DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a light bulb attachment for supporting scent releasing pebbles or the like showing my new design, the light bulb being shown in broken lines for illustration purposes only;

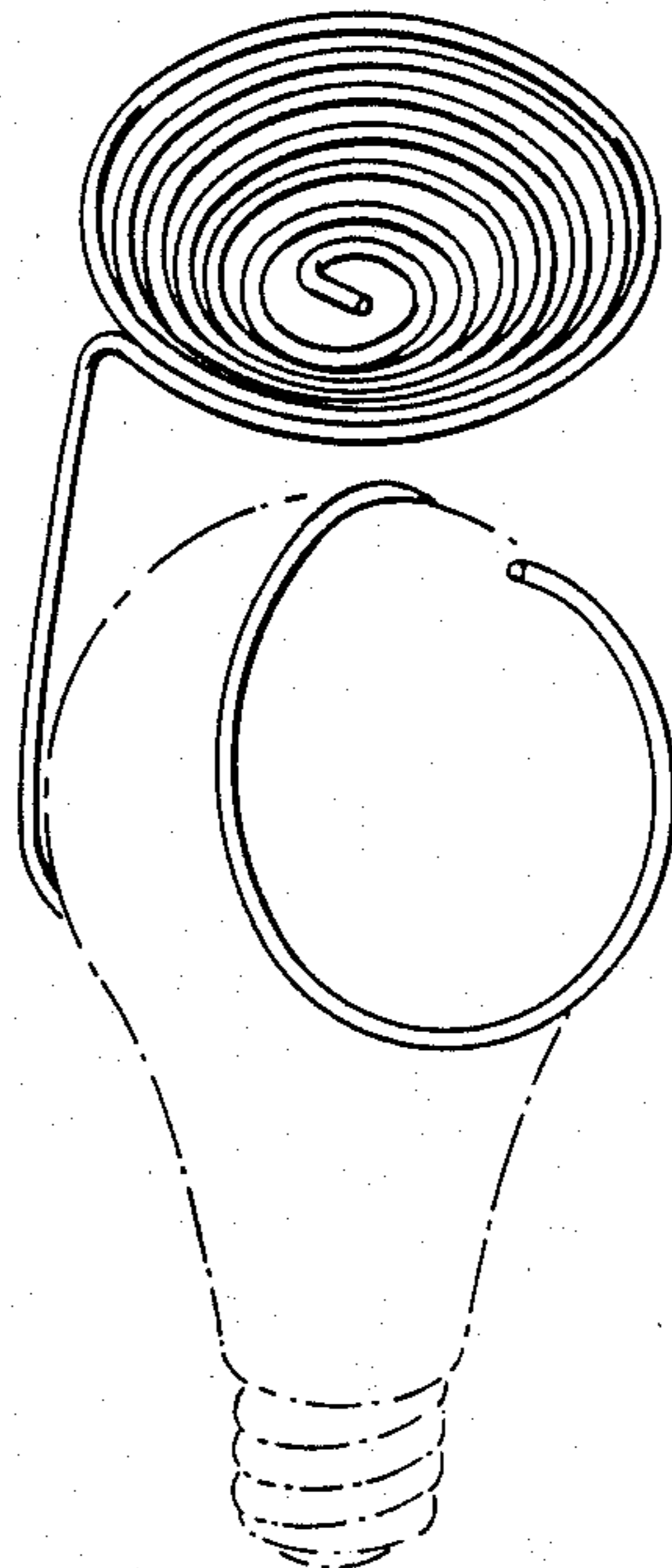
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale.



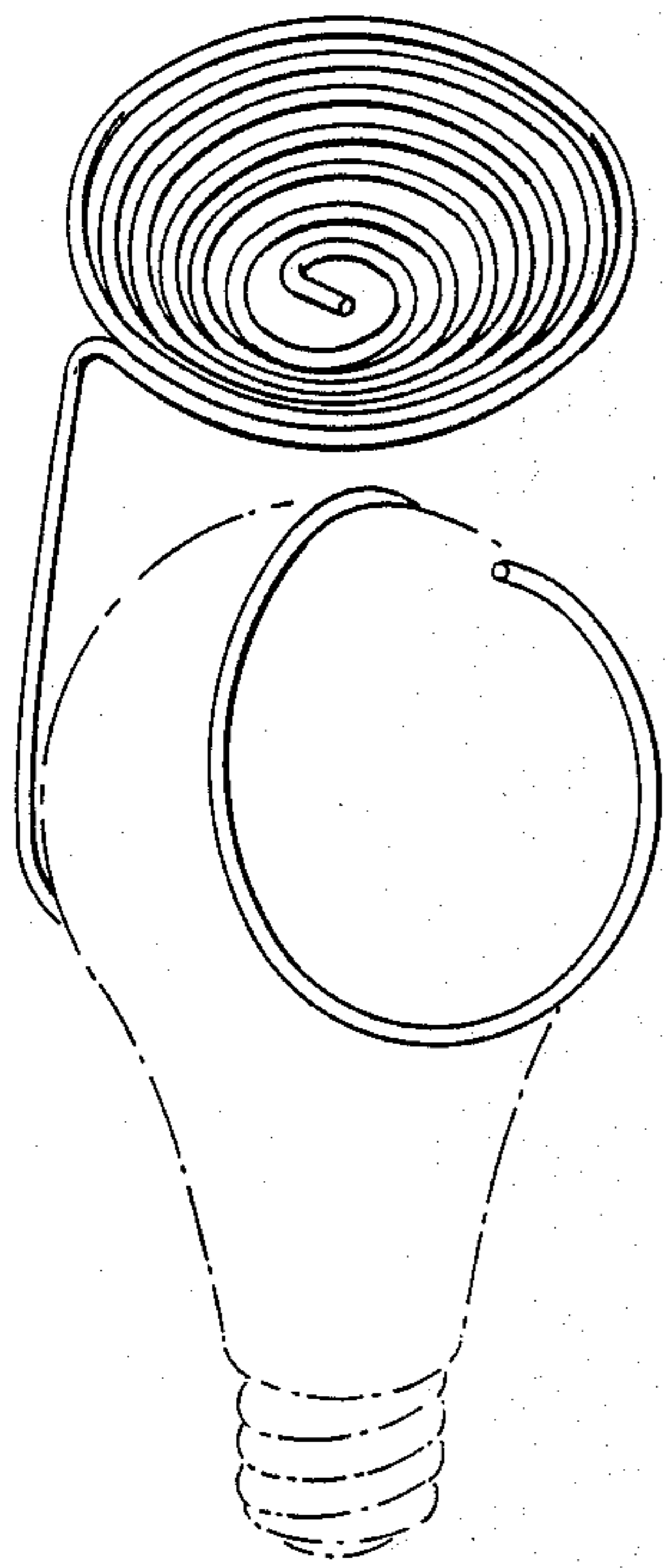

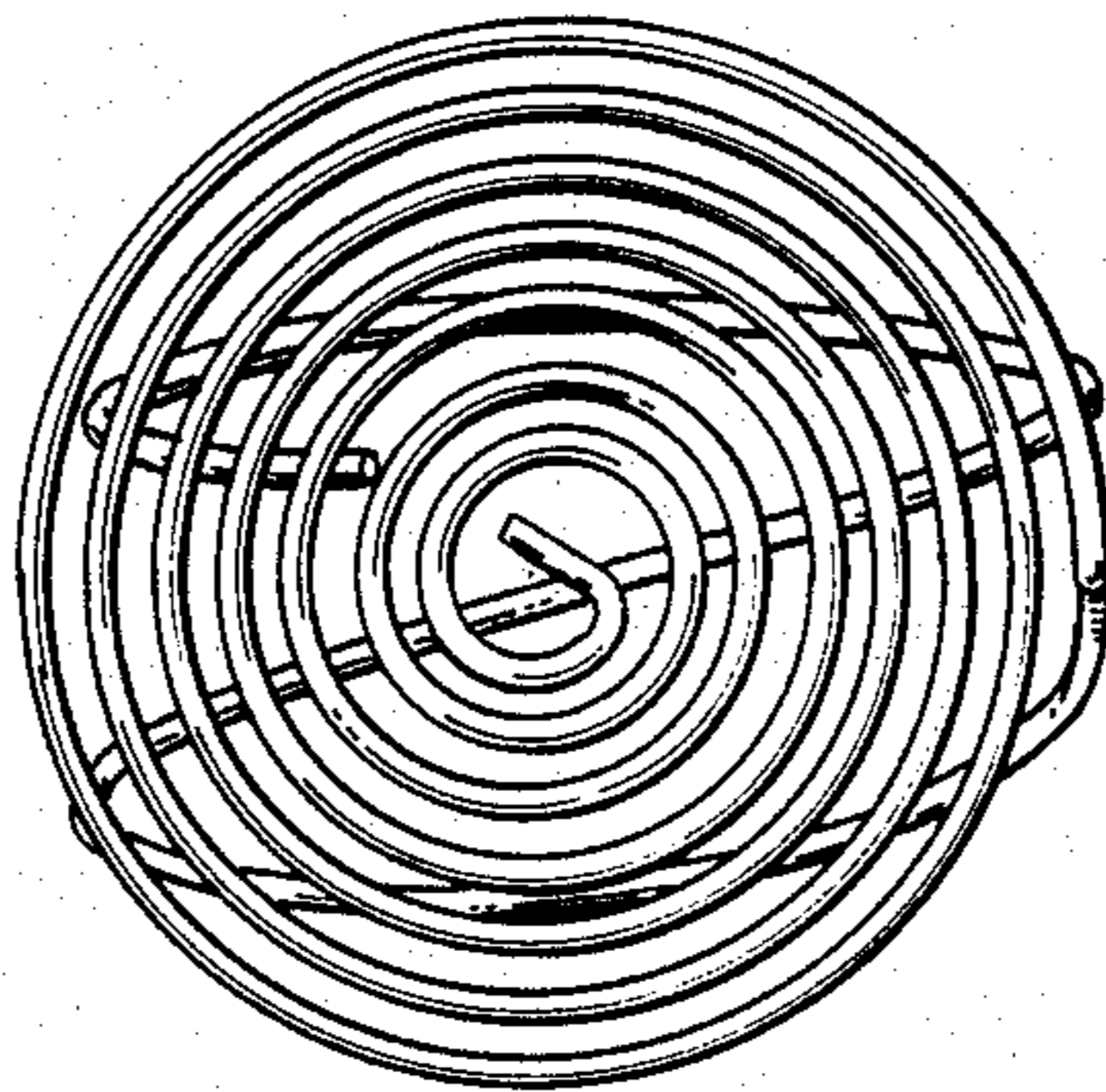

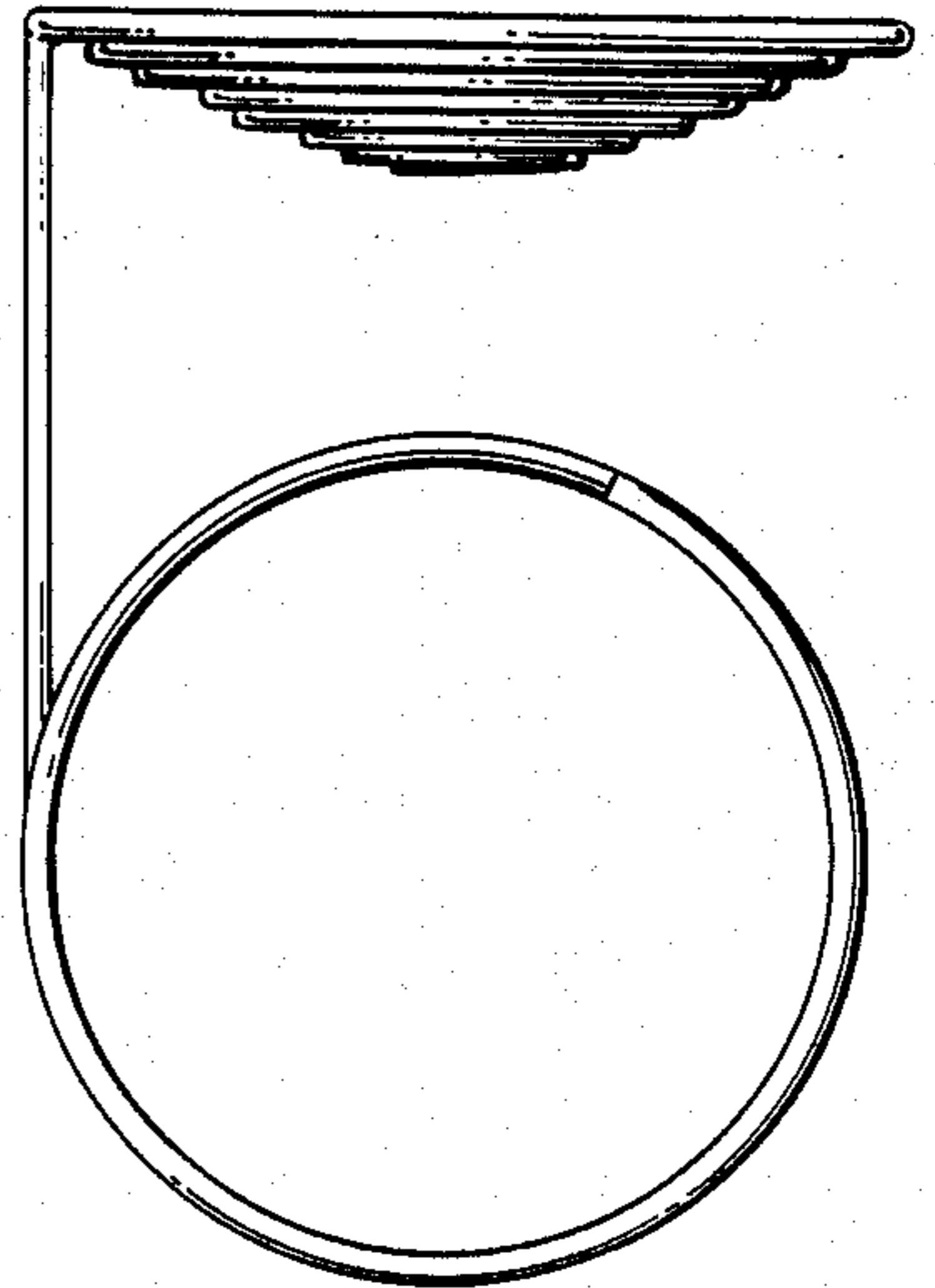

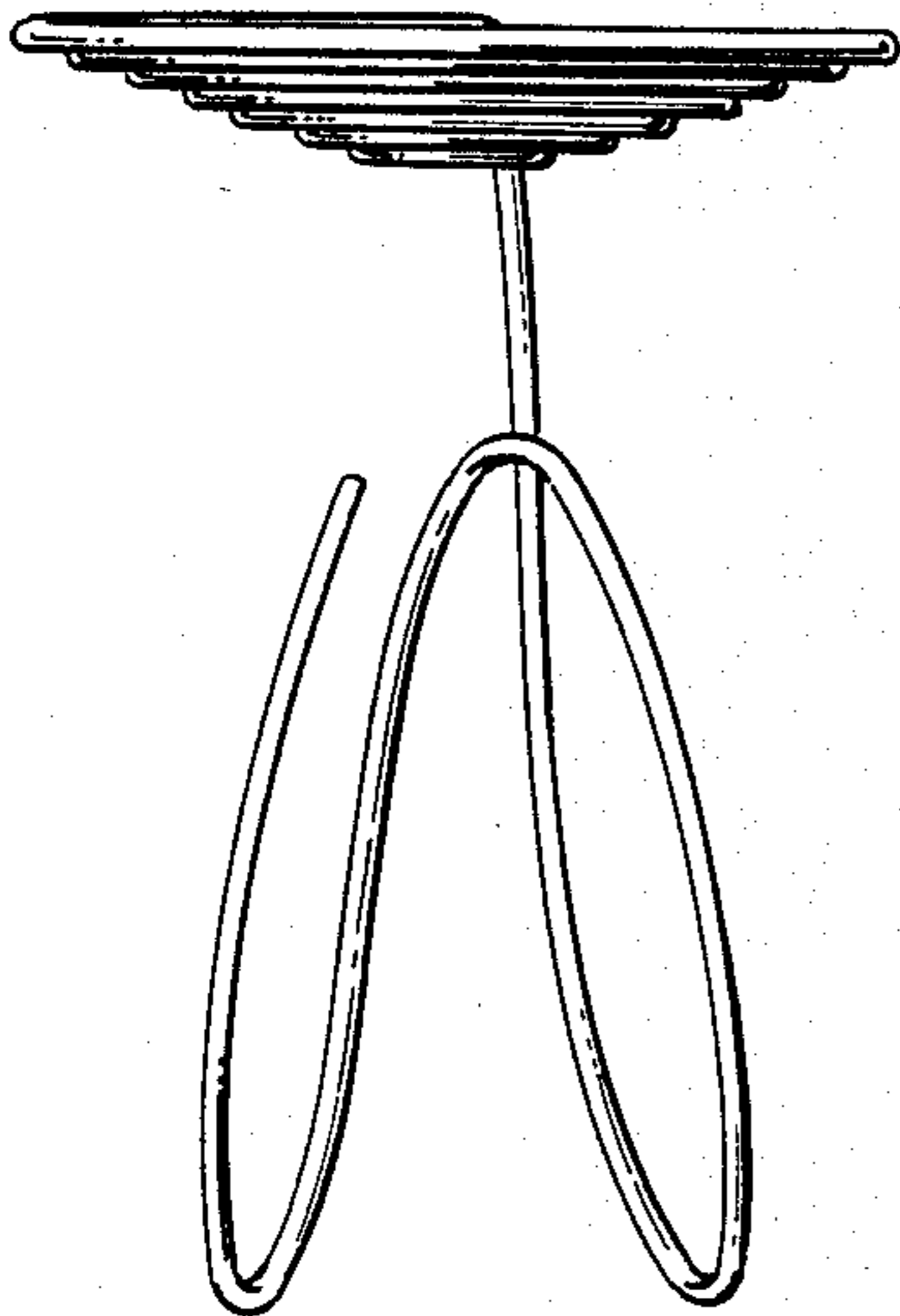

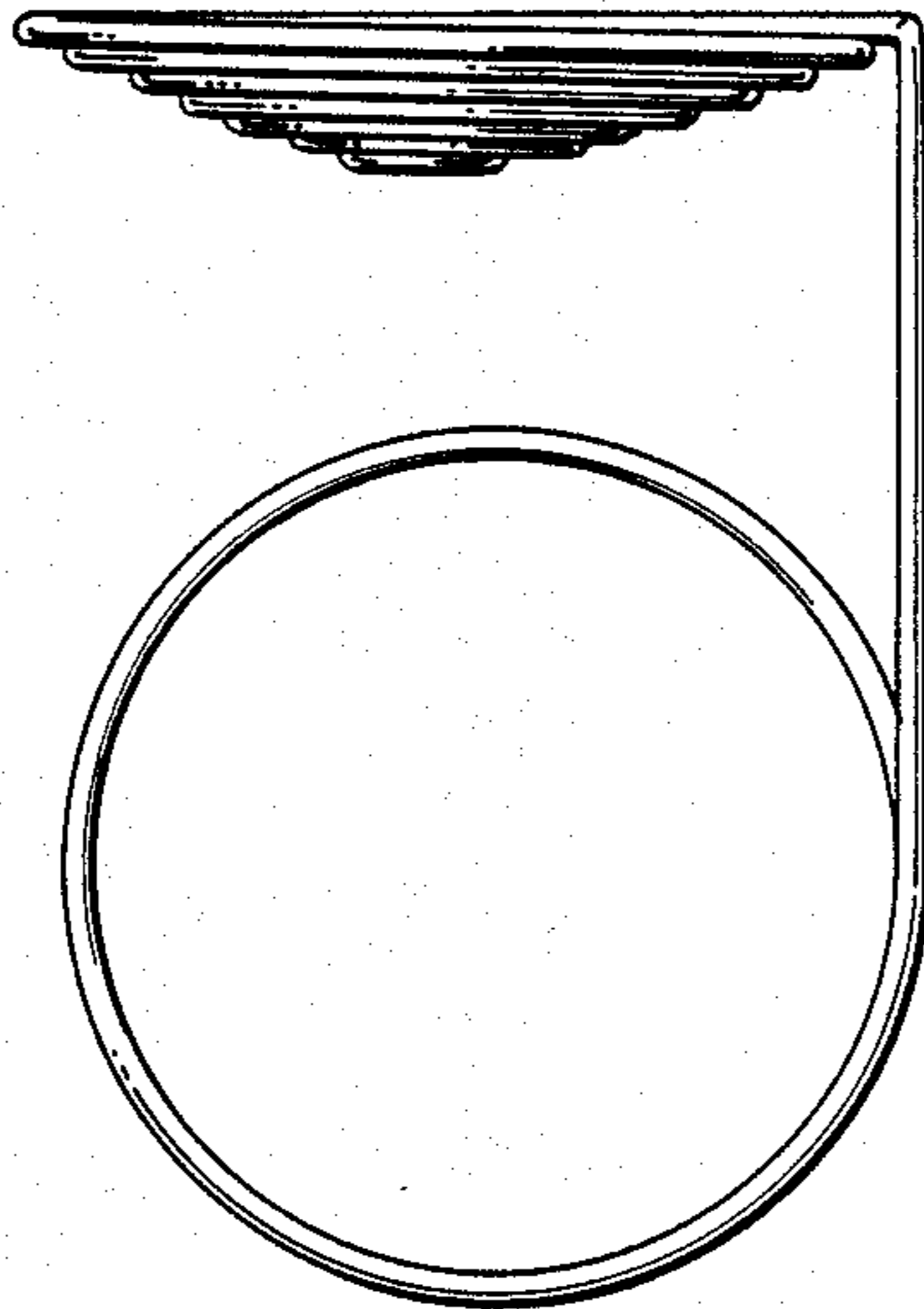

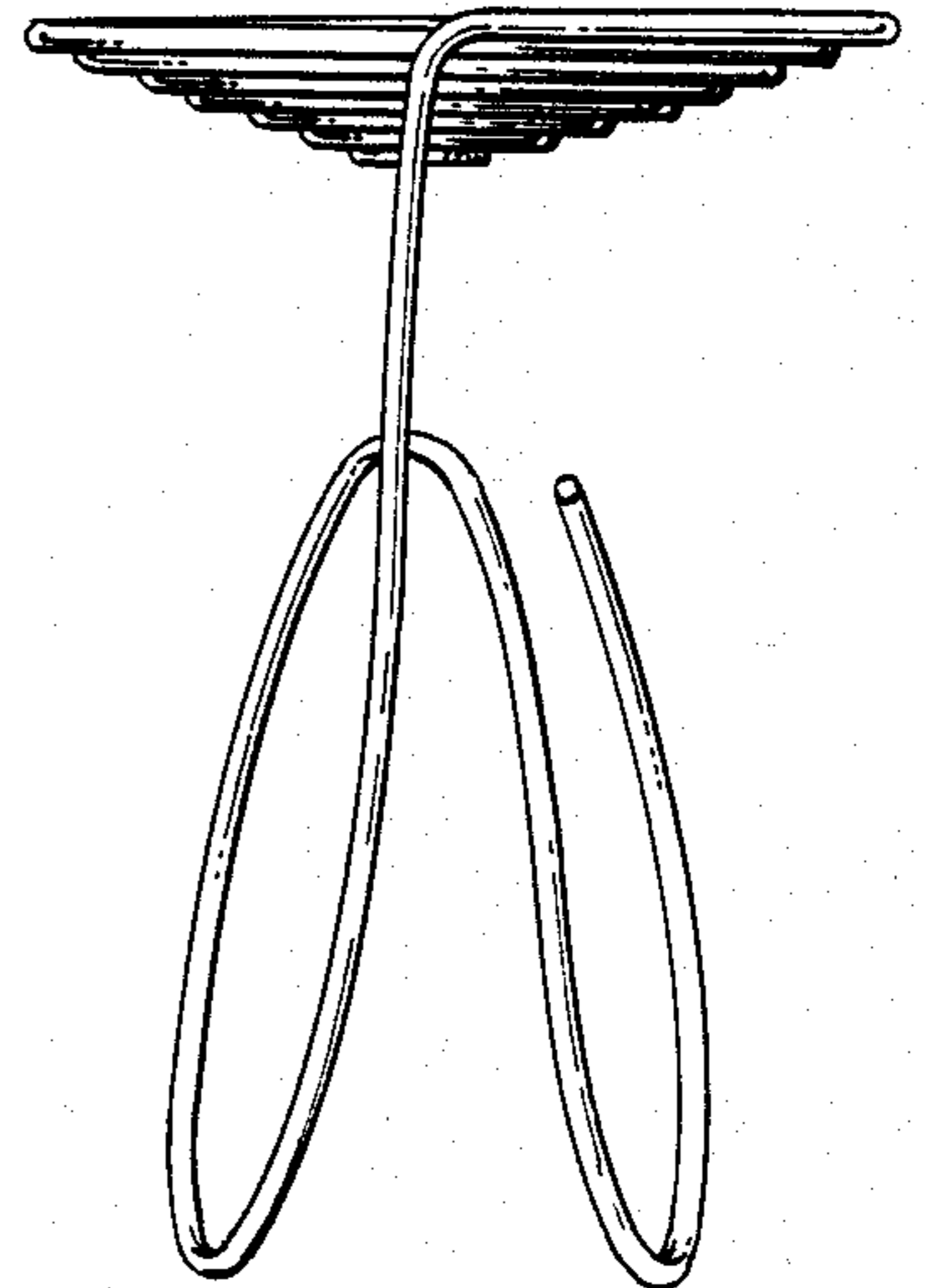
