FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof on an enlarged scale..

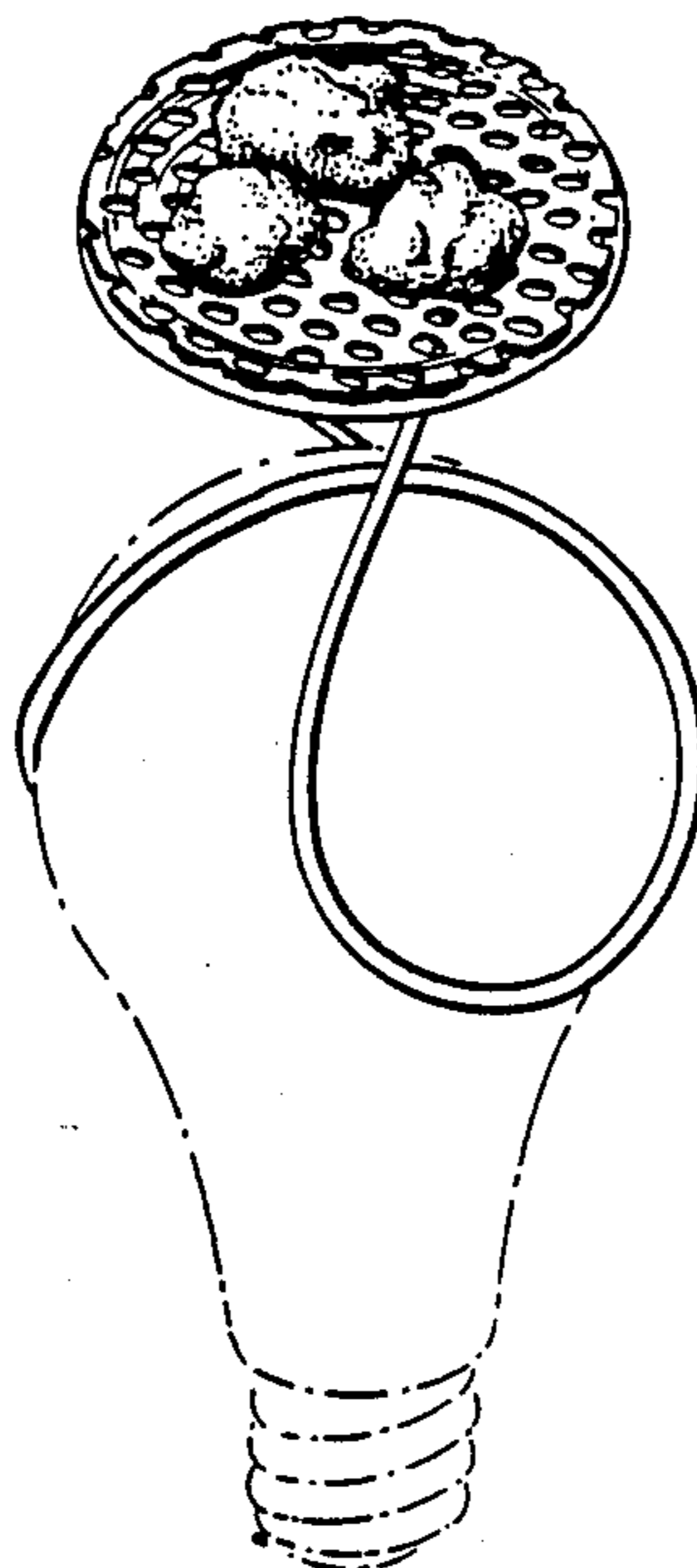

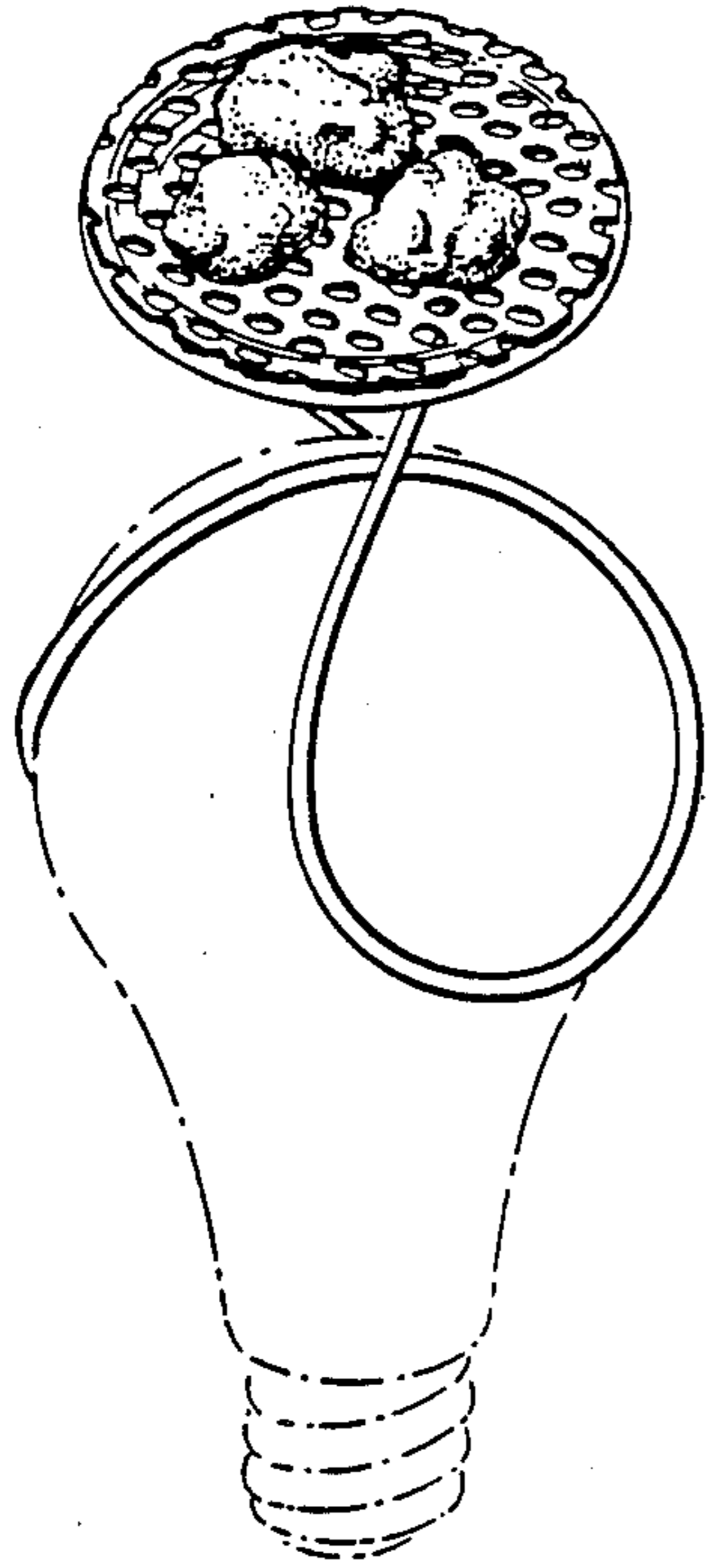

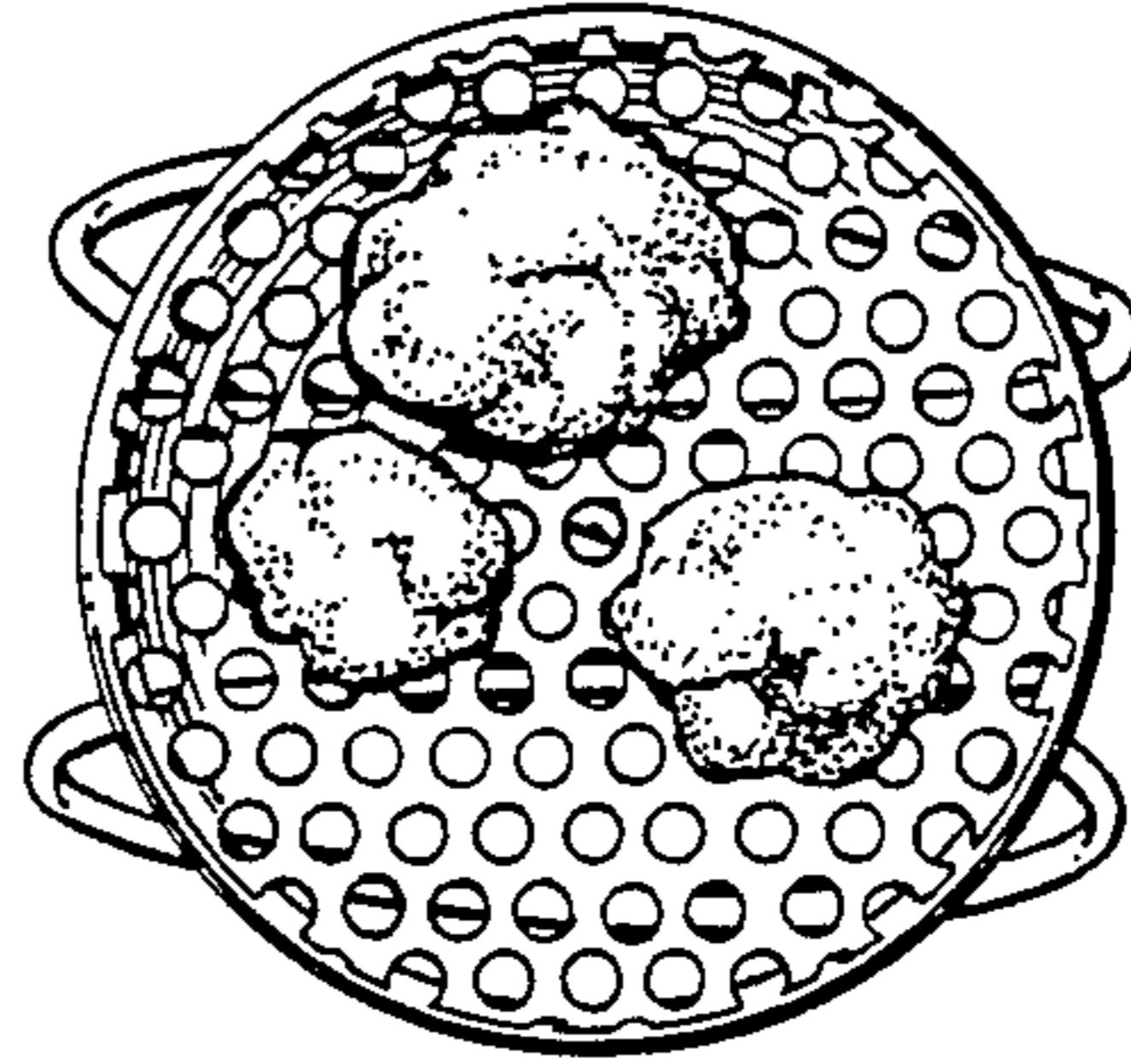

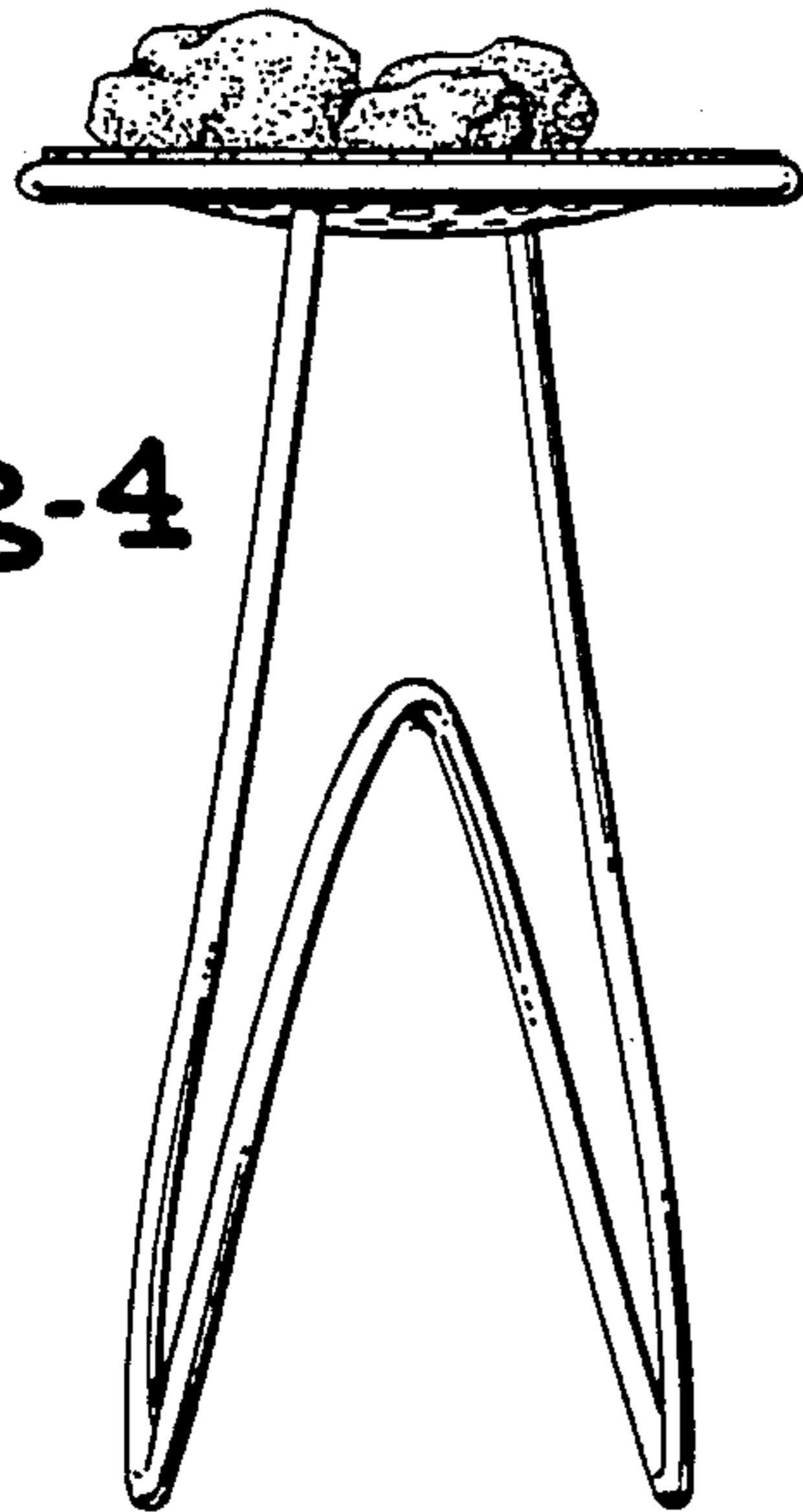

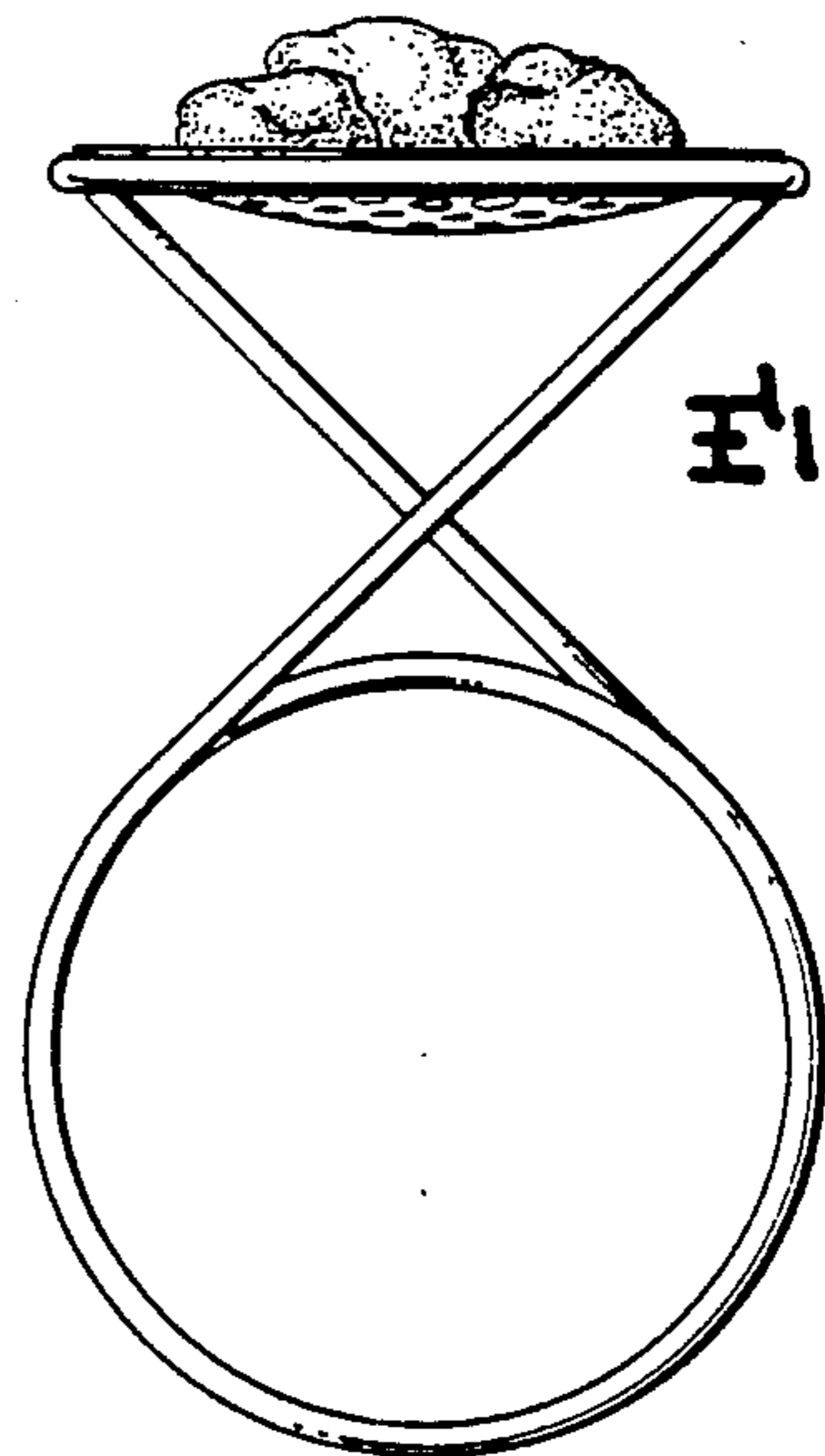
