FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof.

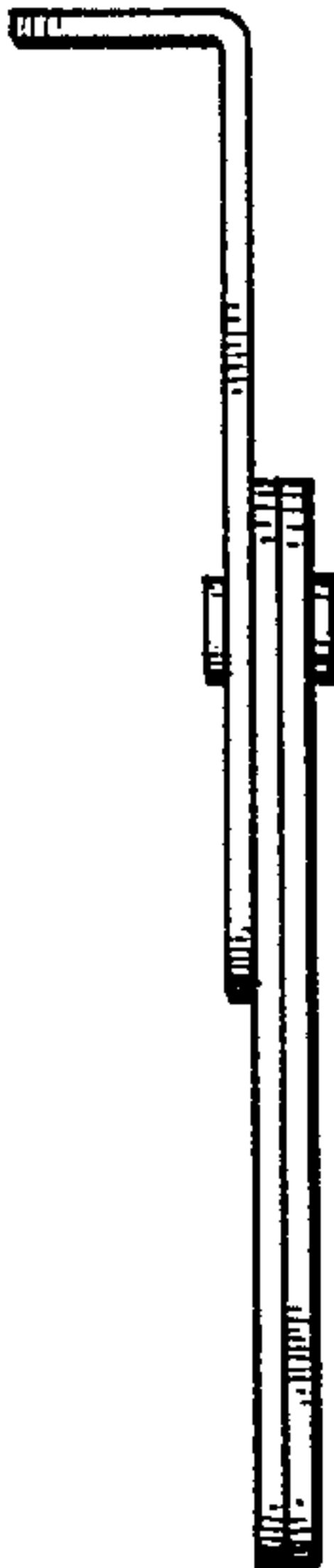
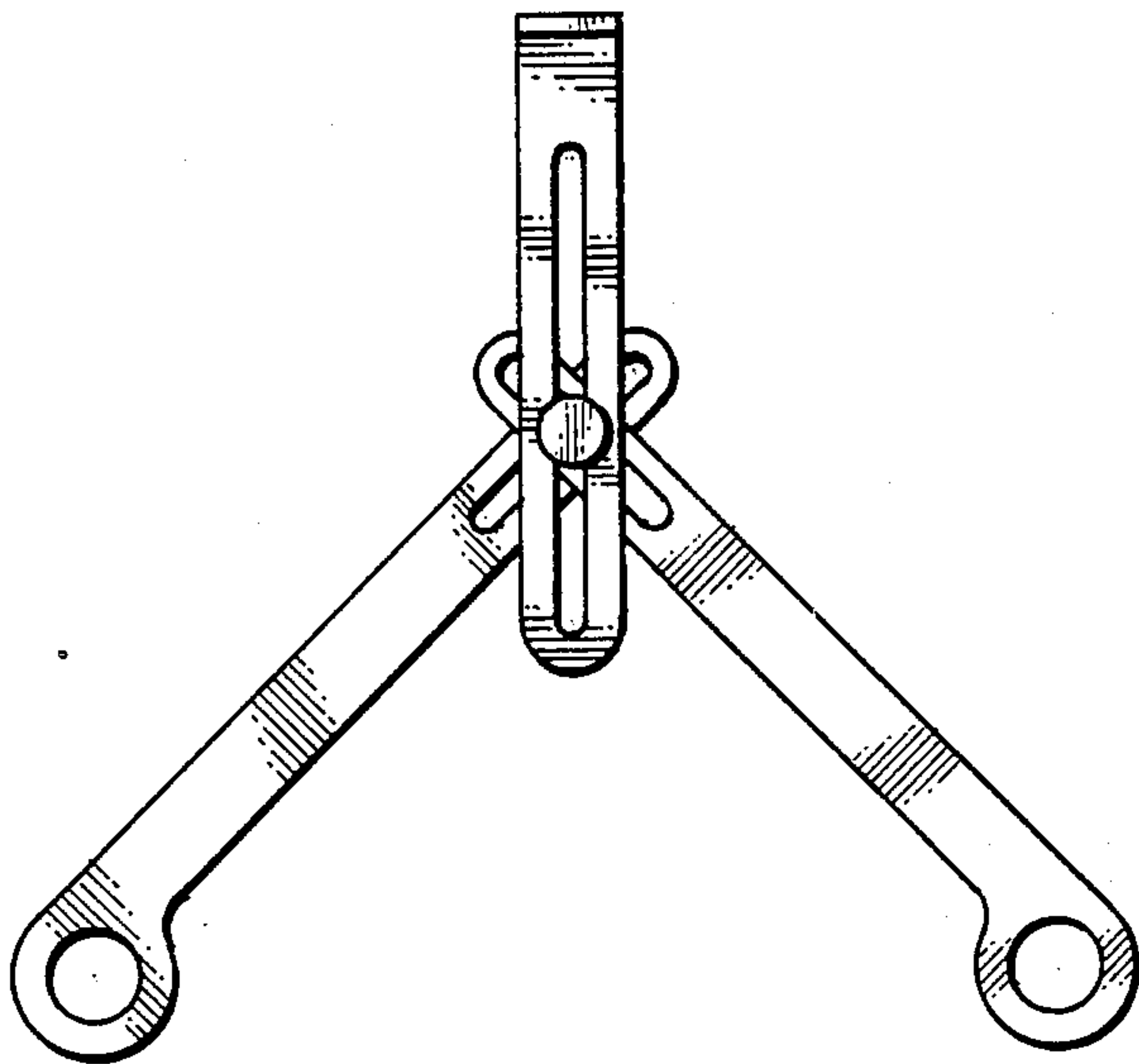

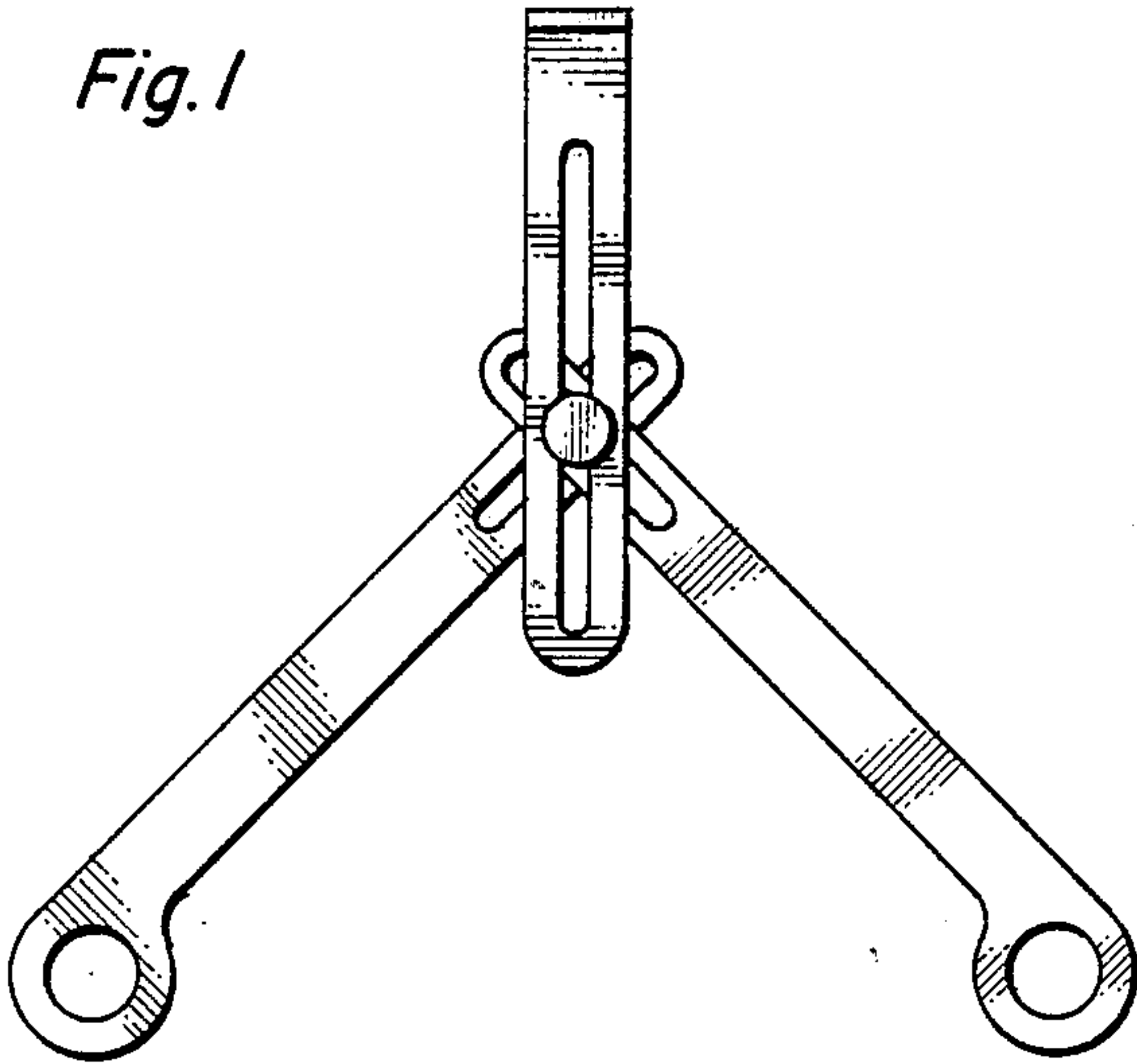

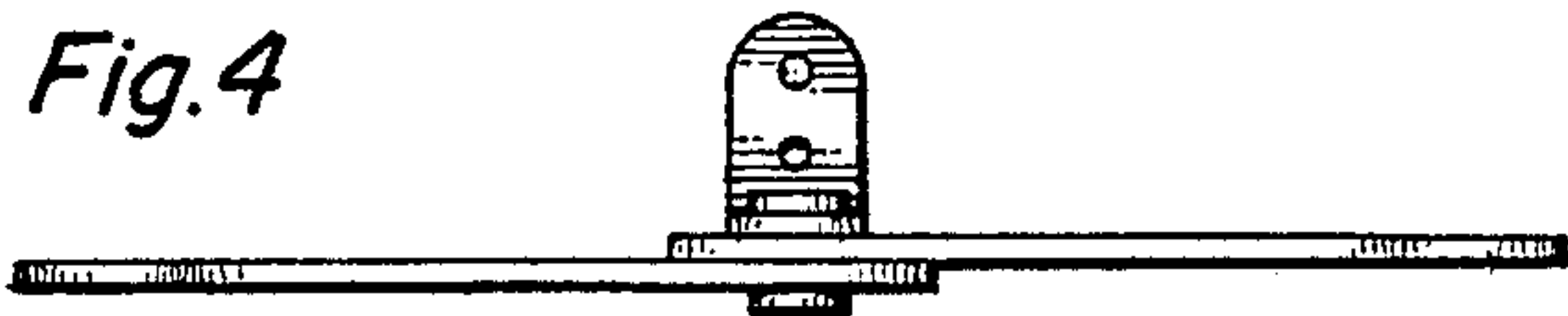
