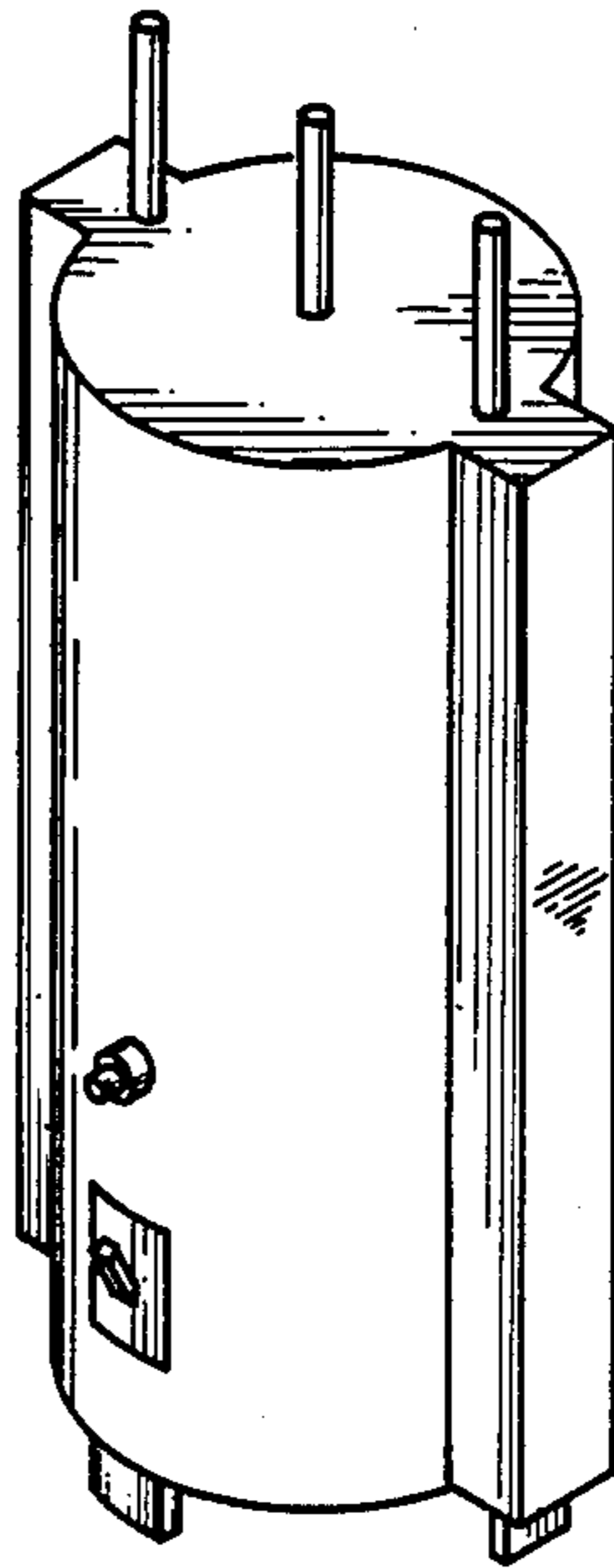

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of that shown.



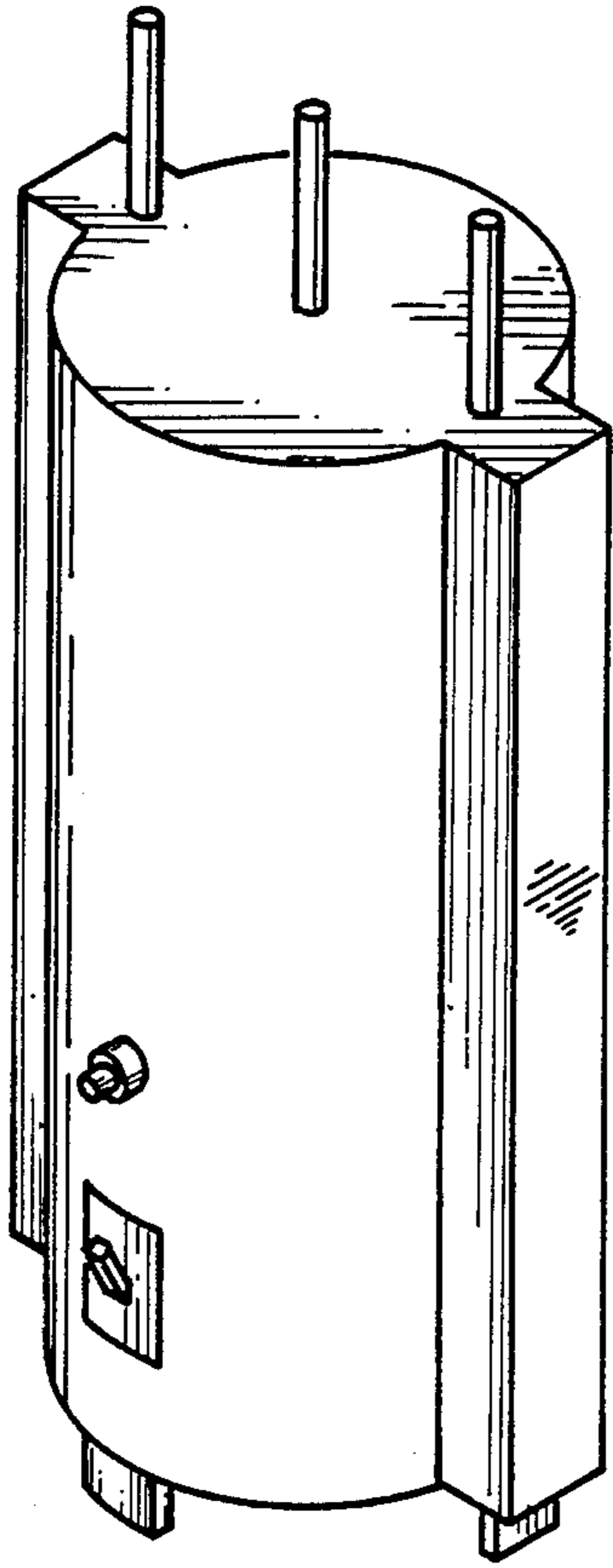

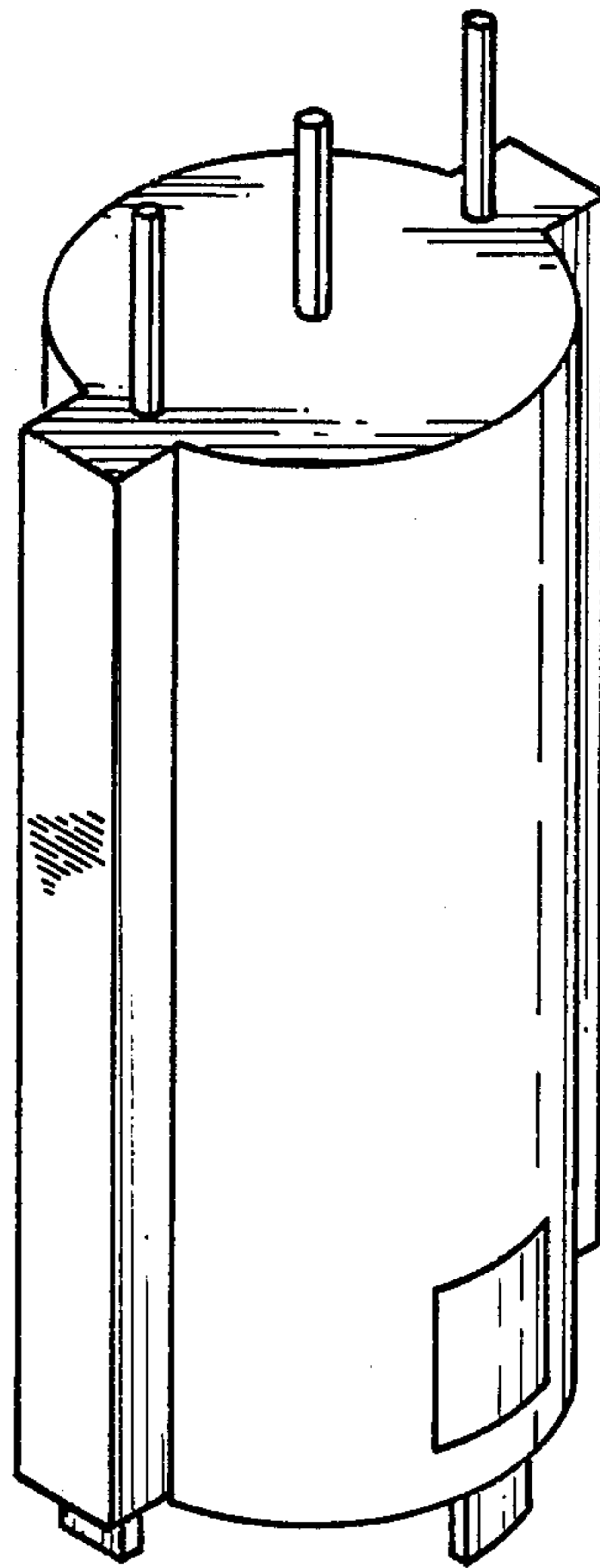

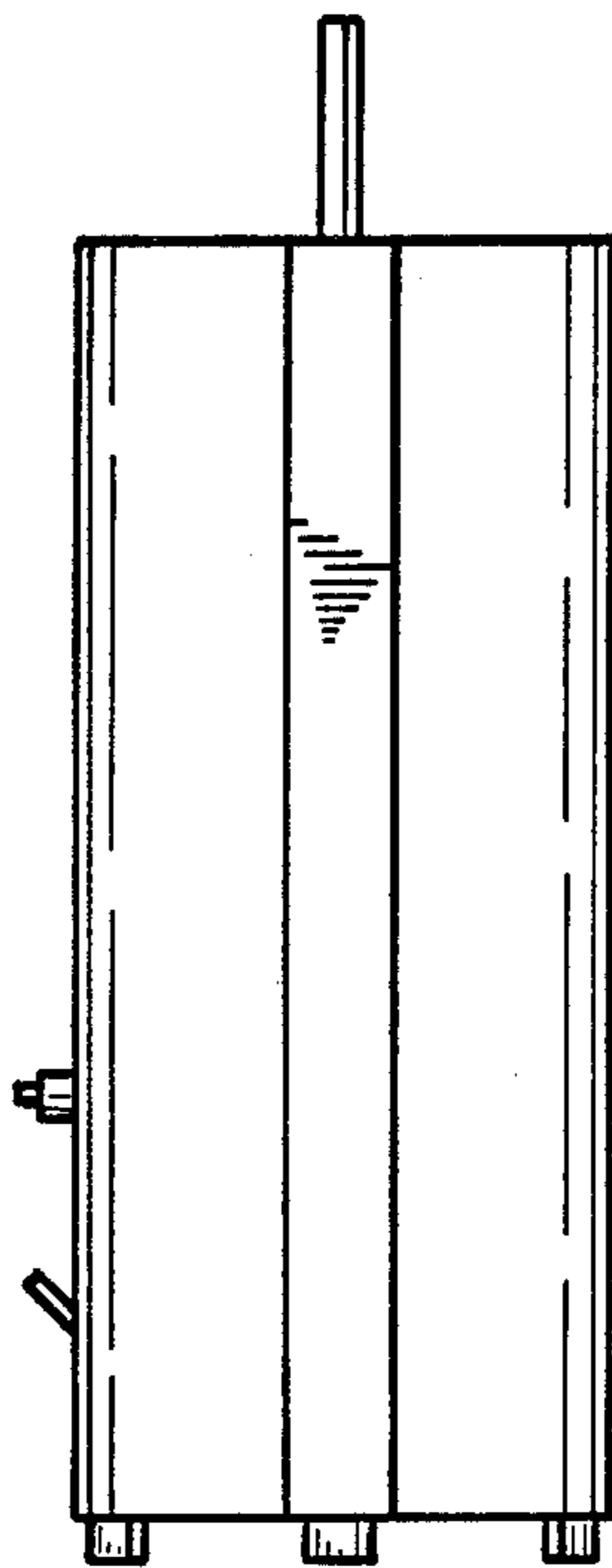
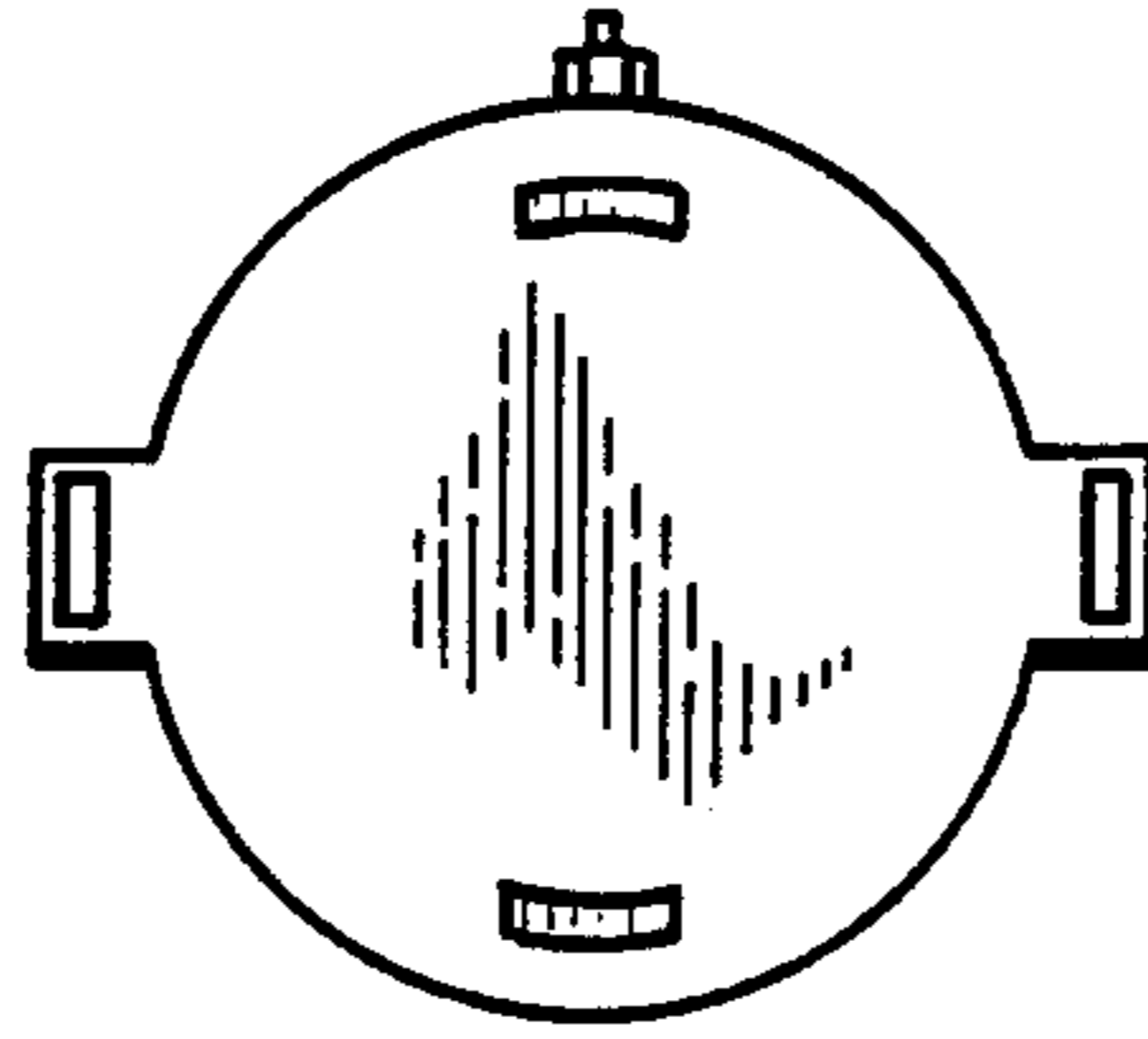
