FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

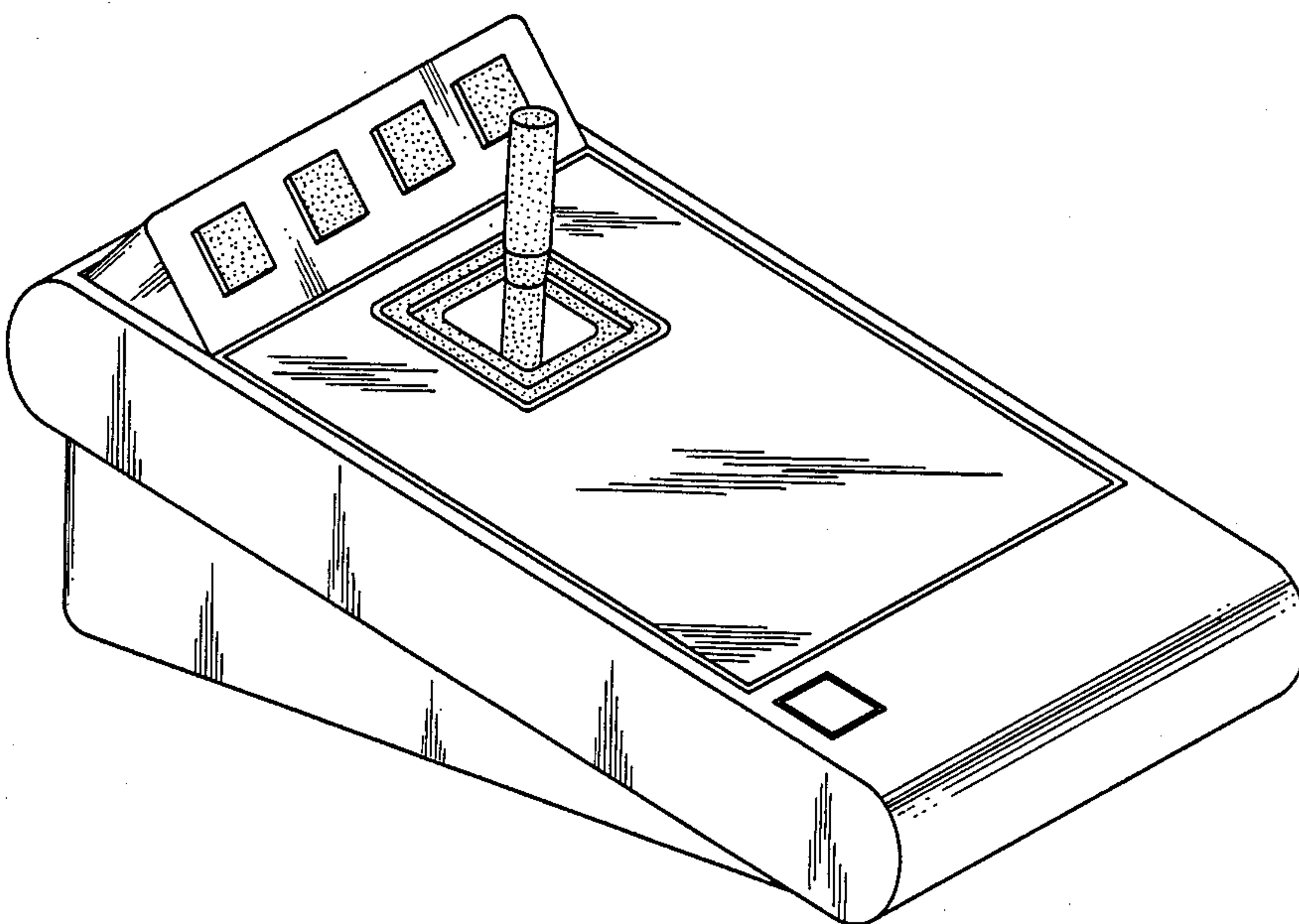
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale.



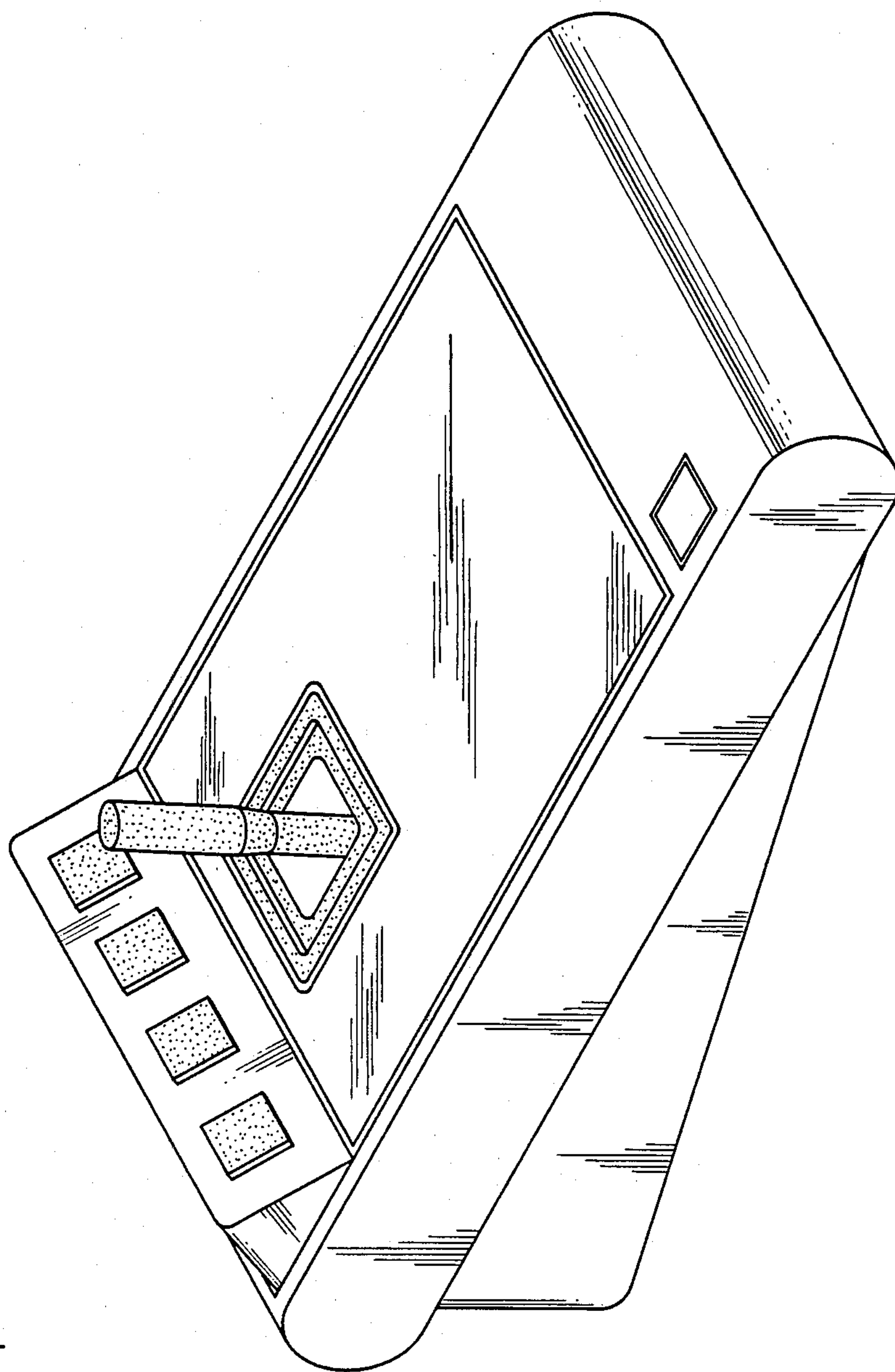
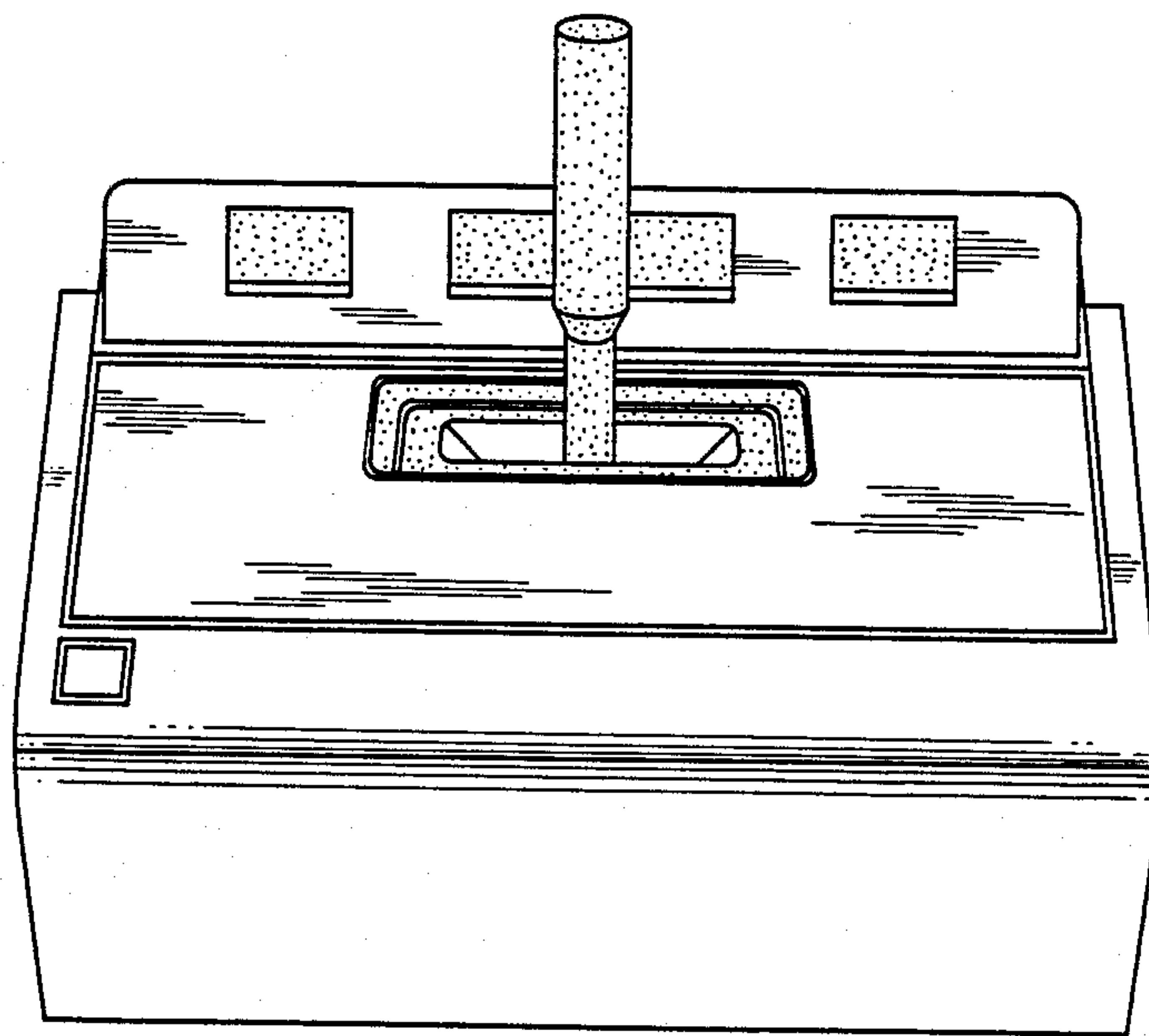

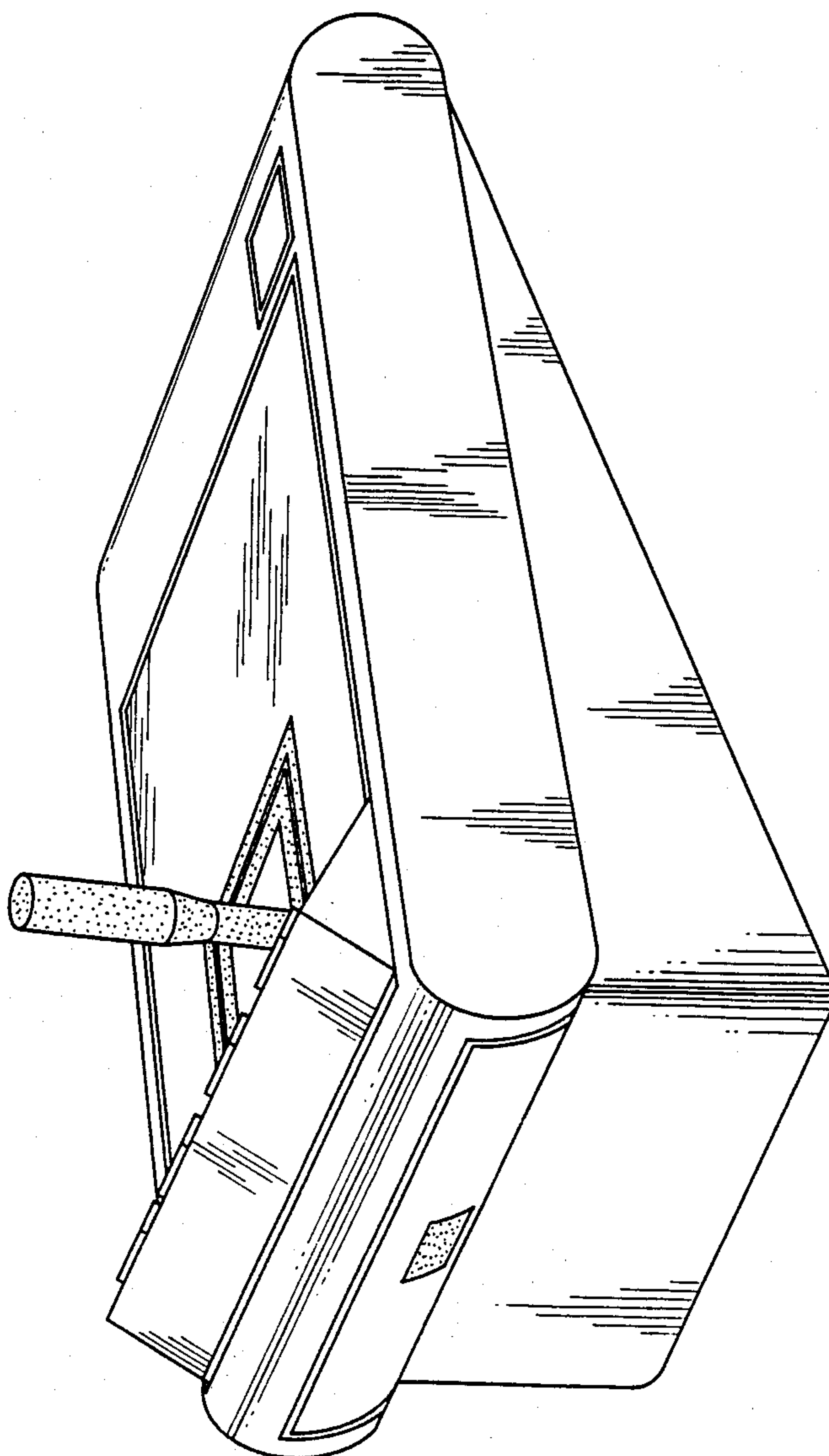

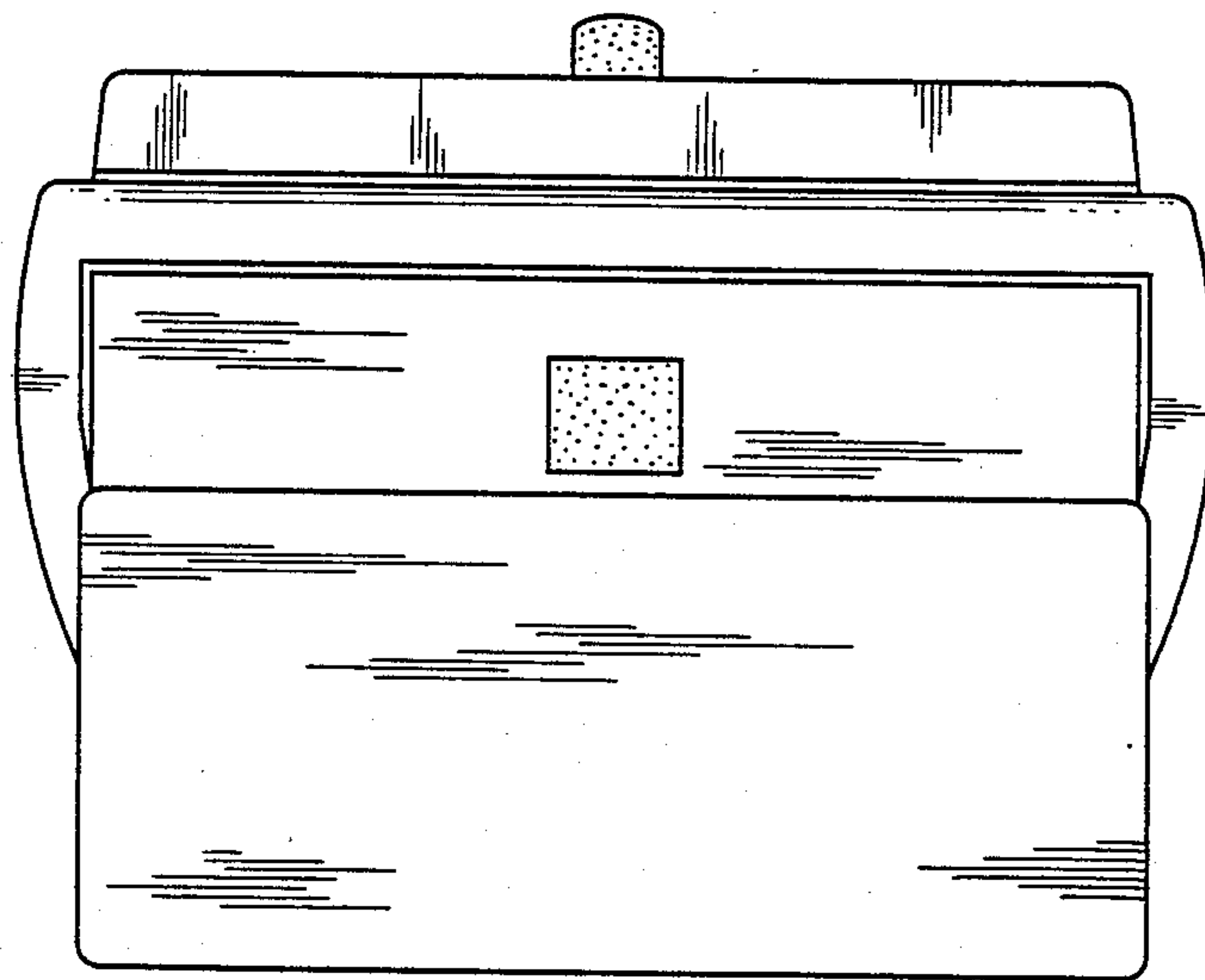
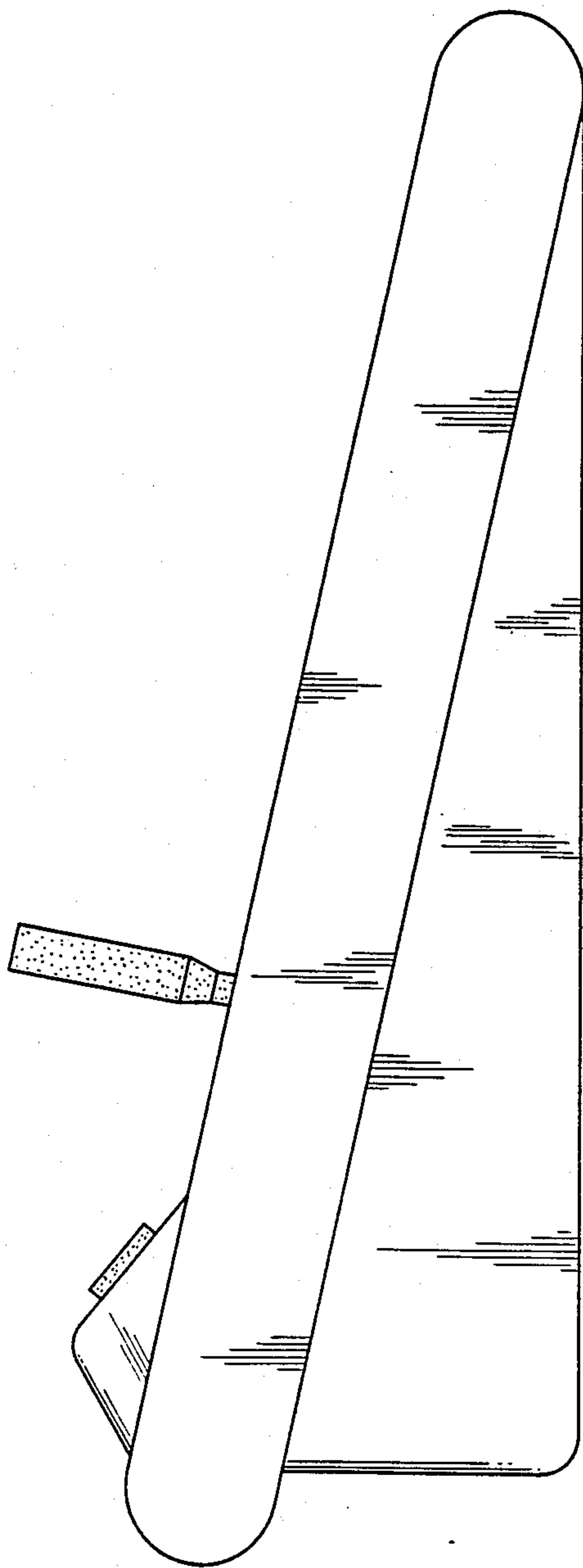

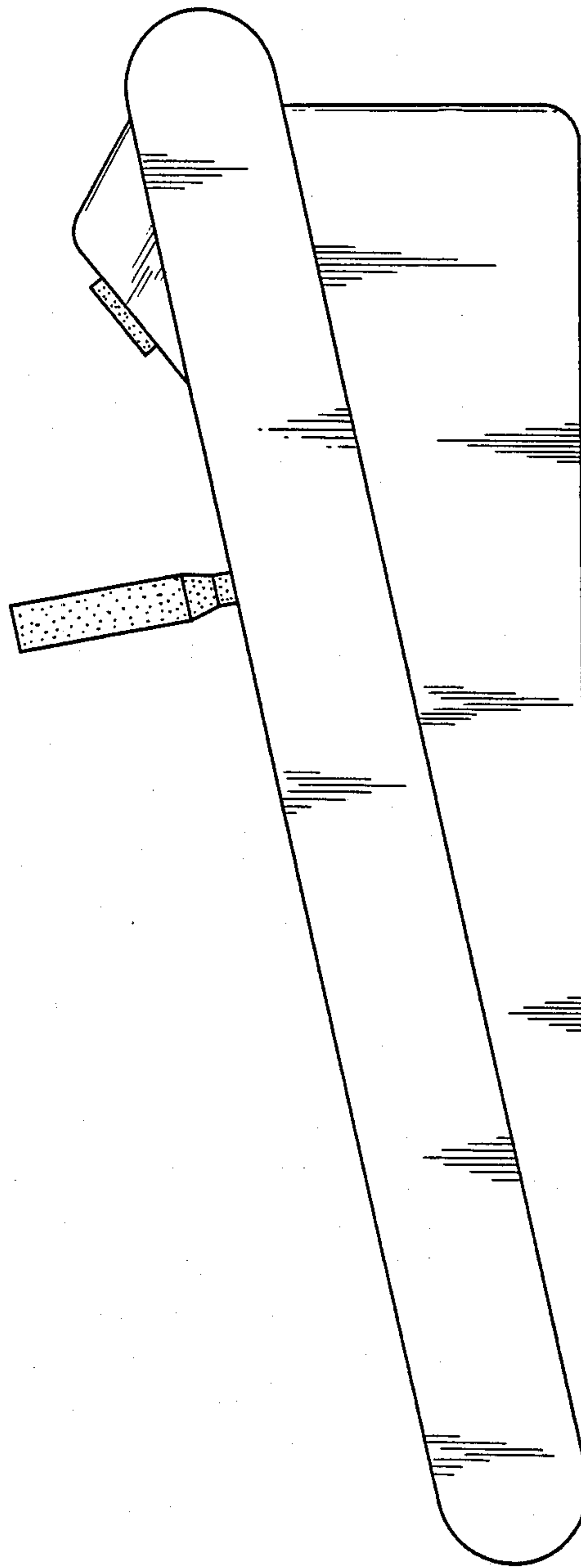
