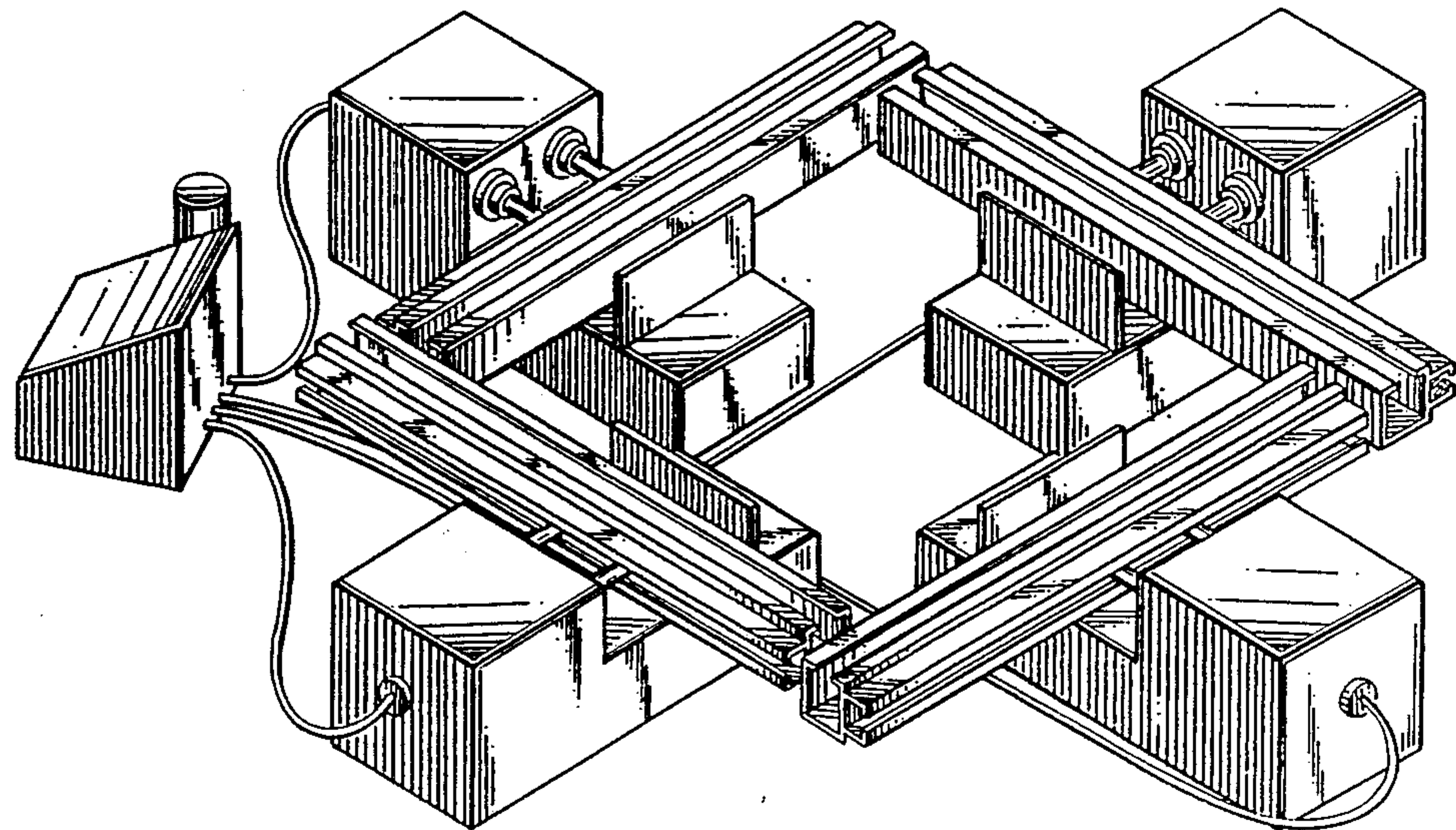

The ornamental design for fabric stretcher unit for screen material or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of fabric stretcher unit for screen material or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof with the control omitted for convenience of illustration only, the other sides being the same as the side shown; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



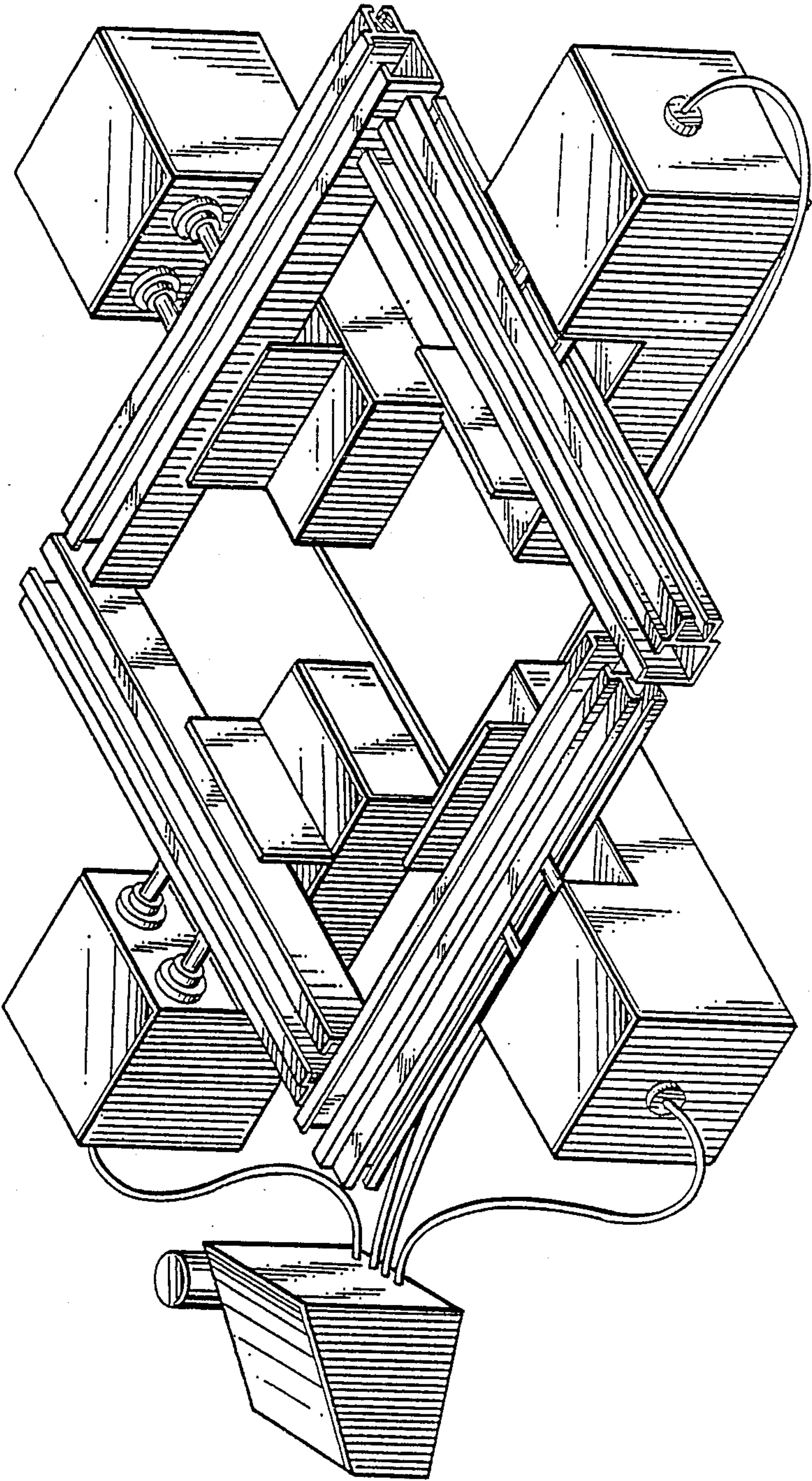

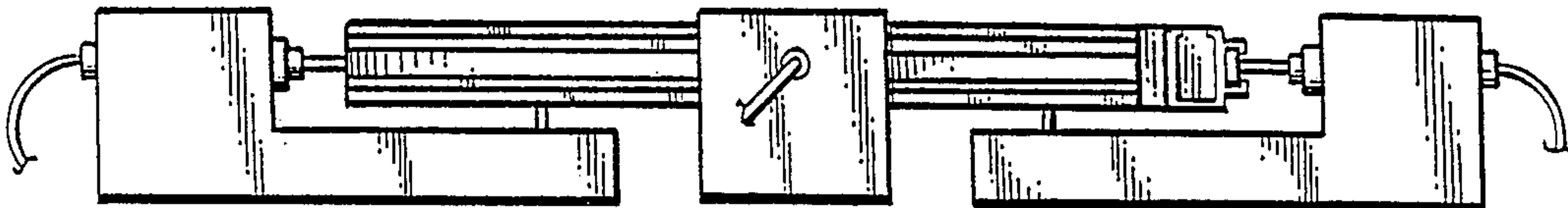
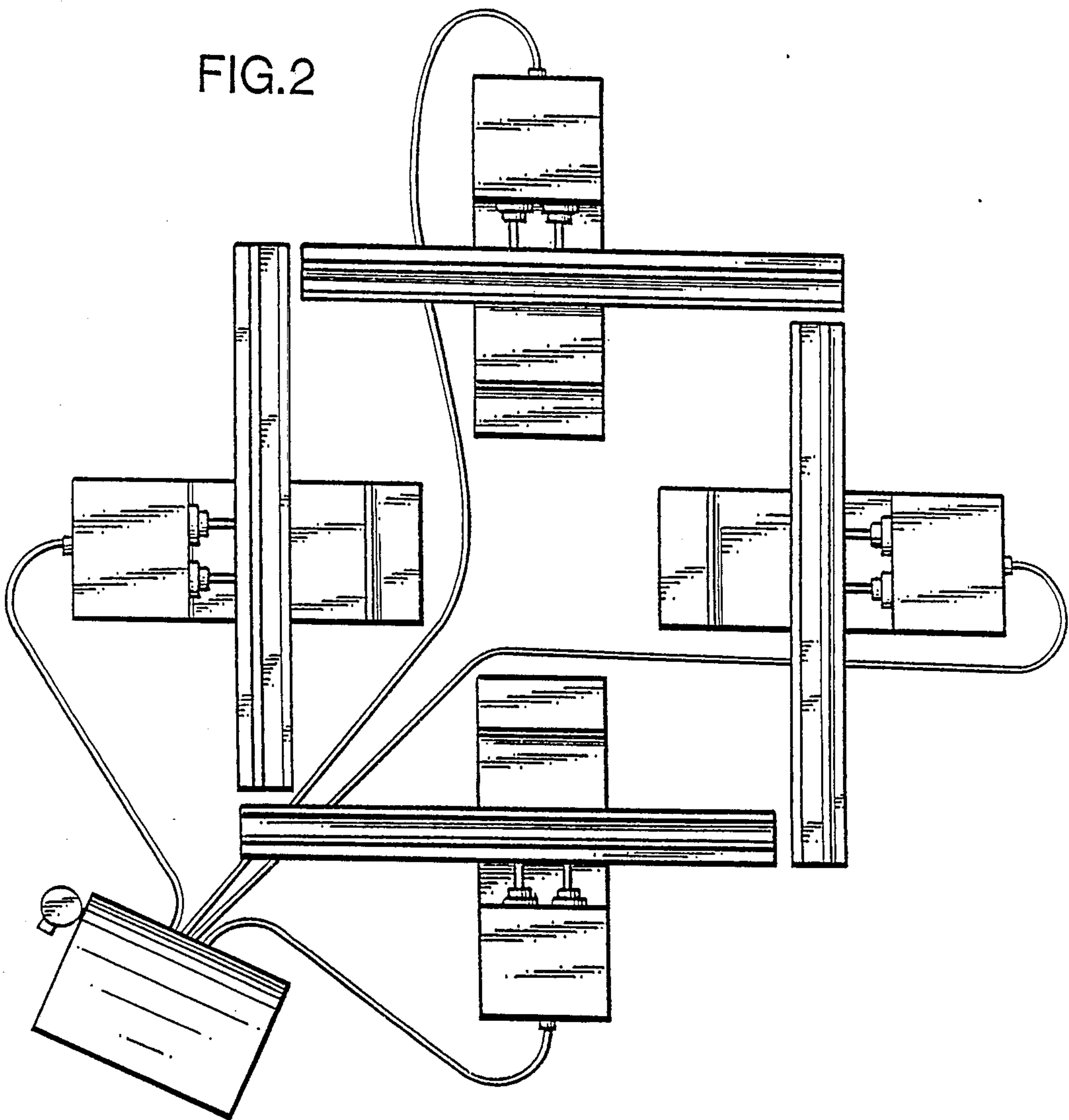

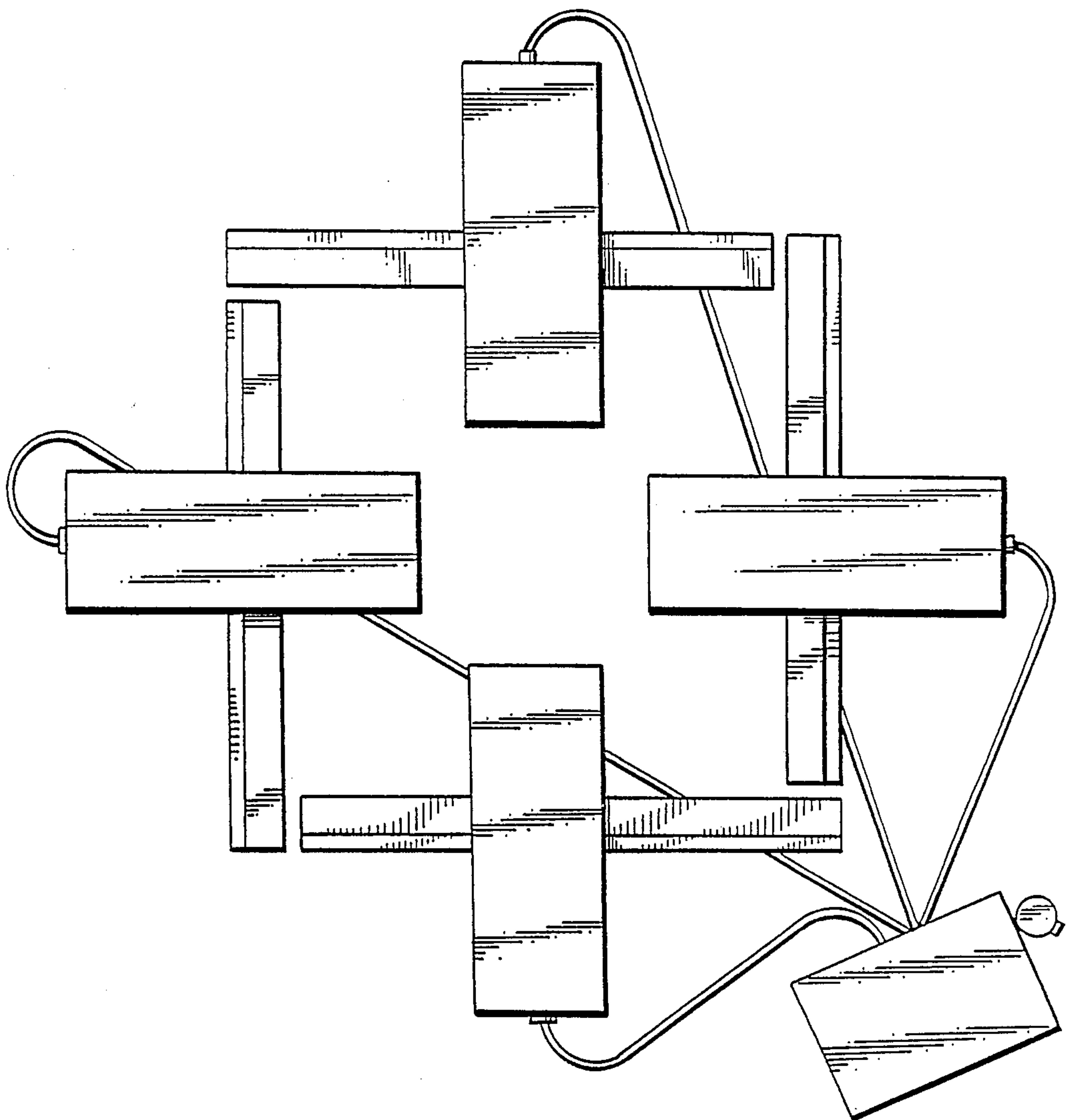
