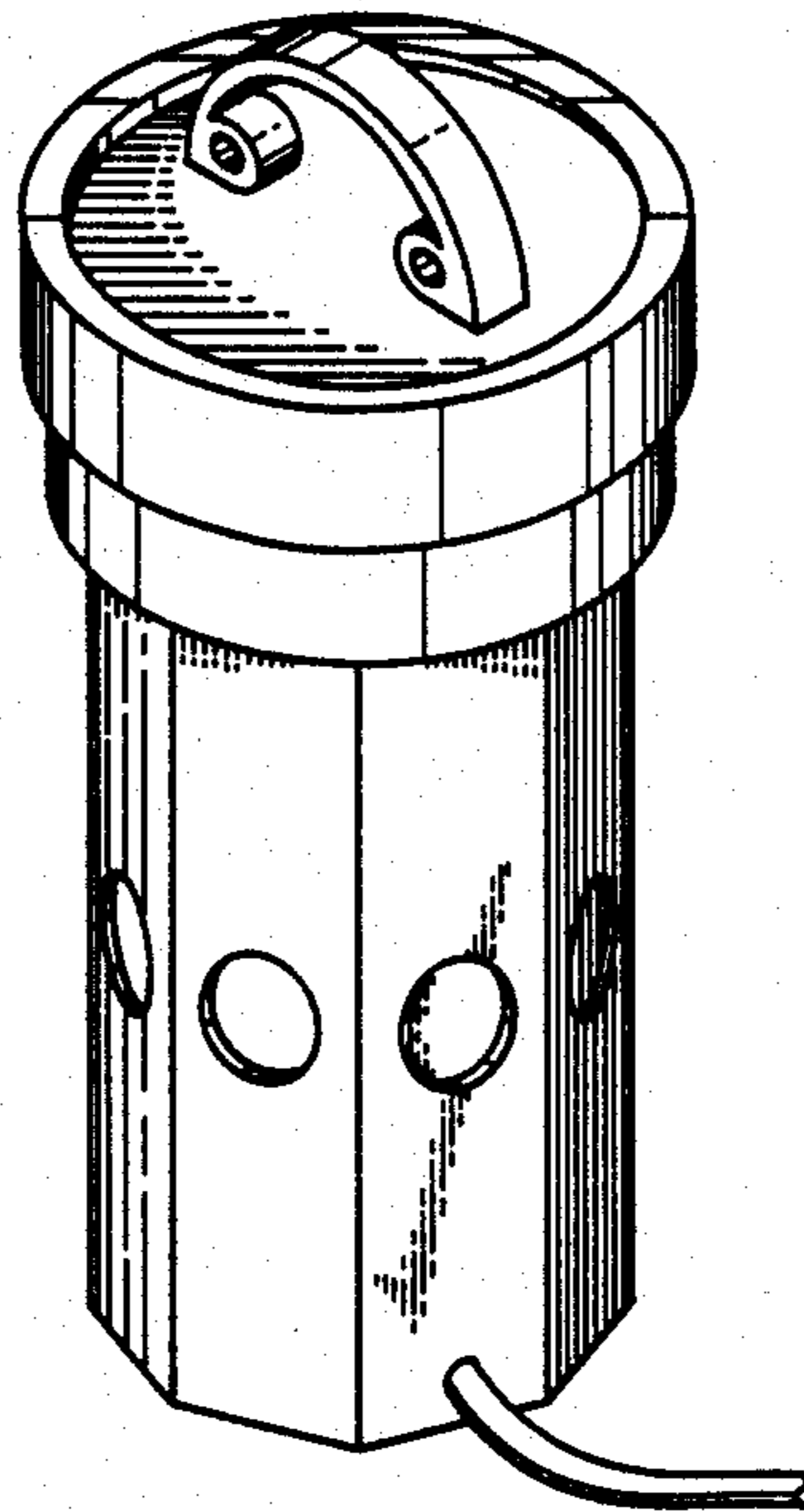
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a wet wipe warmer showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof, it being understood that the rear is a mirror image of that shown. The side opposite to that shown in FIG. 1 is understood to be a mirror image thereof.

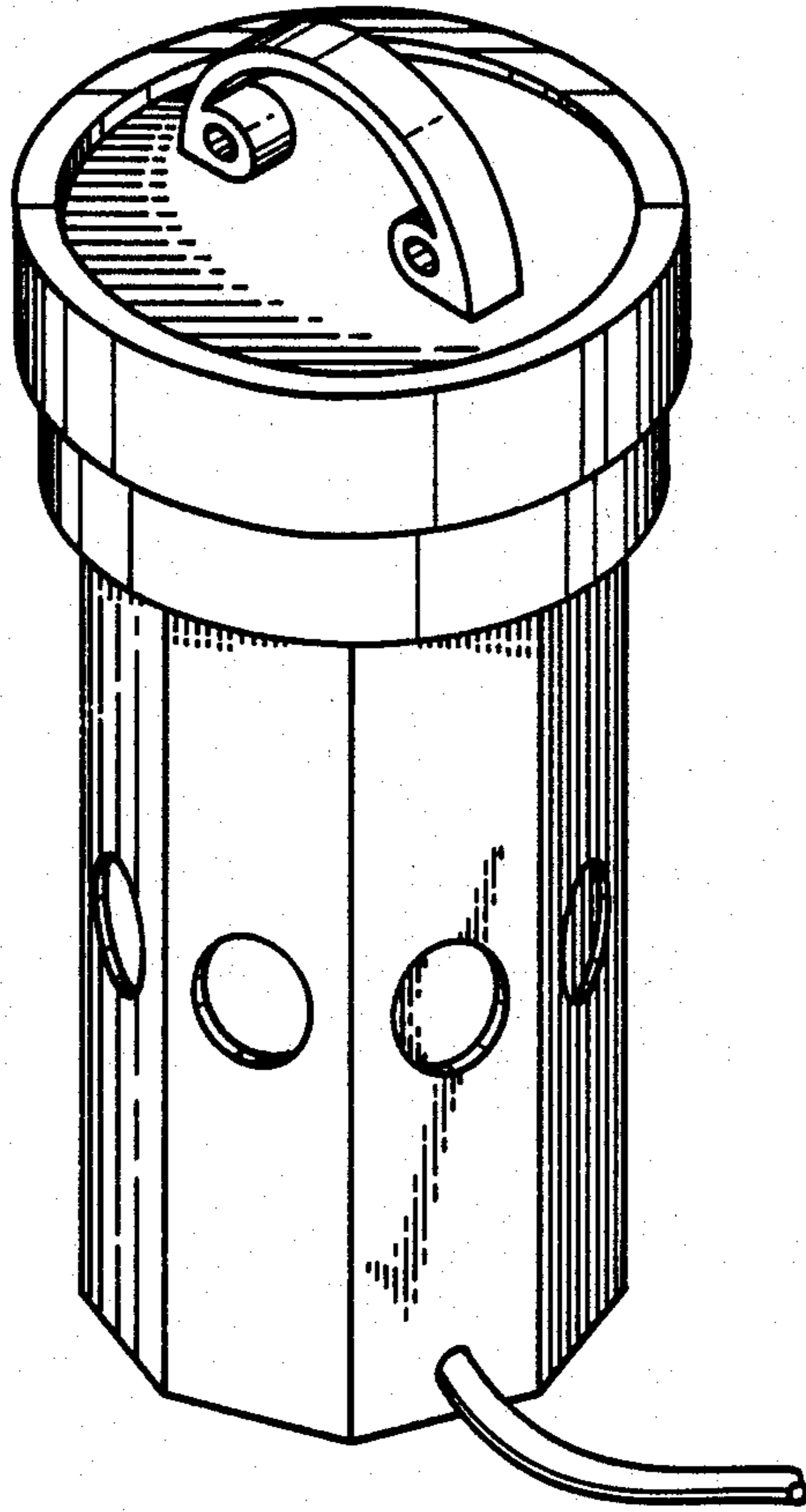

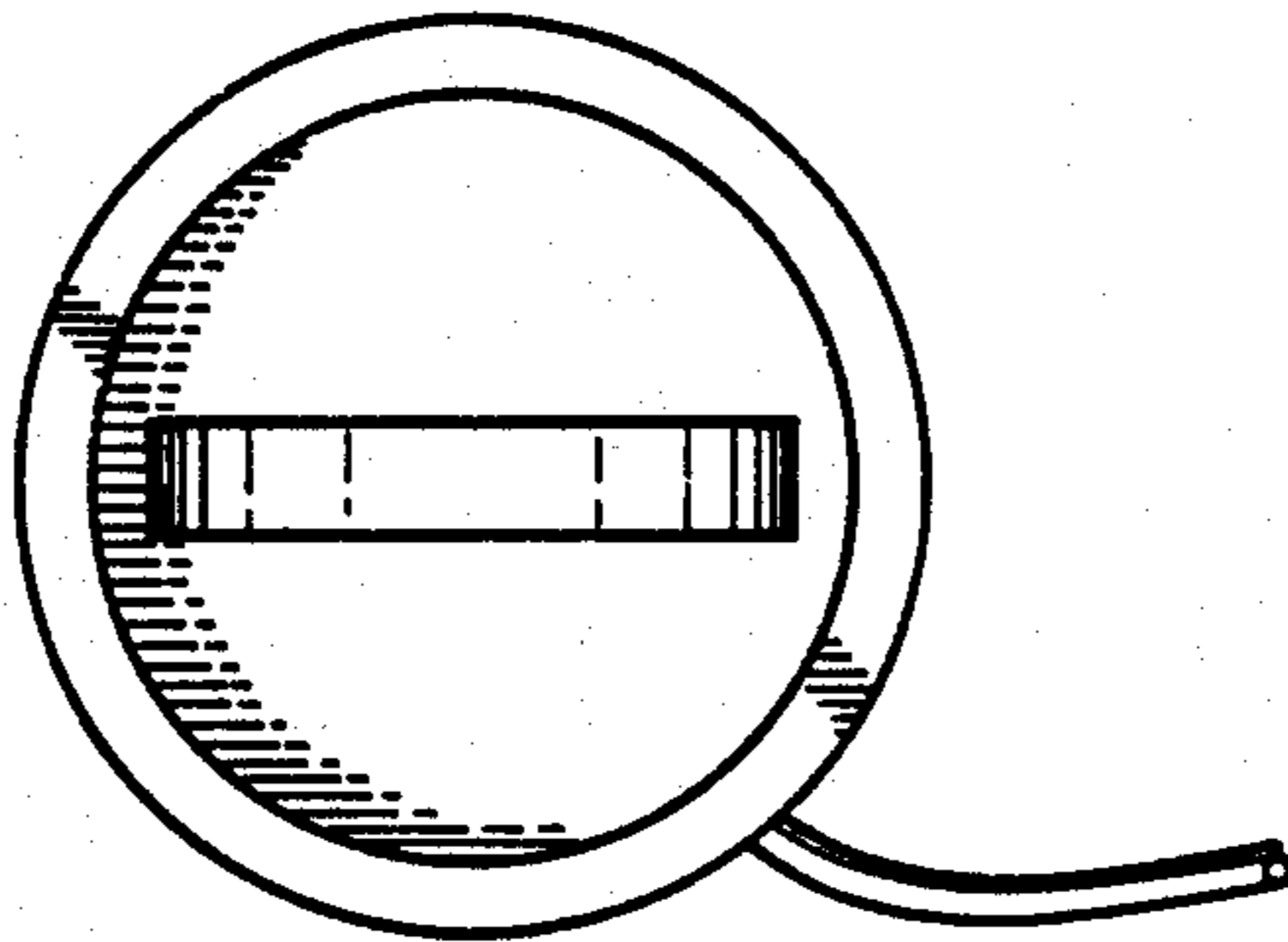

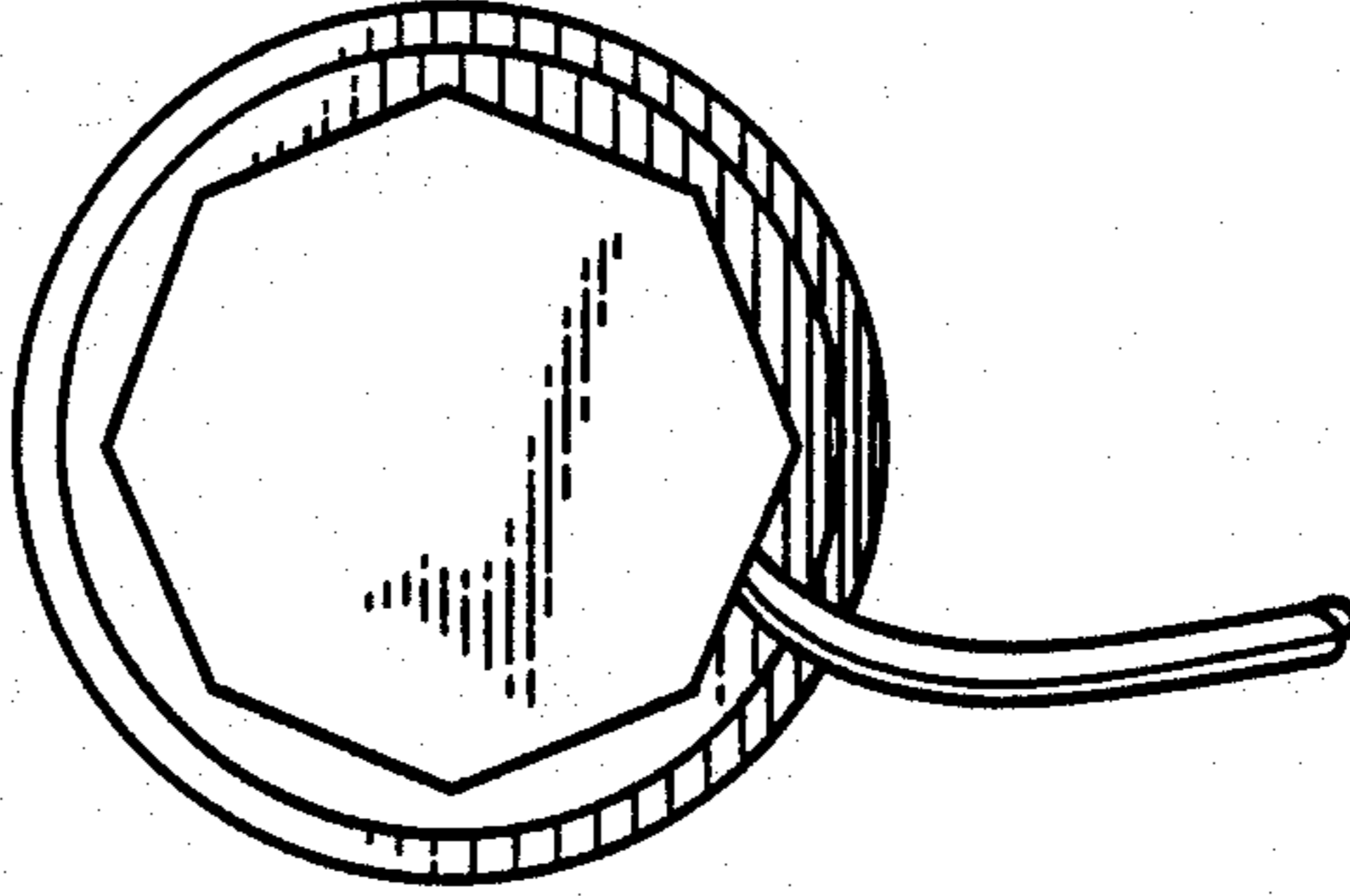

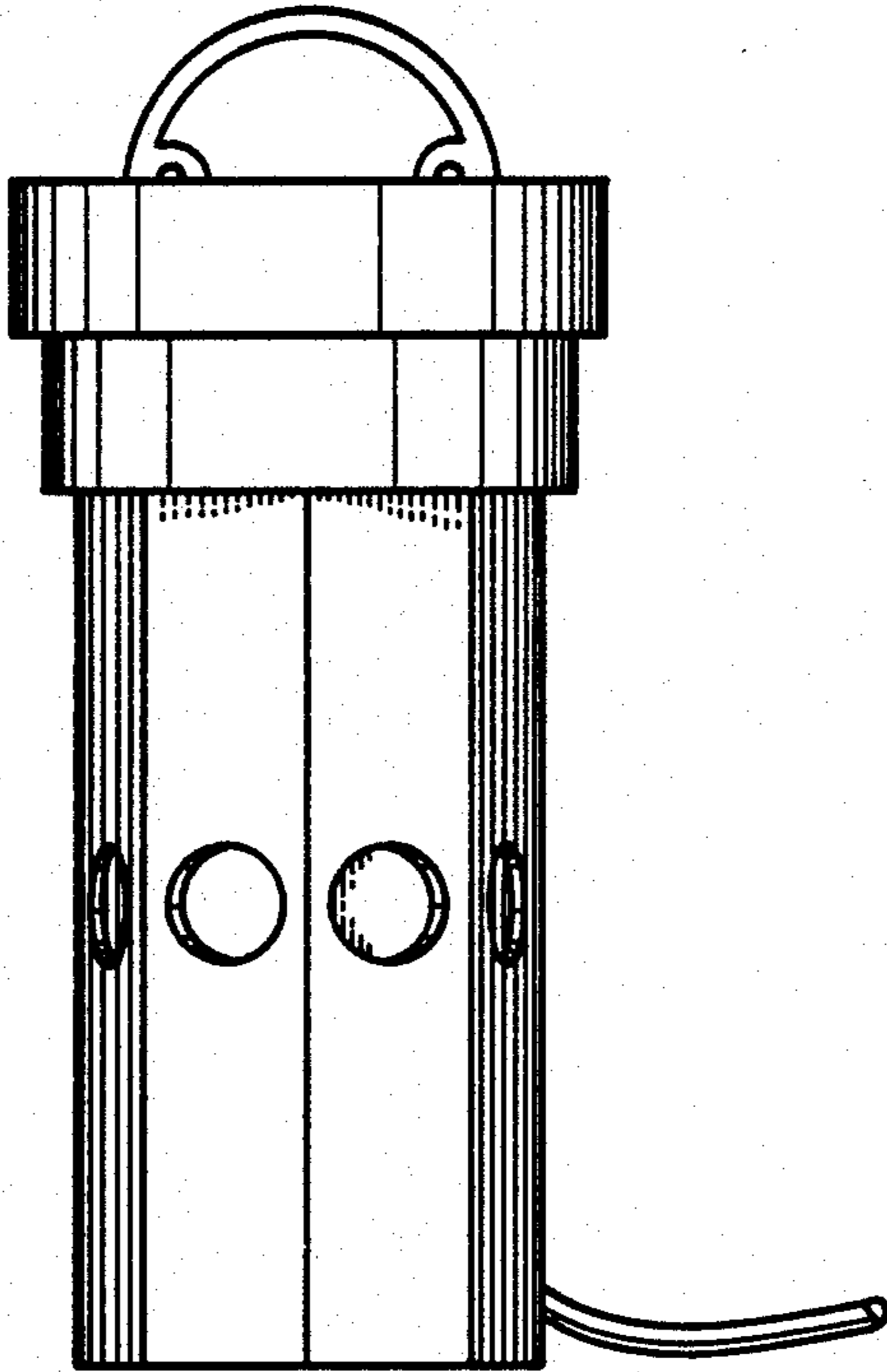
