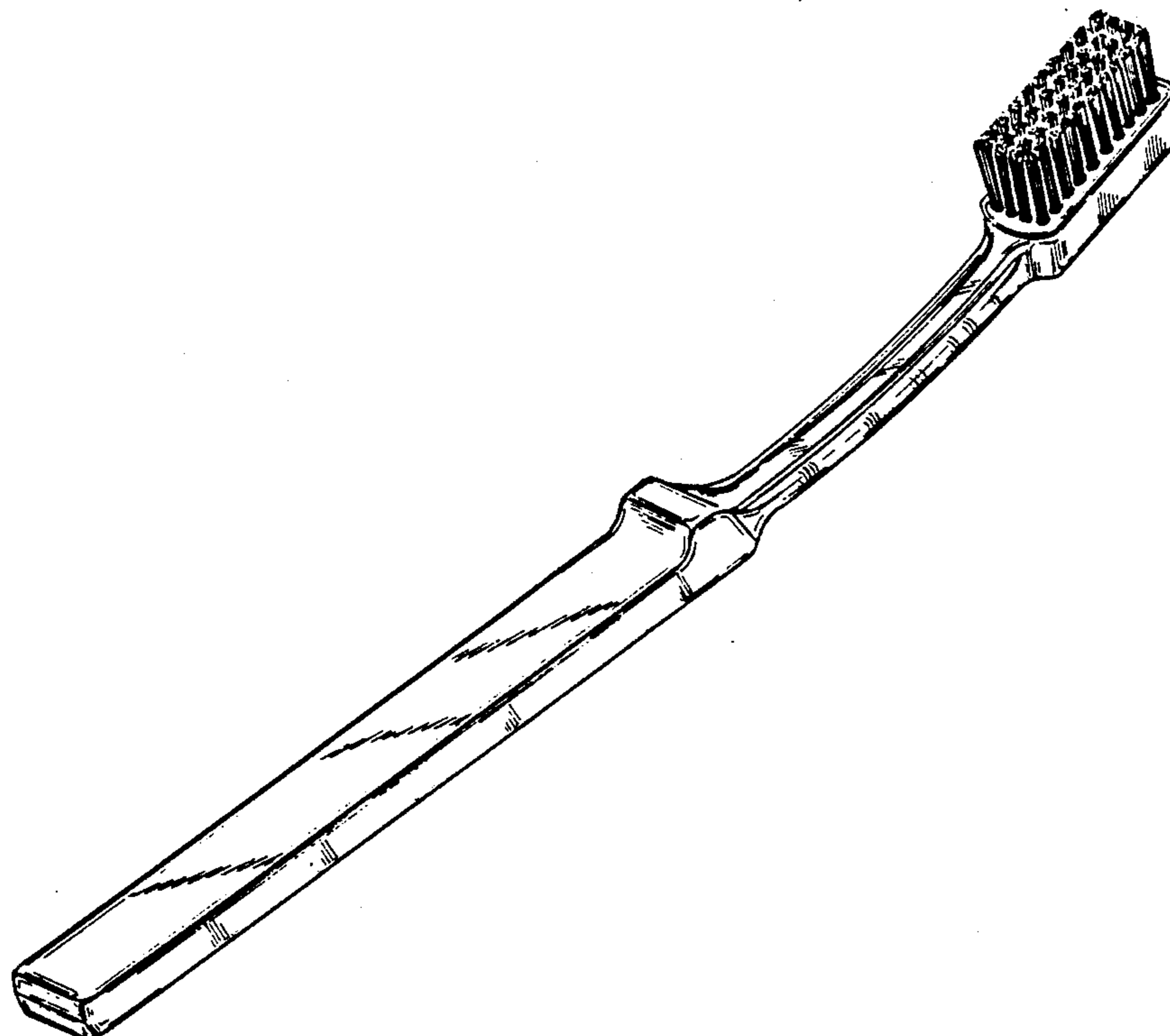

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toothbrush embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a right end elevational view thereof.



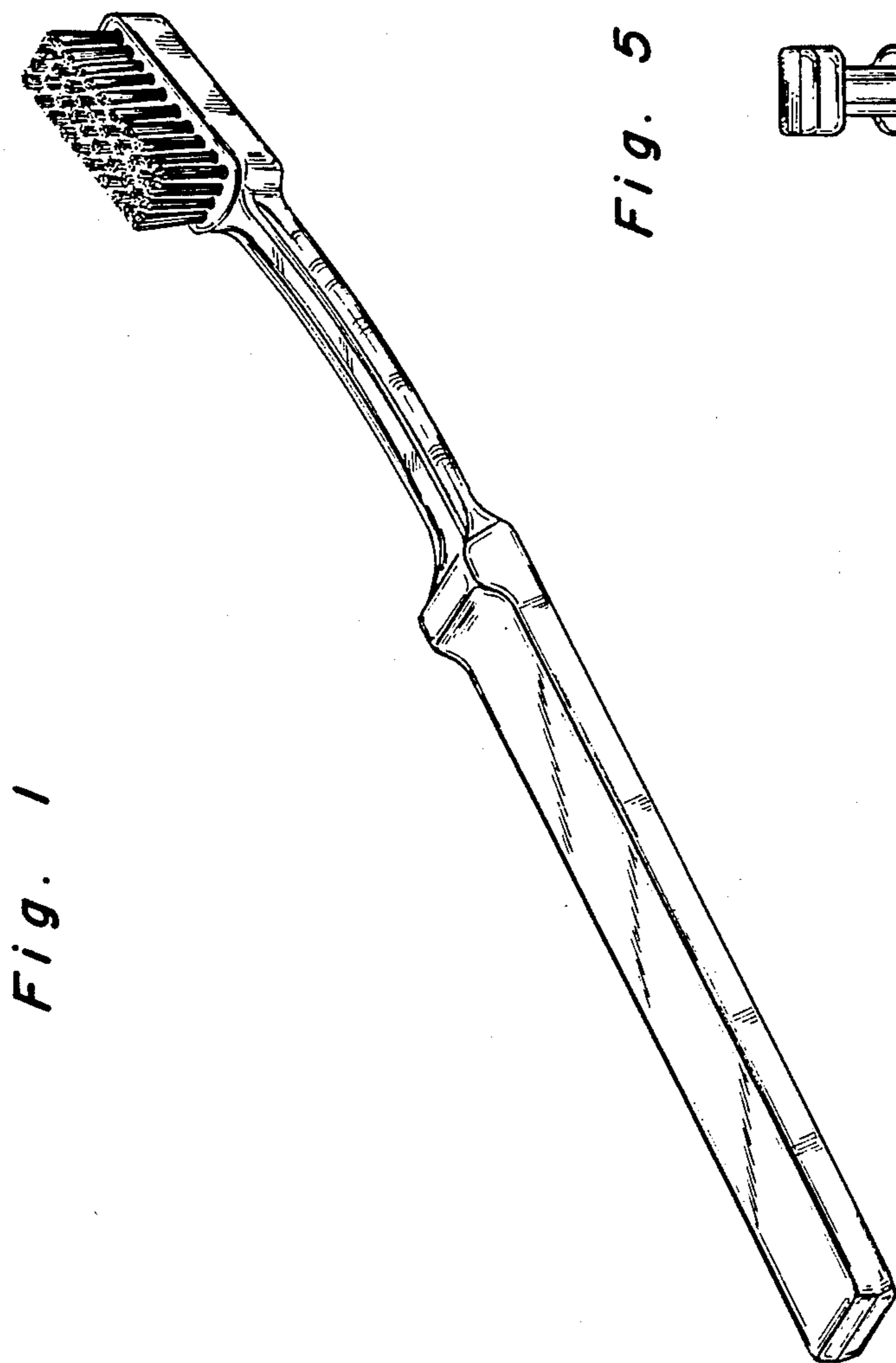

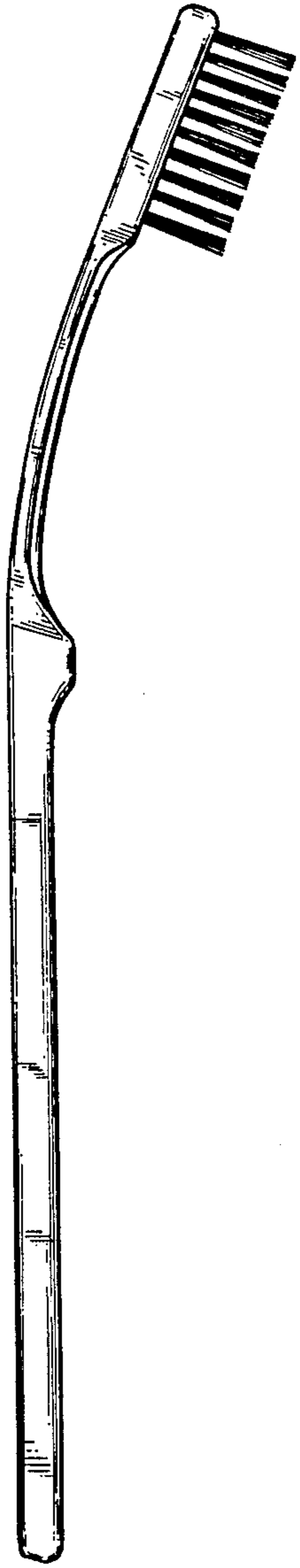
