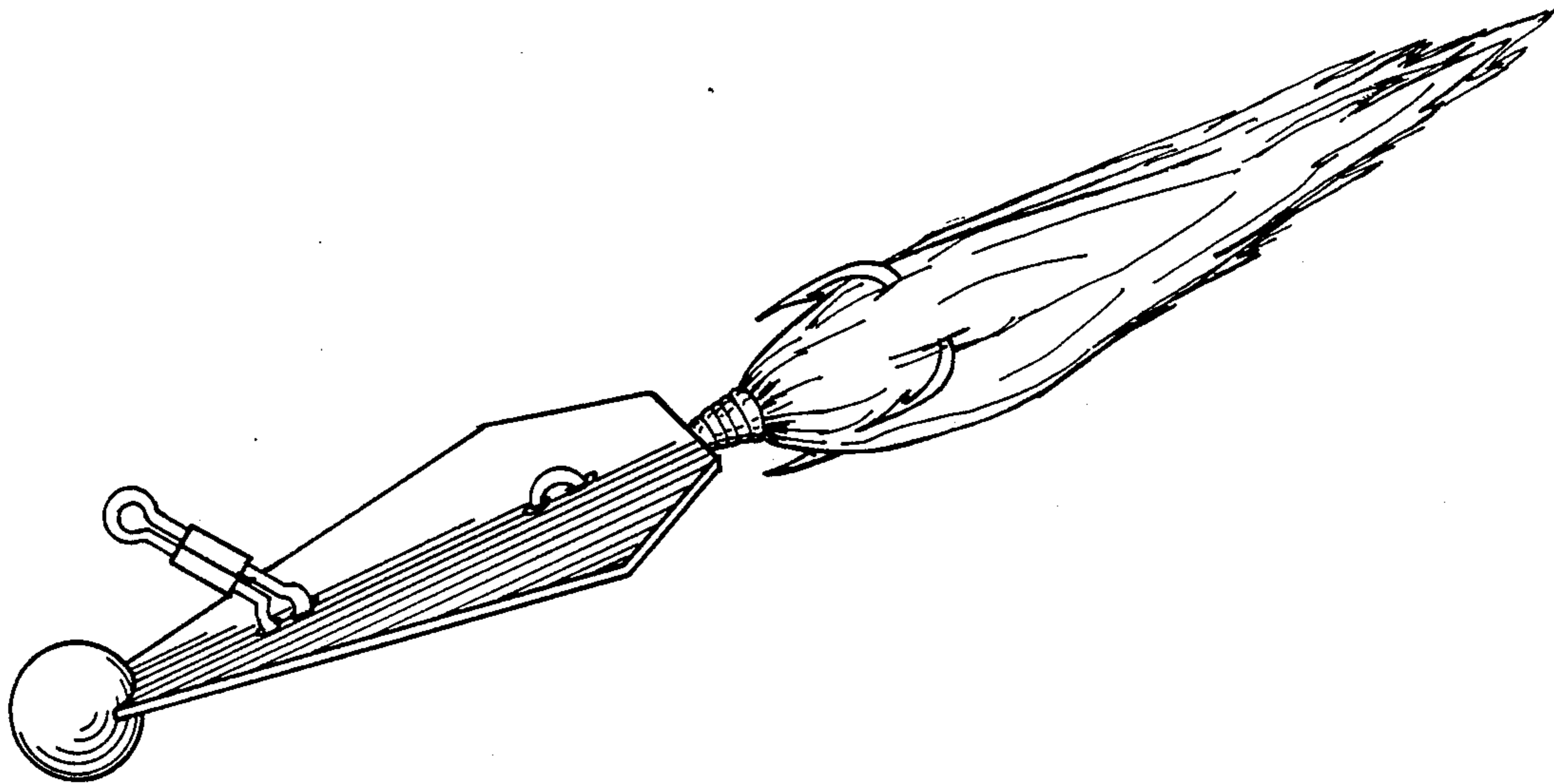

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fish lure showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side view of the lure of FIG. 1, the right side view being substantially identical;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof.



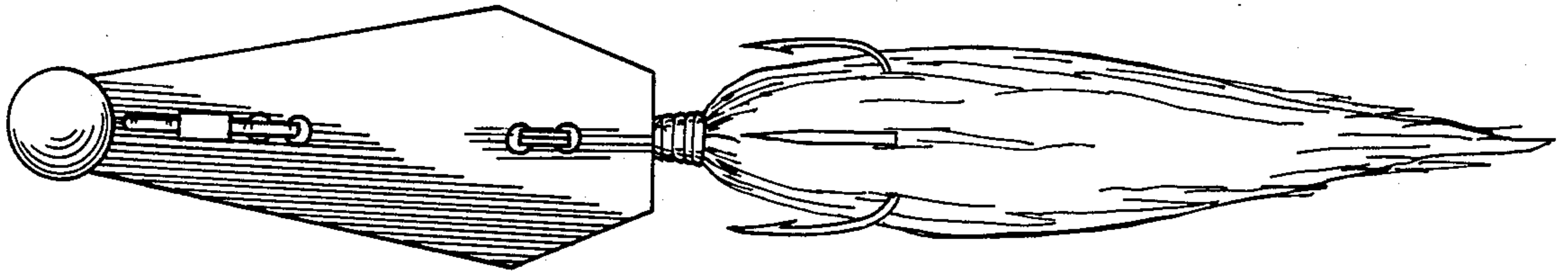

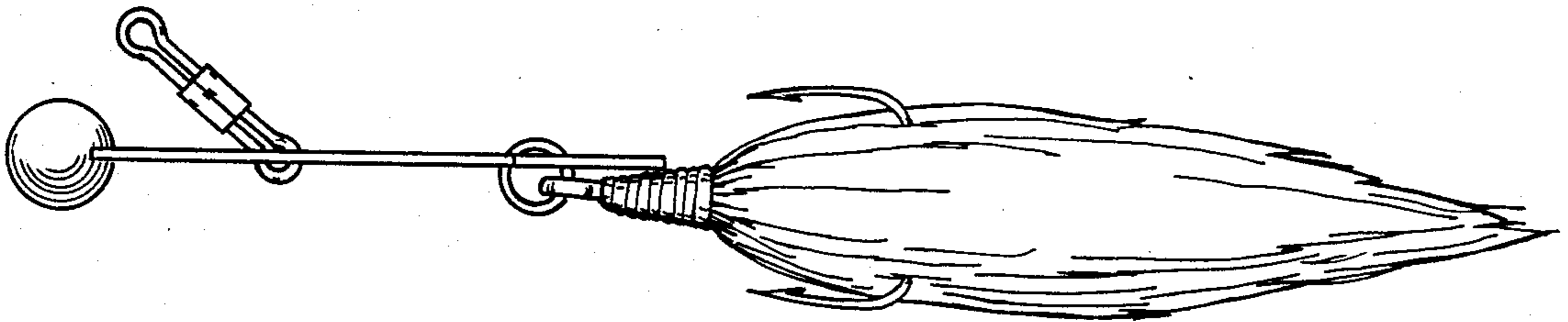

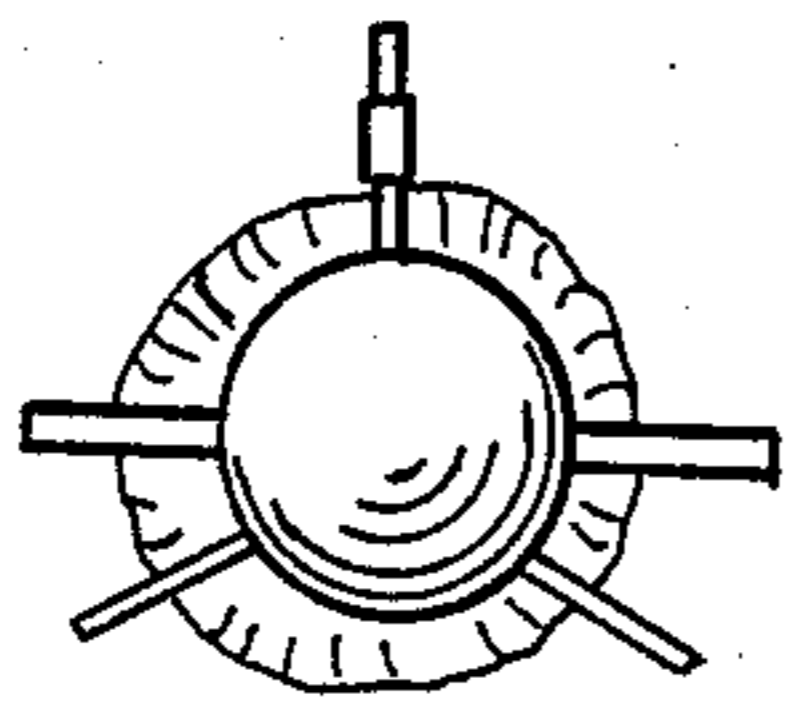

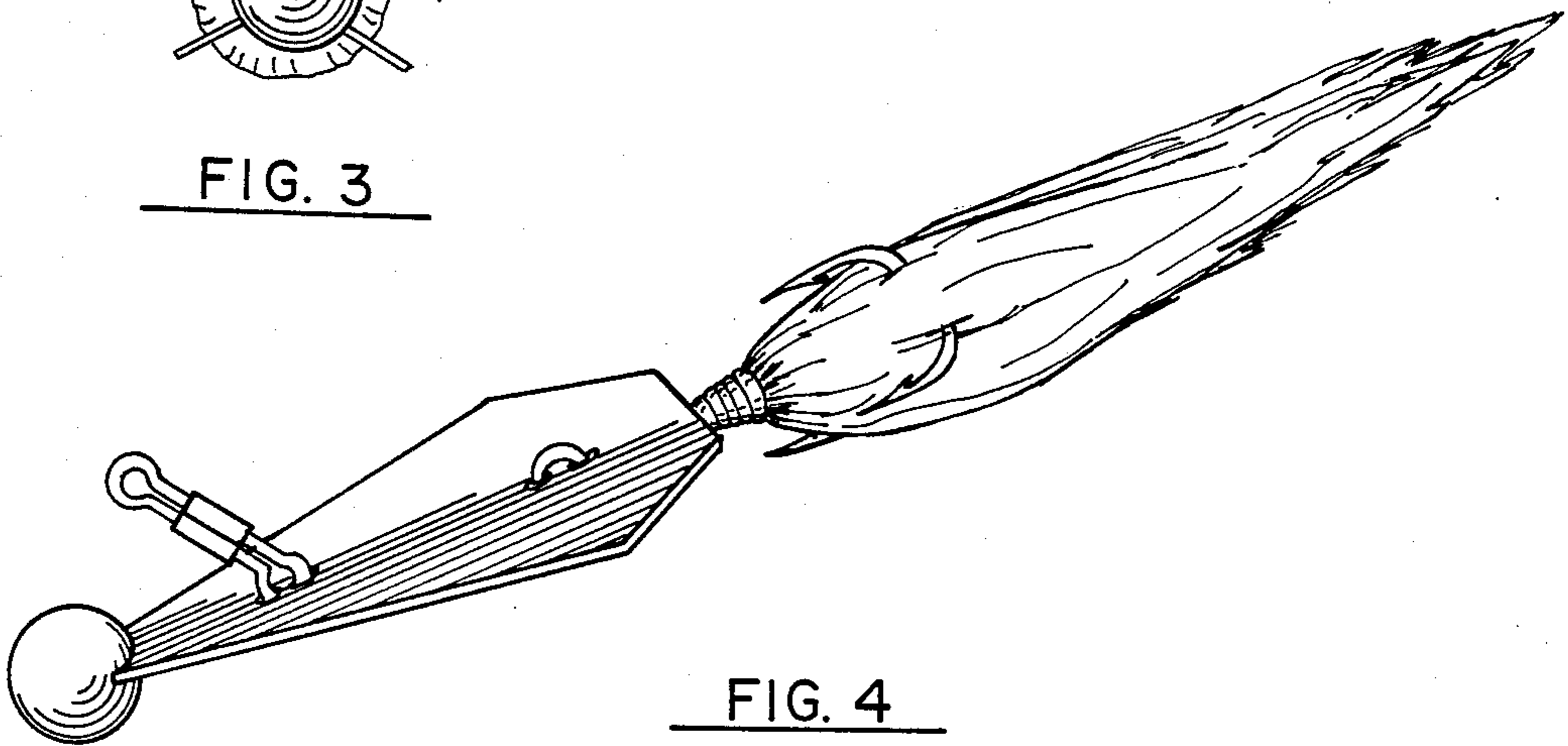
