FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;

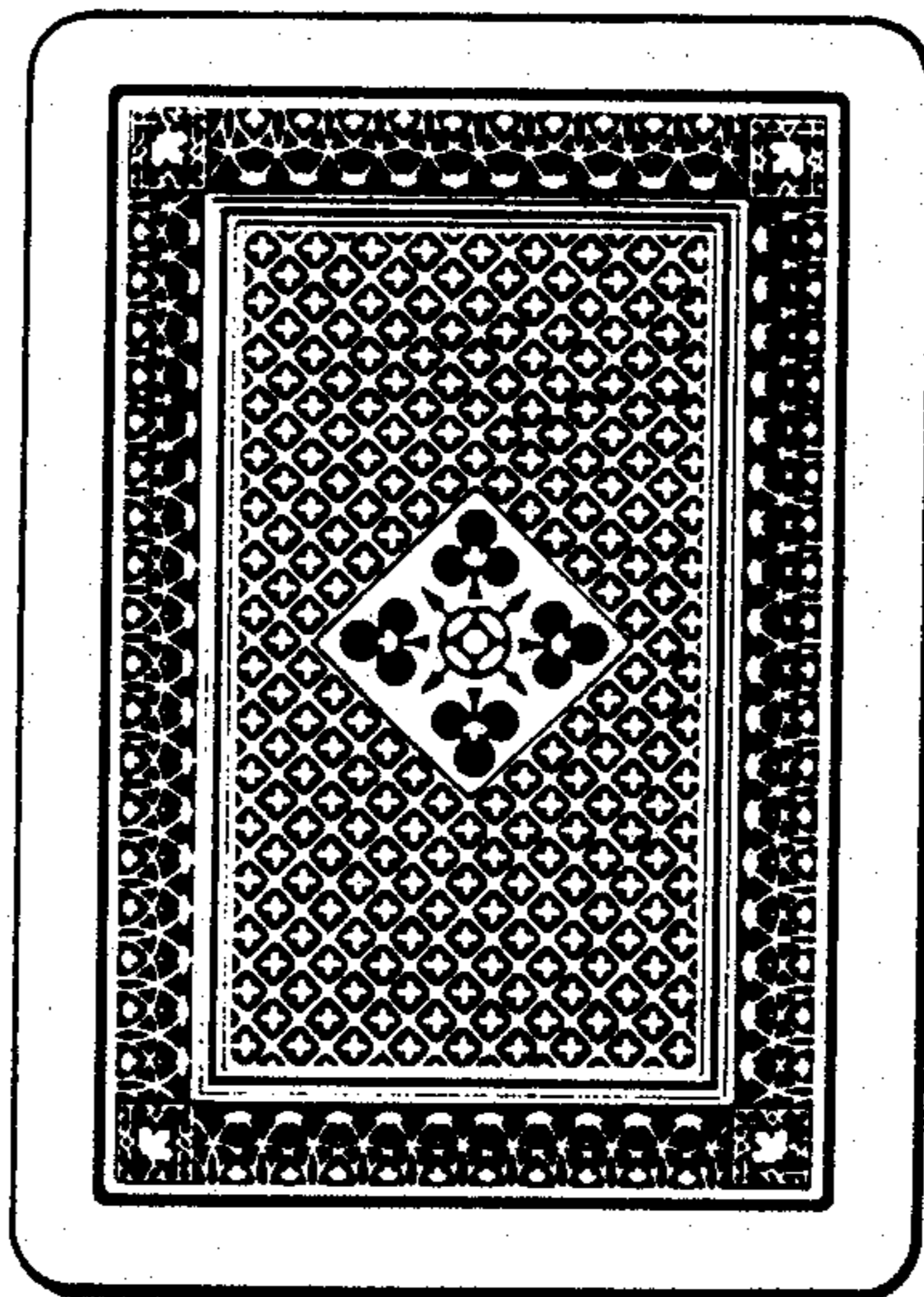
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof;

FIGS. 11 and 12 are top and bottom views thereof.



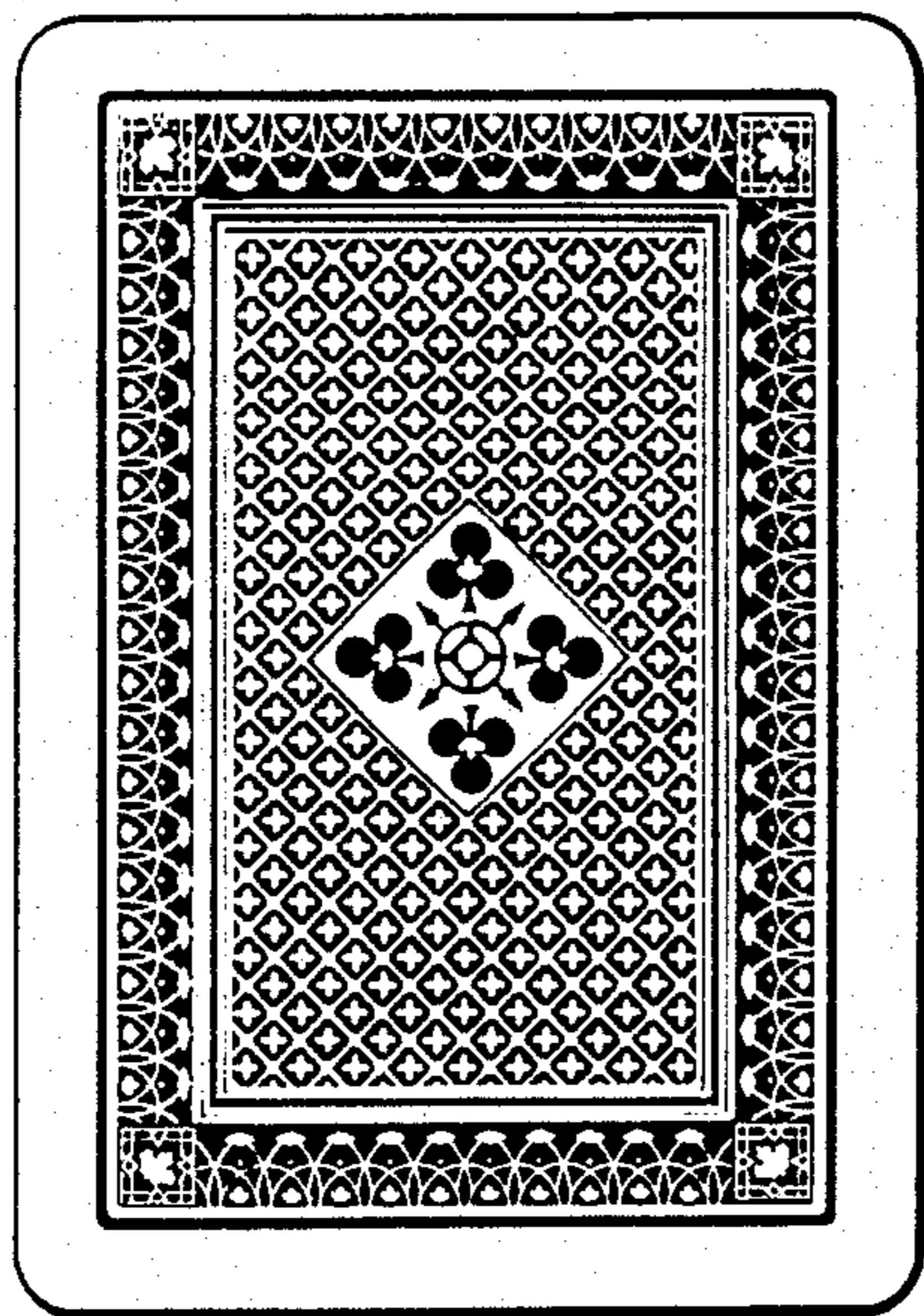

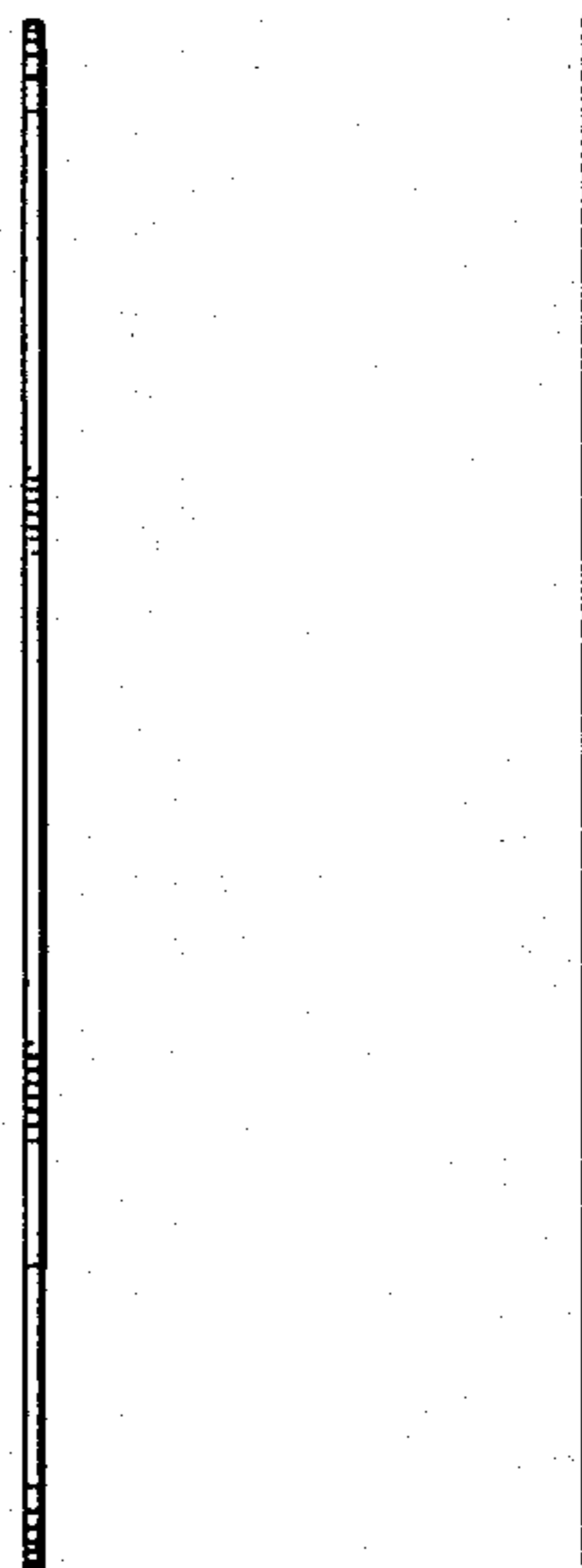


FIG. 3 FIG. 4

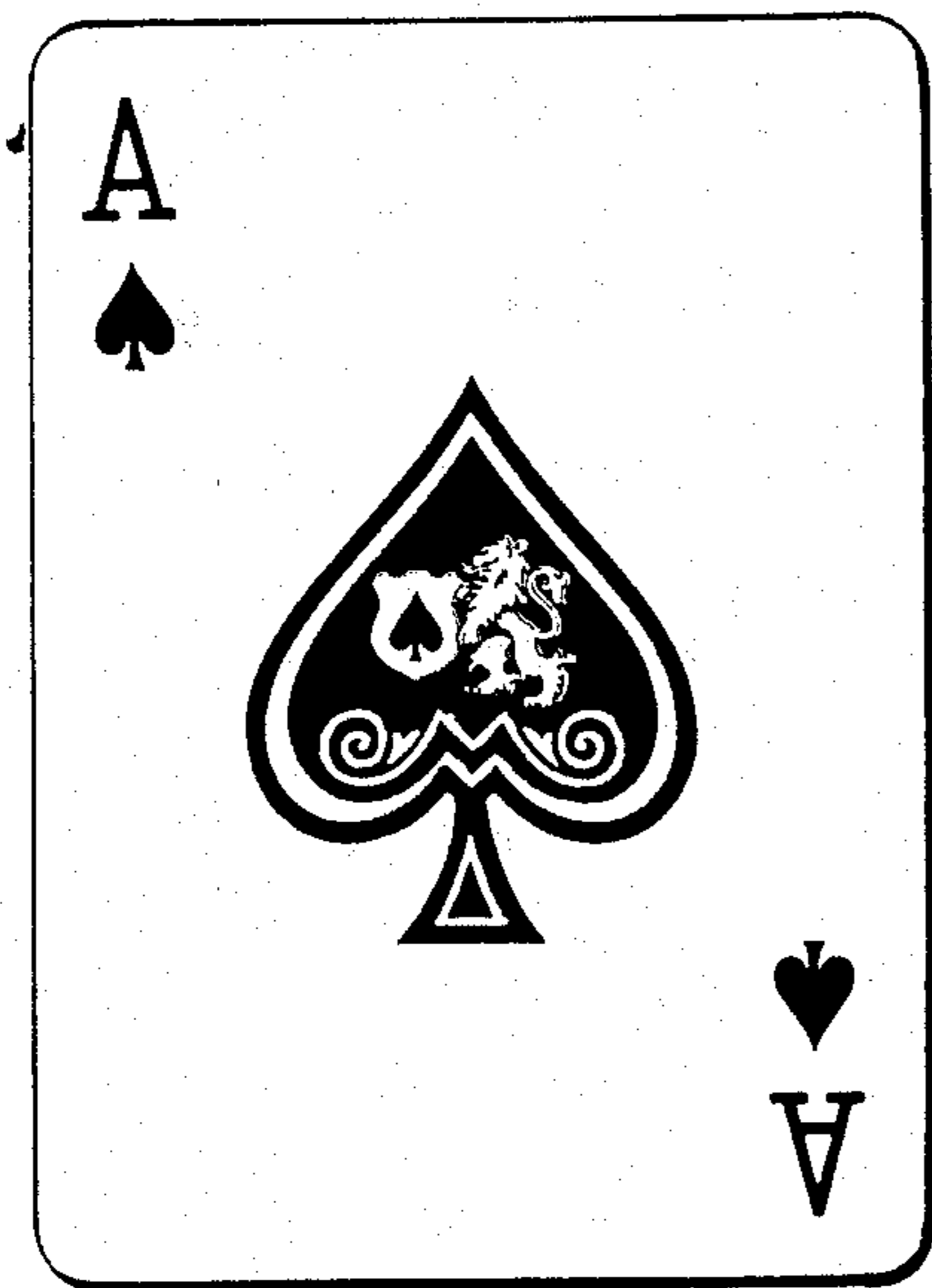

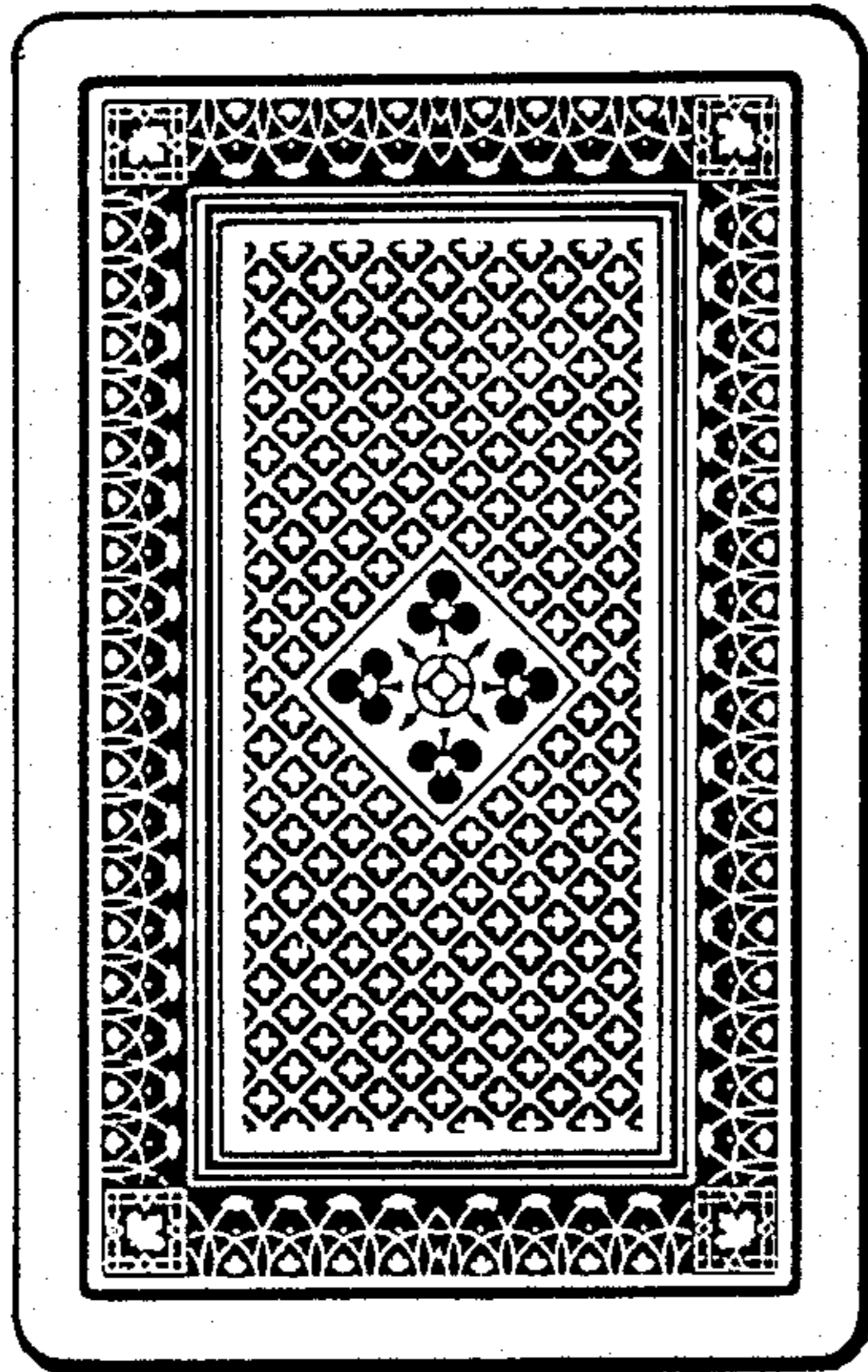
