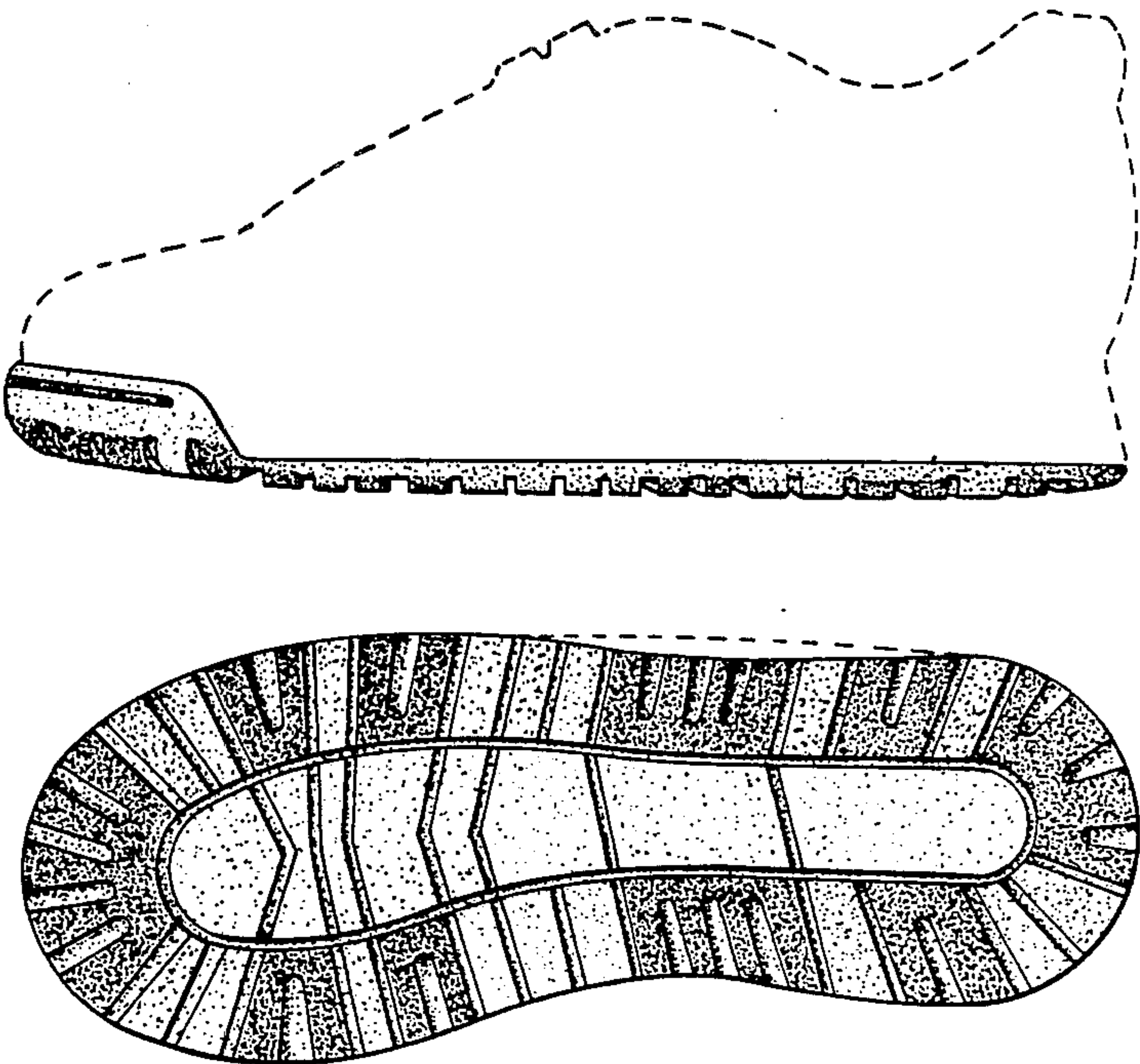

part of the claimed design.



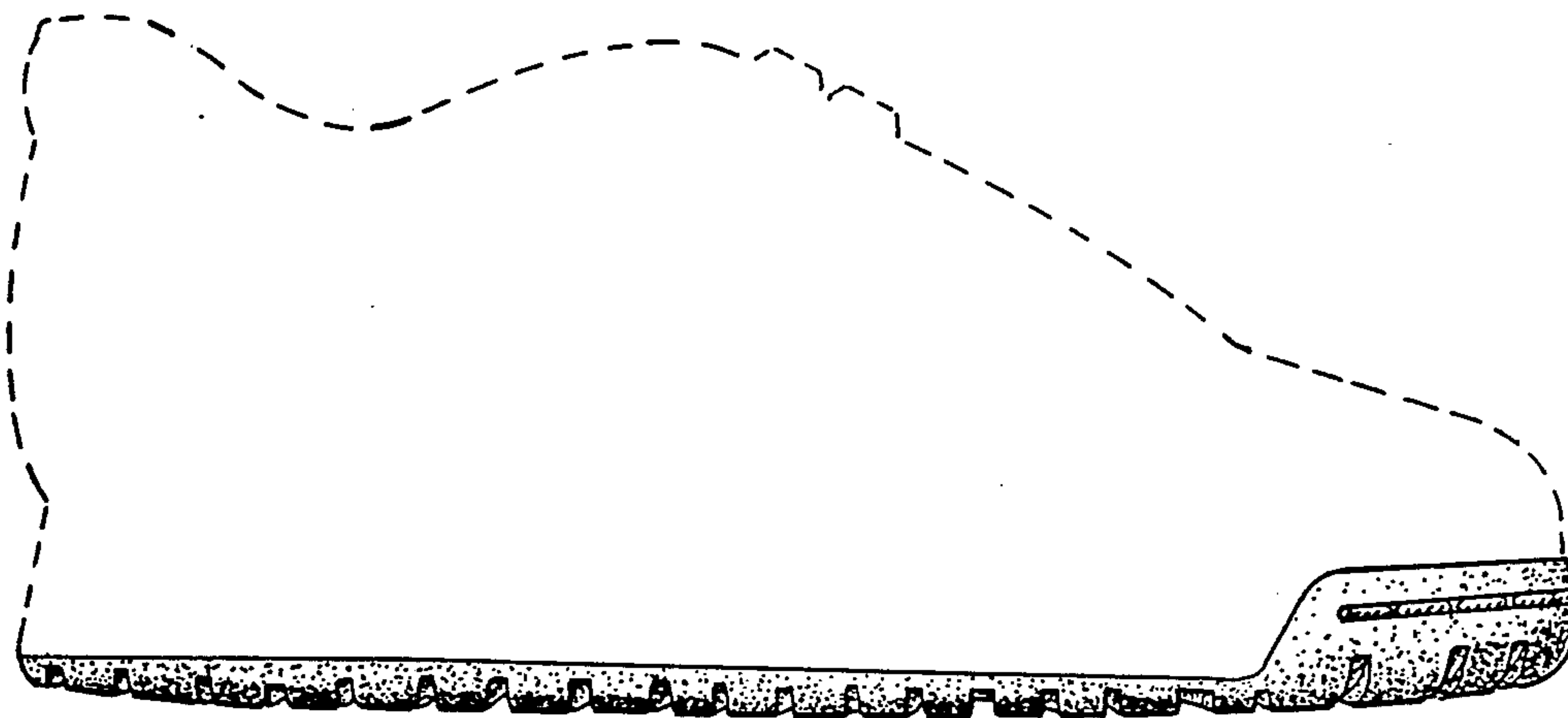

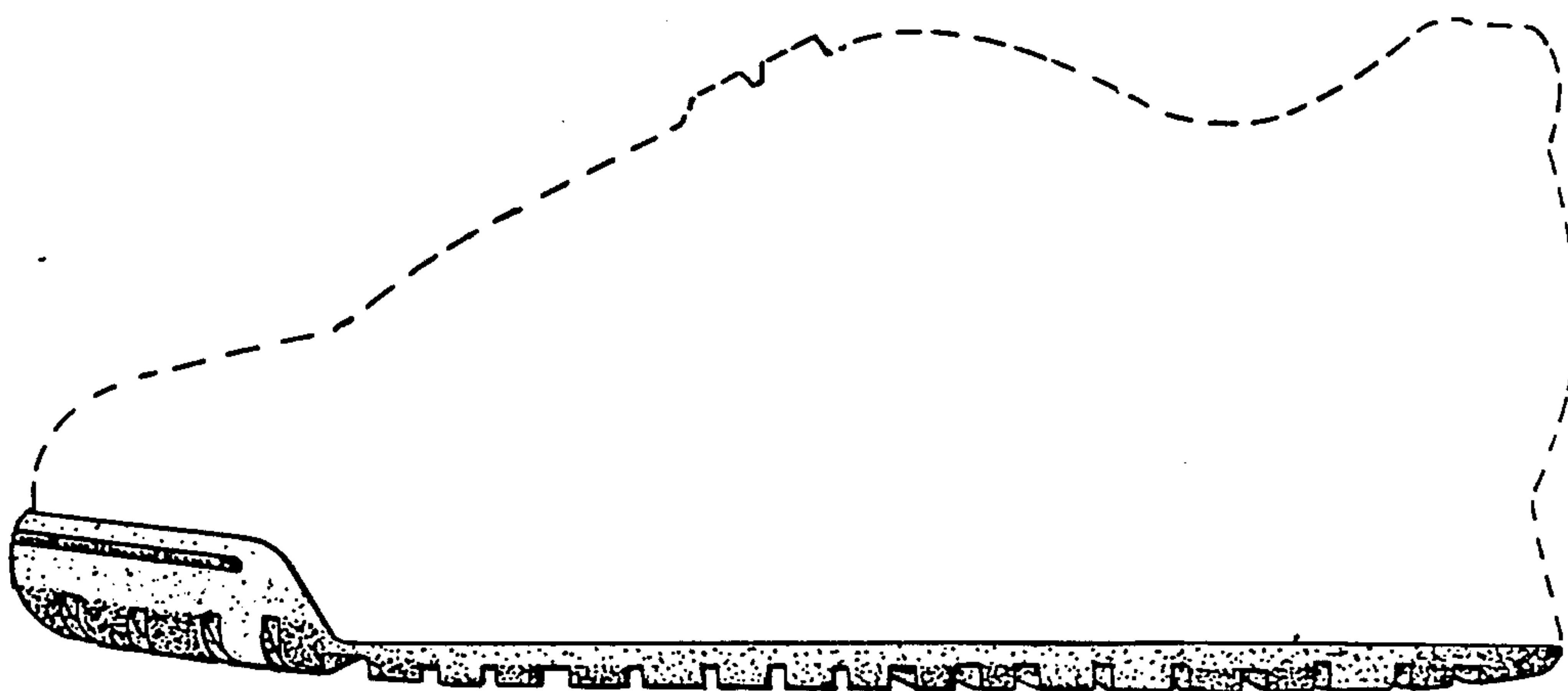

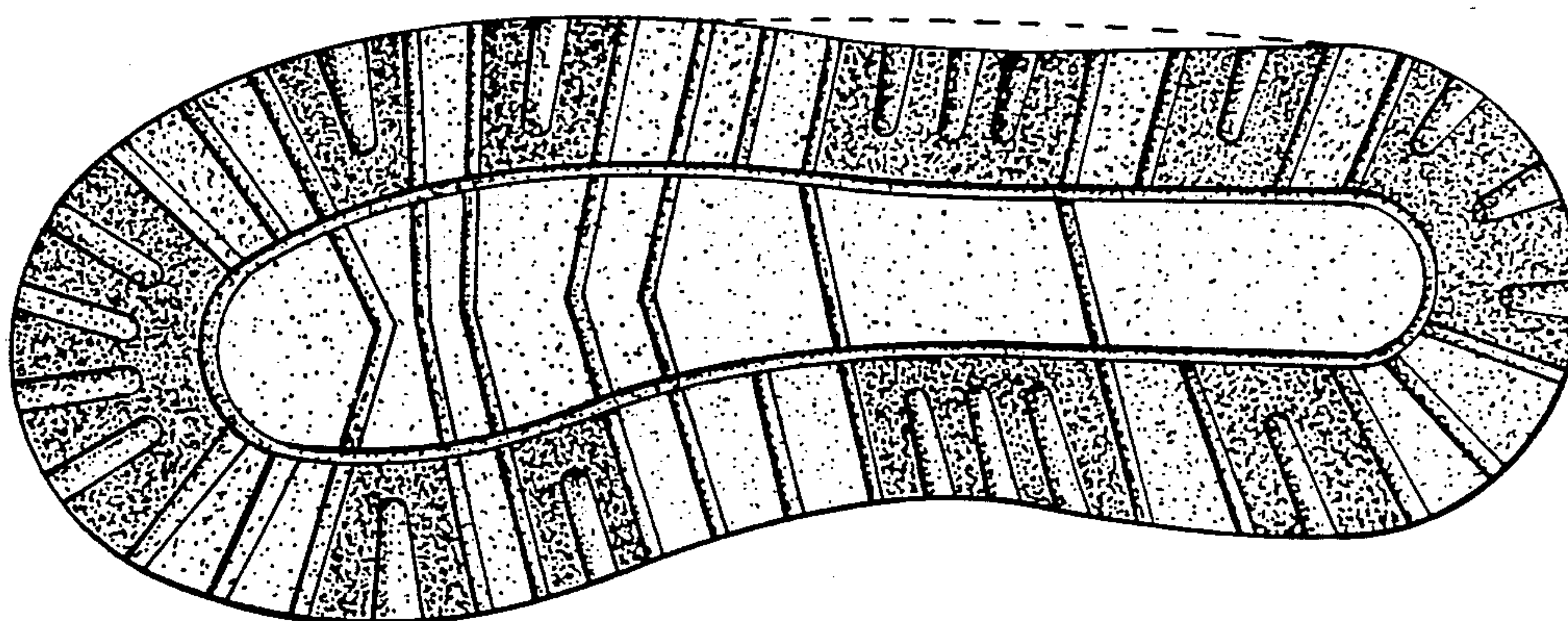

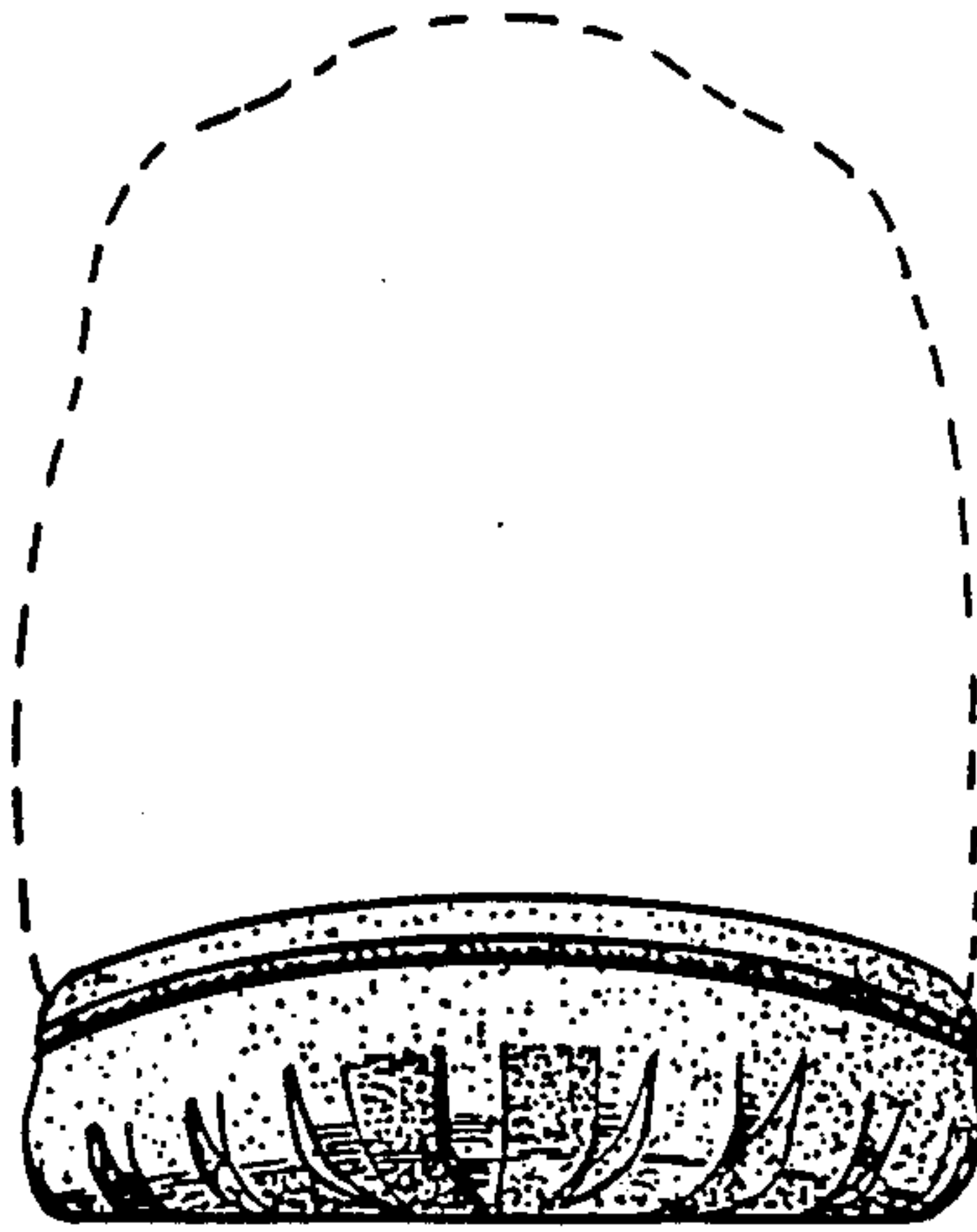

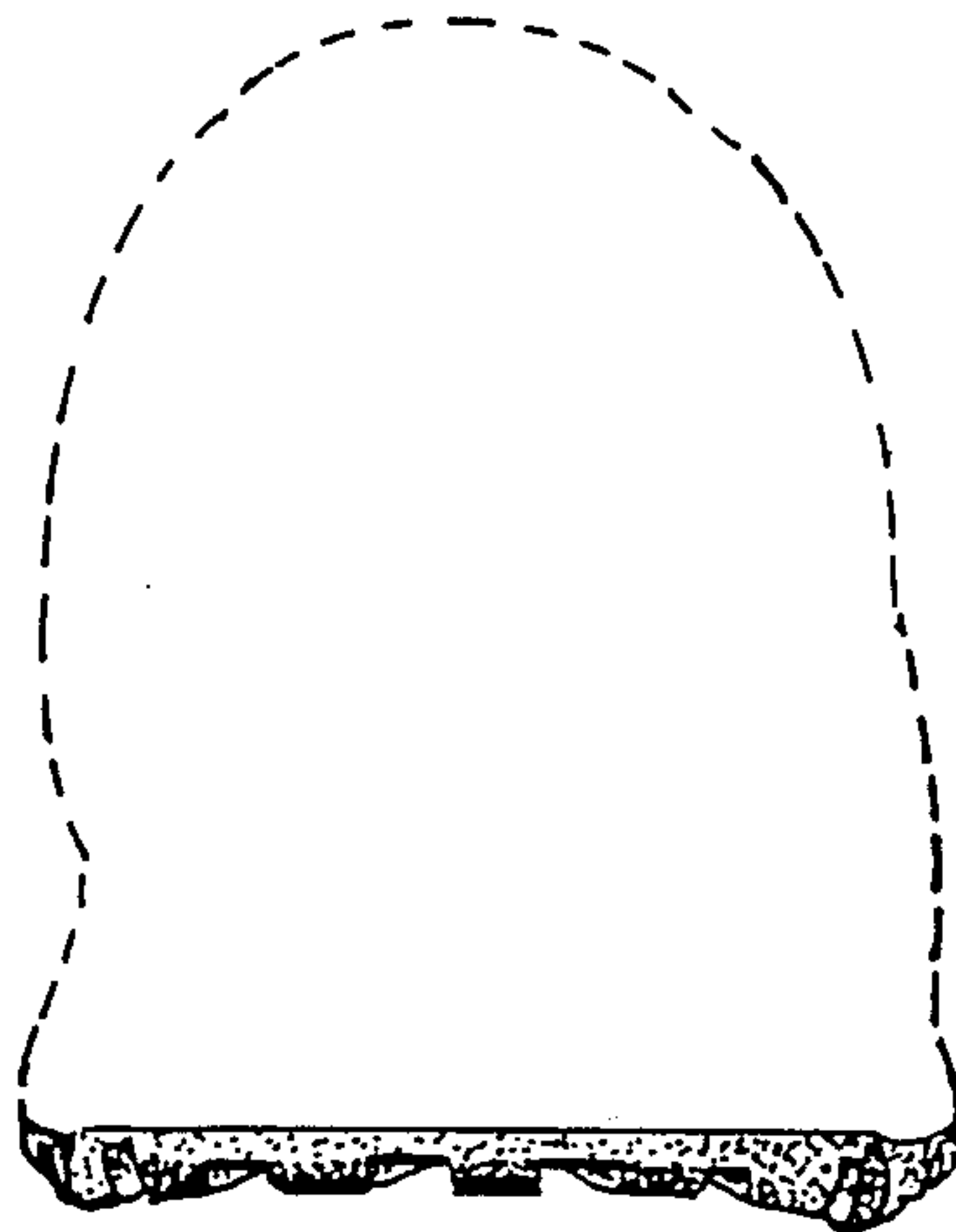
