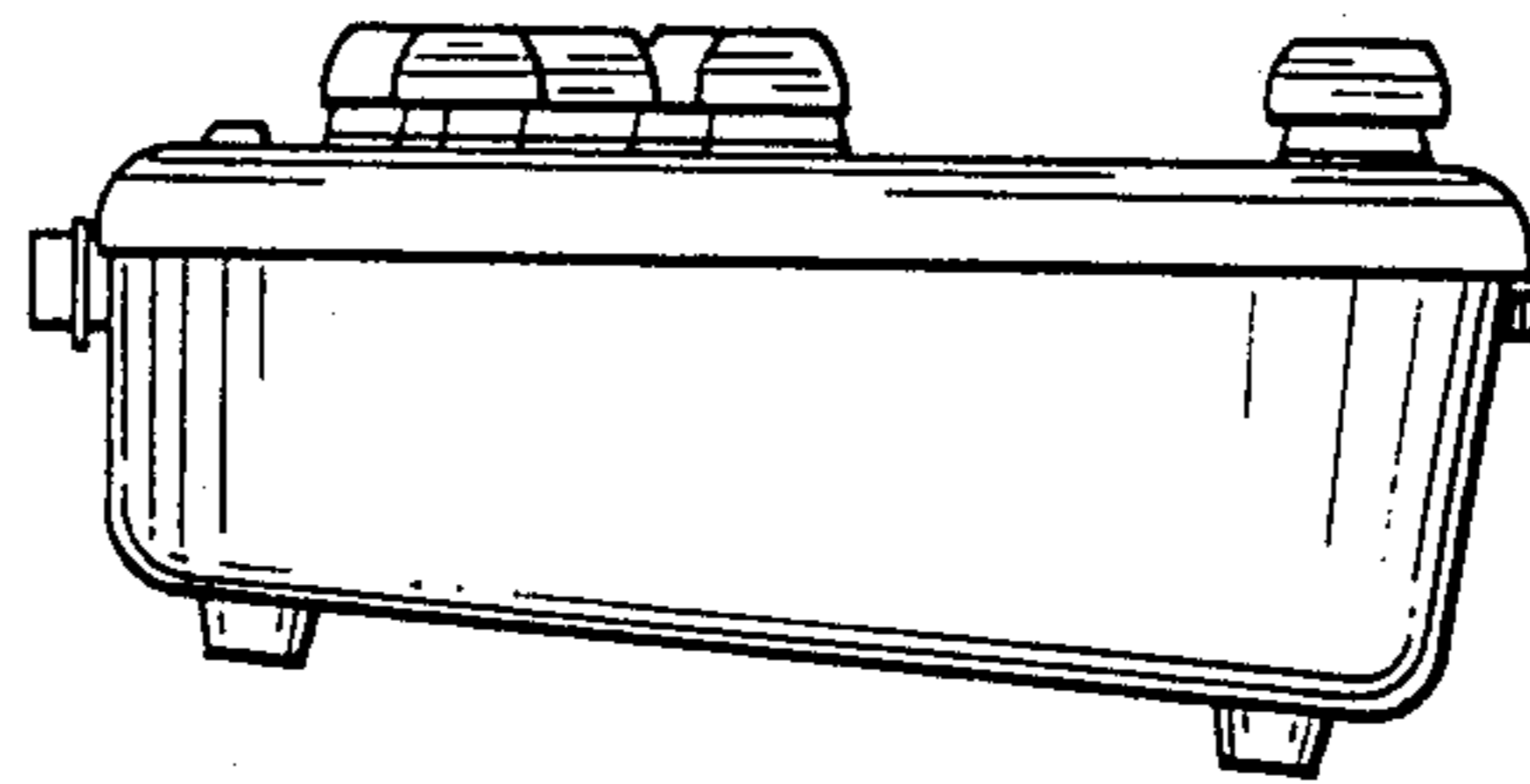
