CLAIM

The ornamental design for a surgical appliance for incontinent women, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a surgical appliance for incontinent women, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front end elevational view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow II in FIG.

FIG. 3 is a rear end elevational view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow III in FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow IV in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow V in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is an oblique top plan view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow VI in FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is an oblique bottom plan view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow VII in FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow VIII in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 9 is a front perspective view thereof, taken from the direction as indicated by the arrow IX in FIG. 1.
