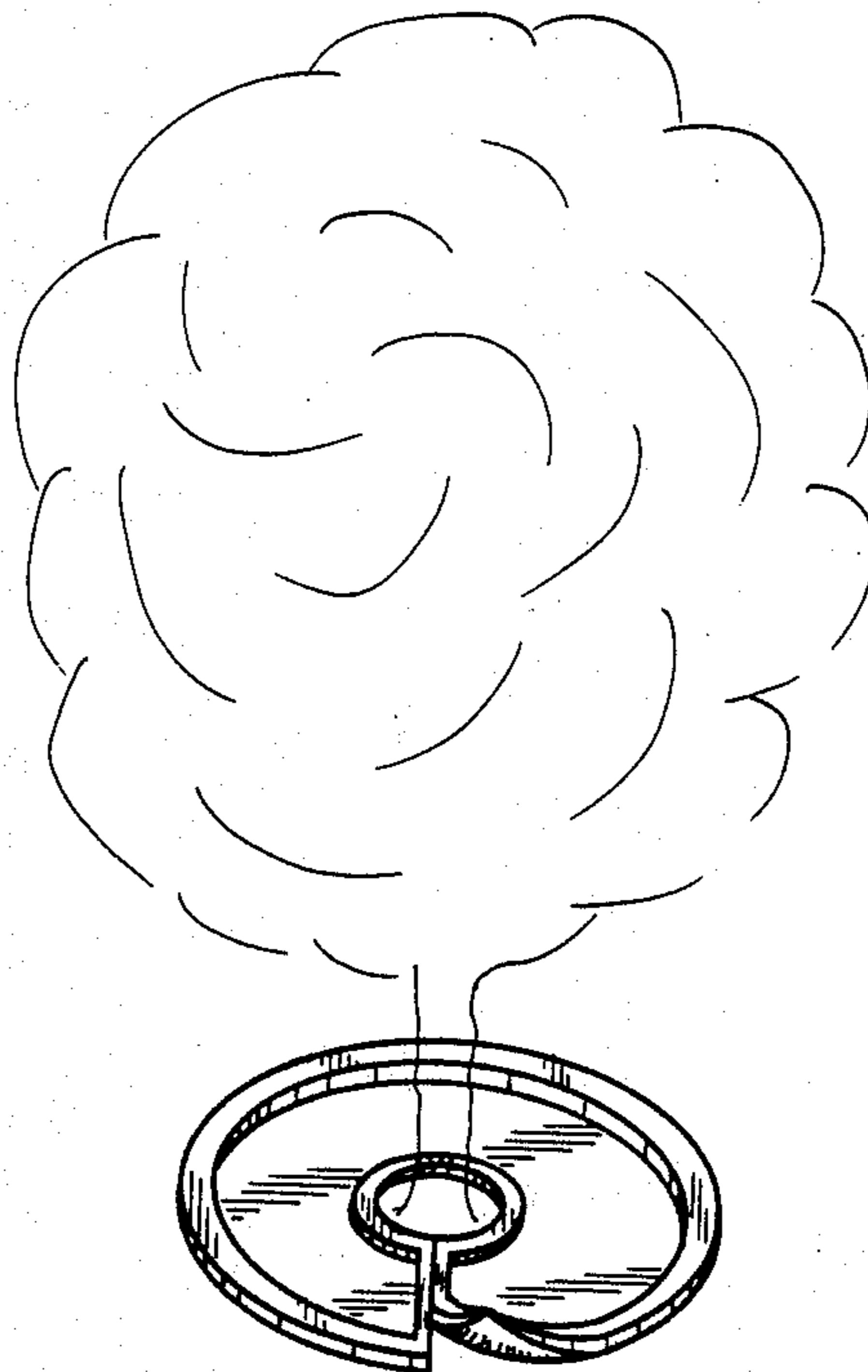

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a removable ground cover to catch shrub clippings, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a removable ground cover to catch shrub clippings showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a sectional view thereof taken along the line 3—3 of FIG. 1; and FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof shown in operative condition on a reduced scale.



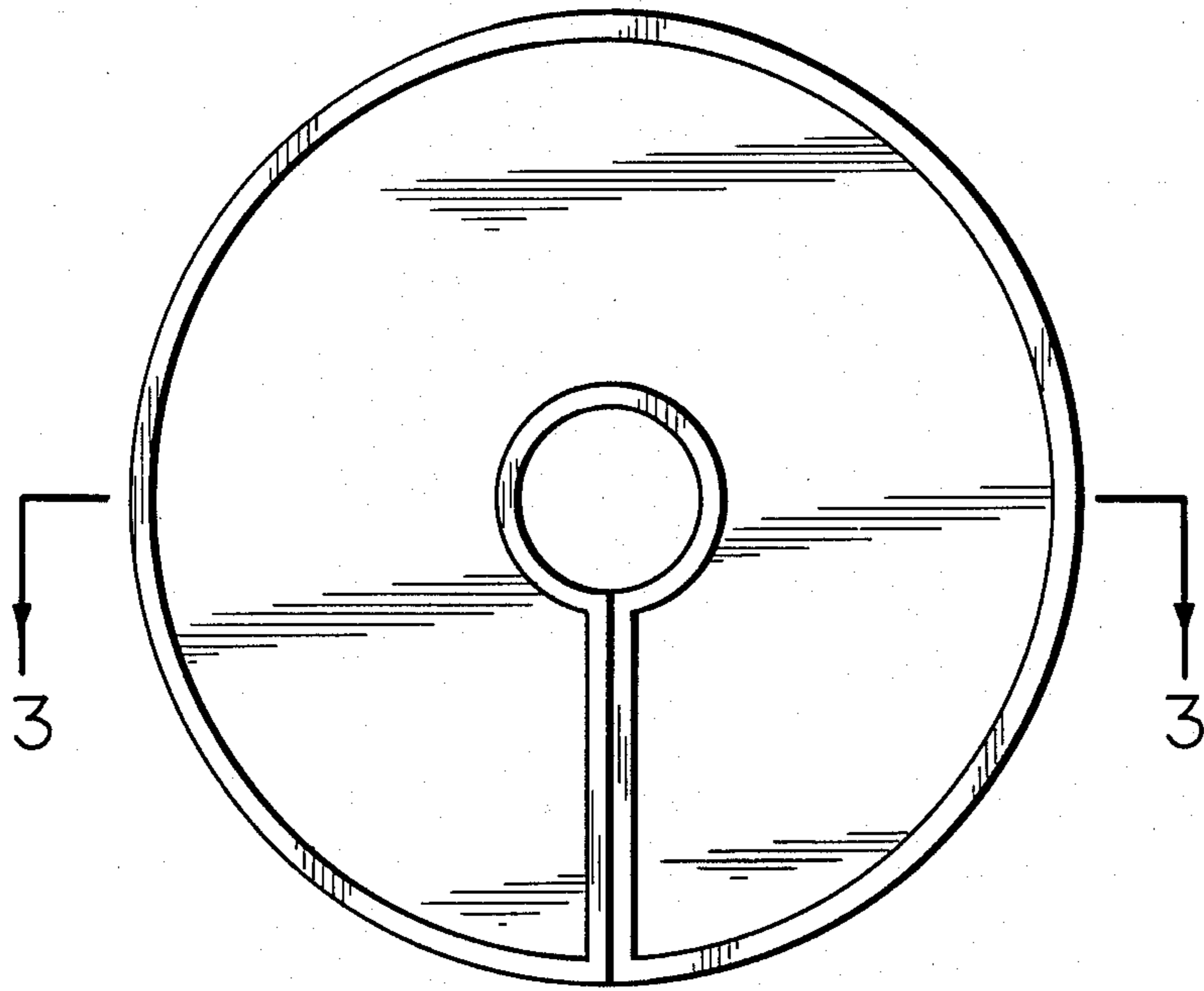

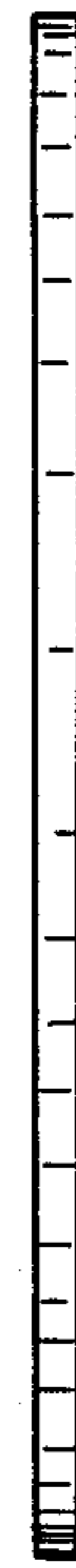

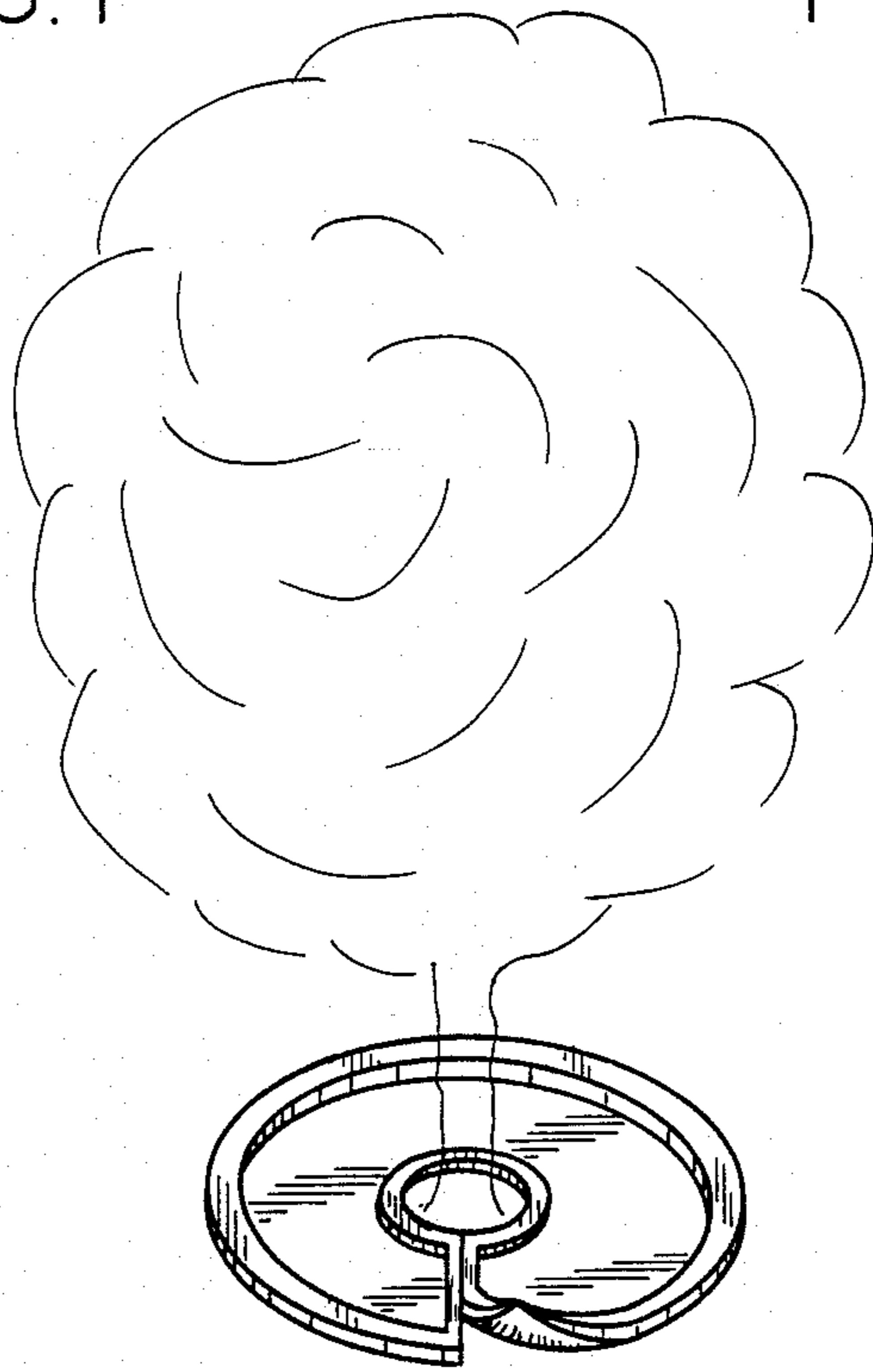
