

The ornamental design for a bus body, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an elevation view of the passenger entry side of a bus body showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is an enlarged front elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is an enlarged rear elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is an elevation view of the driver's side thereof.  
The broken line showing of the tires is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed invention.










