The rear views are flat, plain and unornamented, while the face and hands are conventionally of no appreciable thickness.

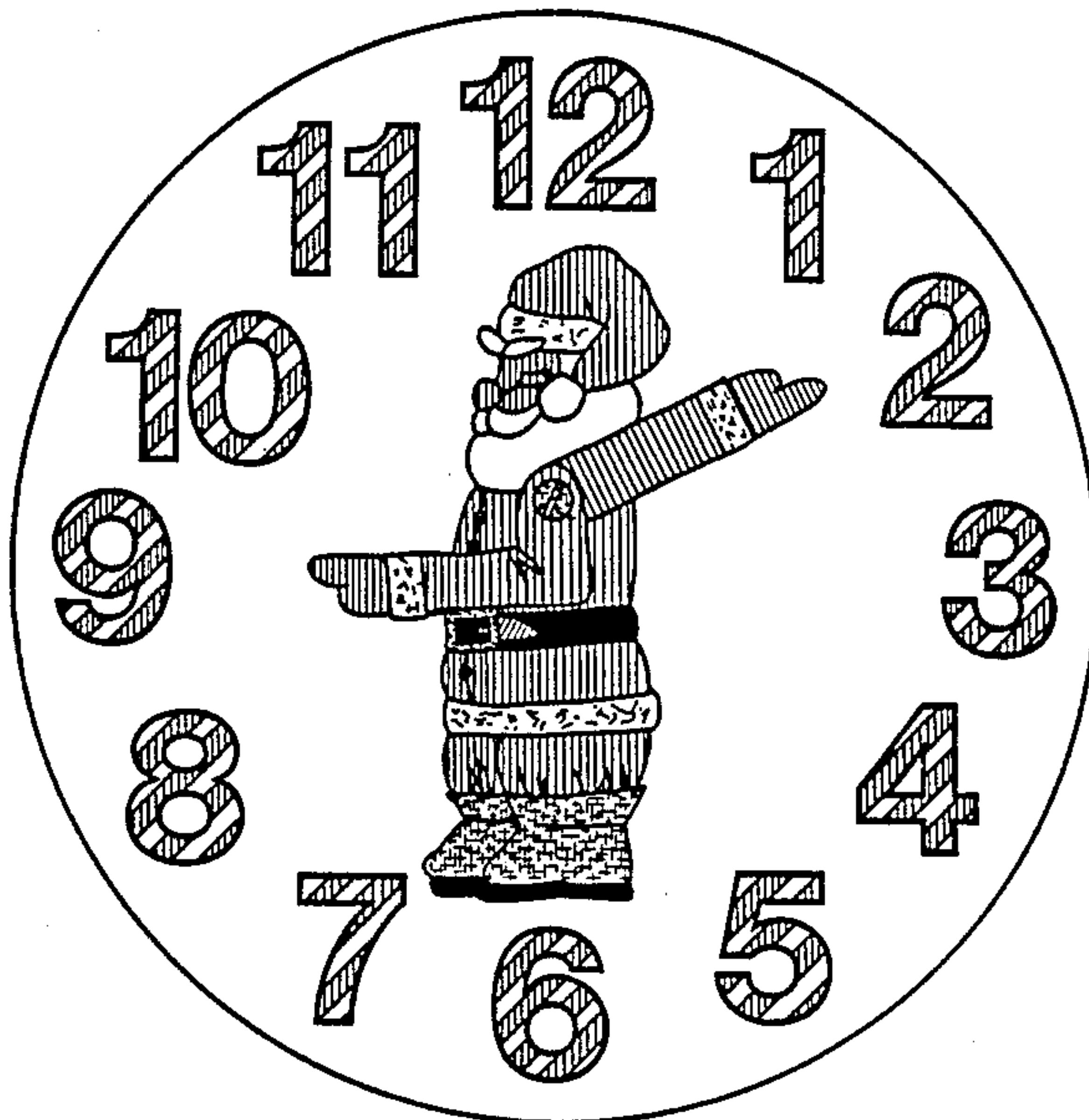

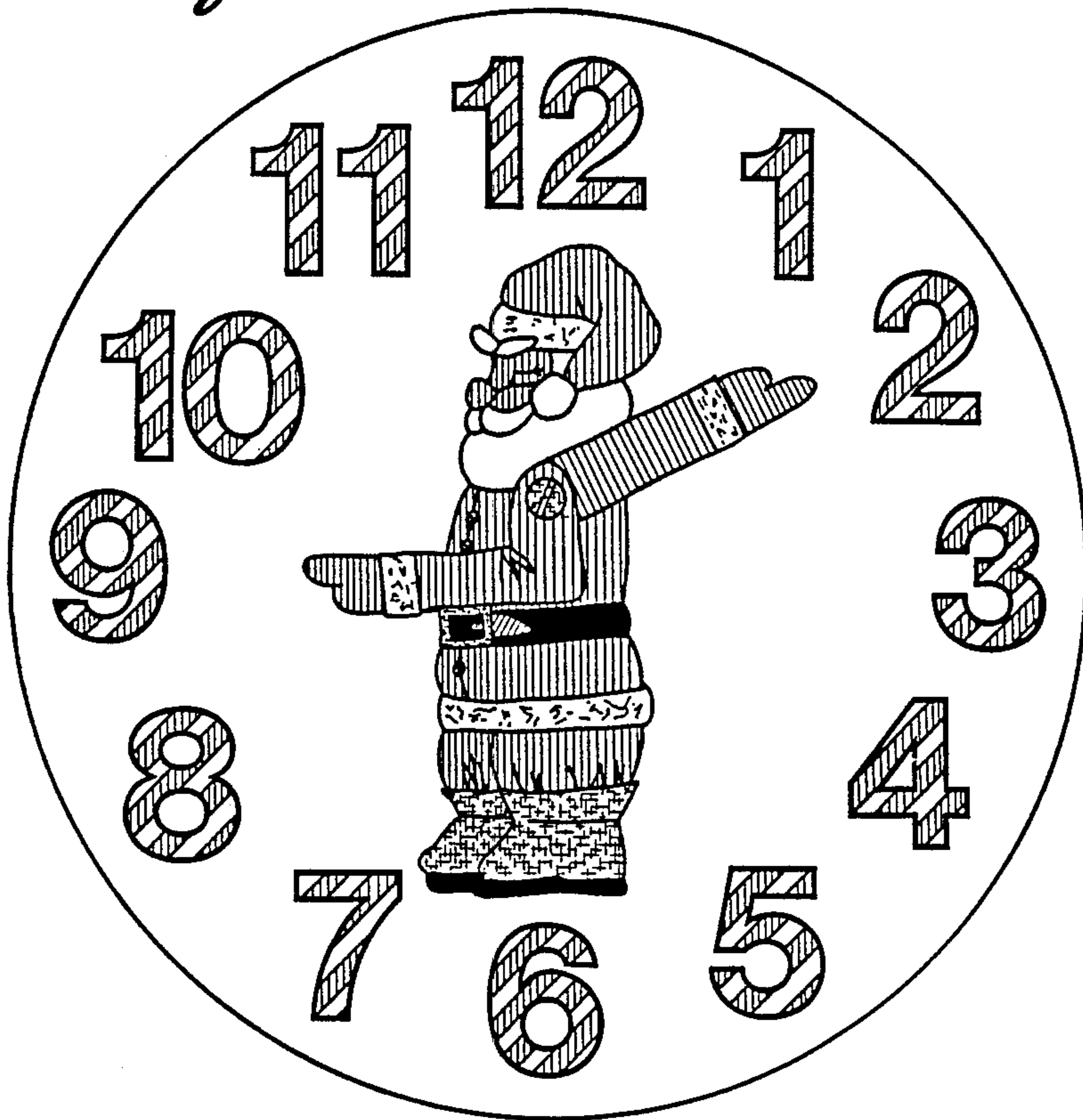
