 FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 4.

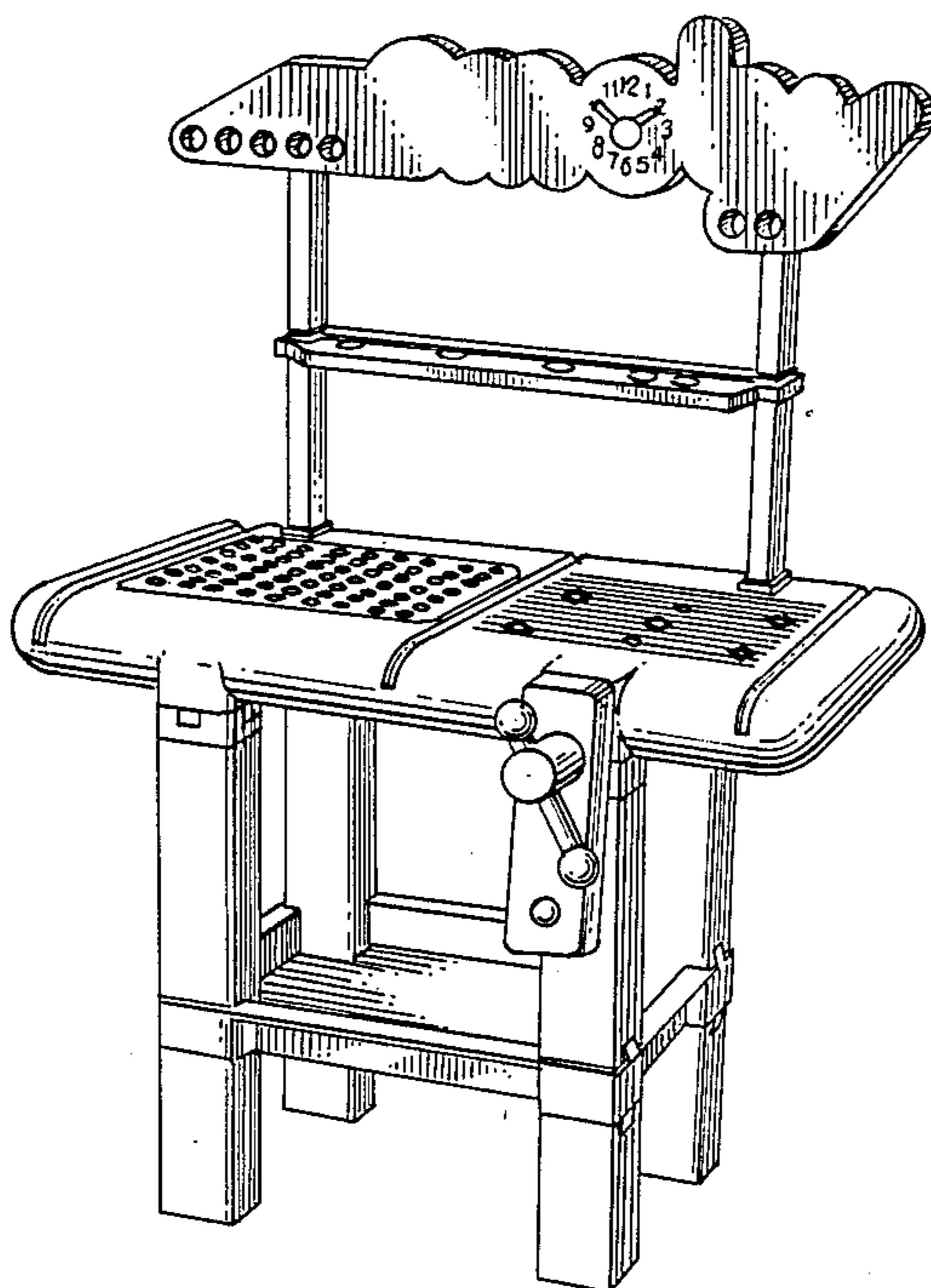

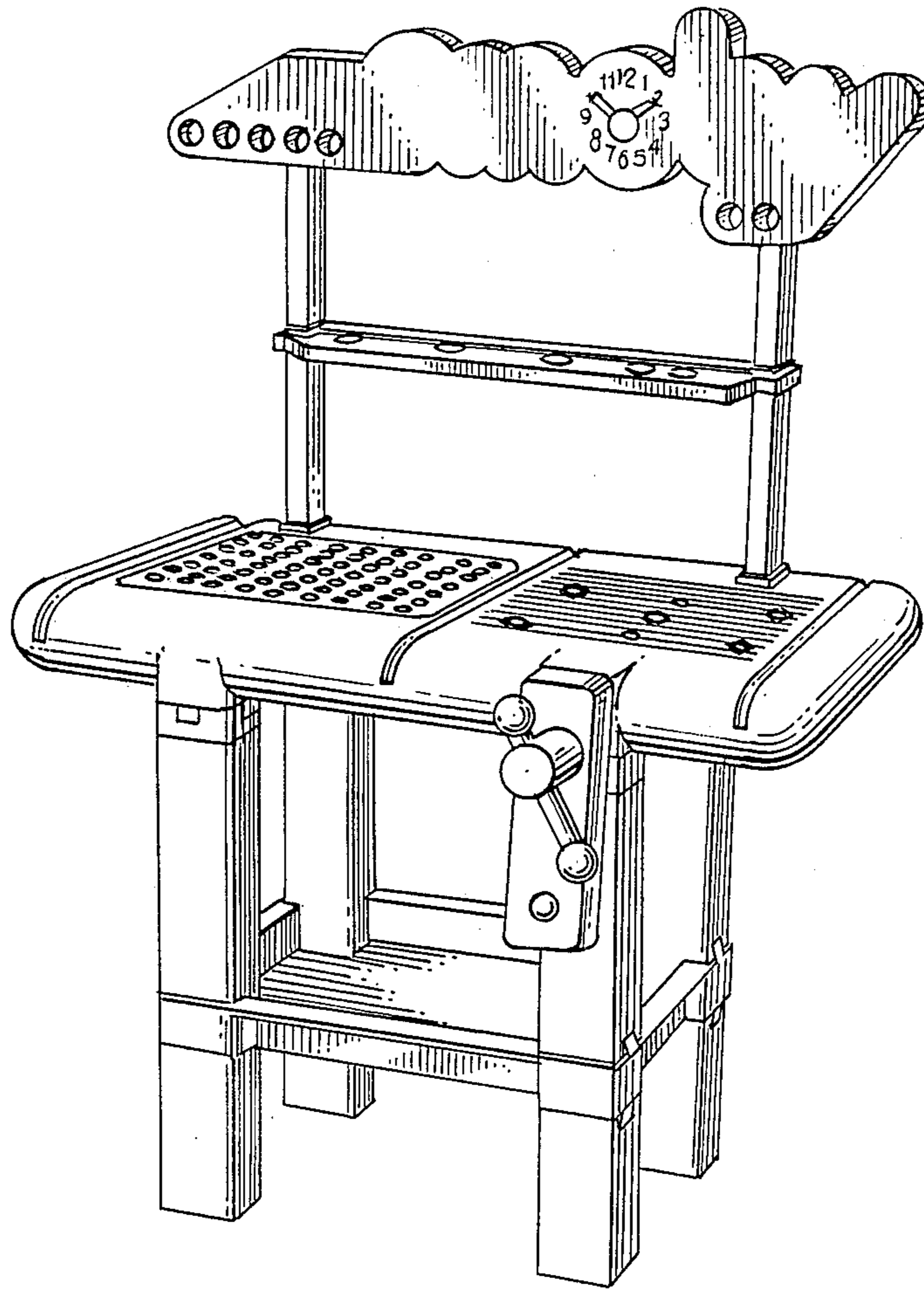

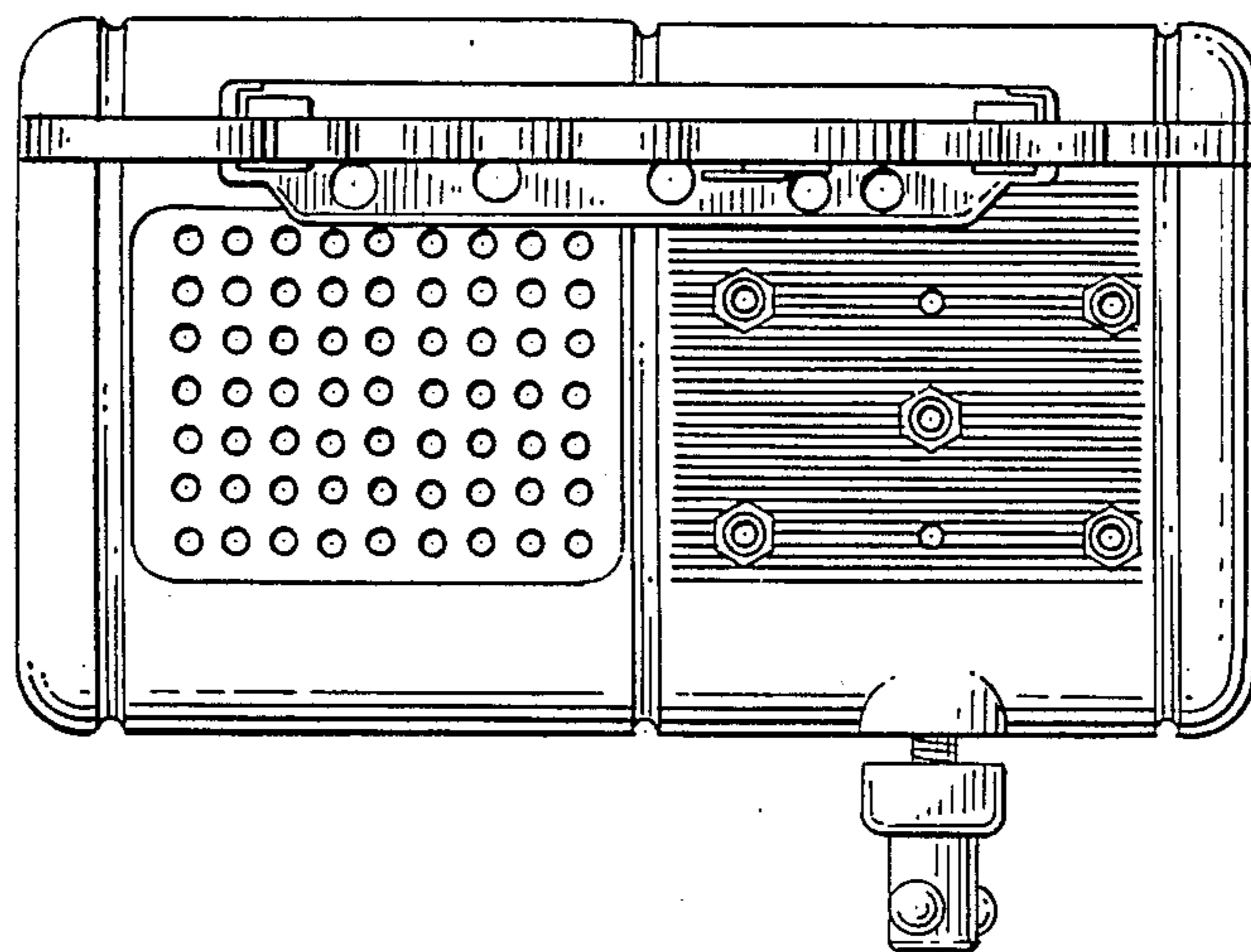

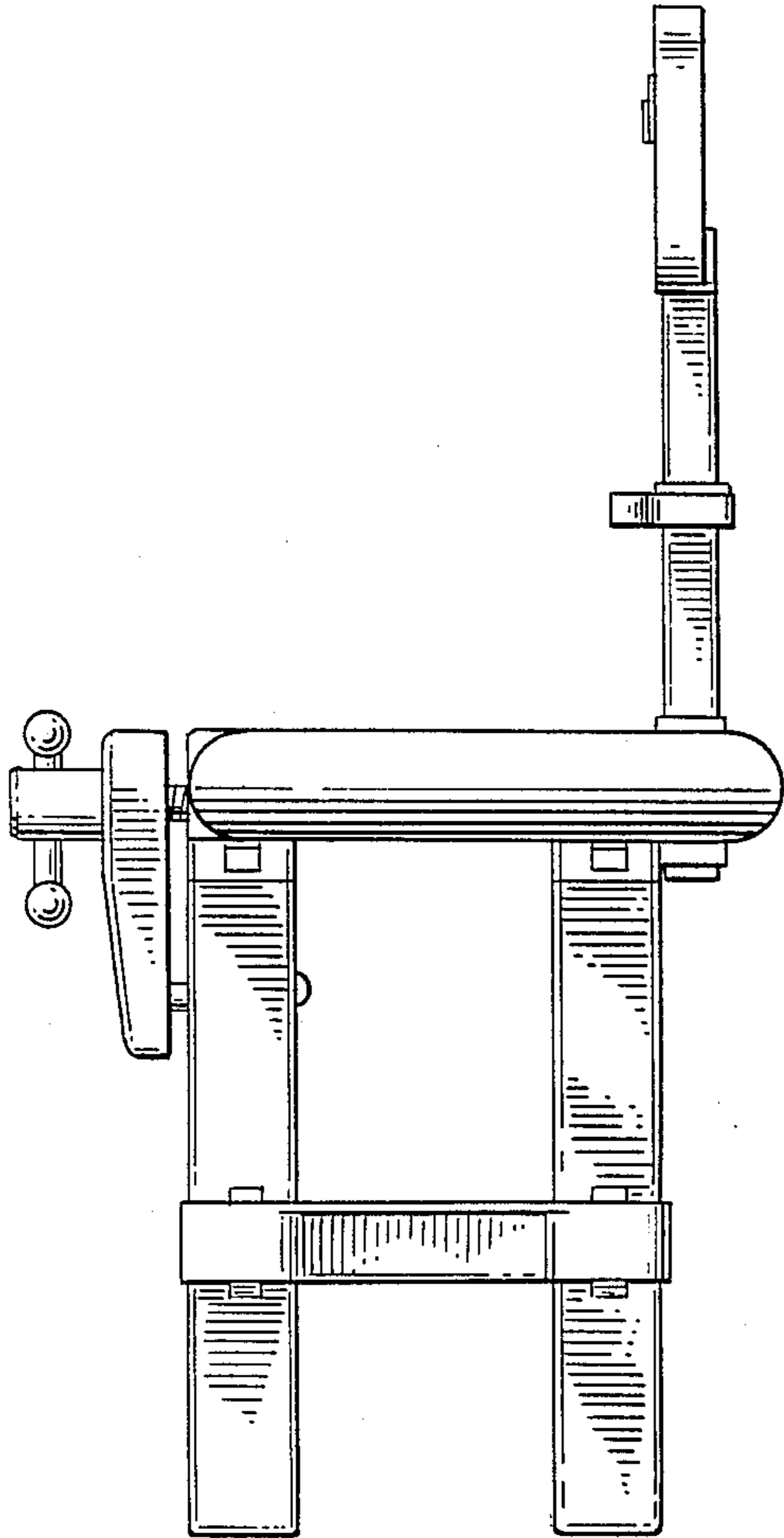

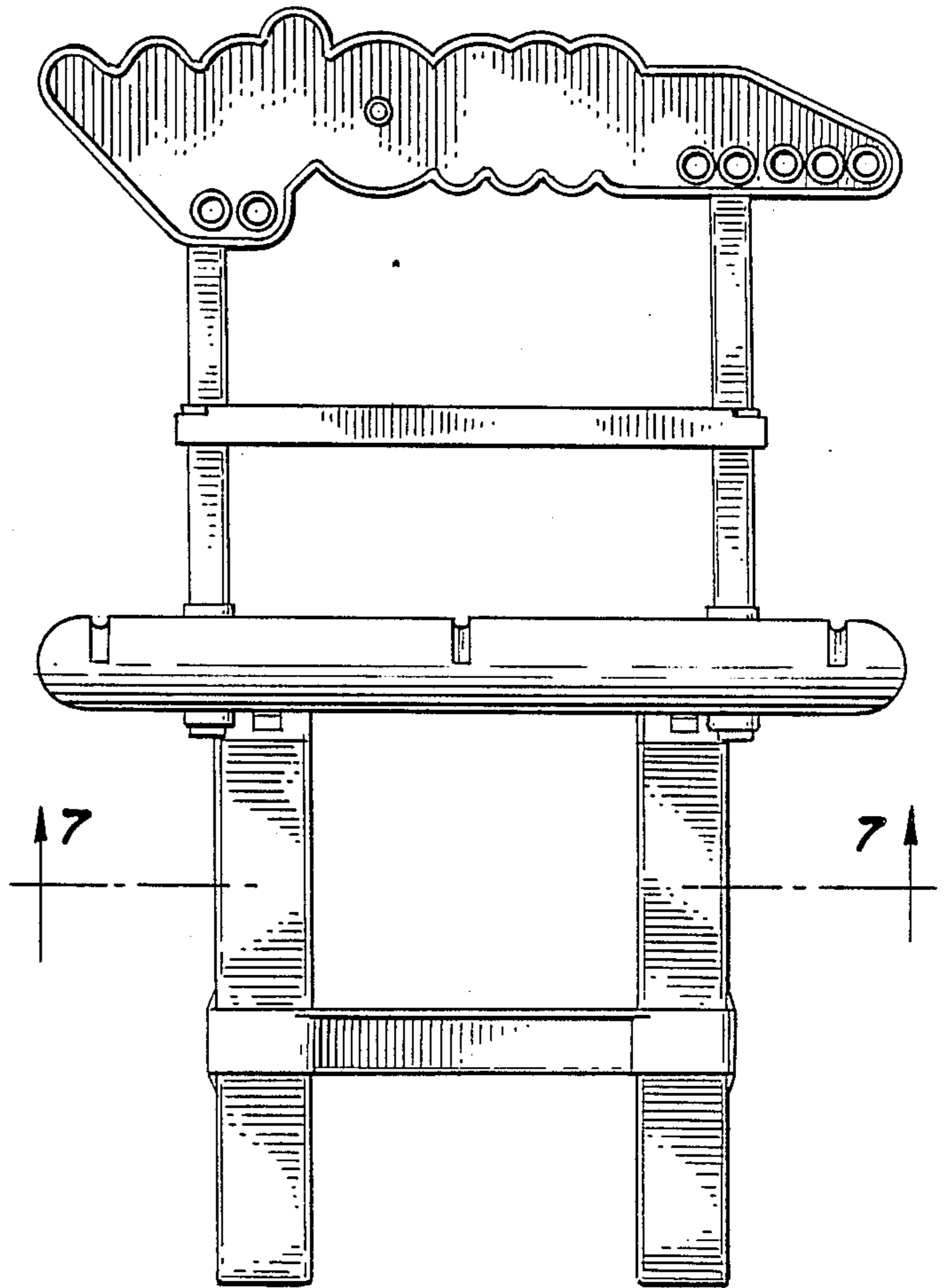

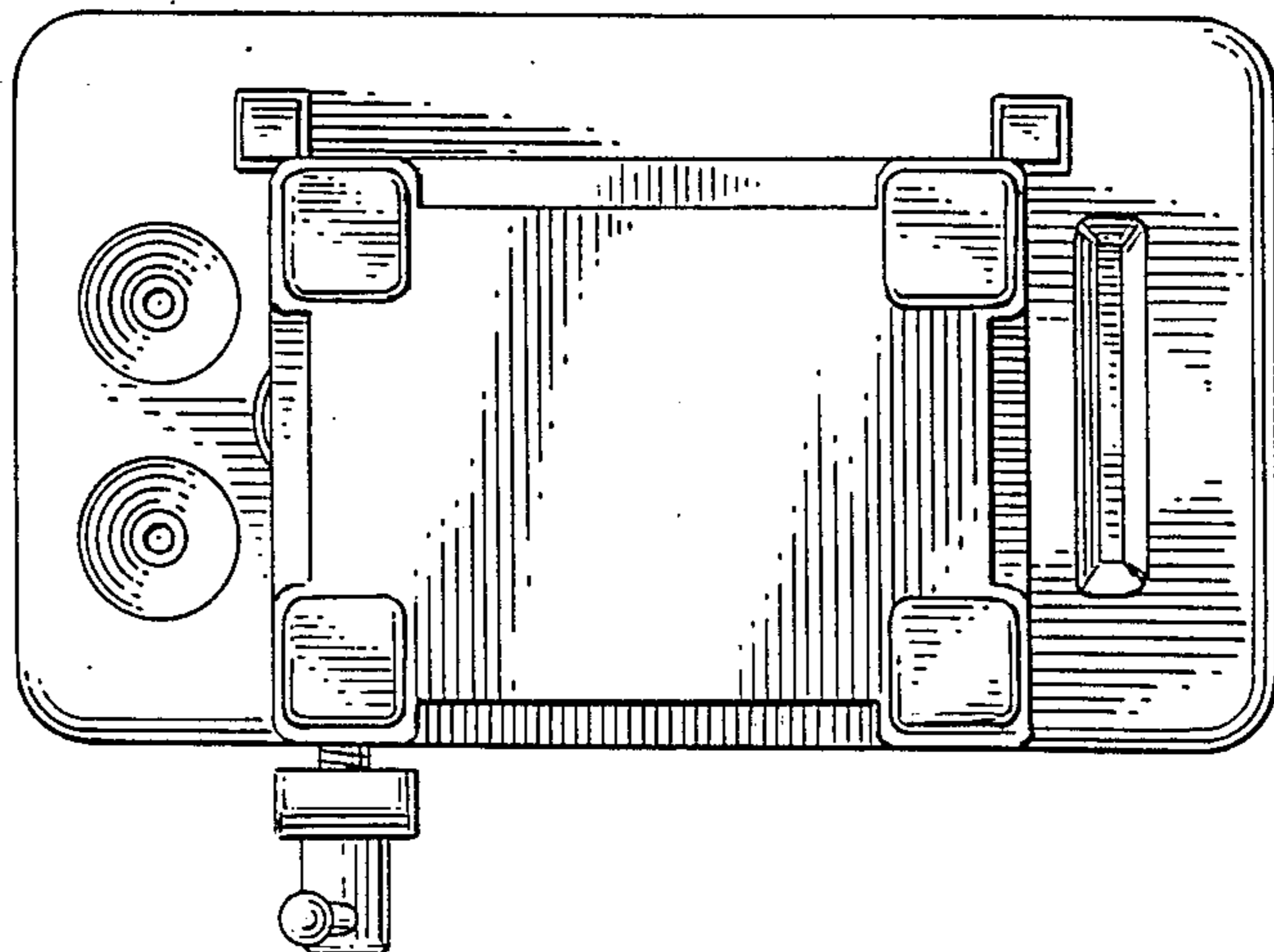

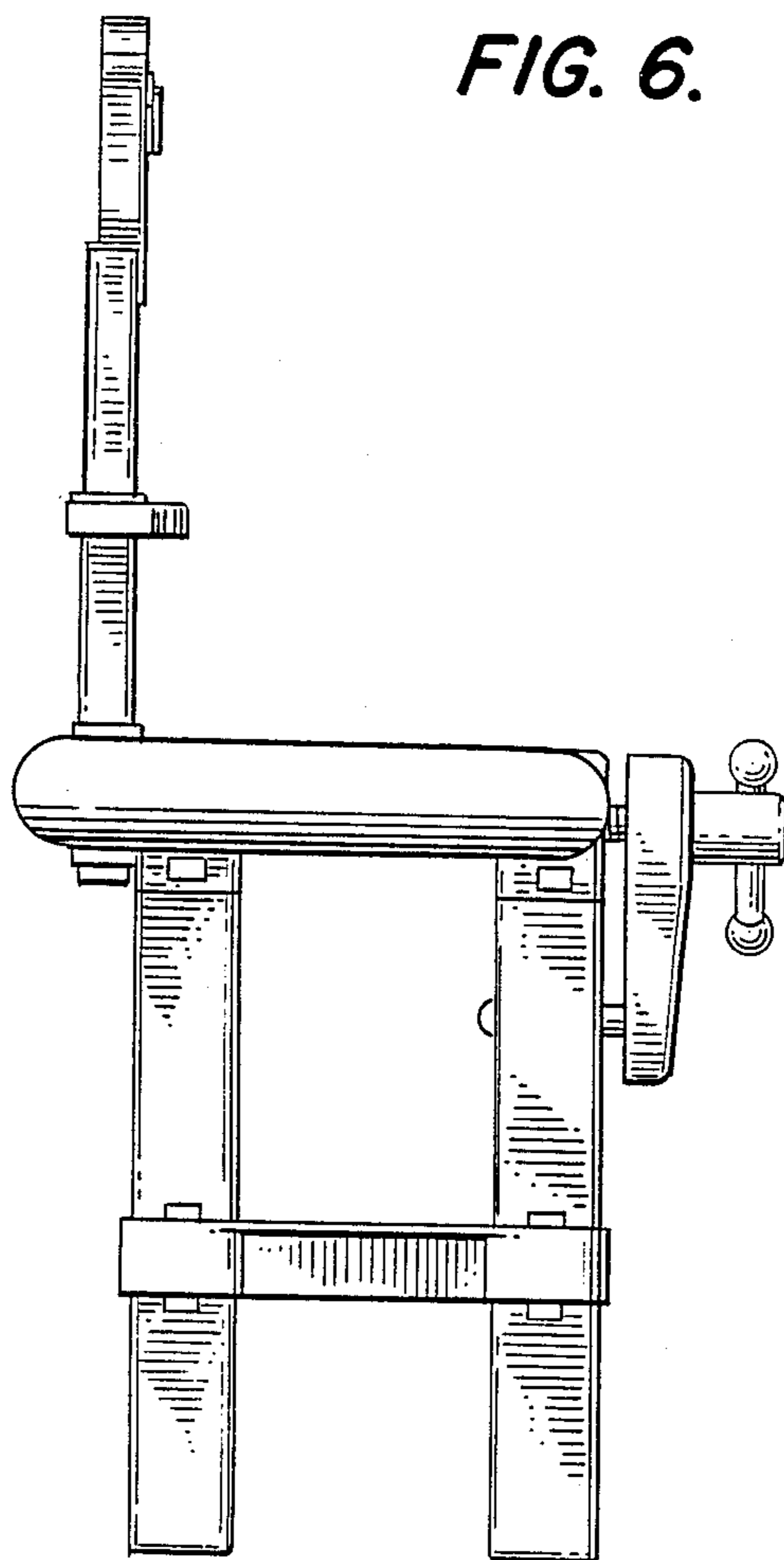
