FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof.

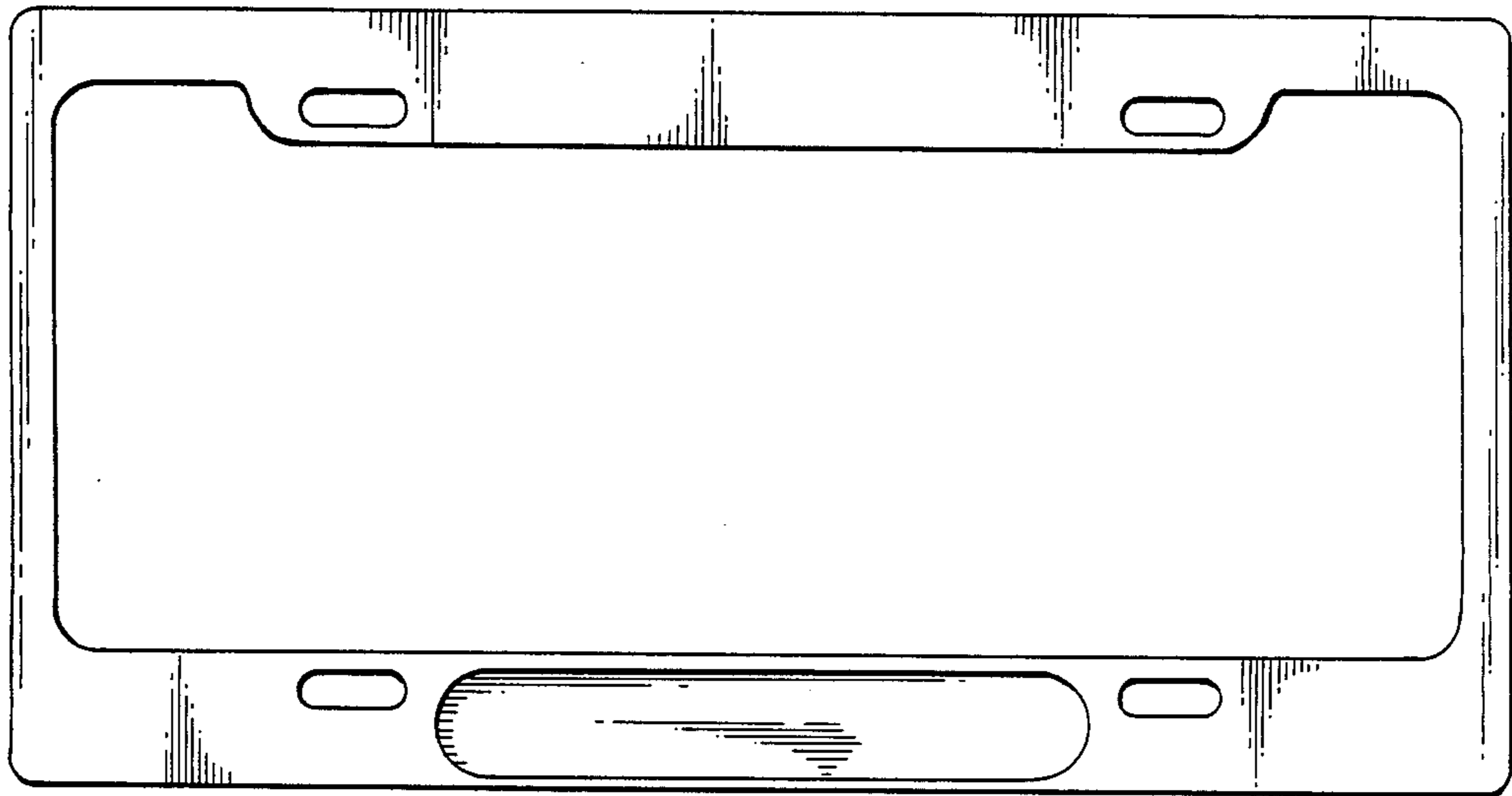

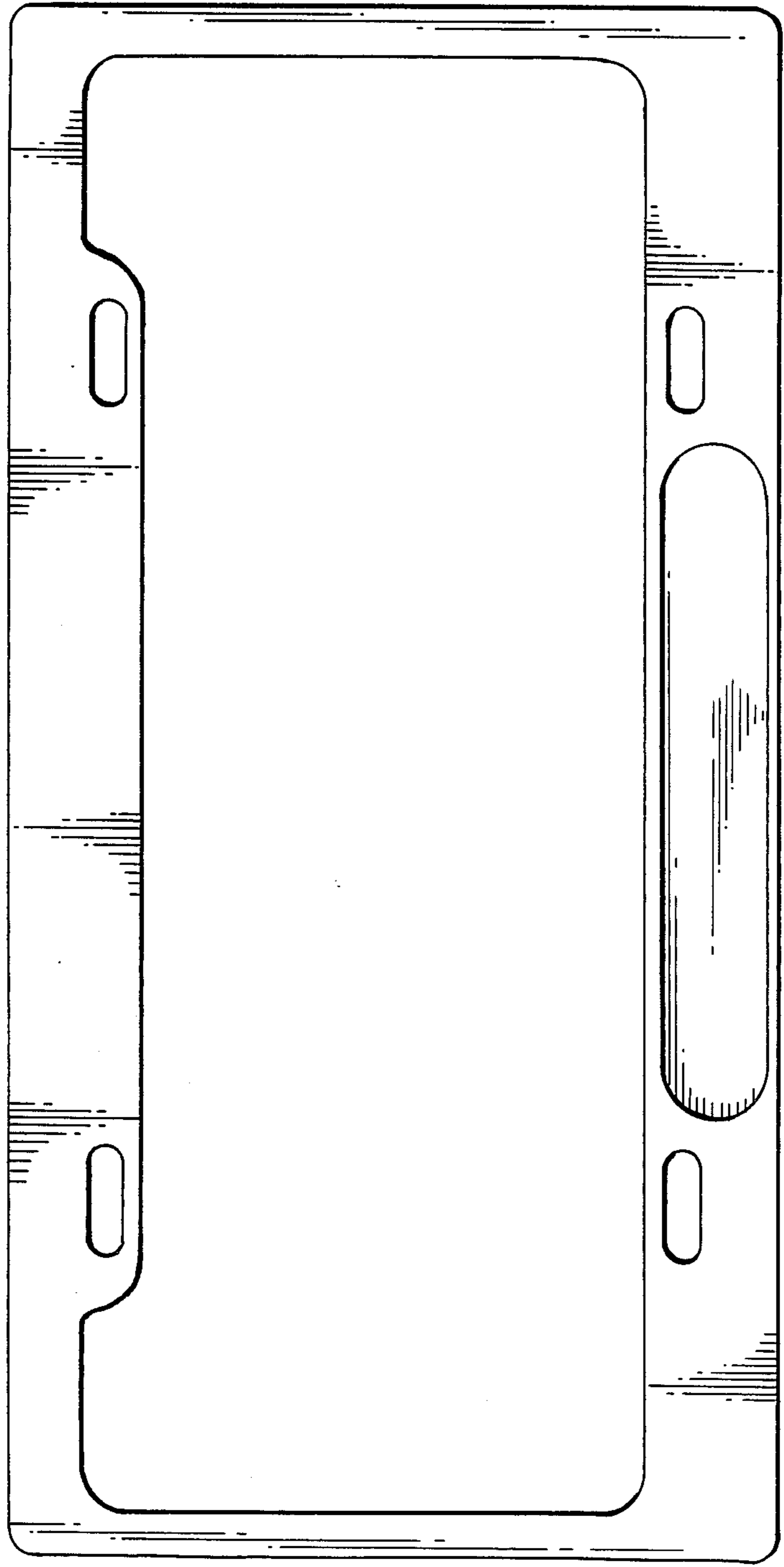
