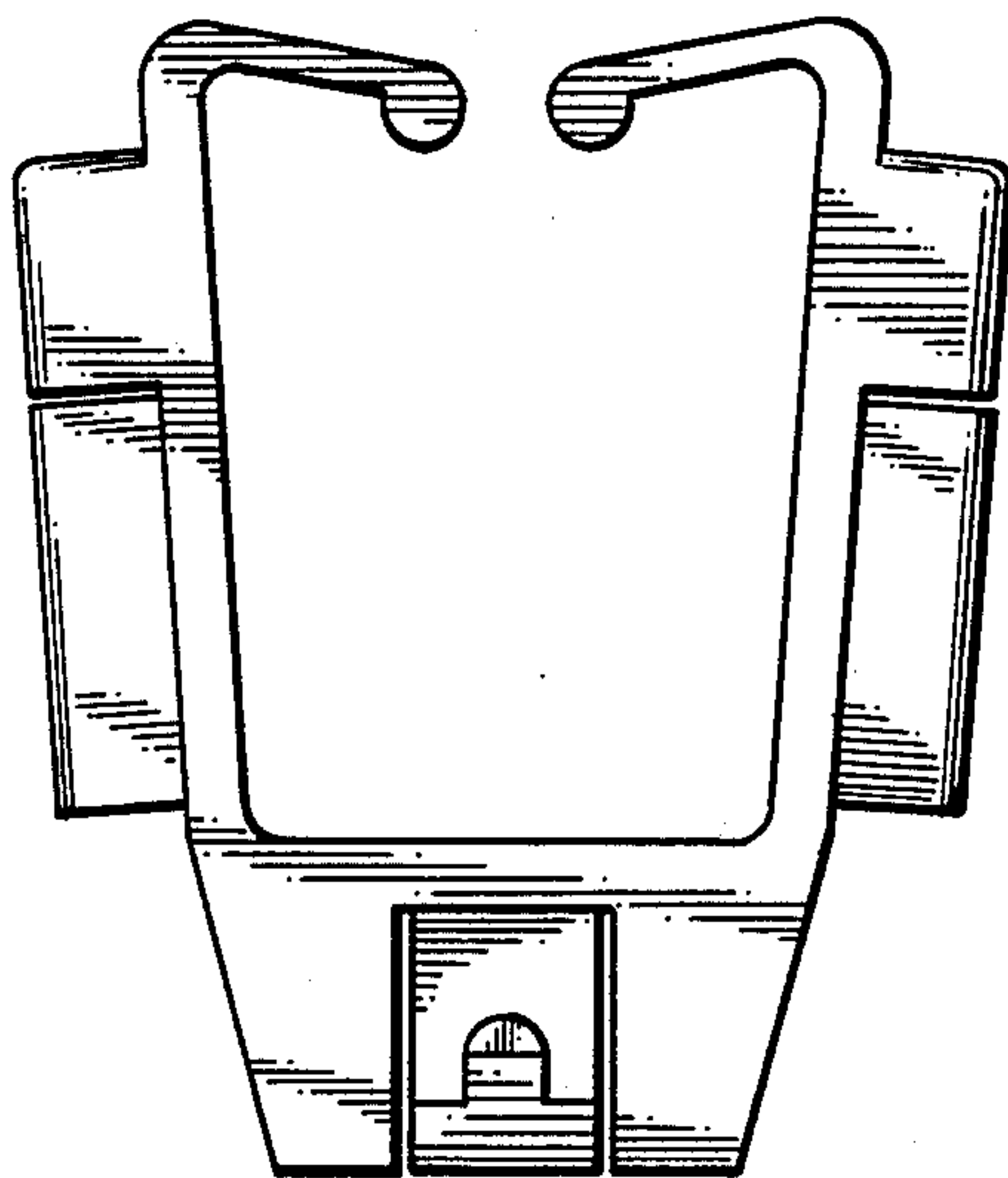

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a grommet for
electrical wires showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left

views thereof.



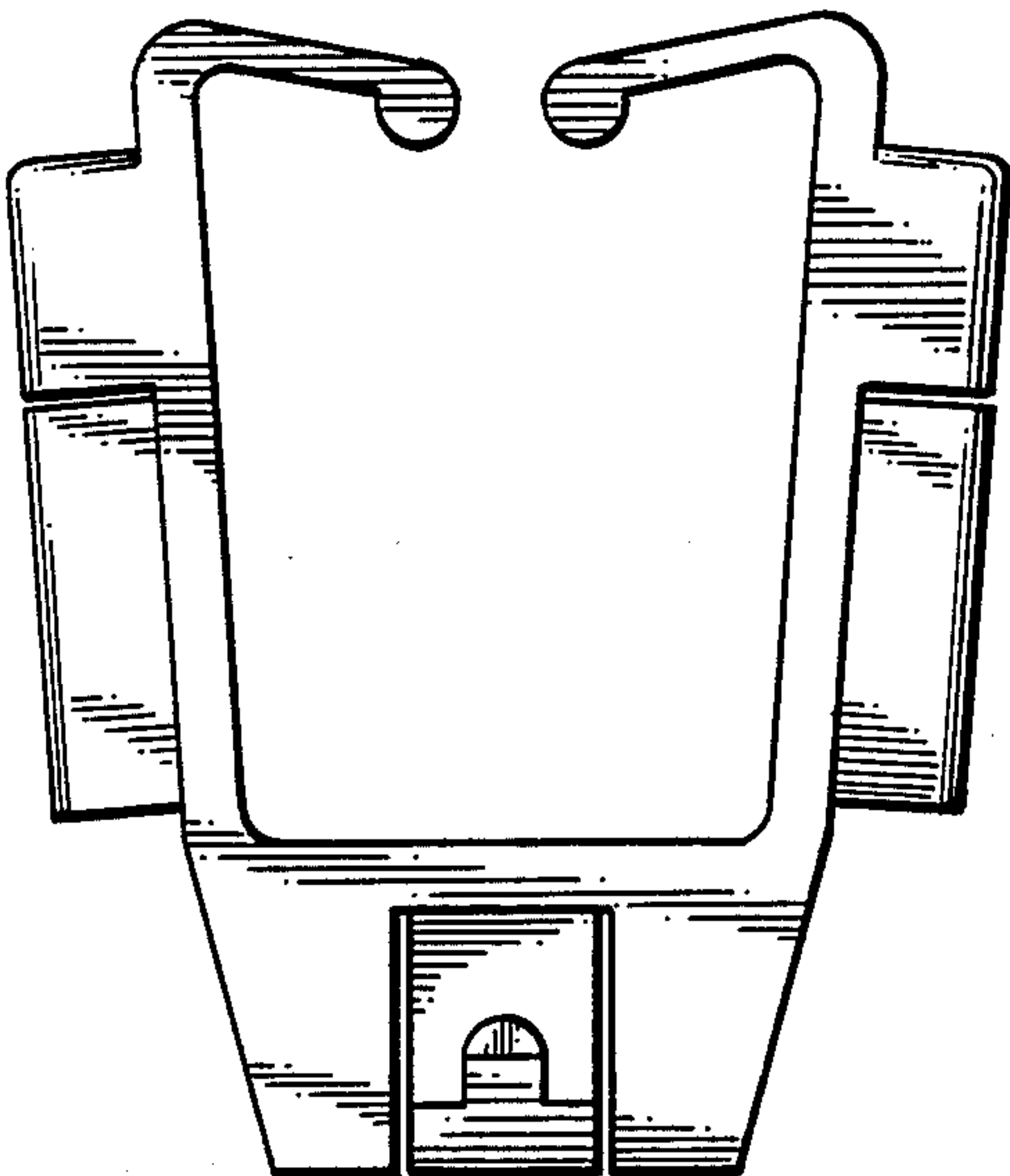

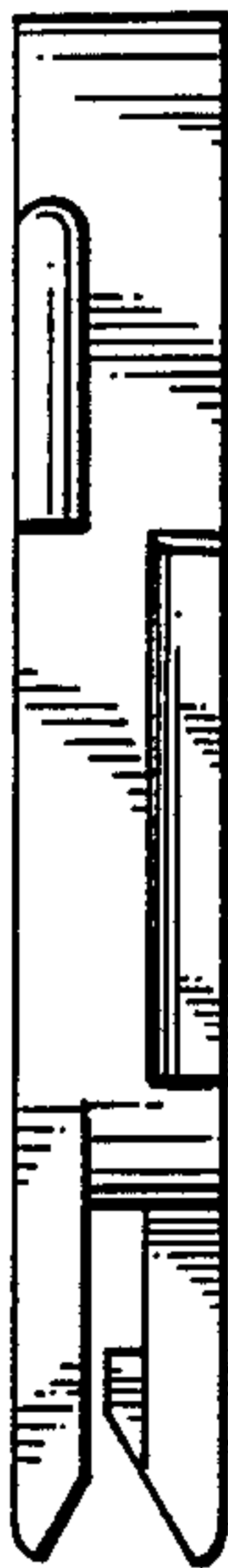

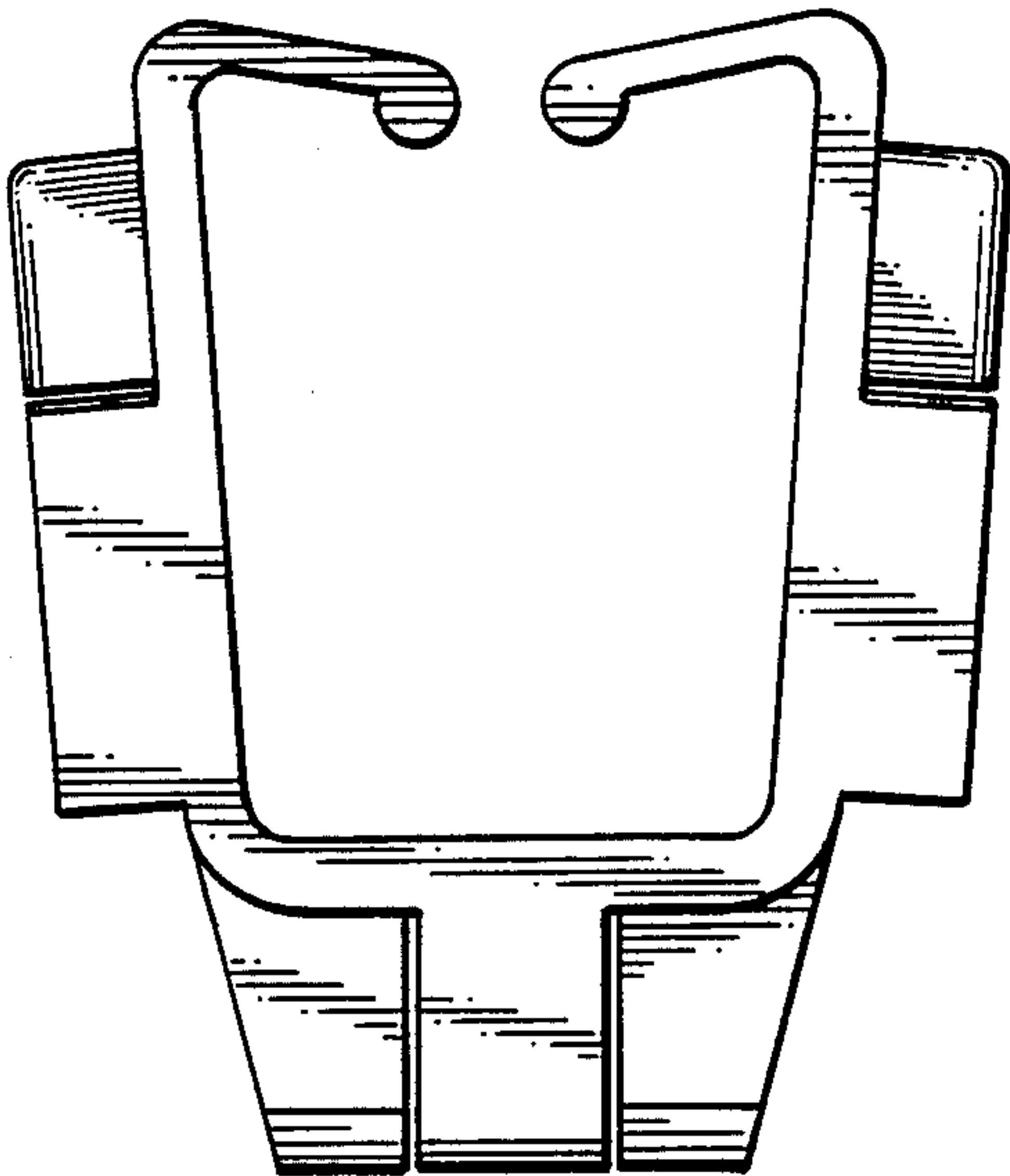

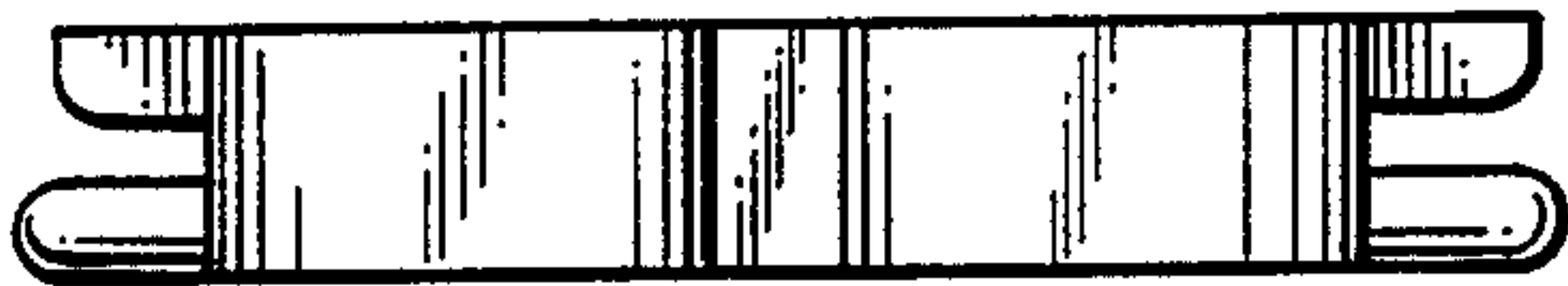
