The ornamental design for a doorway safety gate, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a doorway safety gate in closed position, showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof in open position.

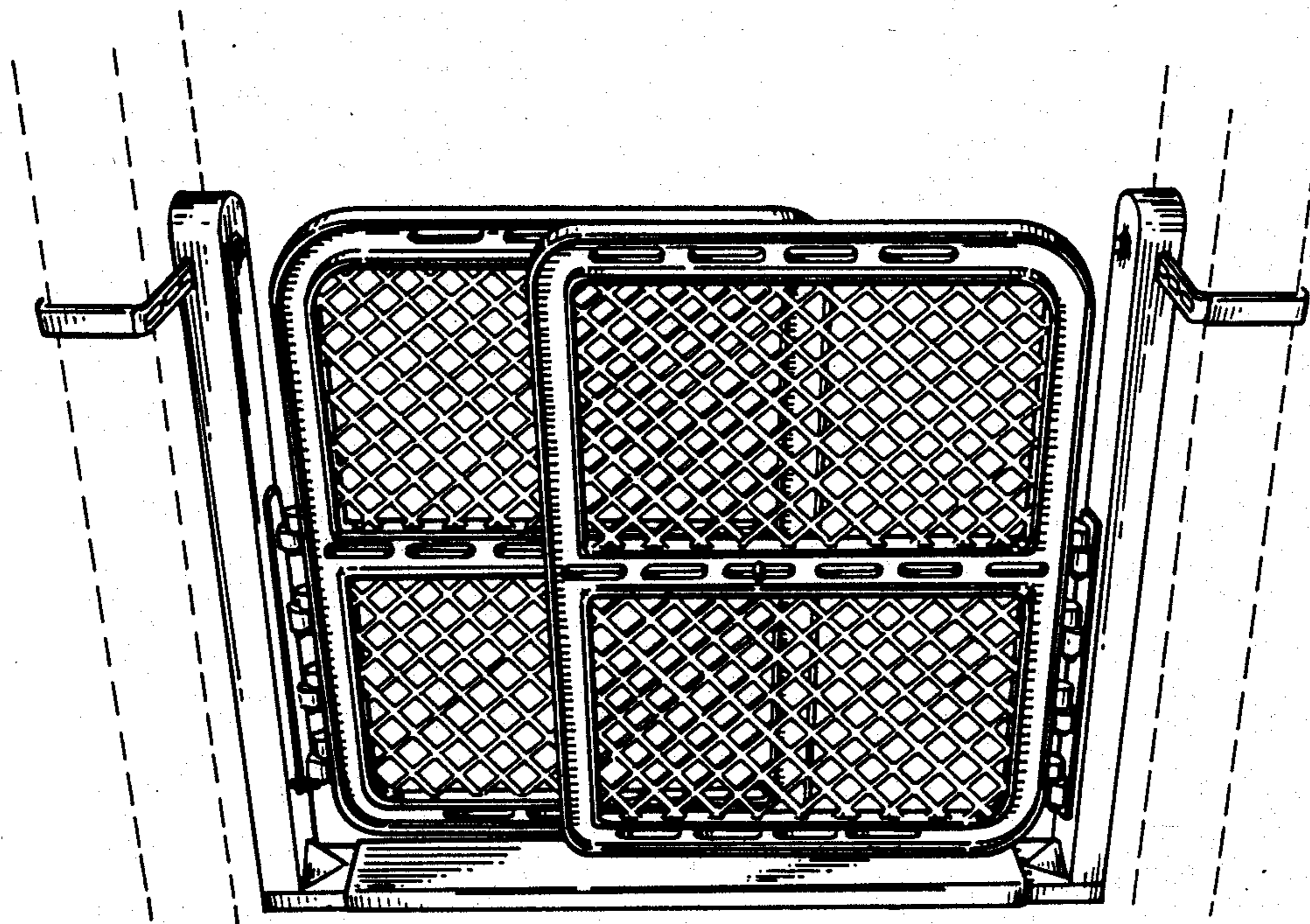
The back of the doorway safety gate of FIG. 1, is a mirror image of the front shown.

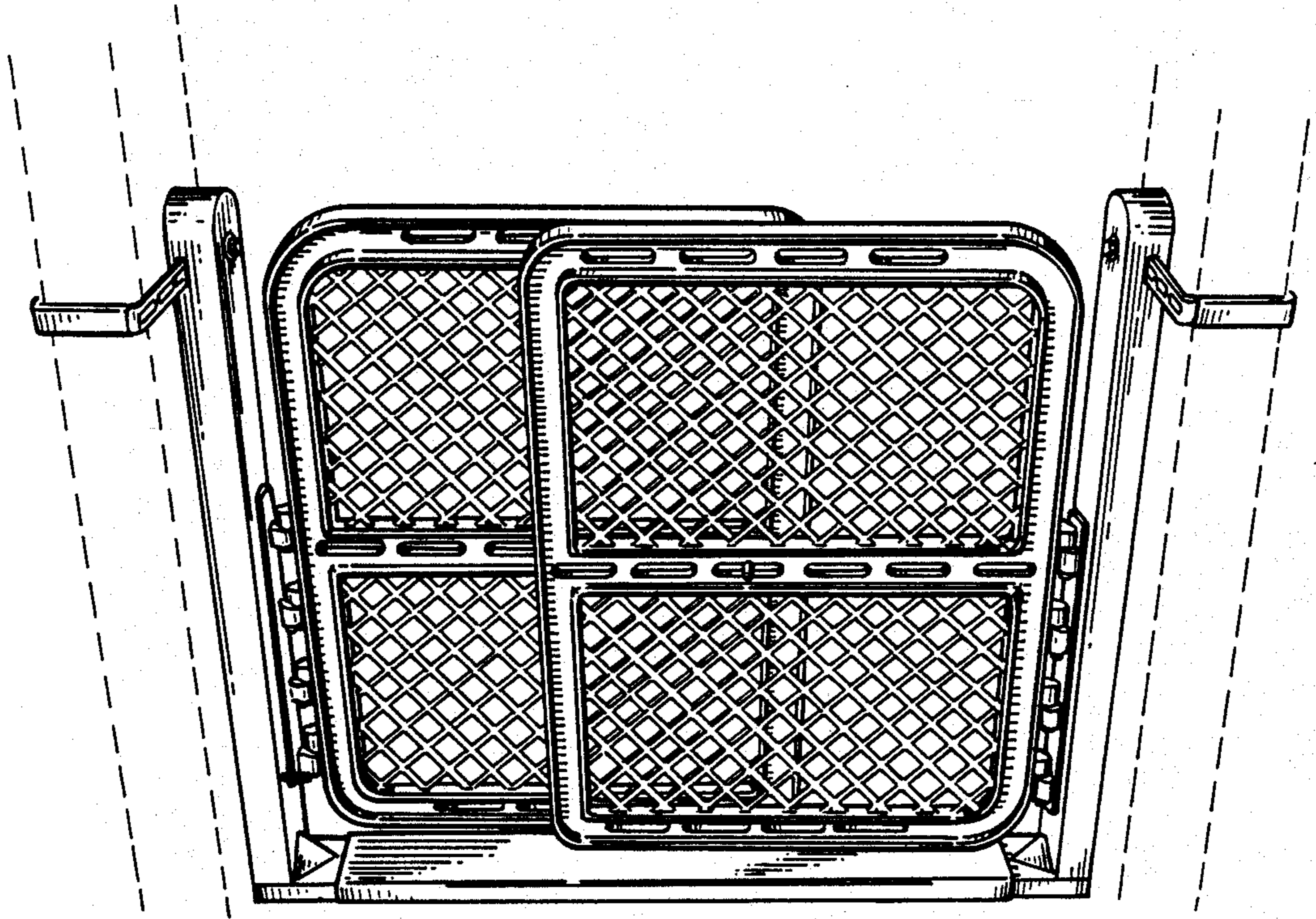

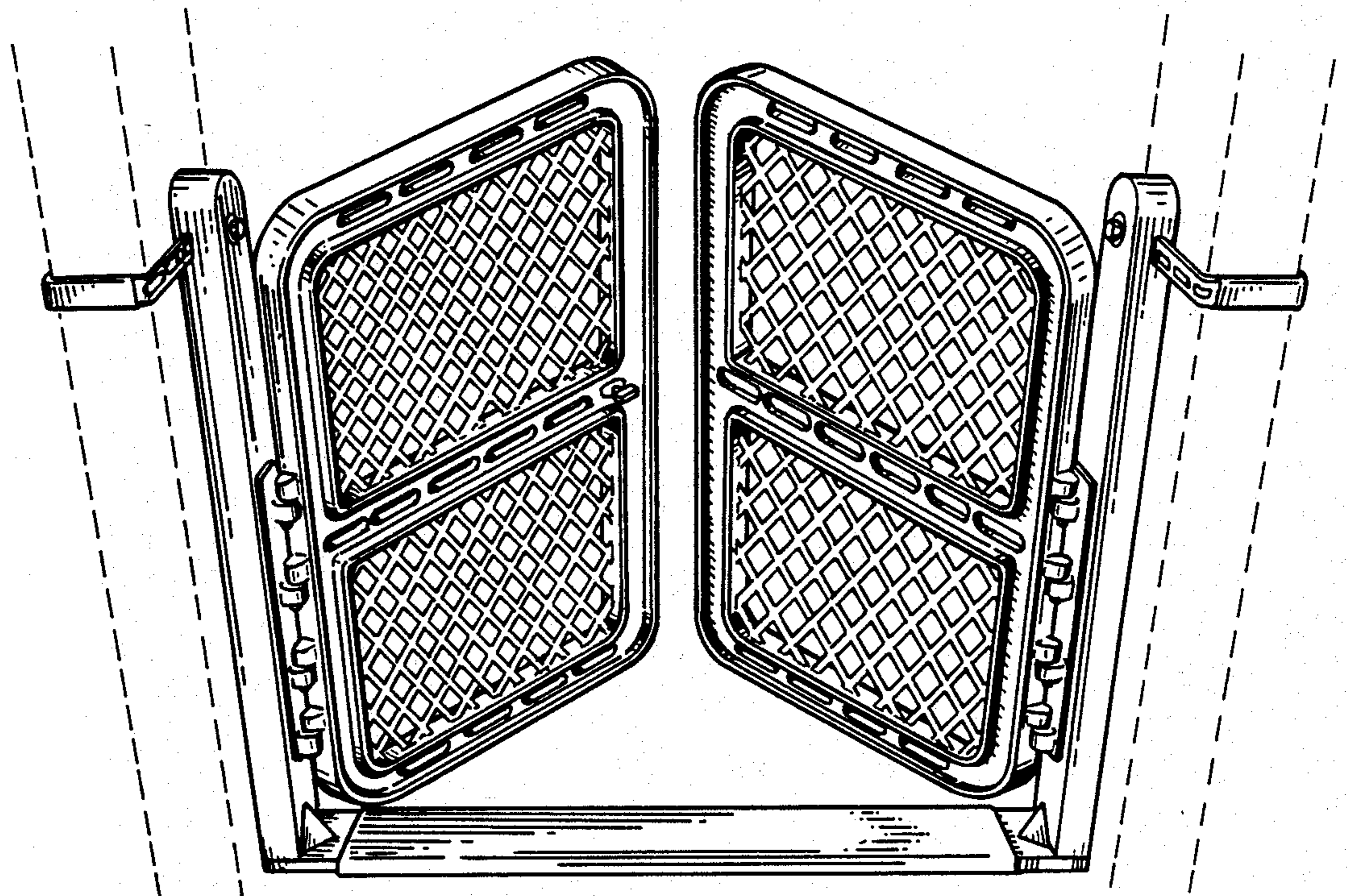
