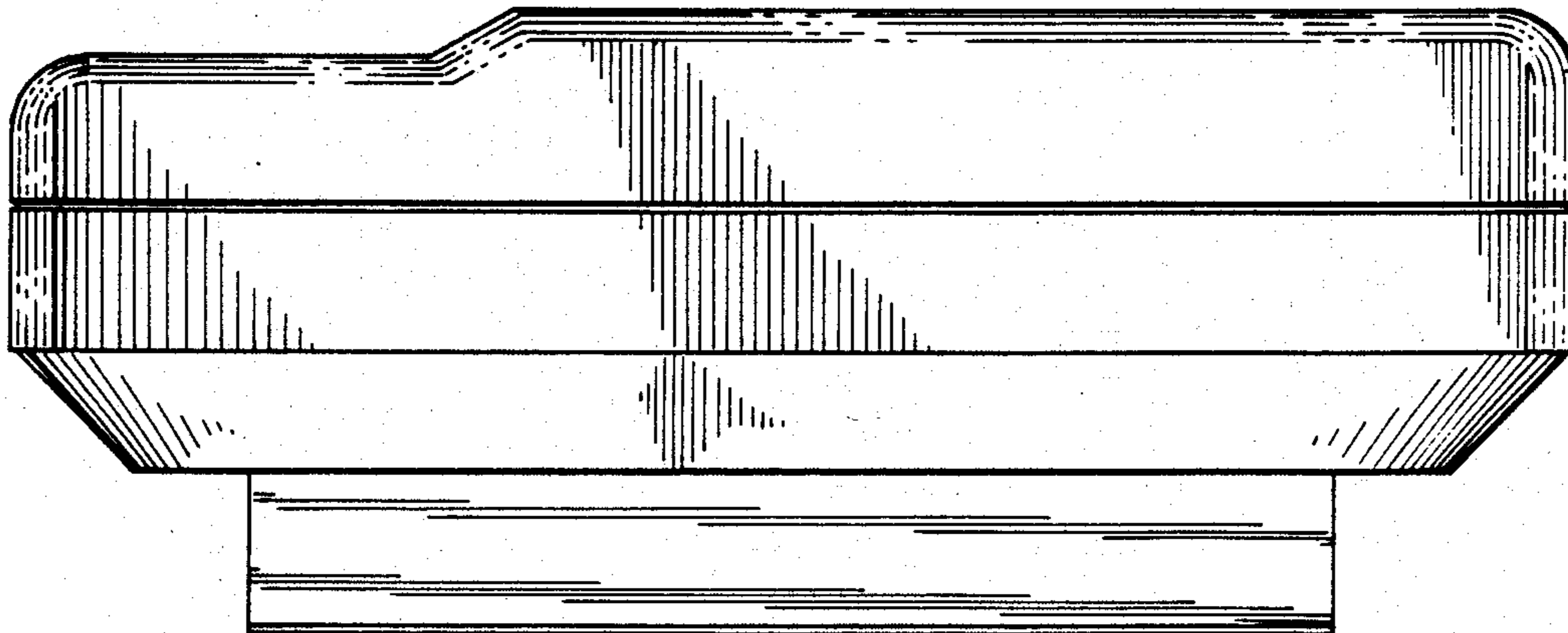
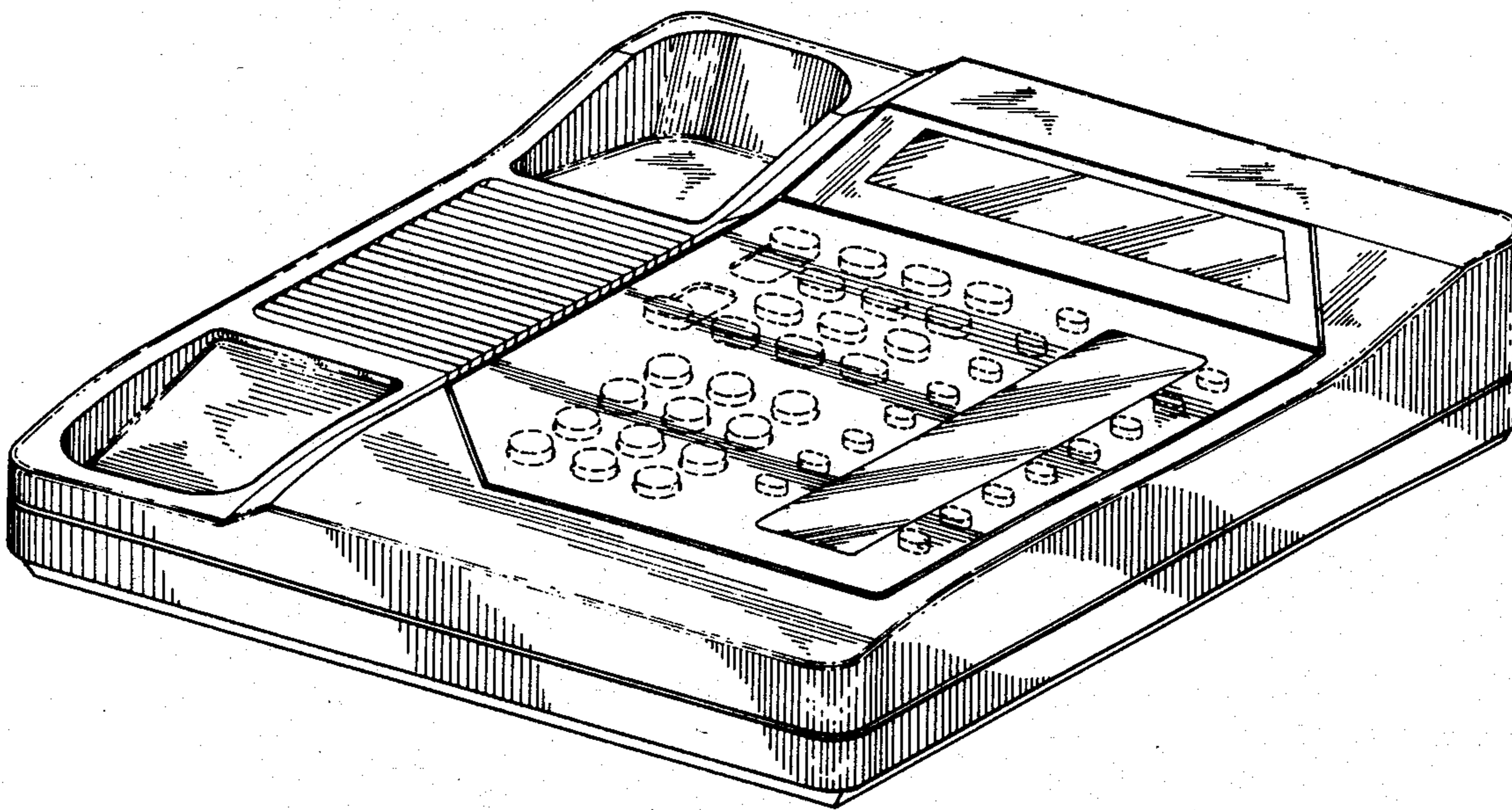

FIG. 4, is a bottom plan view of the claimed design.



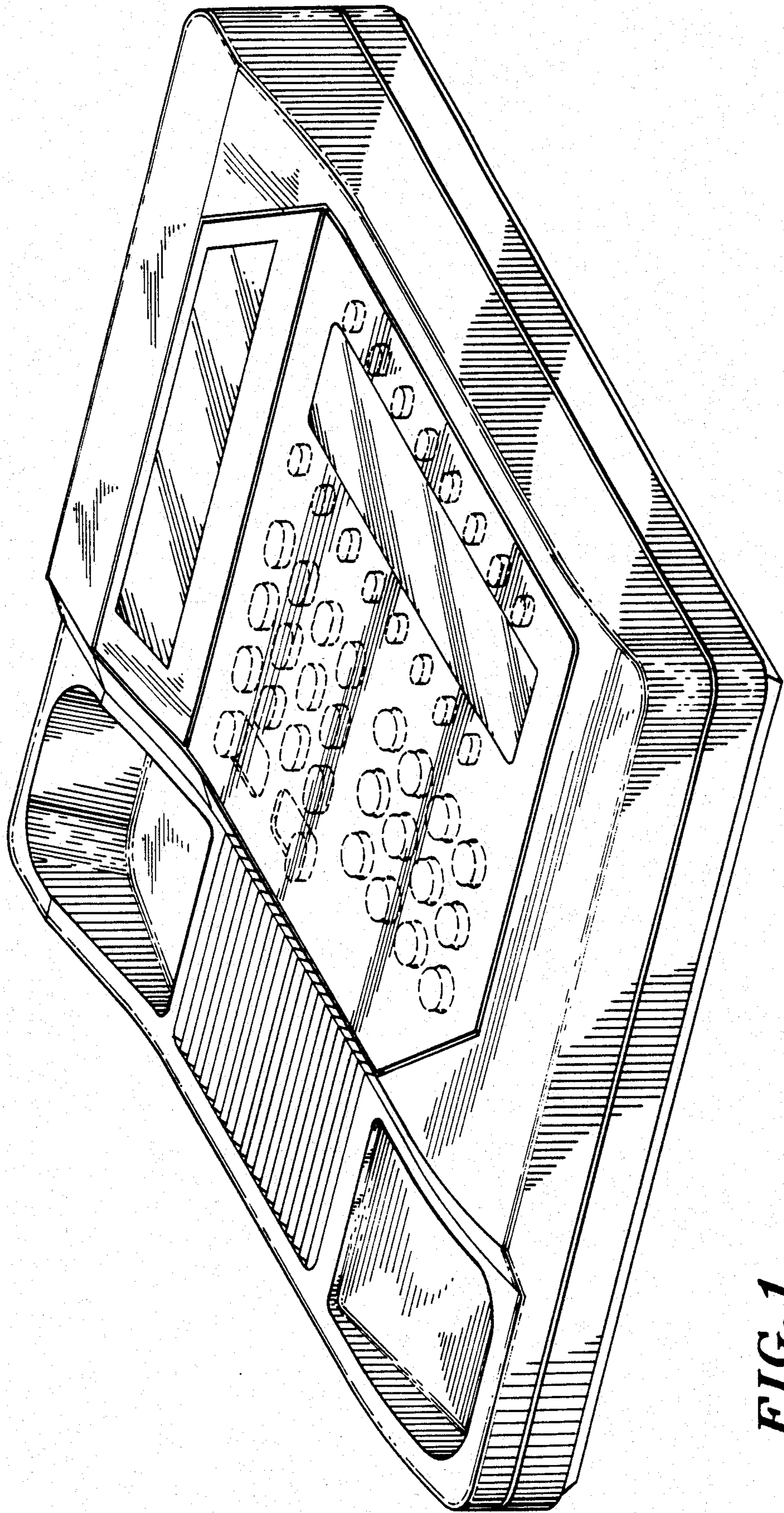

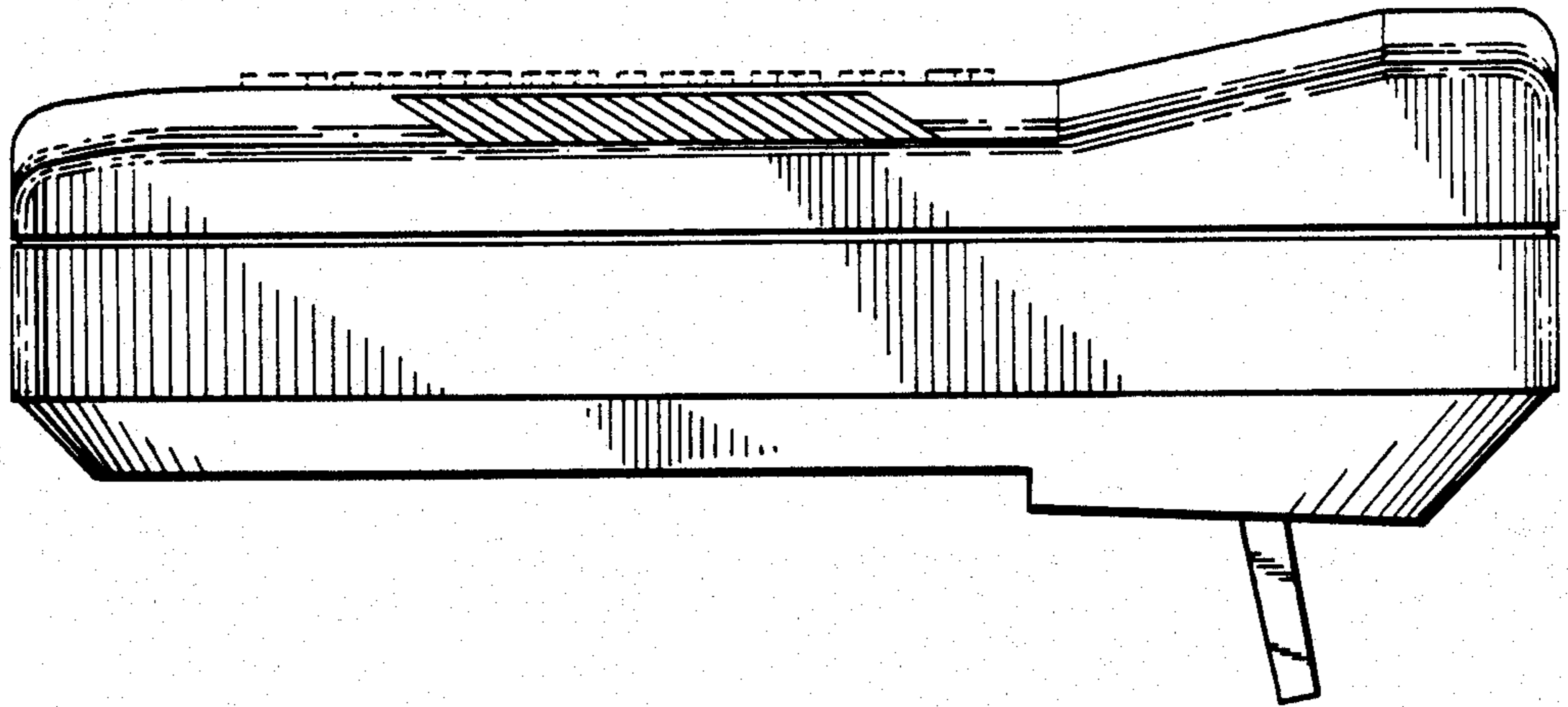

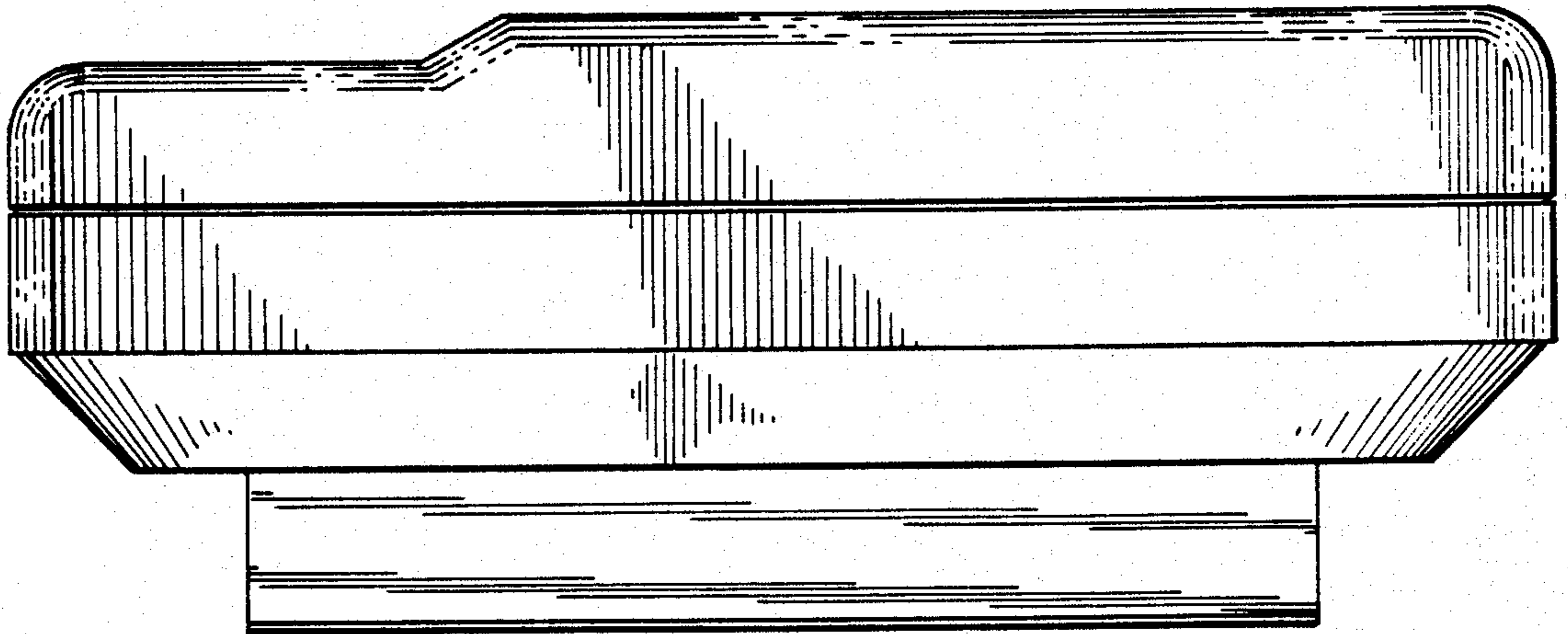

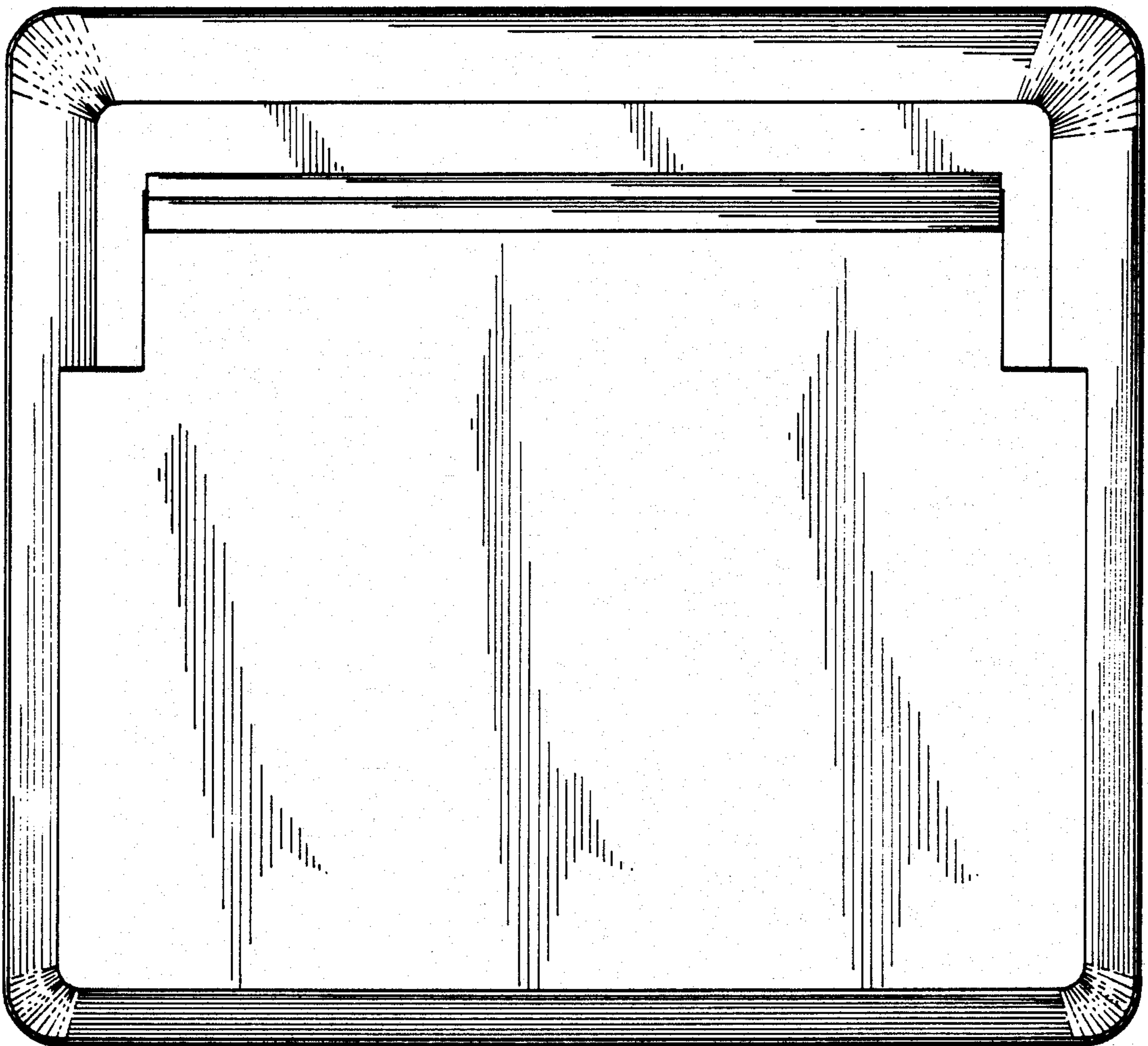
