FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

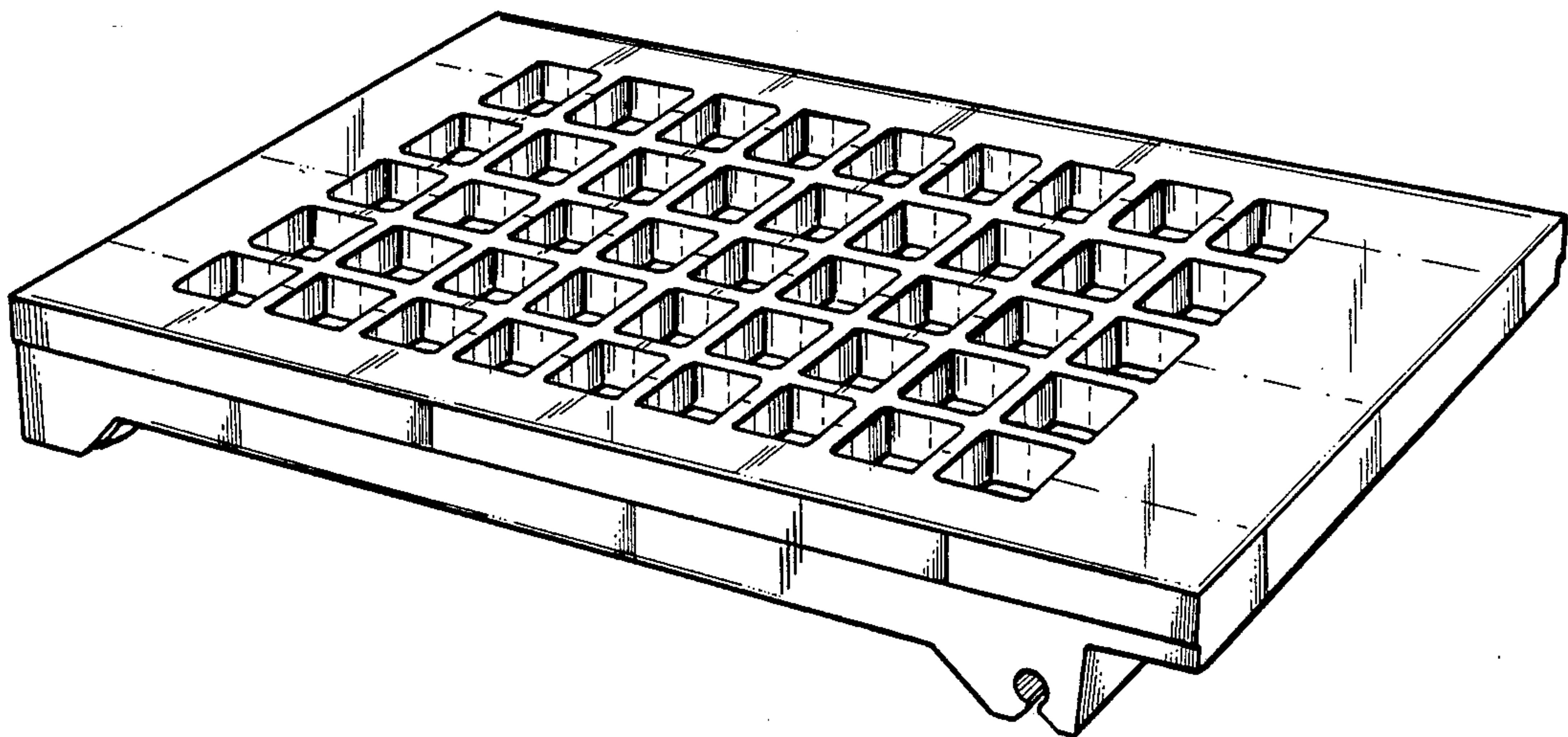

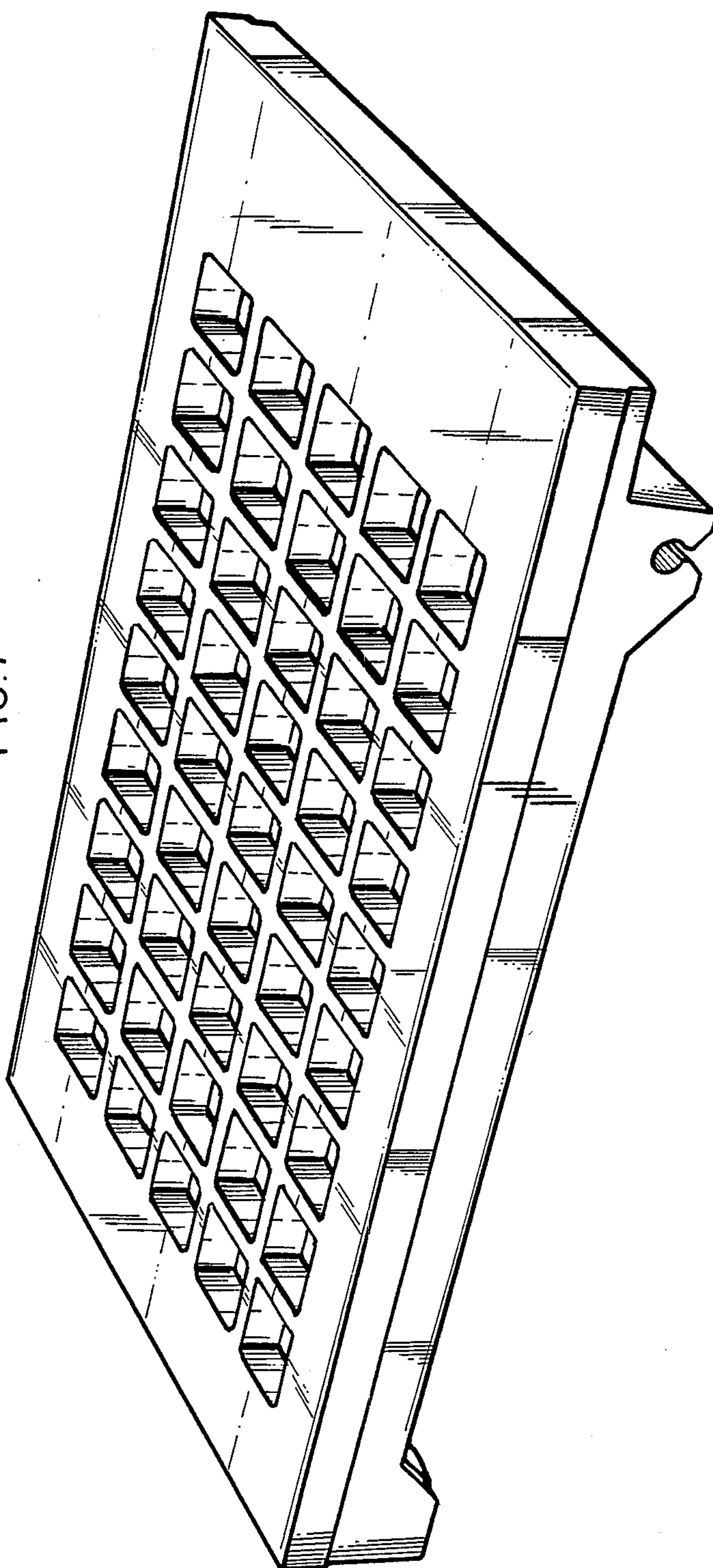
