**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a computer stand showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view portion of the shaft and base removed for convenience of illustration; and  
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view with the drawer in extended position, portion of the shaft and base removed for the convenience of illustration.

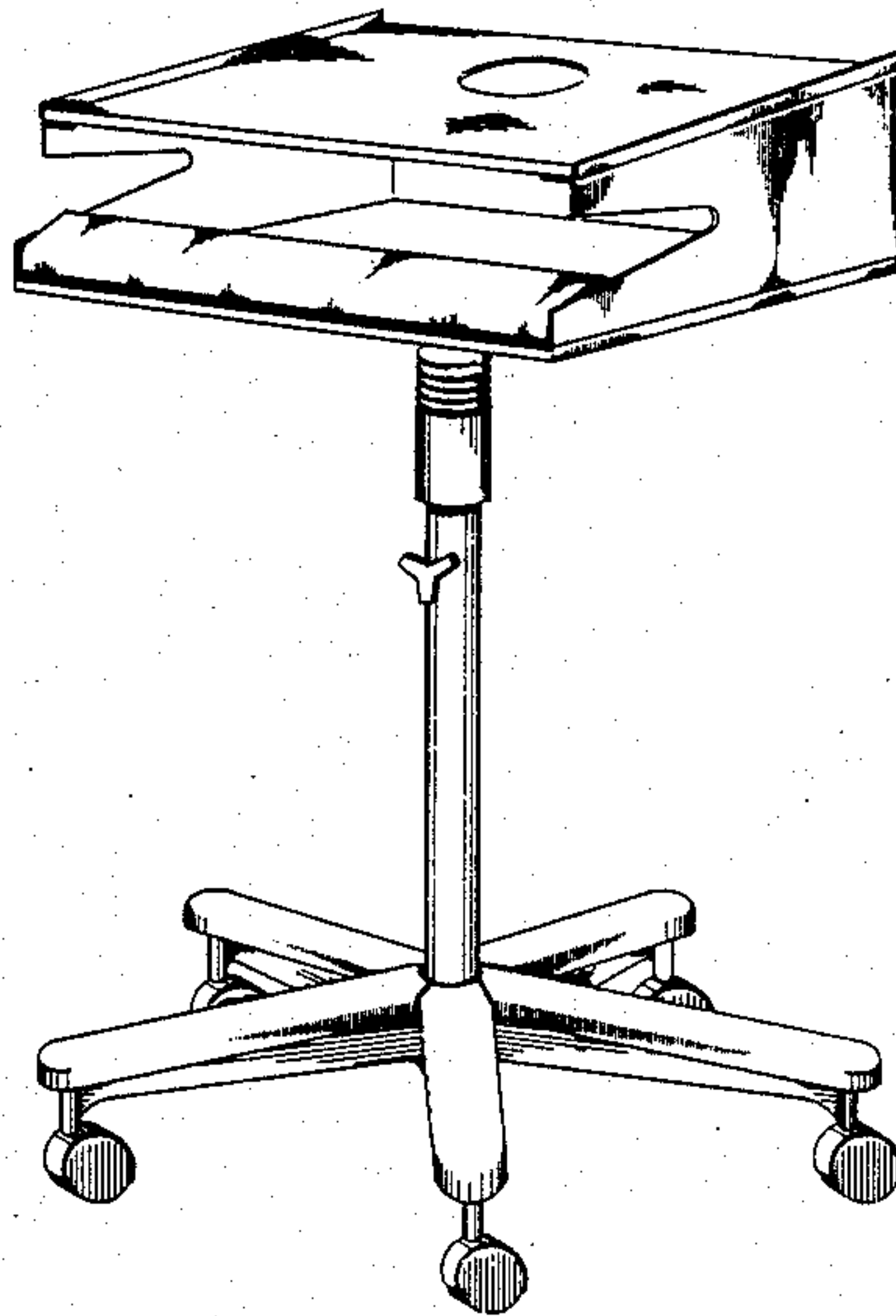

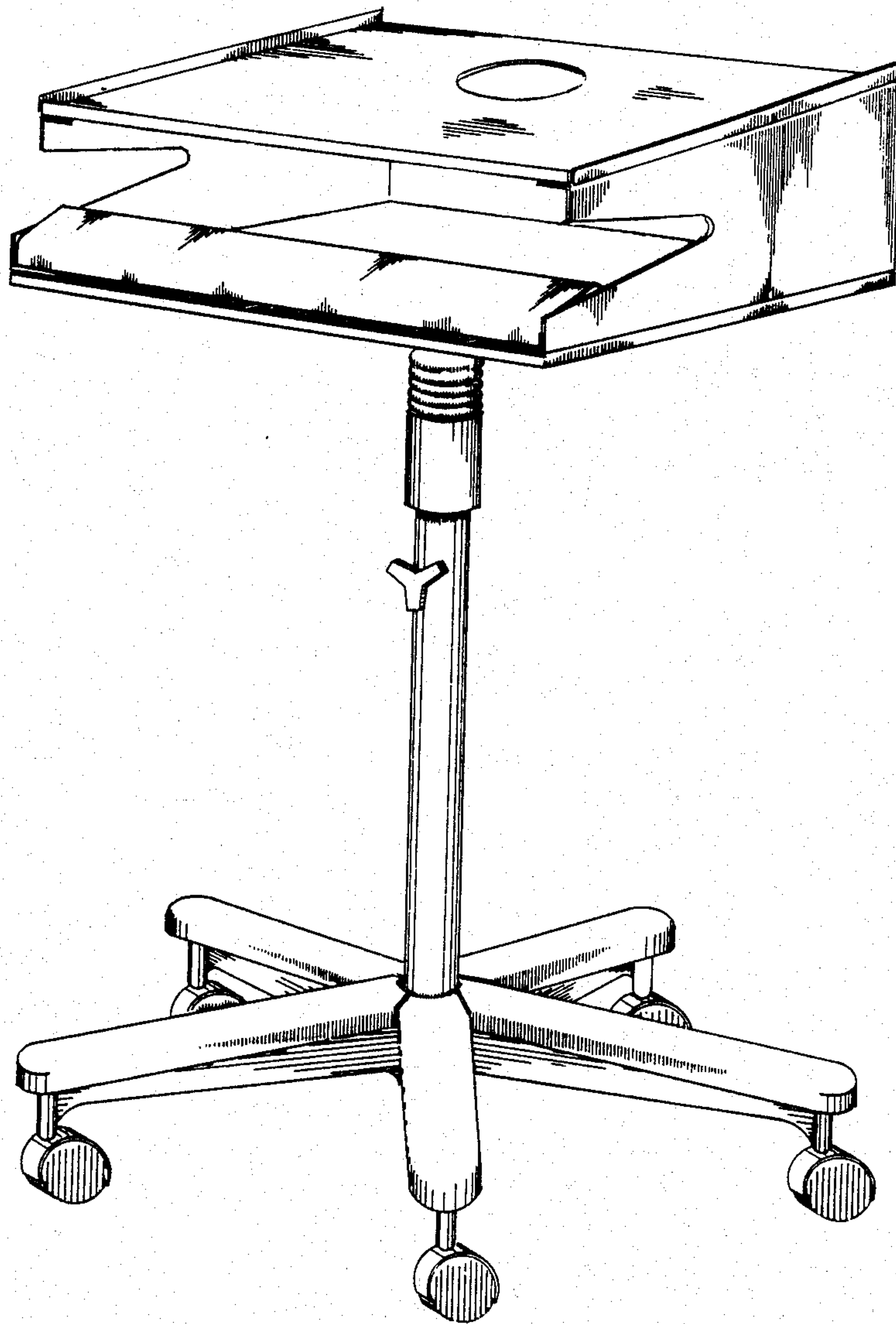

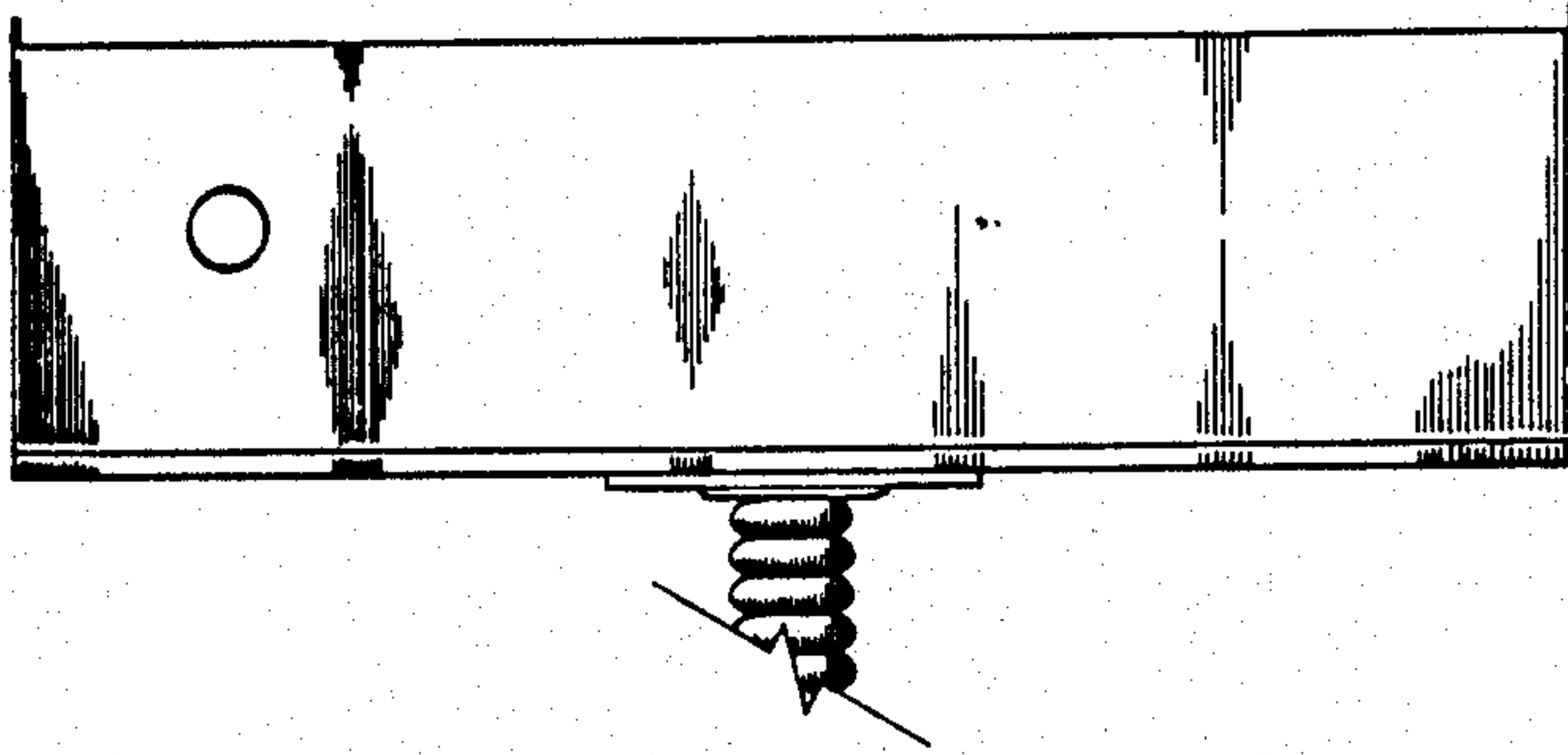
