FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the interior vehicle light showing my new design;

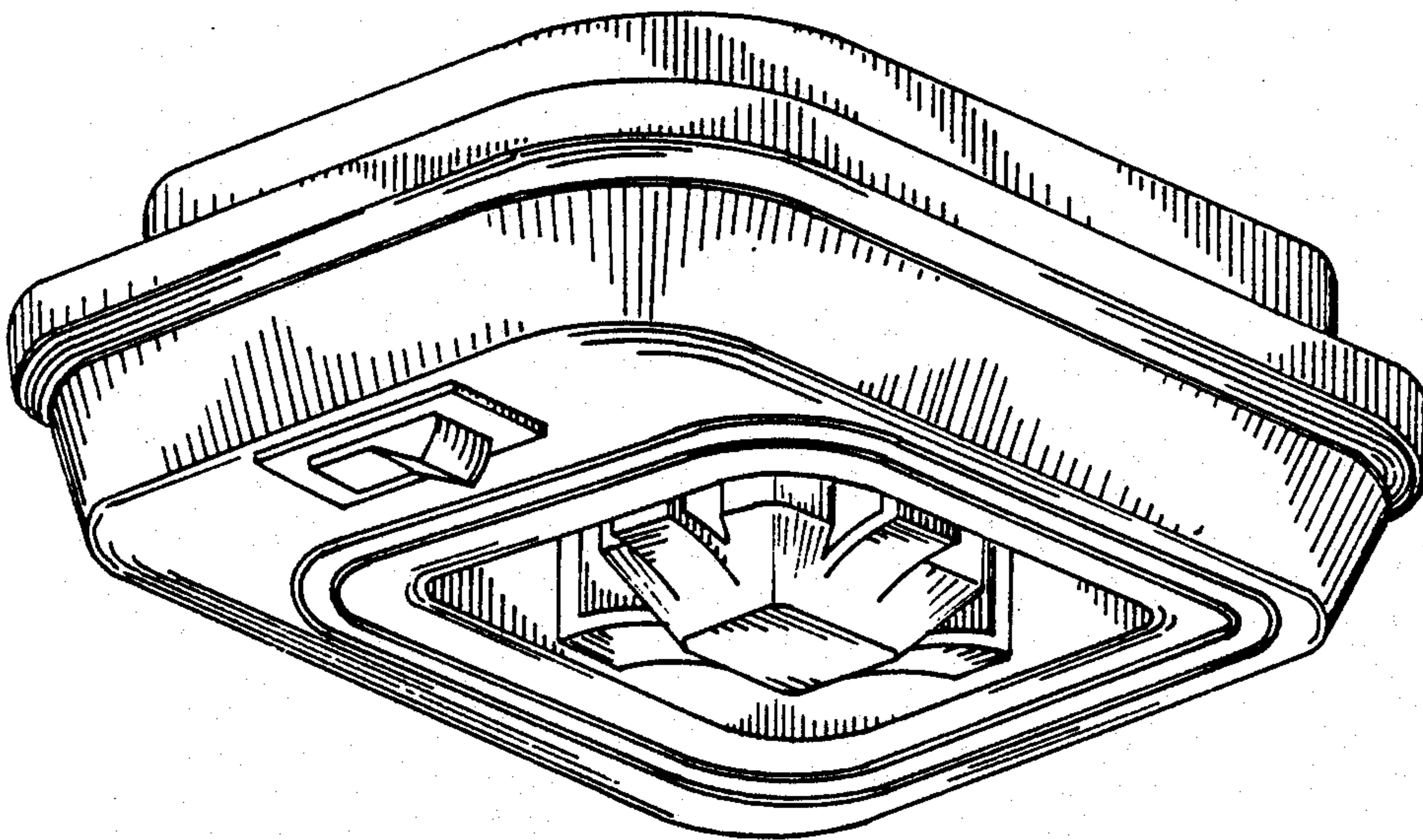
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.



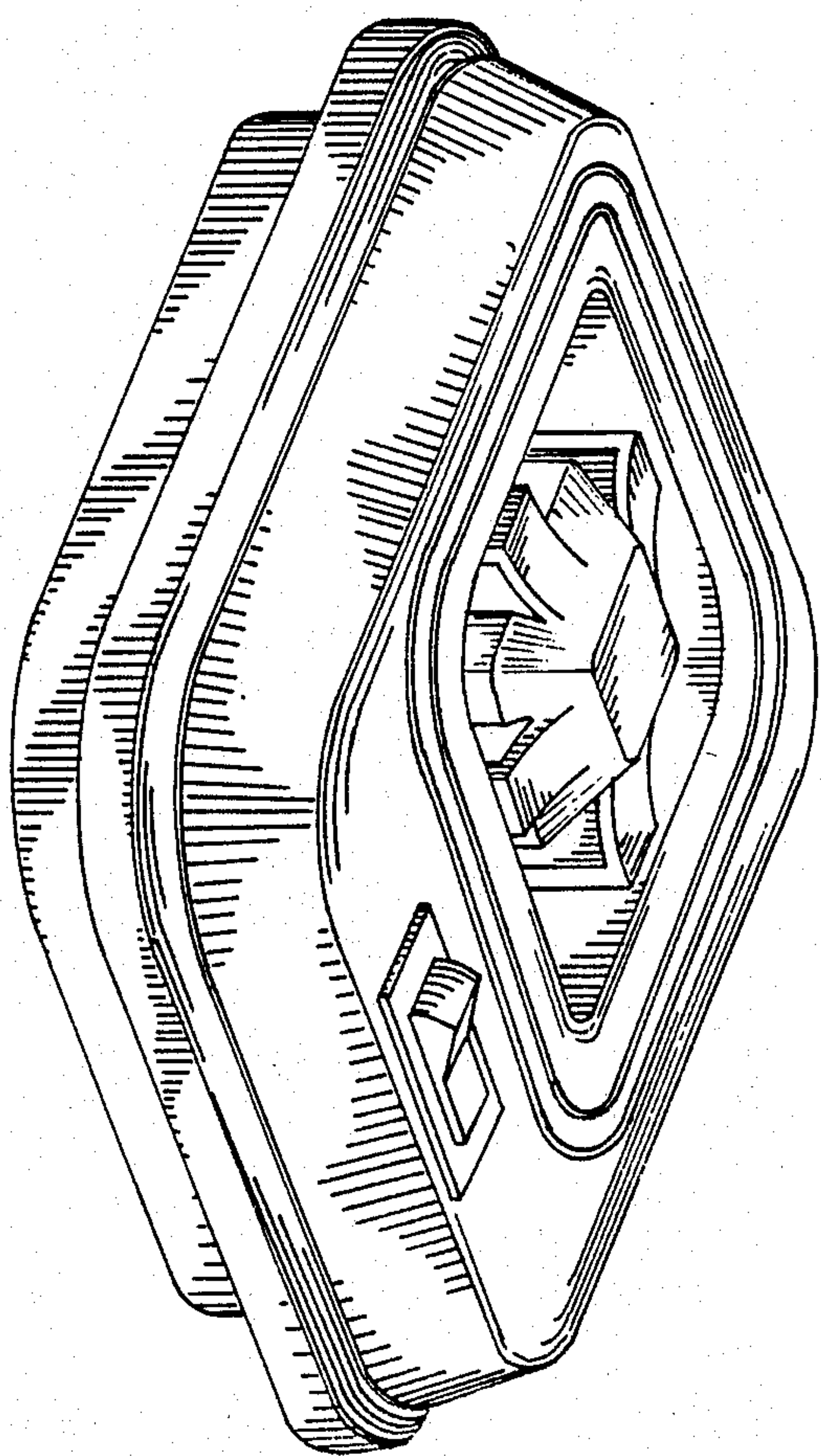

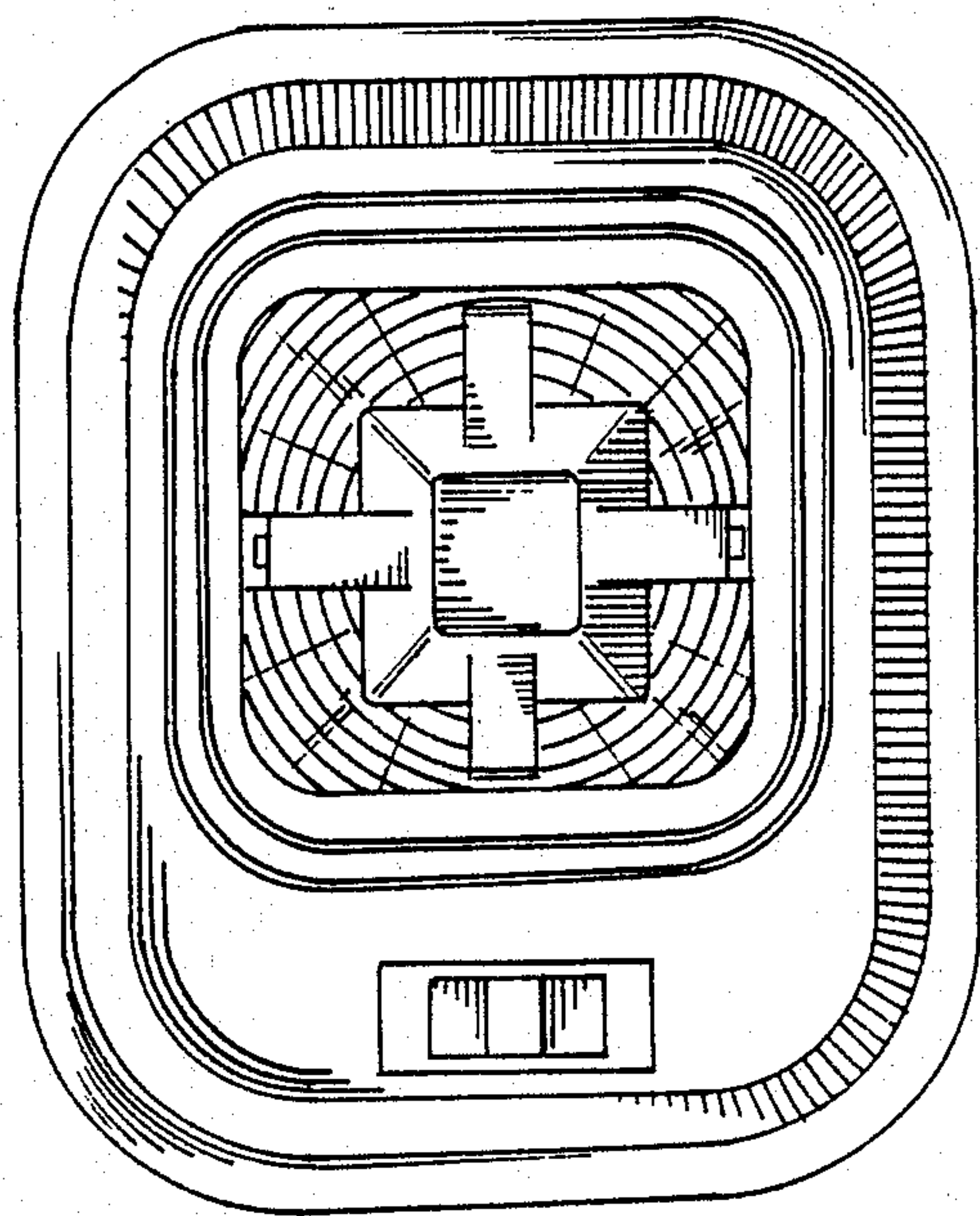

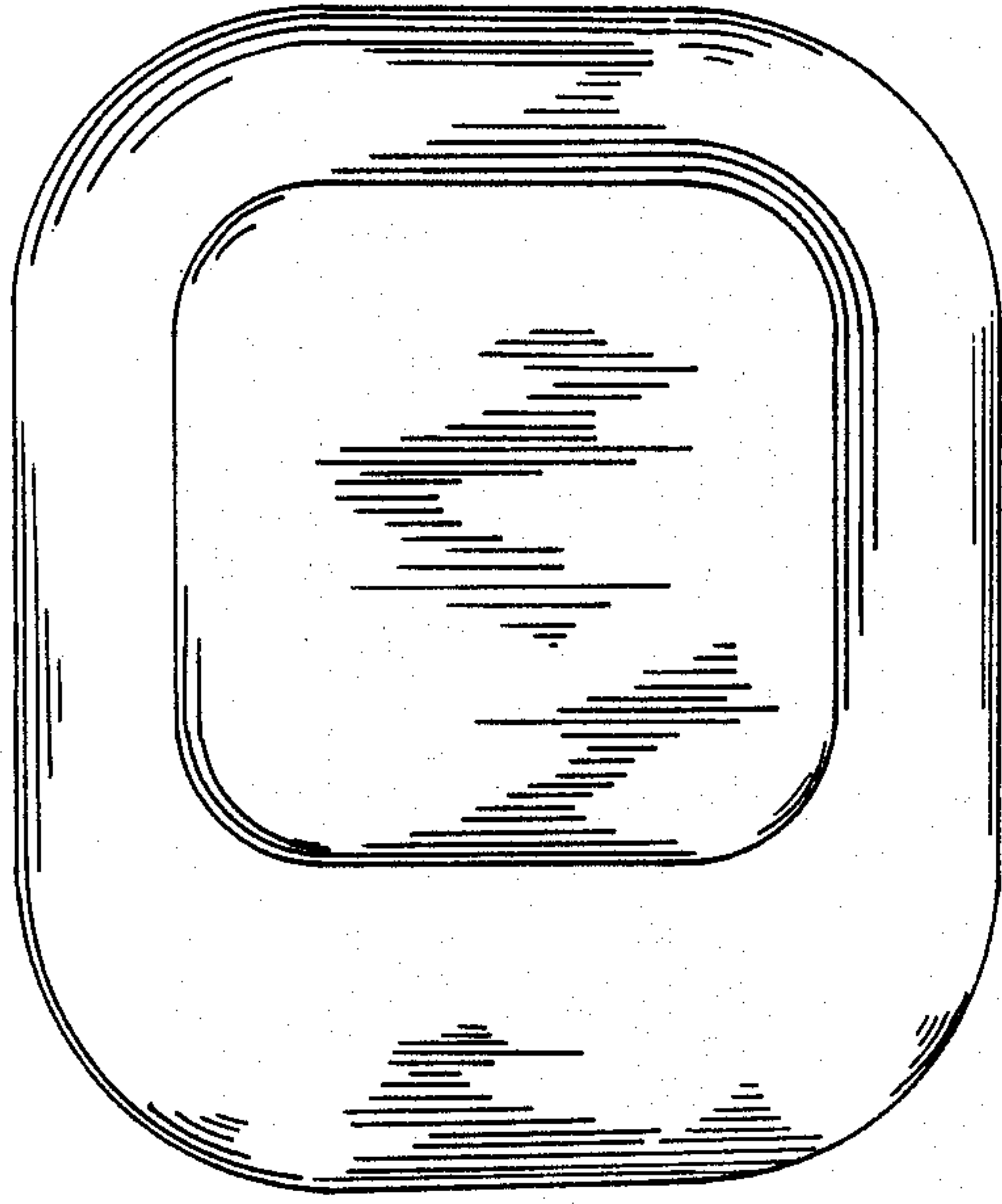

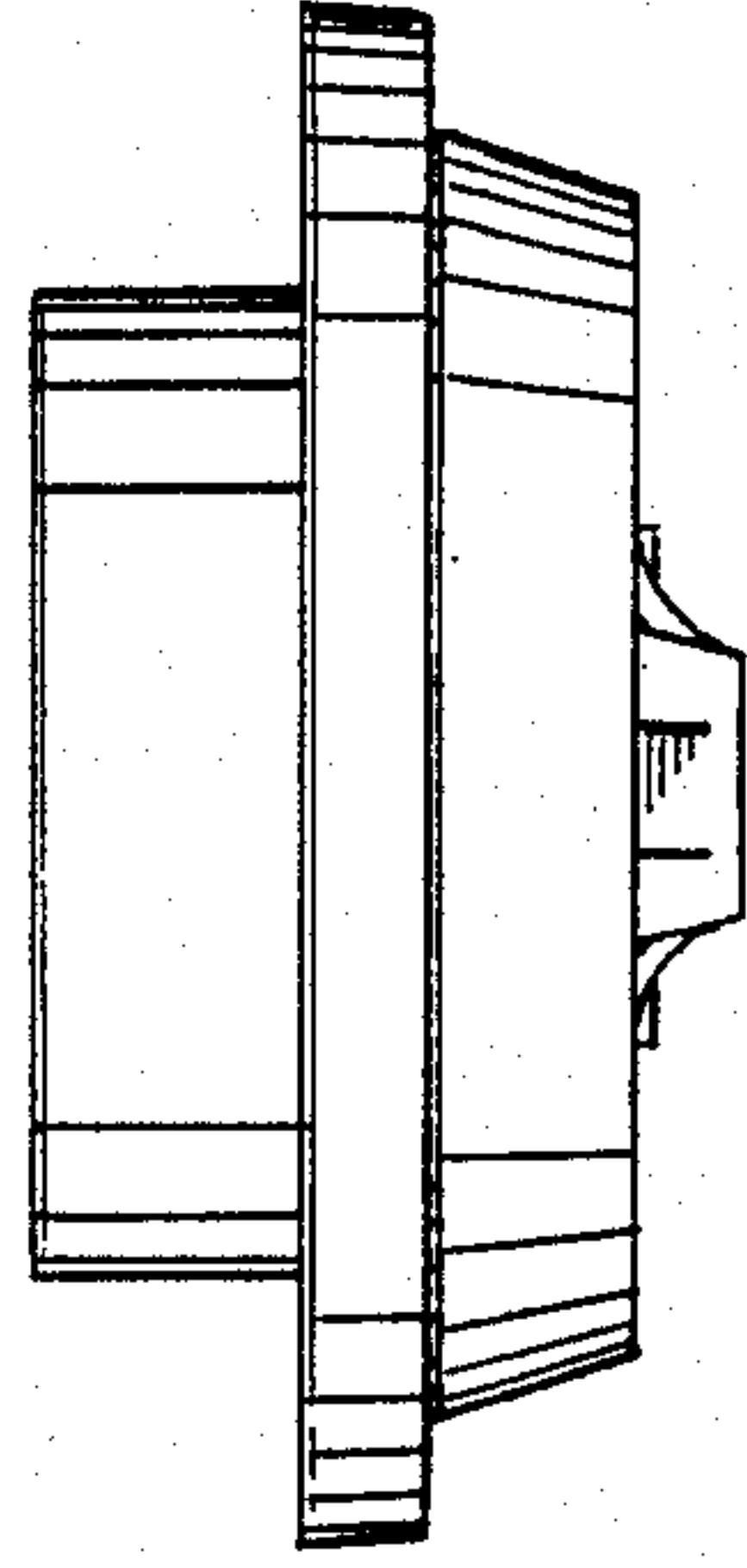

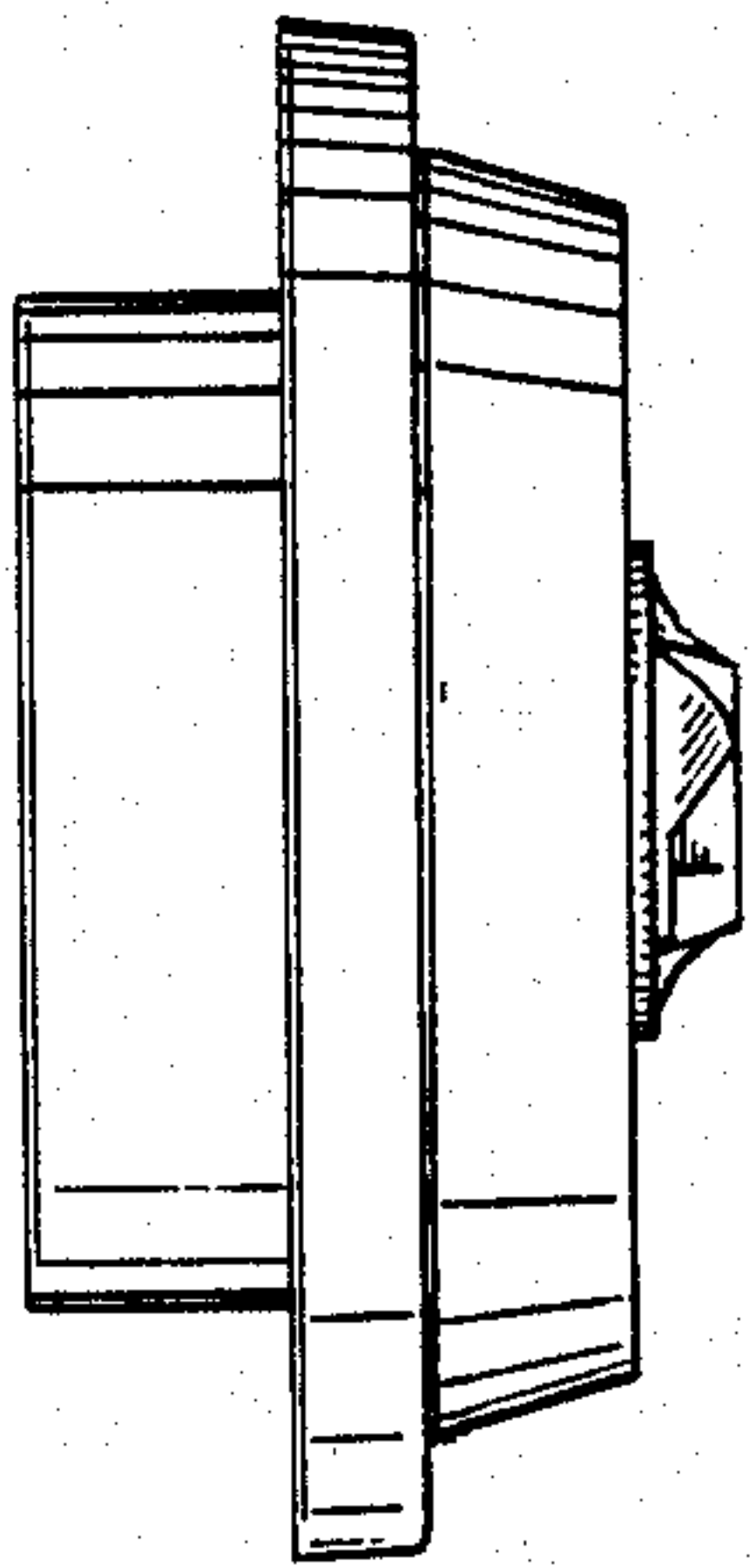

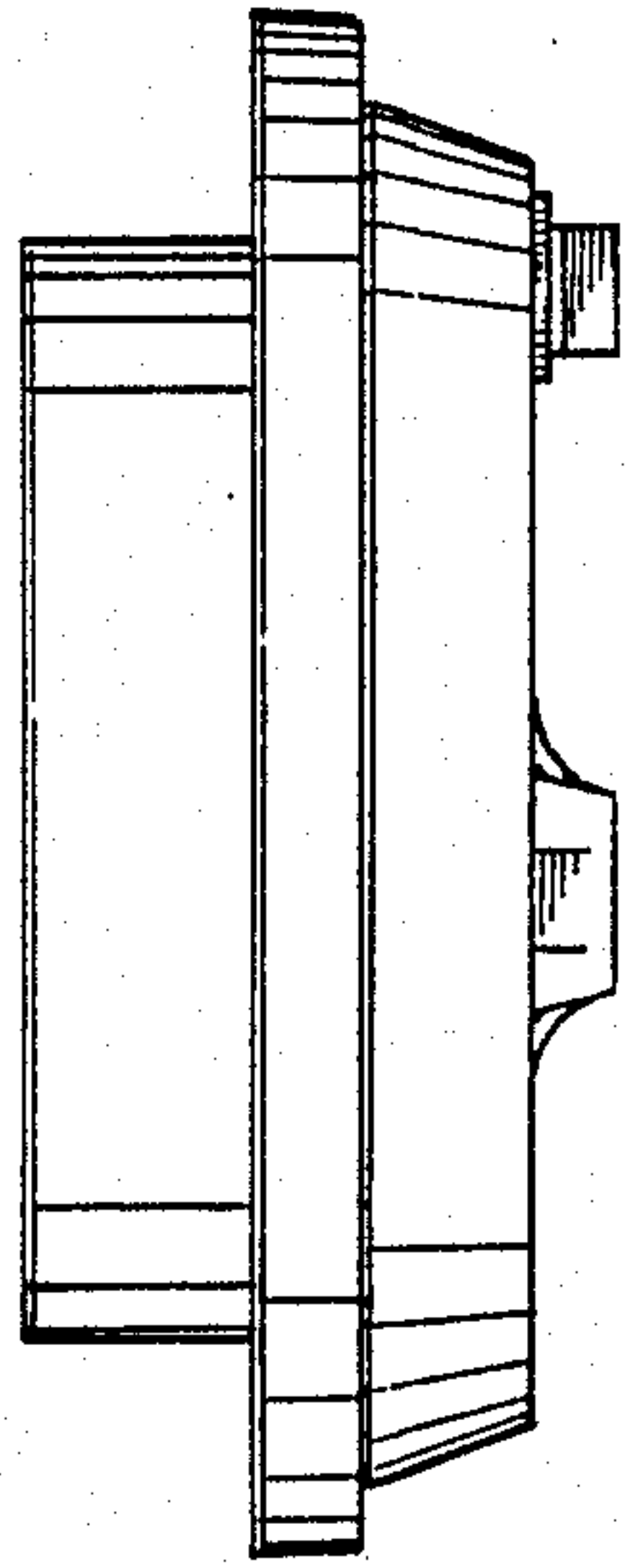
