FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a videocassette shelf unit showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image.

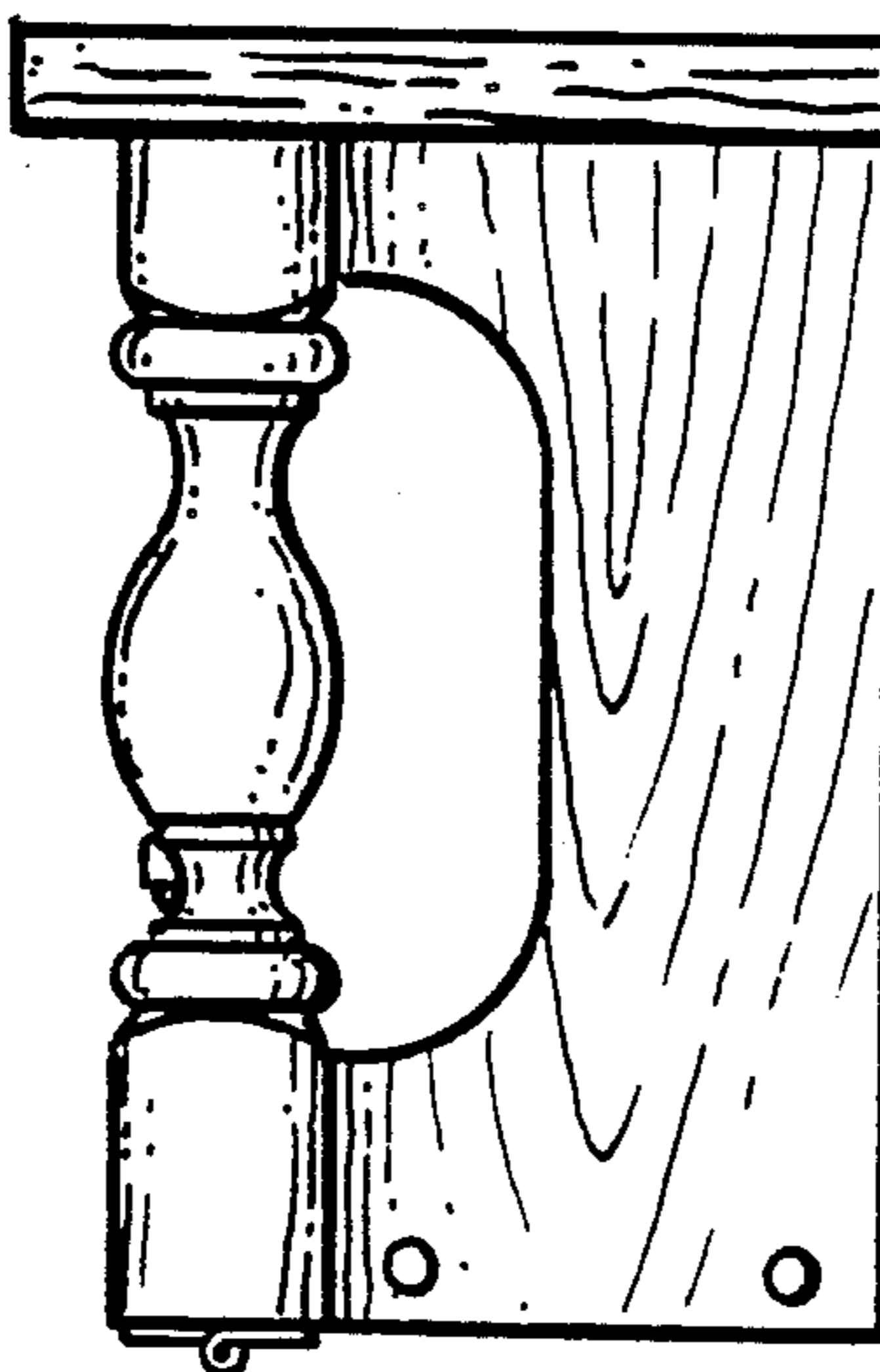
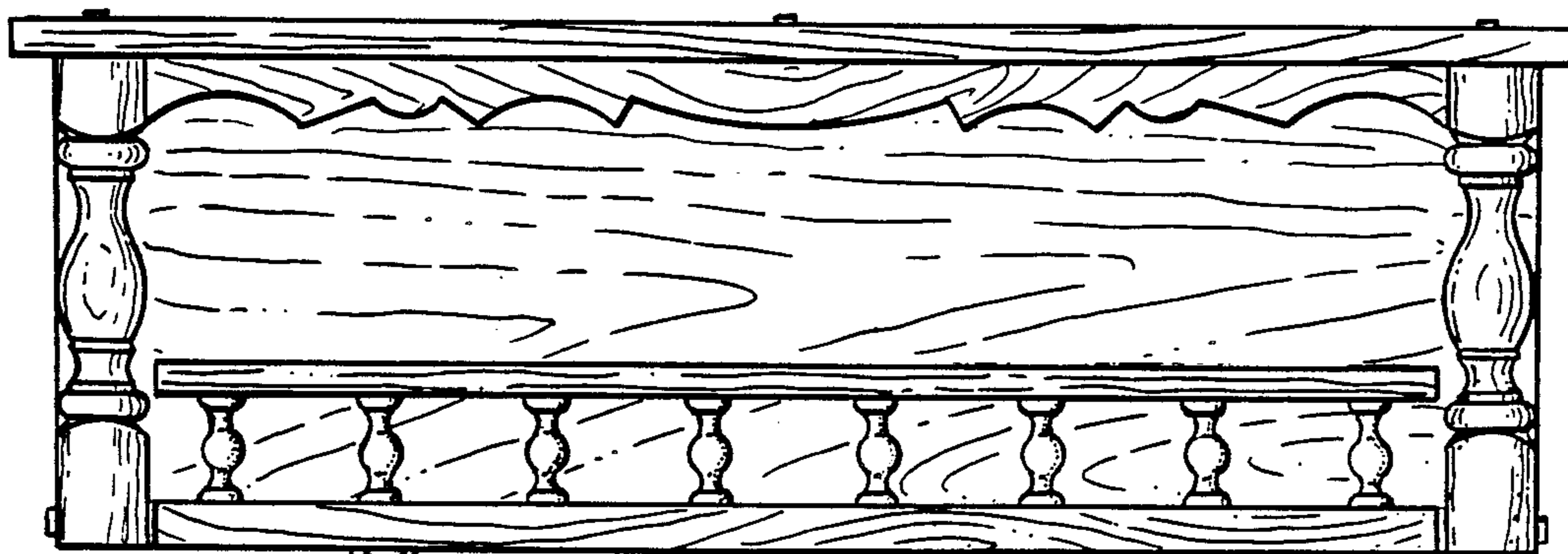

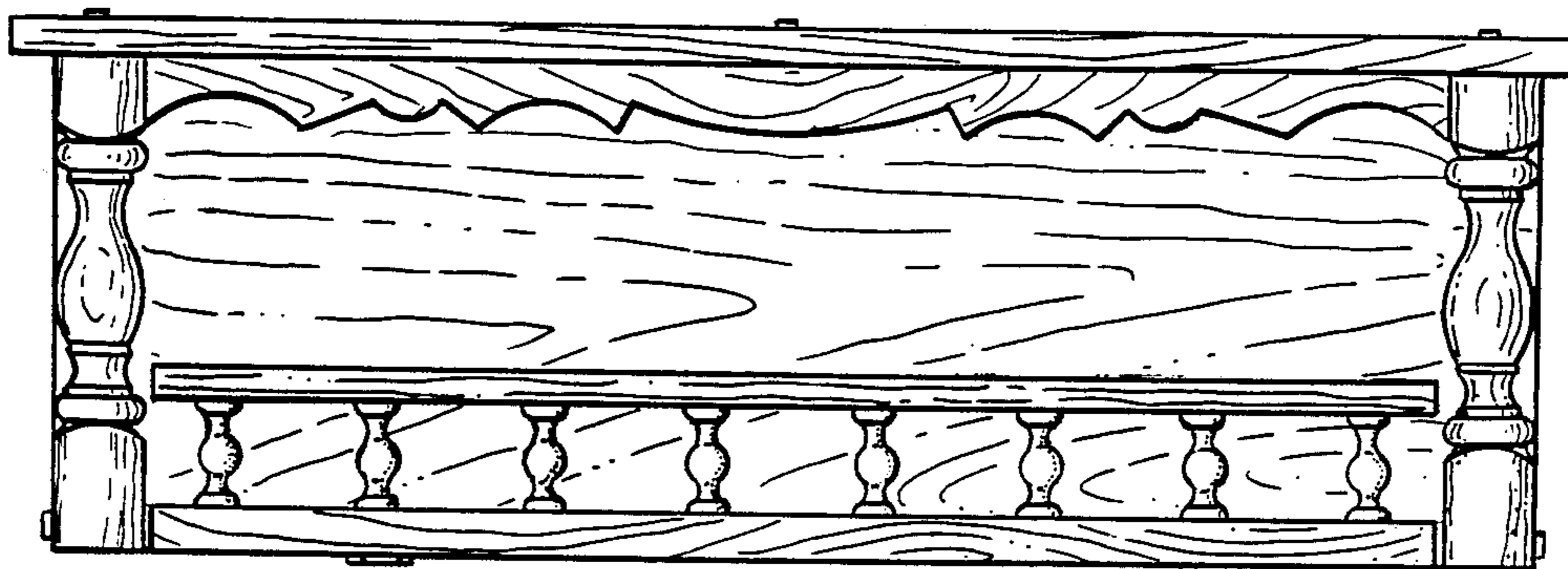

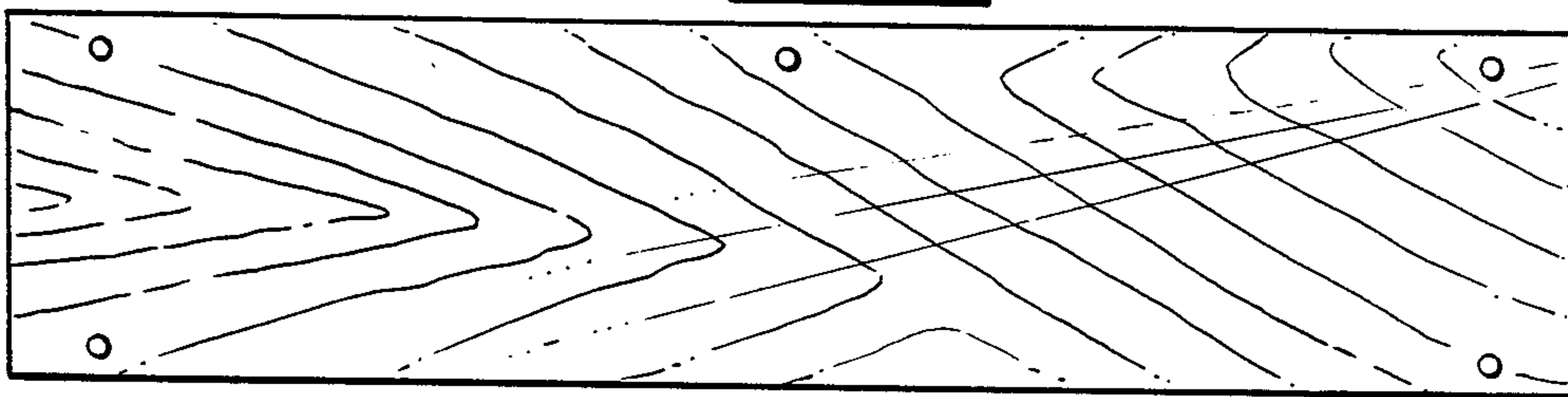

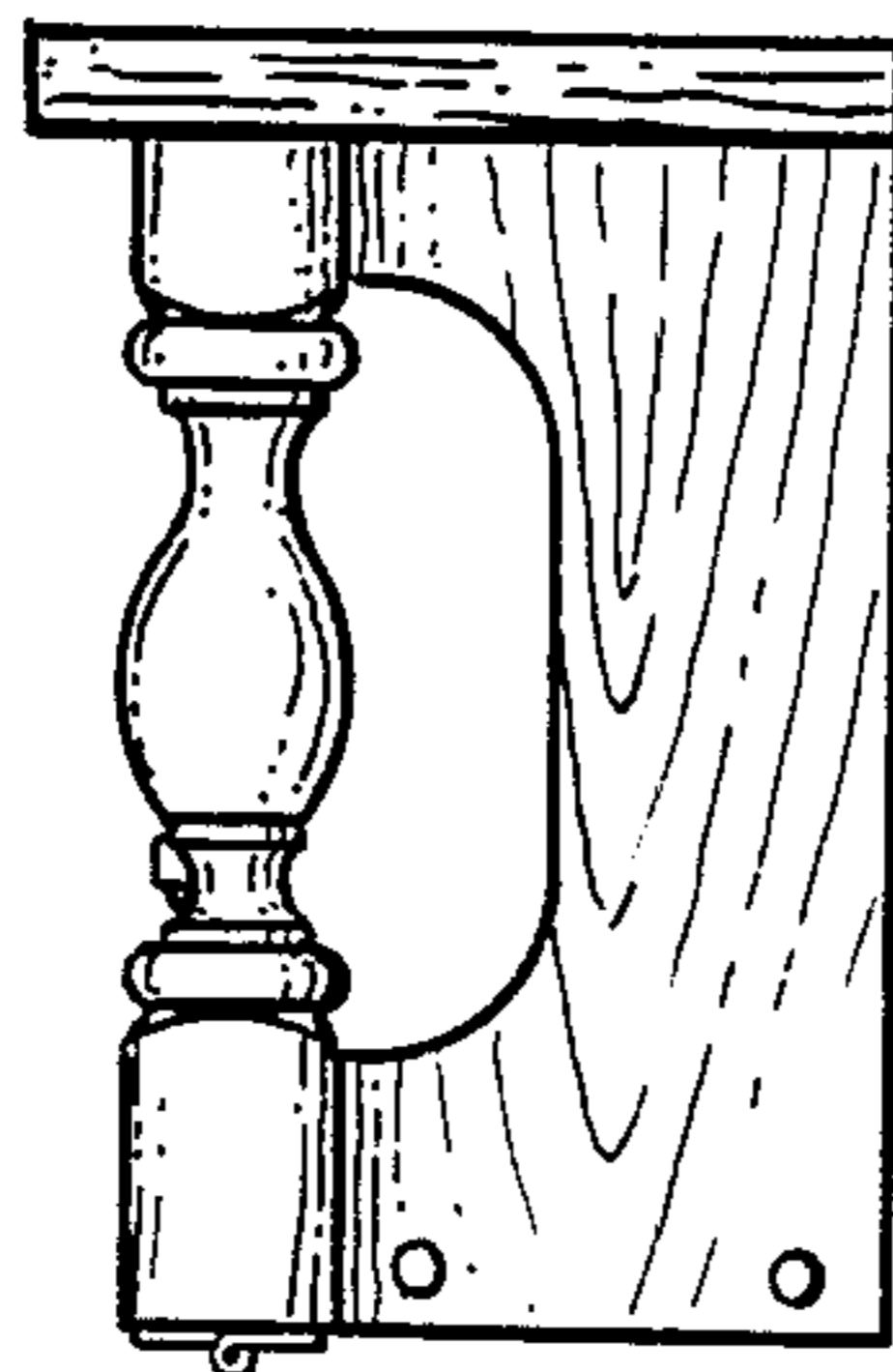
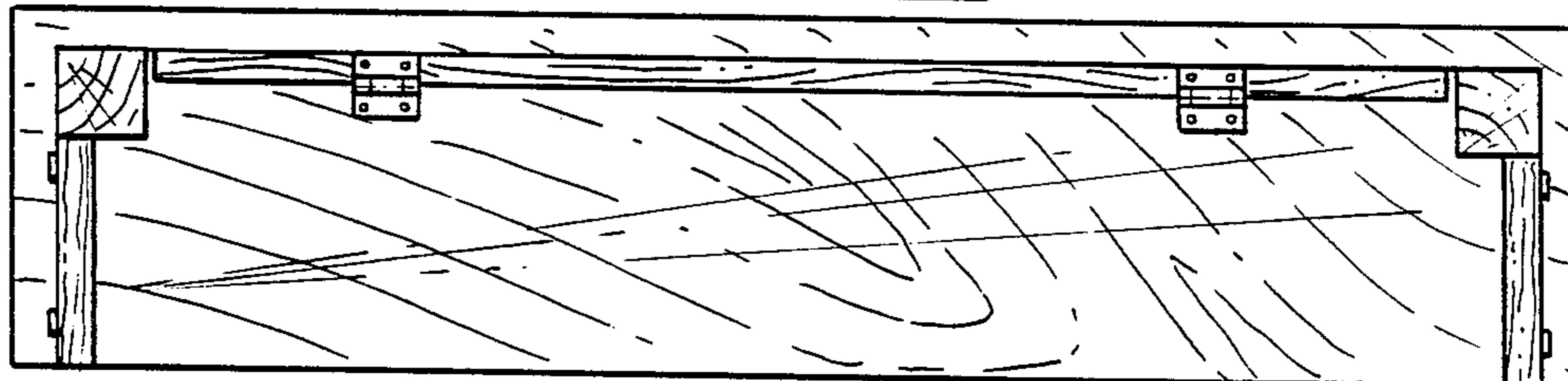
