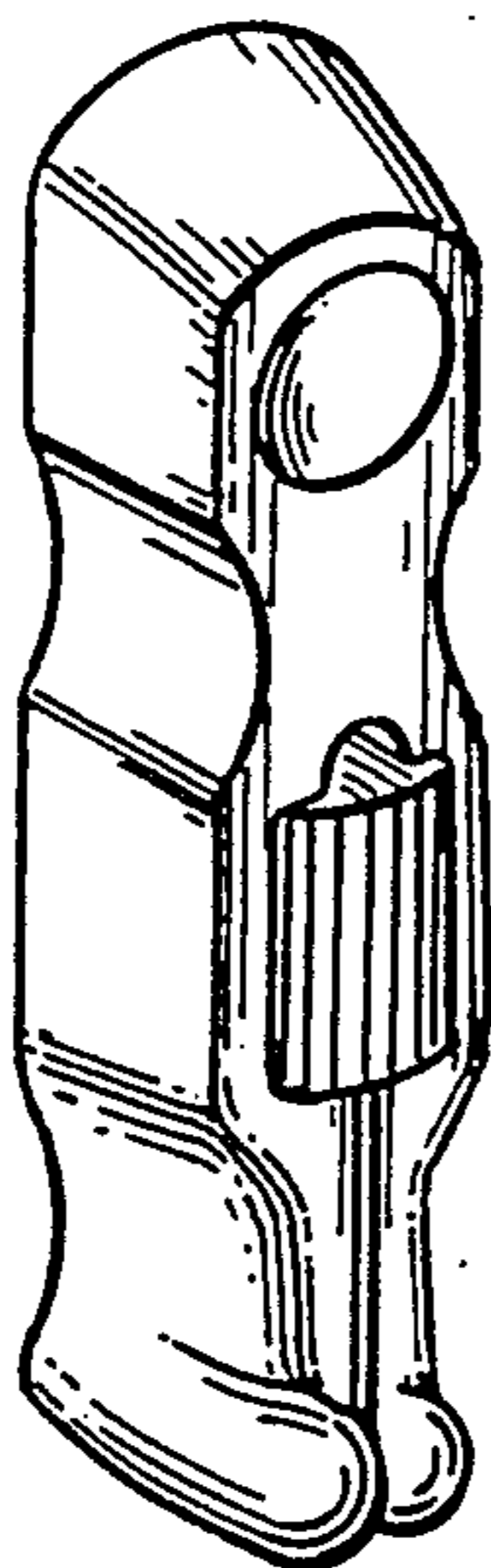

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front and left side perspective view of a food stuff, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



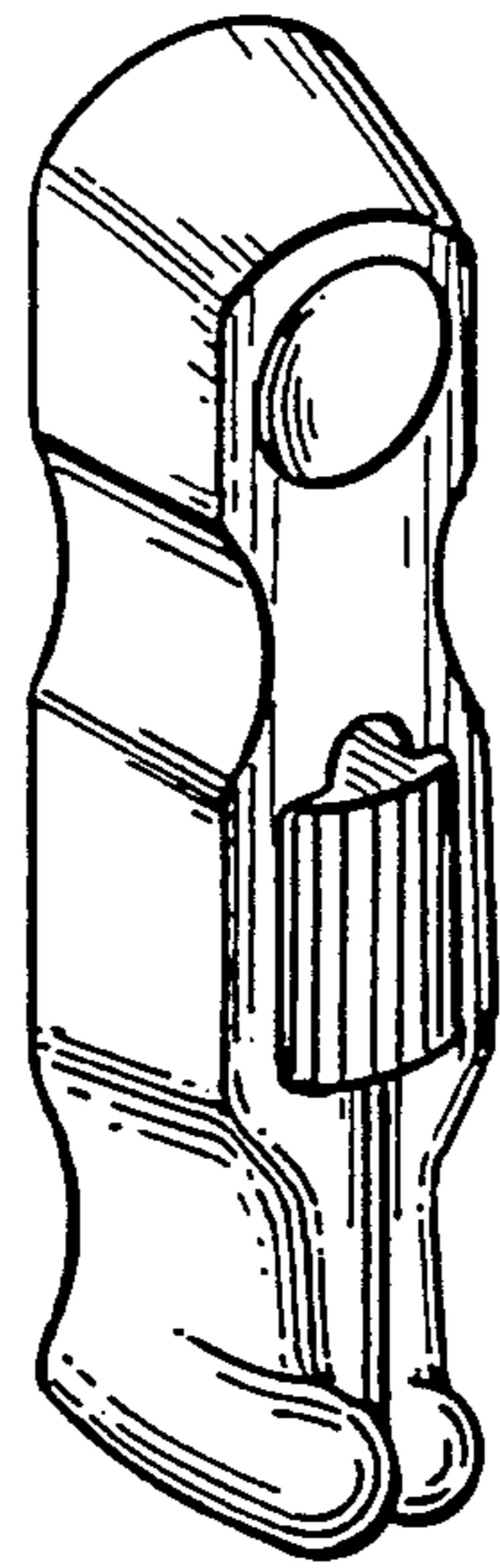
