The ornamental design for a cabinet for a fireplace simulation burner unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cabinet for a fireplace simulation burner unit showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image of that shown.

The broken line showing of the internal elements is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

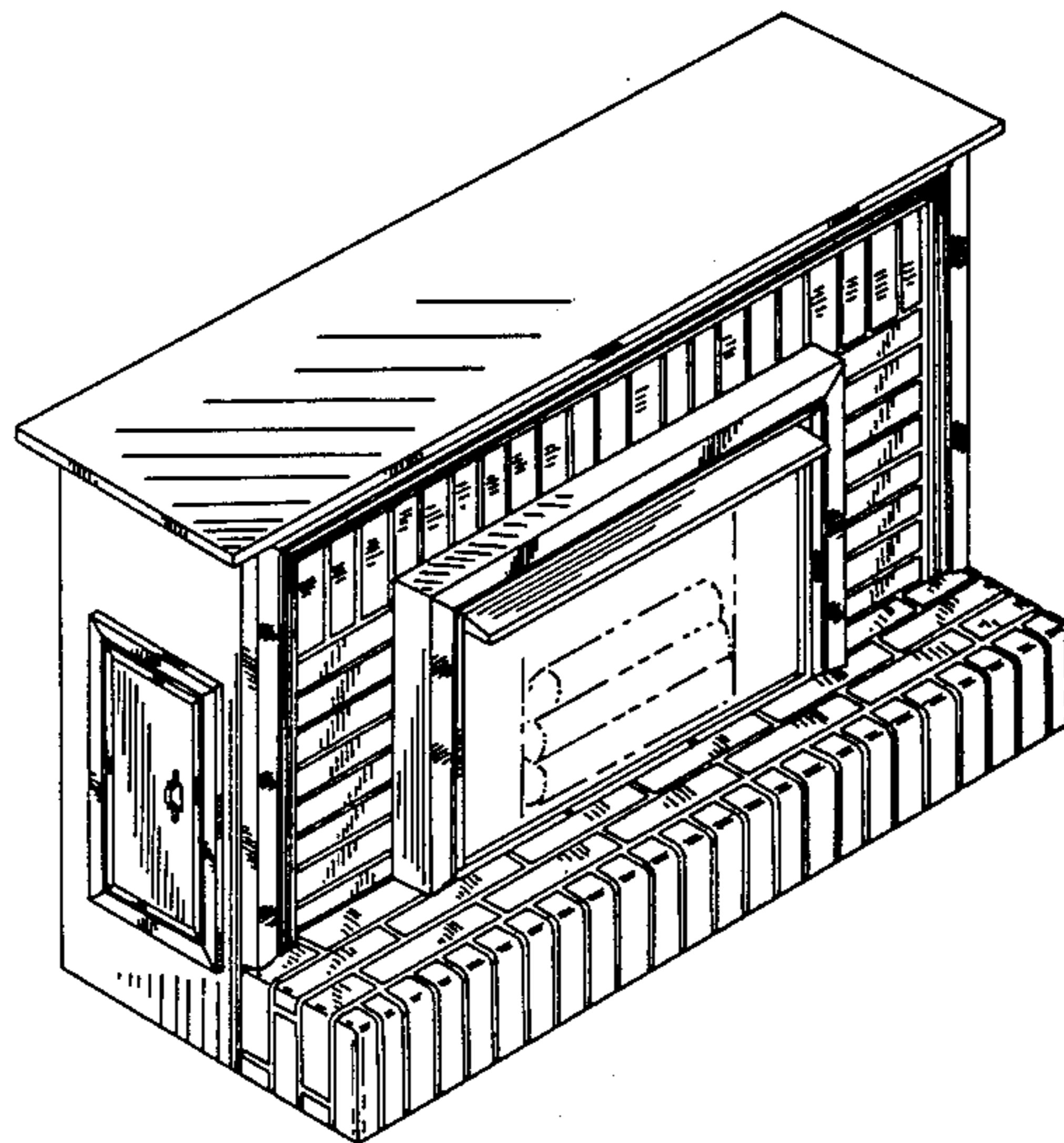

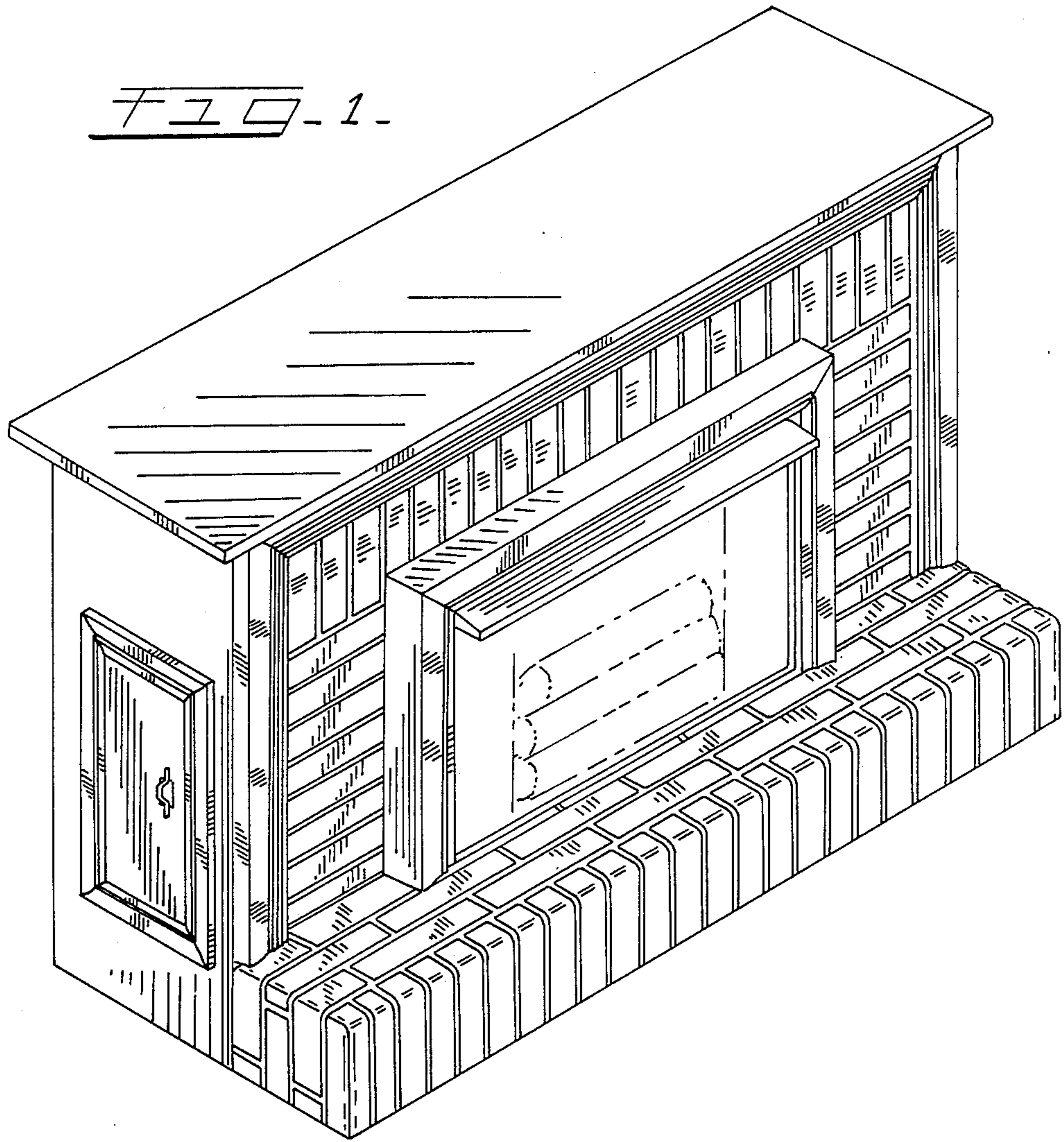

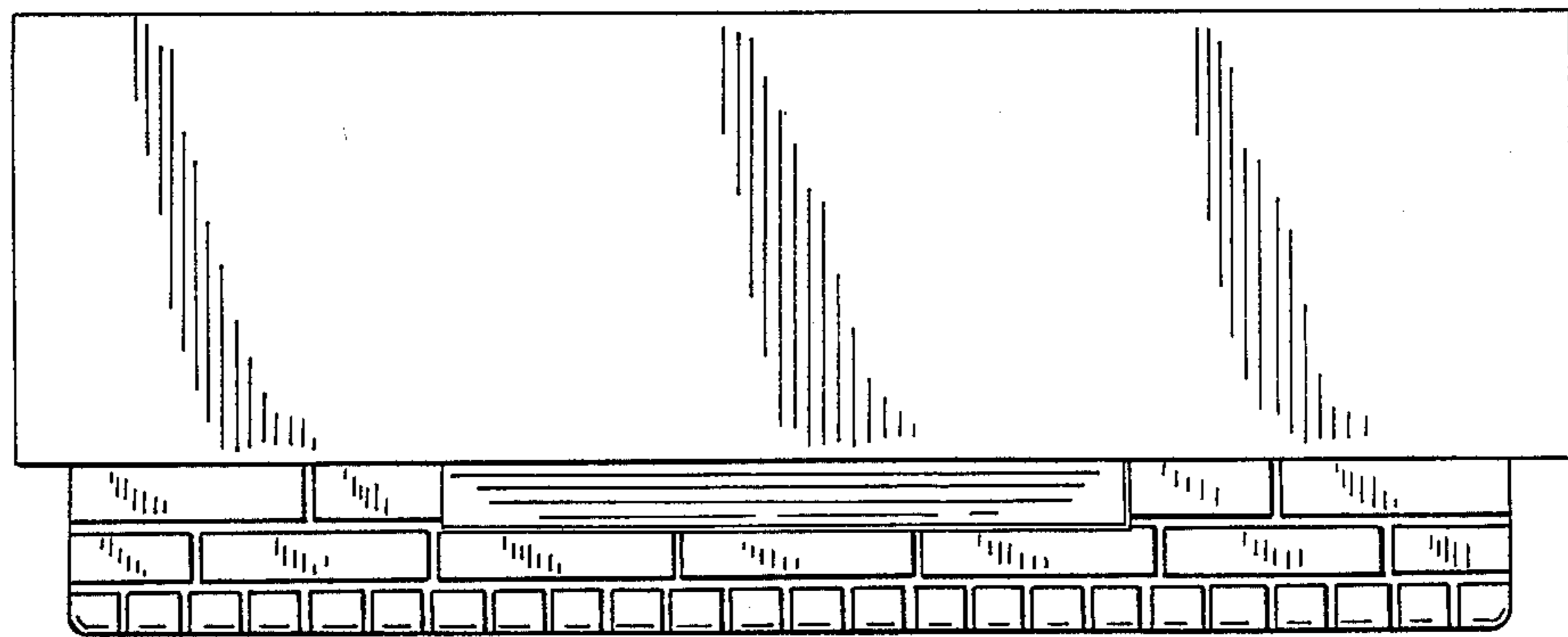

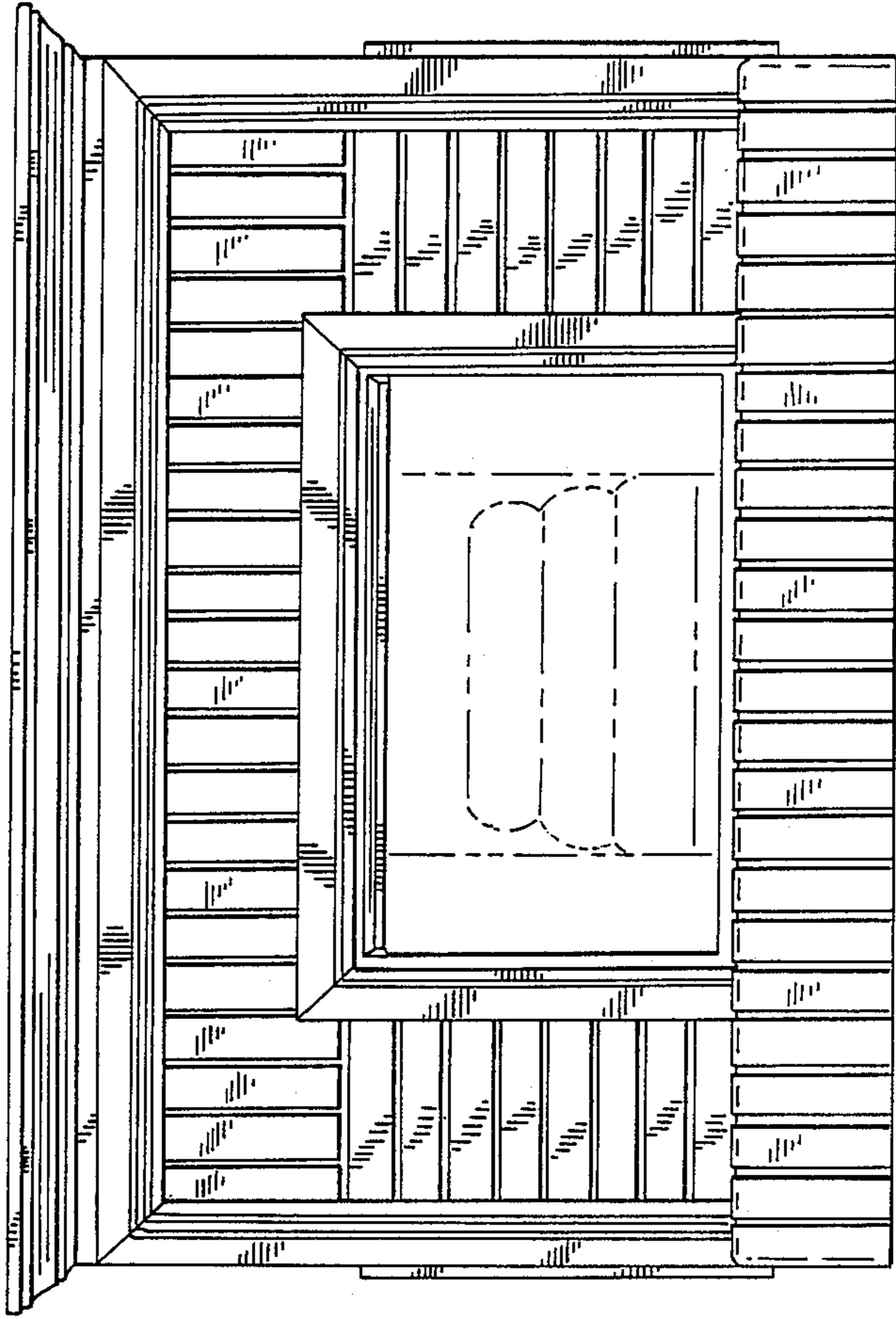
