FIG. 1 is a front view of an earring showing my new design;

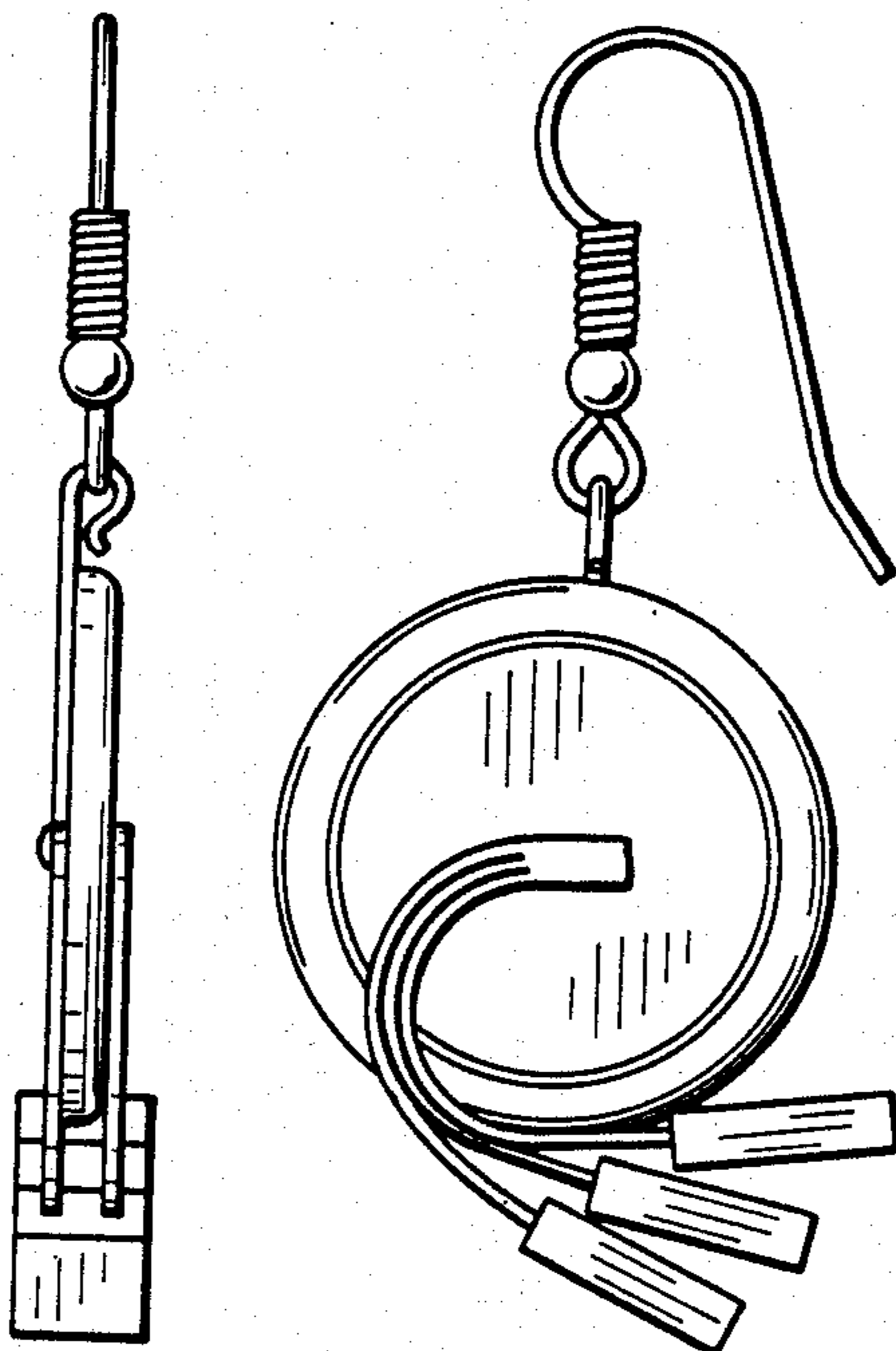
FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.



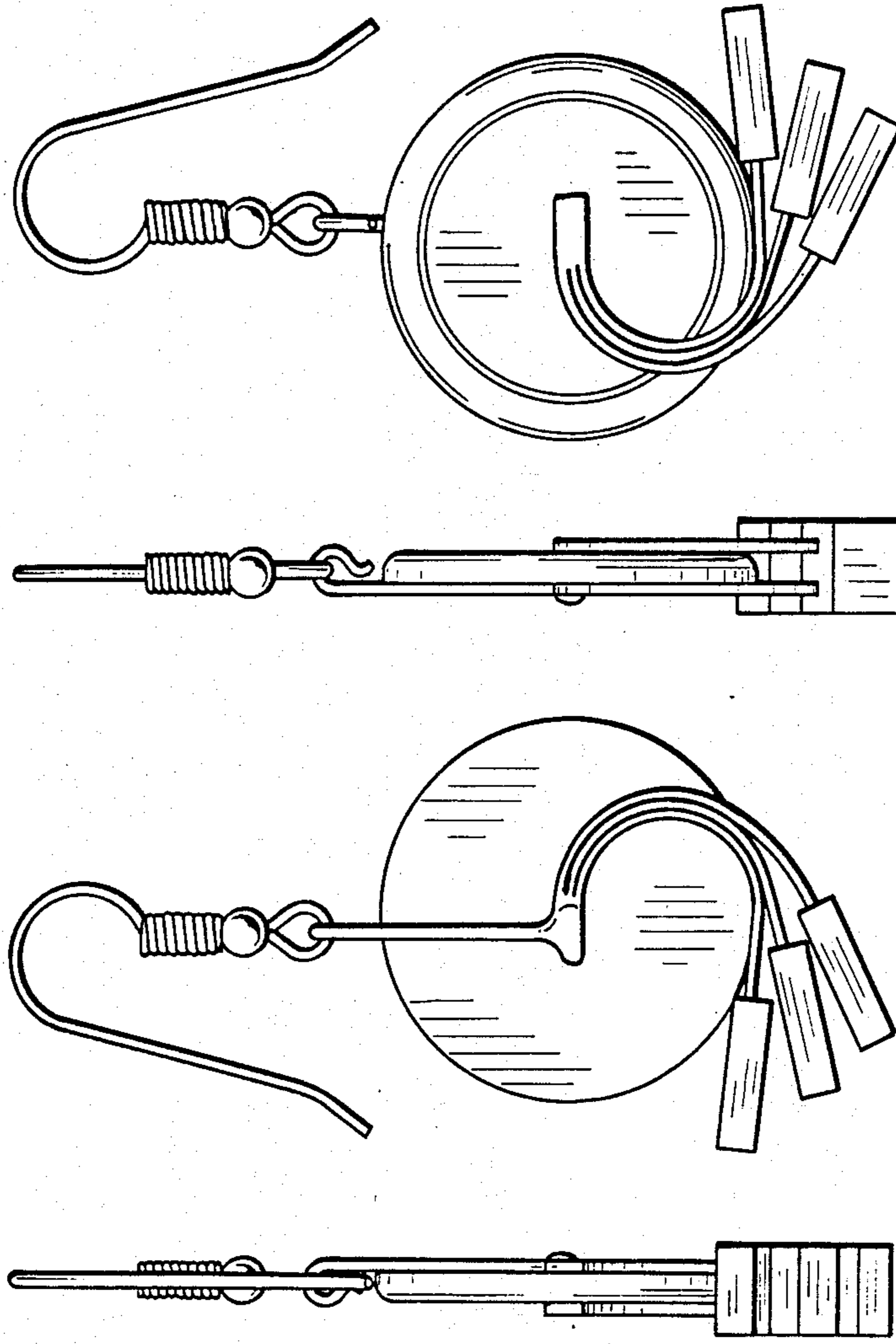

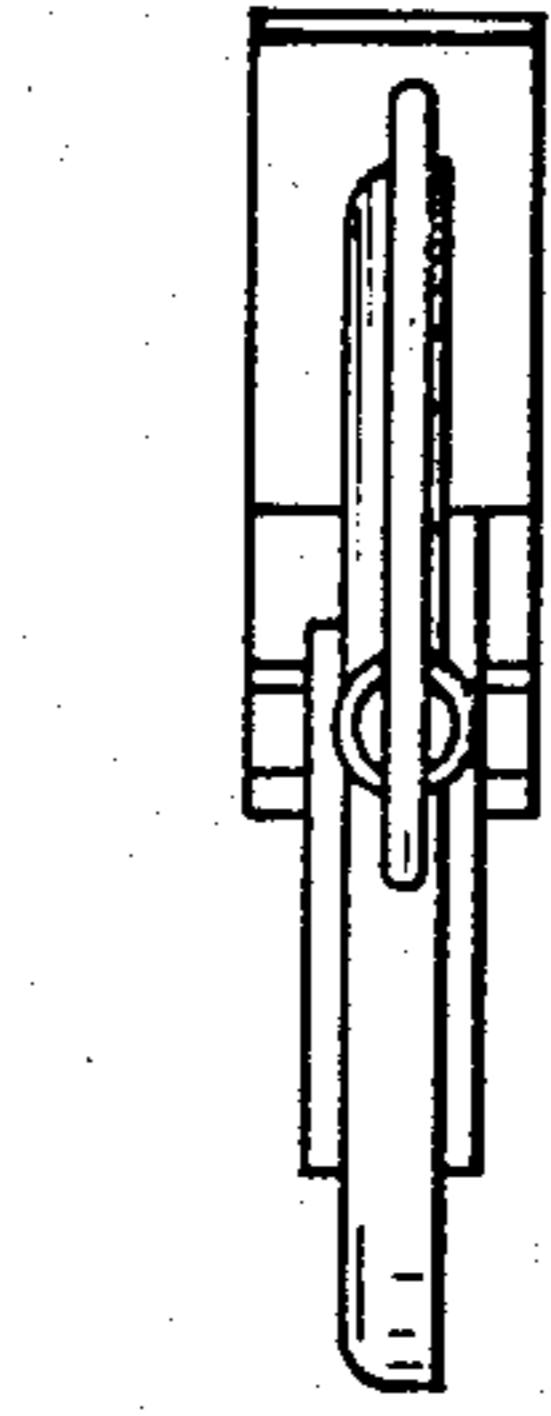

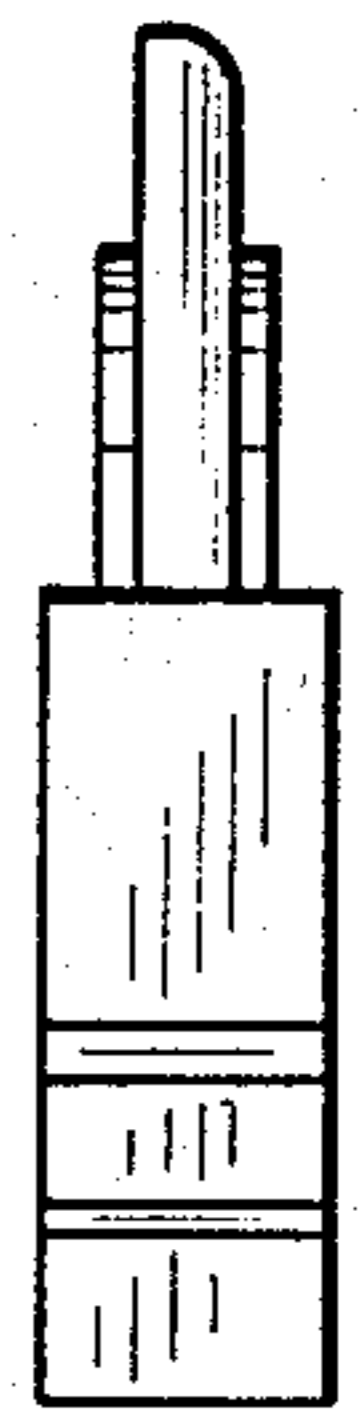
