 FIG. 4 is an isometric view of the bottom thereof.

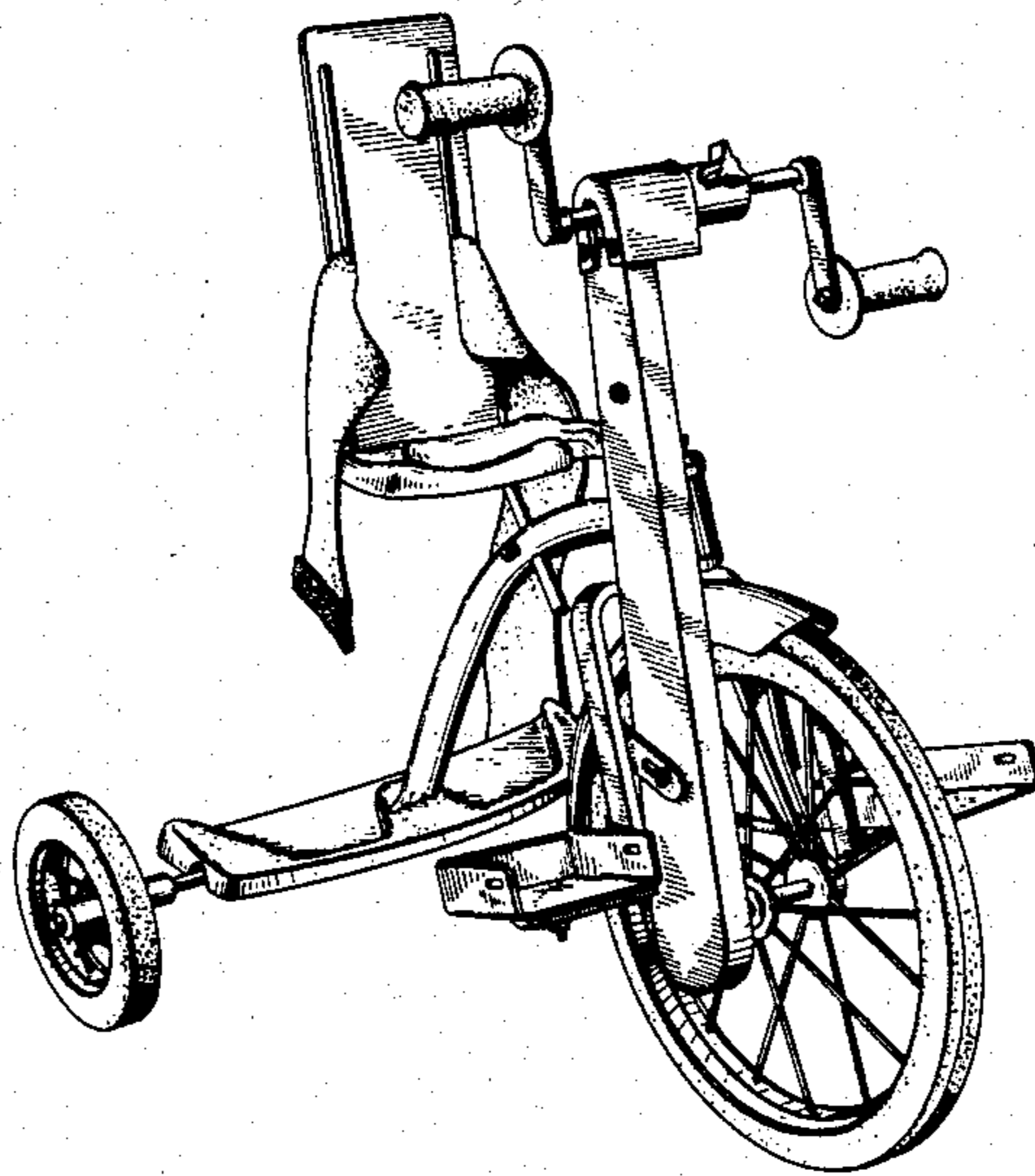

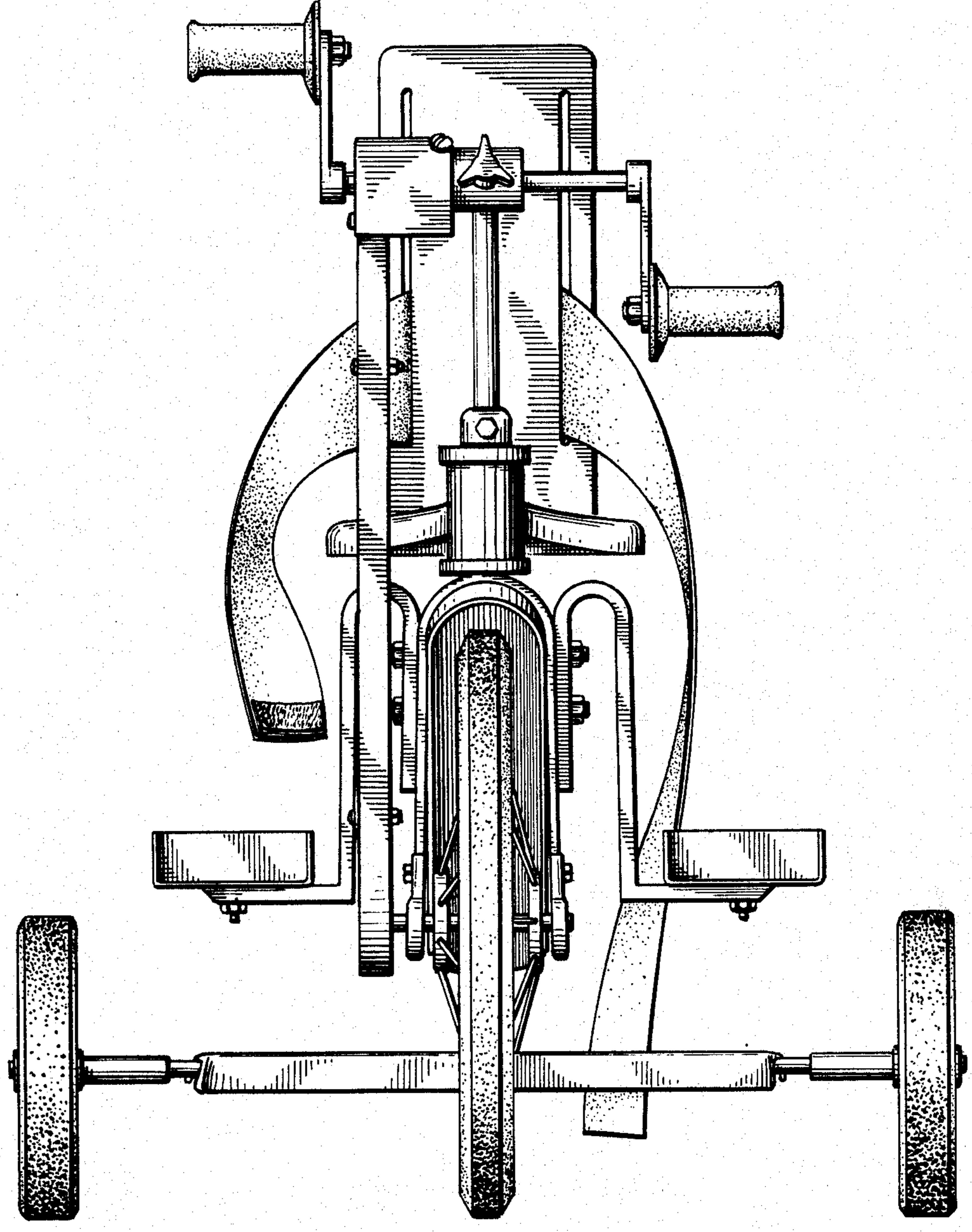

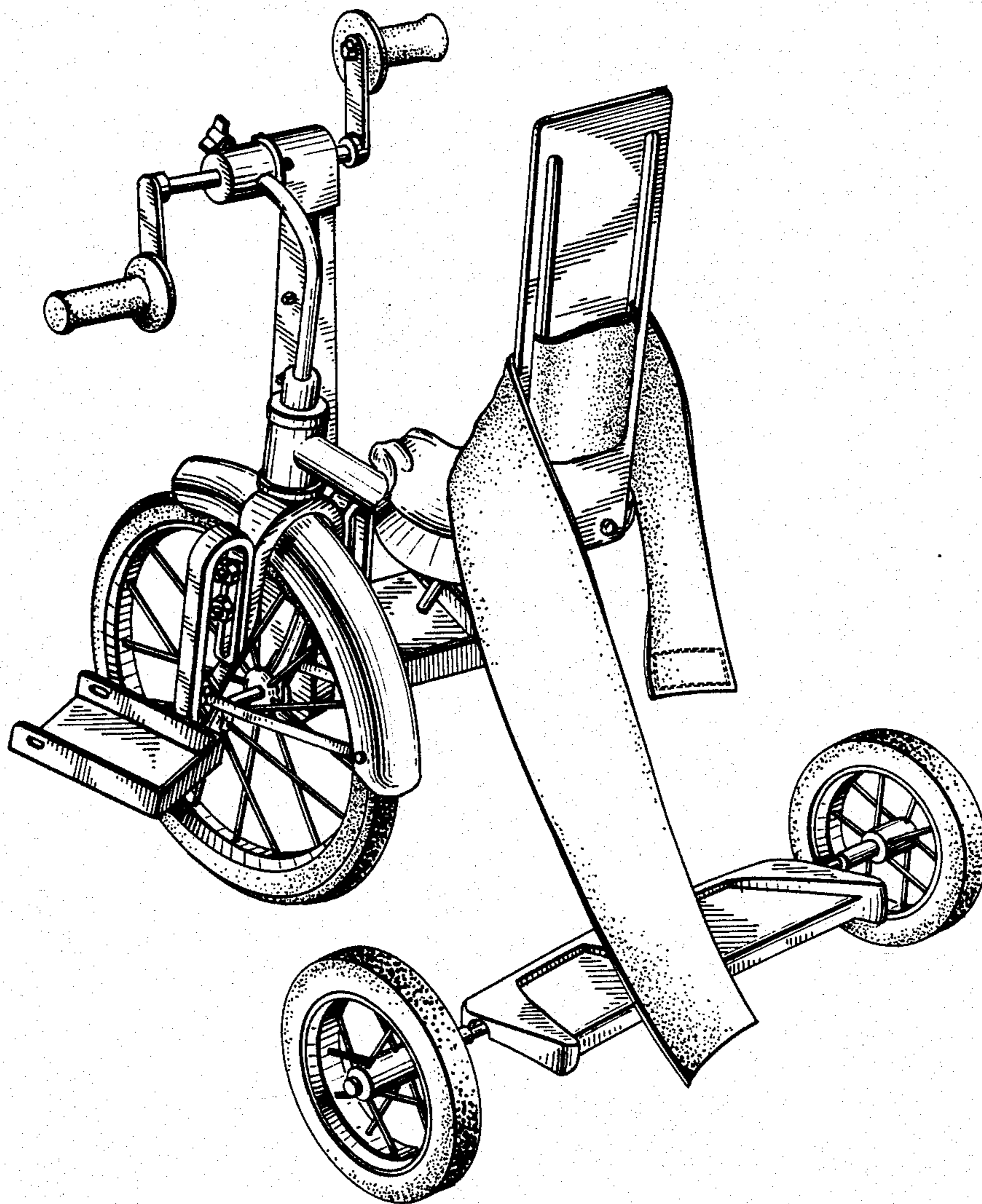

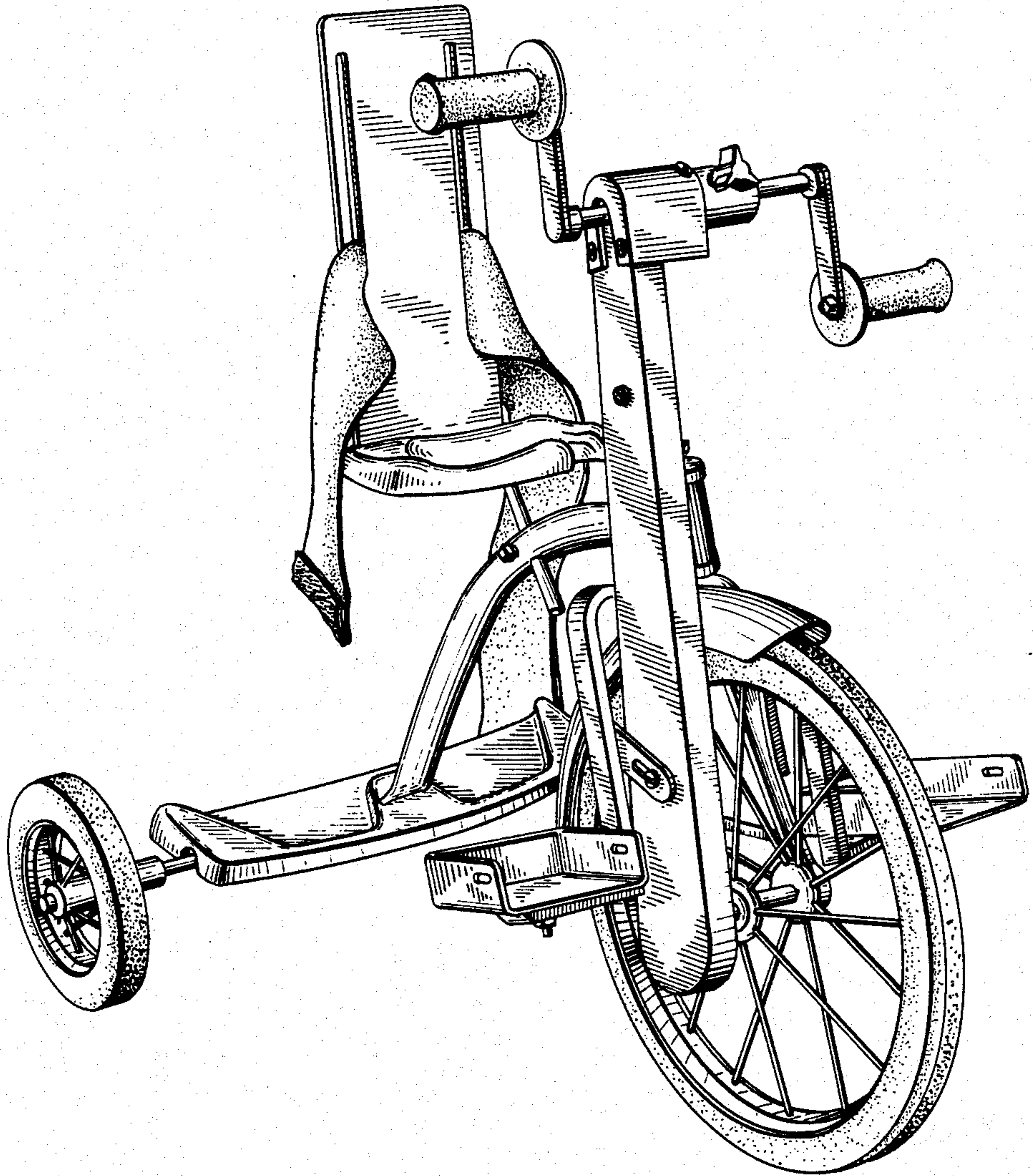
