FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.



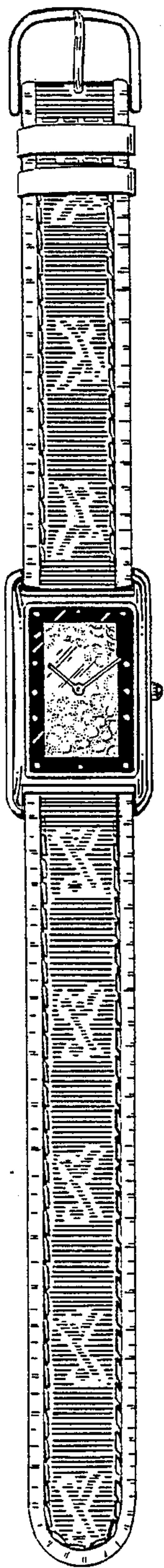

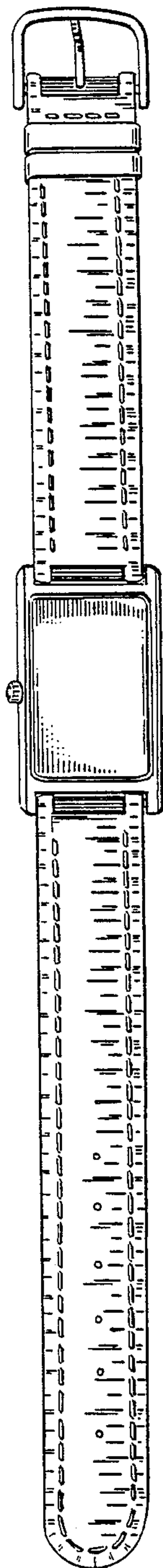
